WELCOME

I would like to take this opportunity to welcome you to the 6th Annual OVAC All-Star Basketball Classic. I hope the games are as enjoyable for you as they are to the players. Our hopes and beliefs are that basketball is the greatest of games and that it teaches many of the real life situations our All-Stars will face after their playing days are over. This story expresses our thoughts:

THE GAME OF LIFE AND THE GAME OF BASKETBALL

1. Both games must have a schedule to follow. In BASKETBALL, a team plays 20 games plus the tournament, has 5 time outs, plus numerous substitutions. In the game of LIFE there is but one game—no tourney—no time outs and no substitutions. You must play the whole game your entire life.
2. Both games have boundaries within which you must remain. In BASKETBALL, the black lines are 84' by 50'. But in the game of LIFE, your morals are your only boundaries.
3. Both games have team members—a BASKETBALL team is composed of 12 members, but only 5 can play at one time. In the game of LIFE, the 5 members have great reputations. They are: faith, hope, charity, honesty, and loyalty.
4. Both games must have goals for which to aim. In BASKETBALL, the goal is 10 feet high, 18 inches in diameter and made of steel. But in the game of LIFE, the goals have no dimensions; they are the Gates of Heaven.
5. Both games have rules to govern the play. BASKETBALL is a book with numerous rules. One says the game is to start with a jump ball. Many games begin with the "Lord's Prayer" in the dressing room. Some gyms may have special ground rules. In the game of LIFE, there are but 10 rules—"The Ten Commandments." These are to be played in strict accordance with your own religion. "The Golden Rule" is the only ground rule in the game of LIFE.
6. Both games must have officials to enforce the rules. In BASKETBALL, there are two officials. But in the game of LIFE, God is the referee and the soul official. He makes all the rules and there is no appeal of them.
7. In both games you must practice to be a champion. A champion in BASKETBALL must practice during the off season. But to be a champion in the game of LIFE, practice must never cease.
8. Both games have scoreboards. The electrical scoreboard in BASKETBALL lets you know where you are at all times. But in the game of LIFE, the only scoreboard is your conscience.
9. Both games are played with a ball. A BASKETBALL is an inflated piece of leather 29½ inches in circumference. In the game of LIFE, the ball is your immortal soul. Hold on to it. See what you can do with it.

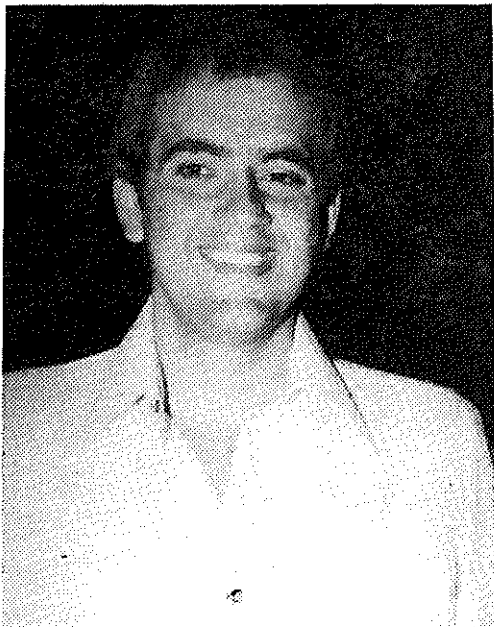
Rules of the Game

THIS GAME IS SANCTIONED BY THE WEST VIRGINIA SECONDARY SCHOOLS COMMISSION, THE OHIO HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION, AND THE NATIONAL COLLEGIATE ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION, AND WILL BE PLAYED UNDER THE FOLLOWING SPECIAL RULES:

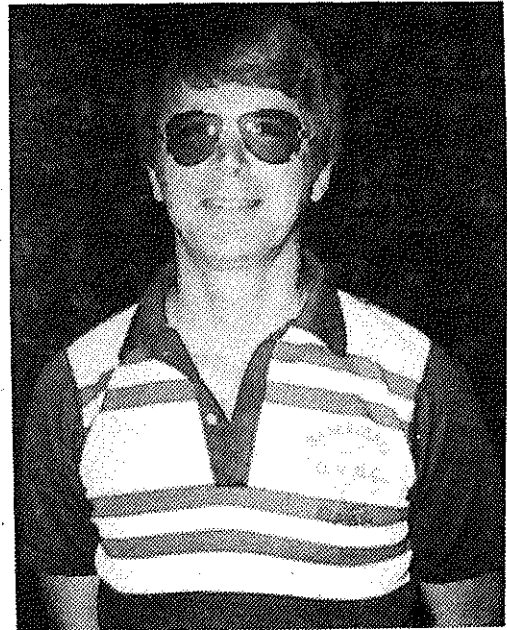
1. Each game will consist of four eight-minute quarters.
 2. Zone presses may be used, but must end after the first trap past half court.
 3. Man to man defense must be played in the normal attack area.
 4. Each player must play one complete, uninterrupted quarter during the game. The only exceptions to this rule would be if a player suffers from an illness or injury or would have accumulated his third personal foul during the first half.
 5. All players must be inserted into the game at least once at some other point in the game unless the player is ill, injured or ineligible.
 6. Dunking will be permitted during the pre-game warm-up.
 7. In the event of a tie score at the end of regulation play, a three minute overtime period will follow. If the game is tied after the first overtime period, a sudden-death playoff period will be held. The team that scores the first TWO CONSECUTIVE points will be declared the winner.
 8. Each player is allowed six (6) personal fouls before he is disqualified.

"Thanks, Earl"



You can't mention the OVAC All-Star Basketball Classic without mentioning the name of Earl Haberfield.

Seven years ago, in the lobby of the Holiday Inn in Steubenville, Earl, along with Wellsville's Bobby Dawson and Buckeye South's Hank Lazasz, decided that there was enough interest in an all-star game to create one, and the Classic was born. A year of hard work and discouraging setbacks followed, as approval from the NCAA was sought, an underwriter in the form of Ogden newspapers was found, formats had to be determined, the OVAC had to grant approval, principals had to be questioned, and the list went on. What started as a neat idea soon grew into a full-time job for Earl, who was to become the game's director for five years.

A graduate from West Liberty State College, Earl began coaching in 1958 at Wheeling Central High School, where he produced state champion squads in 1959, 1962, 1963, 1964, and 1966. His 1963 team was the number one team in all classes of West Virginia squads and the only undefeated team in the school's history. From there he went to Bishop Donahue, producing another state champion in 1969.

Before resigning from coaching in 1972 to spend some time with his family, Earl coached at

Warren Local High School in Vincent, Ohio, where he was the Tri-Valley Coach-of-the-Year. The following year he came out of retirement at Crooksville High School where his squad made it to the District playoffs before being defeated by a powerful Charlie Huggin's Indian Valley South squad.

In 1974, Earl moved to Wintersville for five years, and then to Meadowbrook for two. This past year, he coached one of the smallest schools in the state at Vanlue High School. With only SIX players on the varsity squad, he ended the season 11-9. Over his career, Earl has fashioned a 293-183 record. During the past 23 years, he has touched the lives of hundreds of athletes and built the programs for many school districts.

Earl presently resides in Vanlue, Ohio, with his dedicated wife, Joyce and their 16 year old son, Pat. They also have two other children, John, 23, and Connie, 21.

The Ohio Valley and the OVAC Basketball Classic lost a driving force when Earl Haberfield moved this past year. Without his total commitment to the sport of basketball and his willingness to work for what he believed in, the OVAC Classic wouldn't be here tonight. So this evening we welcome back the game's creator and simply say, "Thanks, Earl."
