Hall of Fame/Wall of Fame Criteria

1991 HALL OF FAME/WALL OF FAME INDUCTIONS

Today, August 31, 1991, is a very special day in the history of Bellaire High School as this marks the ninth annual Hall of Fame/Wall of Fame Induction ceremonies. Today at halftime, members of the HOF/WOF will be introduced. They were officially inducted into the HOF/WOF at ceremonies occurring at the high school at 10:00 this morning.

Criteria for membership into the **HALL OF FAME** is as follows:

1. A member must be or have been a Bellaire High School student.
2. Any individual/team winning a state championship.
3. Any captain of a major college team (Major college is to be interpreted as in NCAA Division I)
NOTE: In that it was difficult determining whether some of the larger colleges were Division I at the time of the participant's captaincy, it was decided that all major colleges or universities would be considered, rather than only Division I, up to and including the 1984 school year.
4. Any First Team AP or UPI All-American selection. This will include all NCAA/NAIA Divisions.
5. Any tournament place winners (Top six places) including NCAA and NAIA.
6. Any member of the United States Olympic Team.
7. Any established member of any of the major professional teams sponsored by the United States.

(An established member is to be interpreted as two or more years of registered participation unless injured.)

NOTE: It was decided through Board-adopted policy (February, 1987) that the following would be included in the Hall of Fame policy. "Not more than two members not meeting the above criteria and selected by unanimous vote of the HOF/WOF Committee will be considered through written nomination and information to support the nomination presented to and considered by the committee. This will apply to public nominations only and will be retroactive through 1987."

Criteria for membership into the **WALL OF FAME** is as follows:

1. All Regional, District, and OVAC Championship Teams.
2. Athletes who made All-State
3. Any student who has distinguished himself/herself in athletics and has brought credit to Bellaire High School will be considered by the HOF/WOF Committee for induction through recommendations made to the committee.
4. Consideration will be given to non-Bellaire High School graduates who have distinguished themselves in athletics which have brought credit to Bellaire High School, as recommended to the HOF/WOF Committee.

The **HALL OF FAME/WALL OF FAME COMMITTEE** consists of the following people: Kelley Archer, Terry Brinker, Principal Frank Danadic, Bruce Dunlap Jr., Ken Fowkes, Board Member Dan Frizzi, Roosevelt Henry, Dave Ice, John Magistro, Leo Ragni, Chairman Tom Rataiczak, Assistant Principal/Athletic Director Mike Sherwood.

LOCATED IN THIS PROGRAM is a nomination ballot for the HOF/WOF. Anyone wishing to nominate an individual for consideration should fill this out and return it to the committee. It is important that you include as much information as possible, including photocopies of clippings, scrapbooks, etc., in order that the individual can be given strong consideration. The initial nomination ballot is usually begun in late October, with elimination ballots going into December. 1991 Hall of Fame Inductee

CHARLES TURNER '62

Charlie Turner was a 1962 graduate of Bellaire High School where he was an outstanding athlete in football, basketball, and track. In addition to lettering three year in each, Turner placed in the State track meet his senior year.

Upon graduation, Turner enrolled at Ohio University where he was a four-year performer at both the defensive and offensive end position. While at OU, he received All-Mid American Conference honors as a defensive end.

Turner later played professional football for the Edmonton Eskimos of the Canadian Football League where he received All-Pro Lineman honors for eight years. In 1975, he was awarded the Schenley Most Outstanding Lineman-of-the-Year. That same season, he received the Becket Demarco Trophy for the Most Outstanding Lineman. In 1973, Turner was voted the CFL Players' Association Lineman-of-the-Year. The following year he was selected Mac Truck Lineman-of-the-Year.

Turner, who is the 31st Inductee into the Hall of Fame, resides in Edmonton, Alberta, Canada.

1991 Wall of Fame Inductees

ERNIE BLAZEK '82

Ernie Blazek was an outstanding athlete in baseball, football, and wrestling while attending Bellaire High. In baseball, Blazek was a four-year performer and letter winner. During his senior year, he was selected to the All-OVAC, All-Valley, All-Eastern Ohio, and All-District Teams. He established records for the most triples in a game and the most hit by pitches for a season and career. As a football player, Blazek was a three-year performer and letter winner. In addition to being chosen his senior year to the All-OVAC, All-Valley, and All-Eastern Ohio squads, he was also selected to play in the OVAC All-Star game. Blazek holds the school records for most fair catches on punts for a game, season, and career. He also wrestled and lettered for three years (earning a total of ten varsity letters) and was selected captain of the 1982 squad. In 1981, he received third place honors in the OVAC Tournament (155 pounds), second place honors at the Barnesville Invitational (167 pounds), and was AAA District runner-up. During his senior year, Blazek wrestled to a 2nd place finish in the OVAC Tournament (155 pounds) and was selected Big Reds' Touchdown Club Most Valuable Wrestler. Upon graduation, he entered Ohio Wesleyan University, where he played football and baseball, lettering in football. He later transferred to Ohio University where he played football his junior year. Blazek presently resides at 502 Annarose Run, Westerville, OH 43081 where he is a business analyst programmer for ABB Process Automation.

1991 Wall of Fame Inductees

ANDREW "DUSTY" DESTIFANES '56

Andrew "Dusty" Destifanes was a four year performer and letter winner in football and a three-year performer and letter winner in track. As a junior, he scored eleven touchdowns and earned a 2nd team berth on the All-Eastern Ohio Team and a 3rd team spot on the All-Valley squad. Selected as captain his senior year, Destifanes recorded another 12 touchdowns and was accorded 1st team honors All-Valley and All-Eastern Ohio. He was also chosen Honorable Mention All-State. As a track performer, Destifanes set the school record for the shuttle hurdle team in 1955. A member of Bricklayers Local #9, he resides at 1442 Maple Avenue, Bellaire, OH 43906.

JEFFREY A. DYE '77

Jeff Dye was a three-performer and letter winner in both football and track, and a two-year performer in basketball. As a sophomore, Dye received honorable mention honors on both the All-OVAC and All-Valley squads, and held 1st team honors on these same squads his junior and senior years. His junior year, he was accorded a 2nd team berth on the All-Eastern Ohio team and was named honorable mention All-State. As a senior, Dye was named Tri-Captain, and received a 1st team berth on the All-Eastern Ohio team and a 2nd Team berth All-State. In addition, he was honored on the High School All-American team and chosen to play in the OVAC All-Star Game. Dye, who also captained the track team his senior year, held school standards for most career rushing yardage (2040 yards), most career touchdowns (26), and most touchdowns on punt returns for both a season and career (2). Dye is employed by Victory Express Inc. and resides at 4131 Central Avenue, Shadyside, OH 43947.

CARL COLEMAN JOHNSON '14

Recognized as being the oldest living Big Reds football player and the first black to play for a high school in the Ohio Valley, Carl Johnson was a four-year performer and letter winner at the guard and tackle positions on the 1910, 1911, 1912, and 1913 football squads. Playing tackle at 140 pounds, Johnson was regarded as one of the toughest to play the position, earning All-Star team honors three years in a row. The Bellaire Daily Leader, upon recognizing Johnson on the 1913 All-Star Team, stated "There was but little trouble in selecting tackles. Johnson of Bellaire is one of the quickest and toughest tackles who ever donned a high school uniform. Bellaire has been able to depend upon him all season." Upon graduation, he received a scholarship to Cheney State Teachers' College where he played, lettered, and captained the 1916 and 1917 squads. His college career was cut short in 1917 when he was drafted in the 58th Depot Brigade of the U.S. Army. Upon his release, he returned to Bellaire and was employed by J.H. McGraw and Sons. At this time, he organized and played semi-pro ball for the Peerless Athletic Club. He later was employed by the Standard Oil Company, the First National Bank, and the Farmers and Merchants Bank before joining the Postal Office in Bellaire, where he worked for 28 years until his retirement in 1965. He resides with his daughter at 4534 Franklin Street, Bellaire, Ohio 43906.

TOM MOKROS '65

Tom Mokros was a three-year performer in both football and basketball, lettering in both his junior and senior years. He received honorable mention All-Valley in basketball his junior year, and All-OVAC, All-Valley, and All-Eastern Ohio honors in football his senior year. Upon graduation, he went to Kent State University where he played football for three years, earning two letters. In addition to serving as a game captain, Mokros earned 3rd team All-MAC honors. Voted Most Improved Back his senior year, he turned down an offer to sign as a free agent with the Atlanta Falcons and went to work for The Timken Company. Mokros resides in Canton, Ohio (44718) at 6500 Drake Street.

1991 Wall of Fame Inductees

JOHN PATRONE '60

One of the last four-year performers in both basketball and football, John Patrone earned three varsity letters in both sports, and captained both squads his senior year. As a senior, Patrone earned post season honors in basketball on the OVAC, All-Valley, All-Eastern Ohio (his junior year also), and All State squads. Earning the rank of E-5 as an electronics technician, Patrone earned a scholarship to Jacksonville University where he played and lettered for one year. Employed by Xerox Corporation, he has been active on the local sports scene by serving as a Little Dribblers coach for 5 years, a 7th grade coach for 3 years, and stepped in to serve as an interim coach for Claire Cribbs during his illness. He also coached baseball for both the Bellaire Junior Sports Association and the Martins Ferry American Legion. Patrone resides at 55801 High Ridge Road, Bellaire, Ohio 43906.

BRUCE STOLZ '67

Bruce Stolz was a three-sport performer in football, basketball, and track, earning three letters in football and two each in track and basketball. As a senior, he earned 2nd team honors on the All-OVAC, All-Valley, and All-Eastern Ohio squads. Upon graduation, he entered West Liberty State College, where he played four years of football, lettering his junior and senior years. Serving as captain of the Hilltoppers his senior year, Stolz earned 2nd team All-Conference and honorable mention All-American honors. After serving as a volunteer assistant in football, Stolz returned to his alma mater in 1974 to act as assistant football, basketball, and track coach. Stolz has also seen his individual thinclads place in the State over 10 times and win the Bellaire Relays over 5 times. Stolz also was responsible for seeing Joe Galloway earn two first-place finishes in the State in 1991. Stolz also saw some semi-pro football action with the Wheeling Panthers, serving as captain of that squad. He presently works for the Bellaire City Schools and resides at 64365 Shady Lane, Bellaire, Ohio 43906.

TERRY ZONKER '82

A veteran of Operation Desert Storm, Terry Zonker earned his reputation as a four-year varsity performer in wrestling, a three-year varsity performer in football, and a two-year performer in track. He earned three letters in both football and wrestling, and captained both squads his senior year. Post season honors were accorded him as a senior in both sports on the All-OVAC, All-Eastern Ohio, and All-Valley teams, while he earned All-State honors in football. During his senior year in wrestling, Zonker wrestled his way to the championship crown in the prestigious OVAC Wrestling Tournament in the always tough heavyweight division. Zonk served eight months in Operation Desert Shield/Storm aboard the amphibious assault ship USS Iwo Jima. He was also awarded the Navy Achievement Medal for his performance.
