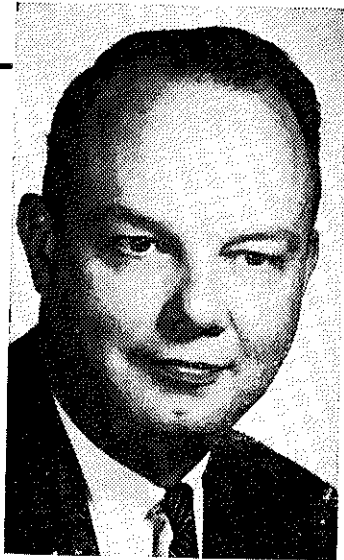

**FOUR STEPS TO A BETTER WEST VIRGINIA**

**1.—ROADS**

CECIL UNDERWOOD has built more miles of high-ways than any other Governor in West Virginia's history. HAROLD NEELY is presenting a comprehensive highway program, an award winning plan for the complete improvement of our State's roads.

**2.—SCHOOLS**

The Incentive plan for school improvement, emphasizing local initiative and local control, was pioneered in West Virginia by UNDERWOOD and is supported by NEELY.

**3.—INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT**

The Economic Development Agency was created by UNDERWOOD to coordinate state, federal and local industrial development efforts. NEELY proposes the establishment of a State Department of Commerce, to centralize all economic development efforts.

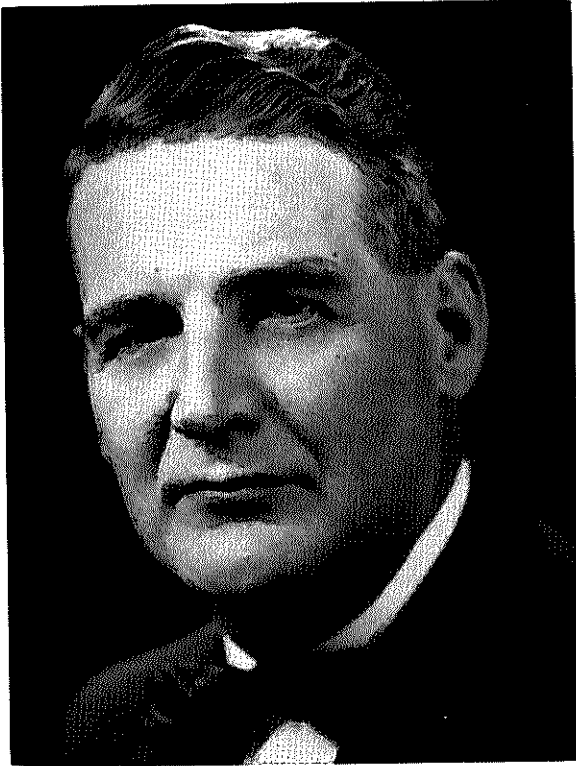

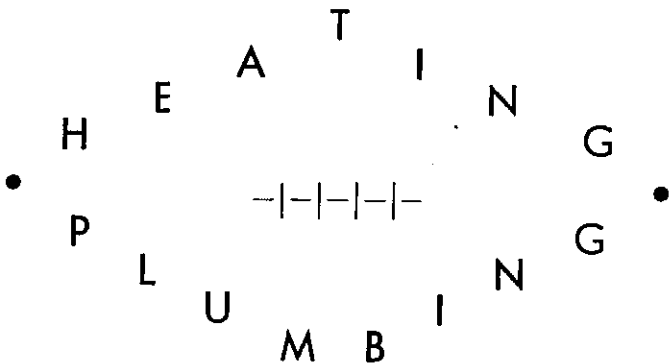

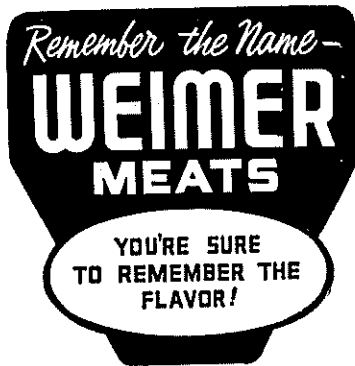
