1992 HALL OF FAME

MARK MLYNEK ('87) 51190 Key-Bellaire Road, Bellaire, OH 43906

****** Although he participated in football, wrestling, and track all through high school, Mark Mylnek ended his high school career by earning nine varsity letters and being selected captain of the wrestling team his senior year. But it was on the mat where Mlynek attained his most success. During the giant OVAC wrestling tournament, the largest such high school tournament in the nation, he wrestled to a 7th place finish his sophomore year, a 3rd place finish his junior year, and capped his senior career by not only taking 1st place honors but also receiving the coveted Dave Bierkorte Award. During Ohio tournament action, Mlynek was a District Champion for three straight years and a Regional Champion his senior year (being Regional Runner-Up his junior season). His high school career ended in a 4th place finish at the Ohio State Tournament. Mylnek also was an OVAC track champion in the 300M hurdles and was a member of the Bellaire record-setting shuttle hurdle team. Upon graduation, Mlynek enrolled at West Liberty State College where he wrestled and lettered for four years, again being elected captain of the Hilltoppers his senior year. He was chosen to the All-Conference team his sophomore, junior, and senior years. Mlynek ended his wrestling career in the NAIA Tournament where he wrestled to a 6th place finish, making his collegiate career record a sparkling 71 wins against 21 losses. He recently graduated from WLSC with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Business Administration.

CHARLES WARD ('86), 57239 Ward Road, Bellaire, OH 43906 **

Although he tried his hand at basketball his freshman year, Charles Ward quickly discovered his greatest success was in running, as he earned eight varsity numerals during his four-year career in cross country and track. Chosen as team captain in both sports for both his junior and senior years, Ward gained post season honors in both sports as All-OVAC, All-Valley, All-Eastern Ohio for both his final years. During his senior season, he was selected as captain of the All-Valley track team. A two-time State performer in both sports, he gained a 6th and 3rd place finish in track, and a 6th and 10th place finish in cross country. In high school, he held the school and Valley records in the 1600M run (4:16.85) and 3200M run (9:24.92). Selected Most Outstanding Athlete in the 1986 OVAC Track Meet, Ward also received MVP cross country honors at BHS his sophomore, junior, and senior seasons. Upon graduation, he enrolled at Marshall University where he ran and lettered in both cross country and track all four years. Selected as captain of the cross country team his junior and senior seasons, and tri-captain of the track team his senior year, Ward received All-Conference recognition his freshman year in cross country (9th place), his sophomore year in indoor track (3rd in the 4 x 400), and his junior year in cross country (8th). He helped set the Marshall University record in the 4 x 1500M relay and had the following personal bests: 1500M run (3:55), 300M Steeplechase (9:16.77), 5,000M run (15:16), and 10,000M run (32:16).

1992 WALL OF FAME

KELLEY ARCHER ('40), 56259 High Ridge Road, Bellaire, OH 43906 ** Those faithful who have attended Big Reds' football games over the past years know they can always expect to see certain things: hard-nosed football, exciting action, and Kelley Archer sitting in the stands. A long time supporter of BHS football, Archer, since his graduation from Law School in 1950, has only missed FOUR Bellaire games! A 1940 graduate, he is a virtual encyclopedia of Bellaire's gridiron history, being able to recall plays, players, fields, and conditions. His keen knowledge of the sport made him one of the first members of the Hall of Fame/Wall of Fame Committee, and his memory has assisted many former grid greats receive their just induction. After law school and three years in the US Army during World War II, Archer returned to the Valley where he has been an attorney in Bridgeport since the early fifties. A longtime member of the Big Reds Touchdown Club, he has served for years on the organization's scholarship committee. But perhaps Archer's greatest service to the Big Reds was his dedication to the Bippus Banquet. For 31 years, he saw the wishes of Howard and Jess Bippus carried out as squad after squad of Big Reds were served a meal topped off with all the ice cream they could eat. Carrying the banquet through some lean times, he saw that each year a former Big Red who had made a name for himself return to speak to that year's team, encouraging them to make something out of their lives. This is easily seen today as former Bippus attendees are eager to return to repay the favor. Although he has "retired" from the Bippus scene, Archer still practices law, and still follows the Big Reds.

RICHARD FRIZZI ('72), 1201 Washington Street, Bellaire, OH 43906 ** Although he participated in varsity football and basketball during his sophomore, junior, and senior years, earning three football letters and two basketball letters, Dick Frizzi will be remembered for his exploits on the gridiron. Frizzi was a two-way starter both his junior and senior years, captained the Big Reds his senior year, and earned numerous post-season honors his final year. He was selected First Team All-OVAC, All-Valley, and All-Eastern Ohio, and made Special Mention All-State. Frizzi also made the *Intelligencer* "Honor Roll" First Team Ohio Valley Big Schools and earned a berth on the Region 12 All-Star squad. Recognized repeatedly for his line blocking and downfield blocking, Frizzi earned Lineman-of-the-Week honors his junior year, and during his senior year recorded 25 catches for 300+ yards, 47 solo tackles, 18 assisted tackles, two interceptions, and one safety. An alternate for the Ohio North-South Game, Frizzi played in the Ohio-West Virginia All-Star Game where he scored a touchdown, intercepted a pass, and had several tackles. Frizzi also was a two-way starter in the OVAC classic. After graduation, he played on a championship slo-pitch softball team in Bellaire, participated in the summer basketball league for several years, and played in the flag football league, going to the State tournament three years. An employee of Wheeling-Pittsburgh Steel, Frizzi was chosen in 1988 to be one of three facilitator/co-ordinators at the Yorkville Mill for their Co-Operative Partnership Agreement Program. For the past several years, he has been active in the Bellaire City Schools Declining Enrollment Committee, 2000 Committee, and the Levy Committee. Married to the former Kim Mylnek, Frizzi has three children, Derek, Rachael, and Audra.

CONNIE HIBBITTS ('81), 4160 Franklin Street, Bellaire, OH 43906 ** When you go back looking at girls' athletics and their attempt to gain equal recognition, Connie Hibbitts has to be considered one of the pioneers. An outstanding athlete, Hibbitts not only participated in volleyball, basketball, and softball for all four years of high school, but she also lettered in them, earning a total of twelve varsity letters. Her leadership skills became evident early, as she was chosen to lead the Lady Reds in volleyball and softball her sophomore, junior and senior years, and in basketball her junior and senior years. Her performances earned MVP honors in volleyball her sophomore year, in softball and basketball her junior year, and in all three sports her senior year. The first girl to score 1000 points in basketball, Hibbitts set the school record of 52 points in a game against Buckeye South. Her post-season honors included All-OVAC and All-Valley in basketball and softball both her junior and senior year, and honorable mention All-State in basketball her junior year. Hibbitts finished her athletic career in the Ohio-West Virginia All-Star Softball game, but not before she placed girls' athletics at Bellaire High School on the track to equality and respectability.

MIKE JOHNSON ('68), 1003 Atlantic Avenue, Apt. 784, Columbus, OH 43229 ** Although he participated in three sports while attending BHS, Johnson was most successful during track season. Few people have established a record that has stood for over a quarter of a century, but Johnson's 13'4 1/2" pole vault standard has never been surpassed. On his way to setting this mark, Johnson broke the Bellaire record six times. During his senior year, he captured first place honors in both the Bellaire Relays (where he set the school record) and the OVAC meet. Johnson also shared the co-holder honor of the All-Time Valley record with Steubenville's Jim Mavromatis. Johnson has spent considerable time assisting Bellaire athletes with their vaulting techniques, most recently his son, Ian, who could have had a shot at the record except for being sidelined his junior year with a back injury. He served as Co-Captain of the track team his senior year and was selected MVP at its conclusion. Johnson was also a three-year letterman in wrestling and not only was a member of the school's first wrestling team in 1966 but was also selected Most Valuable Performer as a sophomore. He repeated this honor his senior year as well as being selected Co-Captain. He currently resides in Columbus where he works for the Department of Taxation as an Assistant Administrator.

RICHARD KALISIESKI ('38) (Deceased), 1777 Arlington, Lincoln Park, MI 48146 ** A four-year participant in football, Kalisieski lettered his junior and senior years, but it wasn't until the end of his junior year that the 5'10," 190-pound end started to develop and receive attention from area coaches and writers. During his senior year, he received Honorable Mention, All-Valley honors as an end, as well as All-State honors. Kalisieski was the only grinder from this district to be selected for a first-team berth. Upon graduation, he received a scholarship to Ohio State University, but chose not to attend. Kalisieski served three years, eight months, with the United States Army, rising to the rank of First Sergeant. It was on the baseball diamond after high school, however, where Kalisieski established himself as one of the top pitchers in the UMWA league playing for the Neffs Co-Op team. A veritable one-man pitching machine, he garnered 23 victories in 26 starts one season. Teaming with Wall-of-Famer Alfred "Tater" Havelka, Kalisieski was primarily responsible for Neffs winning the Southern Division Championship of the United Mine Workers of America League. He enjoyed a no-hitter game, as well as several two-and three-hitters. Employed for years by Modern Cam in Michigan, Kalisieski served five years on the Economic Development Board for the city of Lincoln Park, Michigan.

1992 WALL OF FAME

DR. PETER LANCIONE ('24), 3609 Belmont Street, Bellaire, OH 43906 ** You don't need to list all the honors and awards received by Dr. Lancione to tell of his expertise and dedication. You only have to talk to the hundreds of Big Reds who he treated, the thousands of patients he has seen, or the number of families he started and treated even through today. Although he "retired" from the medical field, Dr. Lancione still continues to see patients daily; patients who have known and trusted him for a lifetime. For over a quarter of a century, Dr. Lancione served Bellaire High School as the team physician. He received national recognition in 1960 when he halted the Bellaire-Marietta football game due to the heat. He was awarded the Outstanding Team Physician Award by the Ohio High School Athletic Association, and was recognized by the Bellaire Touchdown Club for his outstanding service to the Bellaire athletic program. In 1982, Lancione was recognized as the Outstanding Alumnus by the Bellaire High School Alumni Association. He also received the Community Service Award from 97WK Radio. Honored by the Ohio House of Representatives for Outstanding Professional Achievements, Dr. Lancione has served as a member of the Ohio State Medical Board for twenty years, acting as President twice.

SCOT MAFFE ('85), 1253 Birch Street, Bellaire, OH 43906 ** Earning a total of nine varsity letters at BHS, Scot Maffe participated in baseball for four years and basketball and football for three years. Serving as captain of all three sports his senior year, Maffe reaped numerous post season honors. He was First Team All-Valley in all three sports, All-OVAC in three sports, All-Eastern Ohio in football and basketball, and First-Team All State in baseball. Maffe still holds several baseball records at BHS, including: At Bats (Season, 105), Singles (Career, 84), Doubles (Game, 3), Triples (Game, 2), RBI's (Game, 6), Runs Scored (Career, 95), Stolen Bases (Game, 4; Season, 33; Career, 55), Innings Pitched (Season, 76; Career, 202 1/3), and Wins (Season, 12; Career, 26). He also earned First-Team All-Eastern Buckeye League in all three sports his junior year before Bellaire dropped from the league. Maffe was elected to play in the OVAC All-Star Football Game, The OVAC All-Star Basketball Game, All-State Baseball Game, and played on the OVAC All-Star Baseball Team both his junior and senior years. Upon graduating from Bellaire, Maffe went to Ohio University where he played baseball for three years, lettering his sophomore and junior seasons. Graduating in 1989 with a B.S. Degree in Special Education, Maffe currently teaches at Beallsville High School.

PAUL MARCHESE ('74), 53451 Key-Bellaire Road, Bellaire, OH 43906 ** If you mention kicking to a BHS football aficionado, the name Marchese has to be among the top. Coming from a family of kickers, Marchese played four years of football at BHS and earned two letters. Post-season honors following his senior season included first team place kicker All-OVAC, All-Valley, and All-Eastern Ohio. However, it was at Kent State University that Marchese developed into an outstanding place kicker. Playing four years and lettering two, he was selected First Team All-Conference MAC his junior and senior years. His career field goal record was 35 out of 55 for a .636 percentage. During his senior year, playing only 10 of the 11 games due to an injury, Marchese won the NCAA, Division I, field goal championship by booting 18 out of 27 attempts for a .667 percentage or 1.80 FG's per game. Included in this was a school record-setting 51-yard field goal against Bowling Green, which still stands today. Upon graduating from KSU in 1978 with a BS in education, Marchese had a brief tryout with the Oakland Raiders. Returning to the Valley, he began teaching at the School of Hope, where he established a productive Special Olympic Program. After ten years of work, he was responsible for developing a one-fifth mile paved track for the school. In 1982, along with Mary Rataiczak, Marchese started Rat and Cheese Photography, which is currently celebrating ten years in business.

THOMAS E. RATAICZAK ('64), 64960 Breezy Point Lane, Bellaire, OH 43906 ** Although he never participated in any organized sports at Bellaire High School, Rataiczak has been actively involved with the athletic department at BHS since he returned to teach in 1968. Perhaps associated with basketball more than any other sport, he has served as the statistician/scorekeeper for the boys for the past 22 years. During this time he has published an article on basketball statistics in Scholastic Coach magazine and has developed, copyrighted, and published two scorebooks/statistic systems. He has been honored to keep the score for the Holiday Basketball Tournament, the Detroit Pistons/Indian Pacers game, and worked the OHSAA Girls' State Basketball Tournament. Under the tenure of Mark Matz and Gene Ammirante, Rataiczak was responsible for designing the gym floor, pennants, locker room, and record board. For the past five years, he has also served as the statistician for the girls' basketball team. In 1980, Rataiczak became a member of the OVAC Basketball Classic Board of Directors, and has served as program director/scorekeeper for the past 12 years. Renamed the Samuel A. Mumley All-Star Basketball Classic, he also serves as the Secretary/Treasurer of the Board. Rataiczak has been on the BHS HOF/WOF Committee for 10 years, serving as Chairman for the past 5 years. In this capacity, he was responsible for creating the WOF display in the cafeteria and redesigning/refurbishing the current HOF portraits. In 1987, along with Dave Liberati and Mike Sherwood, Rataiczak was responsible for creating the Bellaire High School Sports Foundation, Inc. and has served on its Board of Directors since. The Foundation is responsible for overseeing the Claire Cribbs Scholarship, the Football Memorial Scholarship, and the Johnson & Johnson Student/Athlete Scholarship. For the past ten years, Rataiczak has been responsible for all of the high school athletic records. His Media Writing classes maintain the football display, basketball record boards, and the Archives. A teacher for twenty-five years, he is married to the former Linda Sue Kahl and has two children: a daughter, Sheri McAninch, who currently teaches at First Ward Elementary School, and Terry, a sophomore at Wheeling Jesuit College.

Hall of Fame/Wall of Fame Criteria

1992 HALL OF FAME/WALL OF FAME INDUCTIONS

Today, September 12, 1992, is a very special day for Bellaire High School. This afternoon is the tenth annual Bellaire High School Hall of Fame/Wall of Fame Inductions. Today at halftime, members of the HOF/WOF, Class of '92, will be introduced. They were officially inducted into the HOF/WOF at ceremonies occurring in the high school gymnasium at 11:00 this morning.

CRITERIA FOR THE HALL OF FAME

1. A member must be or have been a Bellaire High School student.
2. Any individual or team winning a State Championship.
3. Any captain of a major college team (major college to be interpreted as in NCAA, Division I.
(NOTE: This criterion will be eliminated this year. It will be up to the discretion of the HOF/WOF committee to use this standard when considering induction.
4. Any "First Place Team" AP or UPI All-American selection. This will include all NCAA divisions, including NAIA.
5. Any Top Six place winners (Tournaments). This will include all NCAA divisions, including NAIA.
6. Any member of the United States Olympic Team.
7. Any established member of any of the major professional teams sponsored by the United States ("Established Member" is to be interpreted as two or more years of registered participation, unless injured).

NOTE: It was decided, through Board-Adopted Policy, February, 1987, that the following would be included in the Hall of Fame policy. "Not more than TWO members not meeting the above criteria selected by a unanimous vote of the Hall of Fame/Wall of Fame committee each year will be considered through written nomination presented to and considered by the committee.

NOTE: It was decided that no person will be inducted into the Hall of Fame OR Wall of Fame until he/she has been out of school at least FIVE years.

CRITERIA FOR THE WALL OF FAME

1. All Regional, District, and OVAC championship teams.
2. All athletes who made All-State, First Team
3. A student who has distinguished himself/herself in some area of athletics and has brought credit to Bellaire High School will be considered by the HOF/WOF committee for induction through recommendations made to the committee.
4. Consideration will be given to non-Bellaire High School graduates who have distinguished themselves in some area of athletics which has brought credit to Bellaire High School, as recommended to the HOF/WOF committee.
5. The Wall of Fame can include persons for any area of service to Bellaire High School athletics: booster, coach, newspaper writer, etc.
