



the major sport attractions in the Ohio Valley.



OVAC WRESTLING FORMAT

A Wrestling Tournament, open to all schools and all classes, will be held in January of each year. A special rotating award will be presented to the over-all champion. In addition, trophies will be presented to the teams scoring the most points in each of the four classes as well as runner-up trophies in each class.

Rules Governing Conference Dual Meet Championships

1. Each school must wrestle five (5) different OVAC opponents in any class.

2. Points shall be awarded as follows:

- a. For defeating a AAAA opponent 4 points (tie 2 points) b. For defeating a AAA opponent - 3 points (tie 1½ points) c. For defeating a AA opponent - 2 points (tie 1 point)
- d. For defeating a A opponent 1 point (tie ½ point)
- 3. One superior point shall be awarded to a winning team every time his defeated opponent wins.
- 4. Any school involved in a tie will be awarded ½ point for each team that its tied opponent defeats.
- 5. No points shall be awarded for defeating a Non OVAC opponent.
- 6. If two schools wrestle each other more than once, only the first meet shall count towards the Champion-
- 7. The final Championship AVERAGE will be determined by dividing the number of OVAC matches into the total number of accumulated points.
- 8. The Home Team must report the results of all meets to one of the local newspapers The Wheeling News Register or Intelligencer, The Martins Ferry Times Leader, or The Steubenville Herald.
- 9. All schedule contracts must be honored in order to count in conference ratings unless contract violates state rules.
- 10. Schedules must be complete and in the hands of: Mr. Ron Mauck of Brooke High School Wellsburg, West Virginia 26070


You may call him at (304) 527-1410. Mr. Mauck will be in charge of all stats, standings, and team and individual records. All schedules must be in the hands of Mr. Mauck no later than November 1. If not done by then you will not be eligible for the dual meet championship.

11. Awards - The dual meet champion in each class will be awarded a pennant.

Rule 9

Scoring

SECTION 1 Individual Match Scoring

ART. 1 . . . Match scoring shall be kept in plain view of spectators. contestants and coaches. It is strongly recommended a visible match timing device be available.

ART. 2 . . . When a takedown has been earned, the wrestler shall be

awarded 2 match points.

ART. 3 . . . When the defensive wrestler earns an escape while the supporting parts of either contestant are inbounds, he is awarded 1 point.

ART. 4 . . . The defensive wrestler who is successful in gaining a reversal while the supporting points of either wrestler are inbounds, is

awarded 2 points.

ART. 5 . . . The wrestler in the advantage position is awarded 2 points for a near-fall. When the criteria for a near-fall are met continuously for 5 seconds, the offensive man shall be awarded 3 points after the situation is ended. A visual hand count, to determine the 5 seconds, shall be used when feasible.

ART. 6 . . . Penalty points, because of infractions occurring during competition, shall be awarded in accordance with the penalty chart.

SECTION 2 Team Scoring

ART. 1 . . . In dual meet competition, scoring is based upon the results of each individual match as follows:

(a) for each match won by default, disqualification, fall or forfeit, 6

points shall be added to the team's total;

(b) for a superior decision, 5 points shall be added to the team score, a major decision earns 4 team points and a regular decision earns 3 points;

(c) in case of a draw, 2 points shall be scored for each team.

ART. 2... In tournaments, individual placement points shall be awarded as soon as earned. Placement points already earned shall be deducted in case of forfelt (other than injury) or disqualification. Points for team scoring shall be awarded as follows:

(a) 2 team advancement points shall be scored for each match won in the championship bracket except for the final first place match. If a wrestler receives a bye in the first round, he shall be awarded 2 advancement points for that round if he wins his next match. No points are award-

ed for the bye if the wrestler loses his next match;

(b) 1 team advancement point shall be scored for each match won in the consolation elimination except for the final third and fifth place matches. A wrestler who has a bye in the consolation round shall receive one advancement point provided he wins his next round match;

(c) 2 additional points shall be scored for each match won by default,

disqualification, fall or forfeit throughout the tournament.

(d) 1 additional point shall be awarded for each match won by a superior decision and 1/2 additional point awarded for each match won by a major decision:






