# RULES OF THE GAME

**This game is sanctioned by the West Virginia Secondary Schools Commission, the Ohio High School Athletic Association, and the National Collegiate Athletic Association, and will be played under the following special rules:**

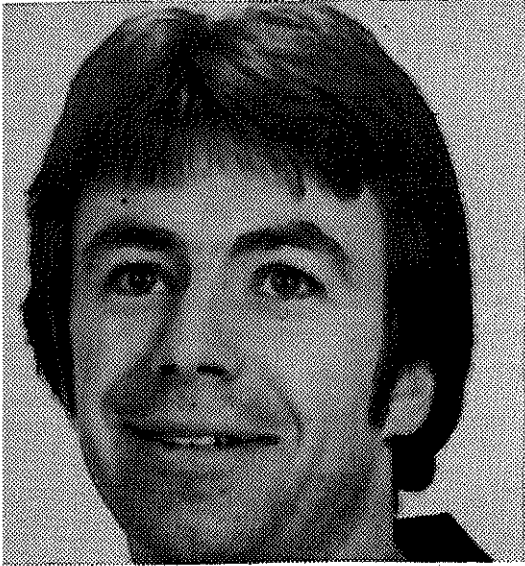


- . Man-to-man defense must be played in the normal attack area.
- . A zone press may be used, but must end after the first trap past the half court line.
- . Each player must play one complete quarter during the first half. This is to be an uninterrupted 15 minute period during the game. The only exceptions to this rule would be if a player suffers from an illness, injury, or would have accumulated his third personal foul during the first half.
- . All players must be inserted into the game at least once during the second half unless the player is injured, or ineligible.
- . All quarters will be of eight (8) minute duration.
- . Dunking will be permitted during the pre-game warmup.
- . In case of an overtime, one extra period of a three (3) minute duration will be played. If the game is still tied at this point, a second "sudden death" overtime will be played. The winner will be the first team scoring two CONSECUTIVE points.
