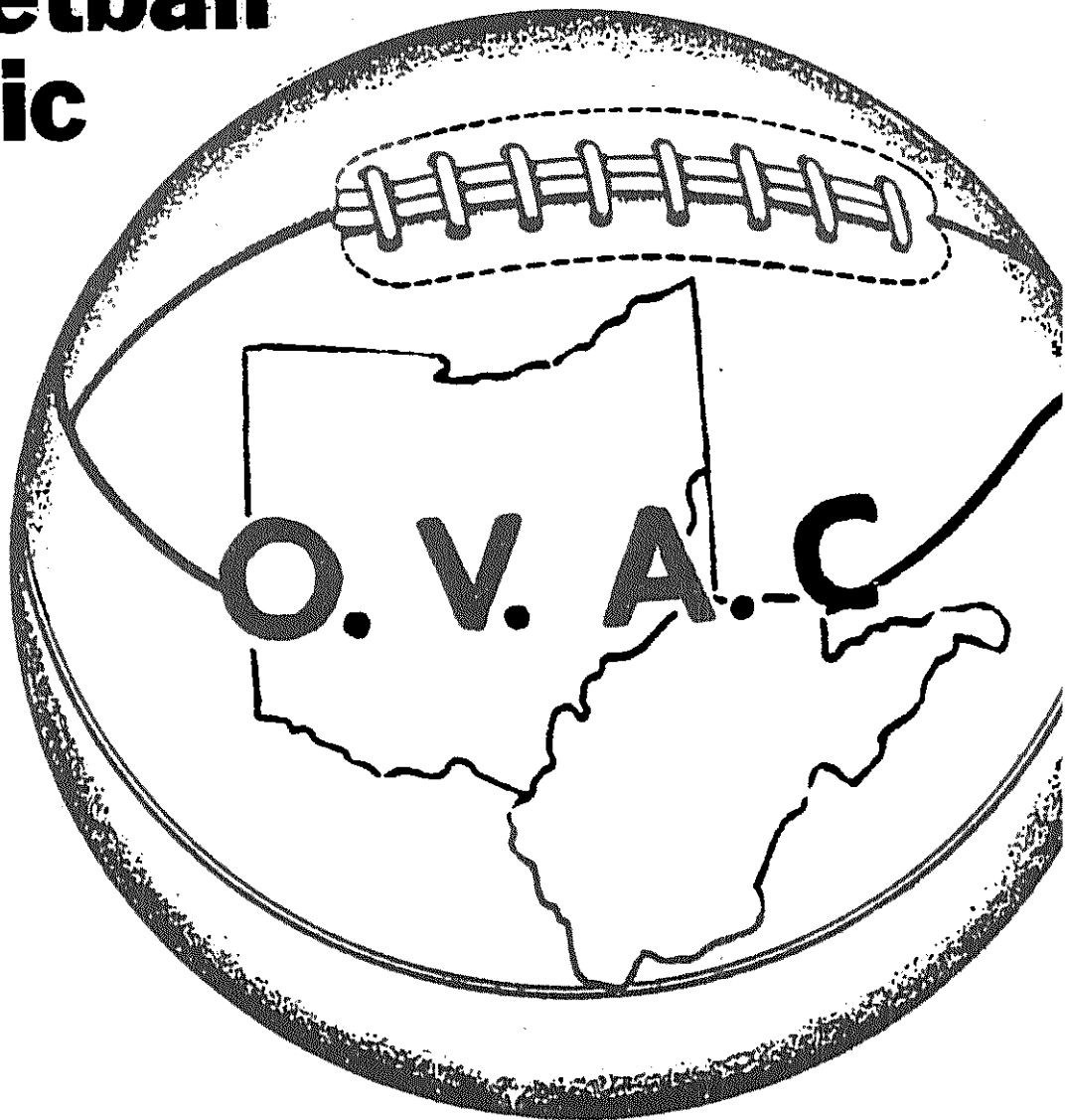

WELCOME

I would like to take this opportunity to welcome you to the 7th OVAC All-Star Basketball. I hope the games are as enjoyable for you as they are to the players. Our hopes and beliefs are that ball is the greatest of games and that it teaches many of the real life situations our All-Stars will face when their playing days are over. This story expresses our thoughts:

THE GAME OF LIFE AND THE GAME OF BASKETBALL

1. Both games must have a schedule to follow. In BASKETBALL, a team plays 20 games in a tournament, has 5 time outs, plus numerous substitutions. In the game of LIFE there is but one tournament—no time outs and no substitutions. You must play the whole game your entire life.
2. Both games have boundaries within which you must remain. In BASKETBALL, the boundaries are 84' by 50'. But in the game of LIFE, your morals are your only boundaries.
3. Both games have team members—a BASKETBALL team is composed of 12 members, but only 5 can play at one time. In the game of LIFE, the 5 members have great reputations. They are: faith, charity, honesty, and loyalty.
4. Both games must have goals for which to aim. In BASKETBALL, the goal is 10 feet high and 18 inches in diameter and made of steel. But in the game of LIFE, the goals have no dimensions; they are the Gates of Heaven.
5. Both games have rules to govern the play. BASKETBALL is a book with numerous rules. The first rule says the game is to start with a jump ball. Many games begin with the "Lord's Prayer" in the dressing room. Some gyms may have special ground rules. In the game of LIFE, there are but 10 rules—"The Ten Commandments." These are to be played in strict accordance with your own religion. "The Golden Rule" is the only ground rule in the game of LIFE.
6. Both games must have officials to enforce the rules. In BASKETBALL, there are two officials, but in the game of LIFE, God is the referee and the soul official. He makes all the rules and there is no appeal of them.
7. In both games you must practice to be a champion. A champion in BASKETBALL must practice during the off season. But to be a champion in the game of LIFE, practice must never cease.
8. Both games have scoreboards. The electrical scoreboard in BASKETBALL lets you know your score at all times. But in the game of LIFE, the only scoreboard is your conscience.
9. Both games are played with a ball. A BASKETBALL is an inflated piece of leather 29½ inches in circumference. In the game of LIFE, the ball is your immortal soul. Hold on to it. See what you can do with it.

Rules of the Game

THIS GAME IS SANCTIONED BY THE WEST VIRGINIA SECONDARY SCHOOLS COMMISSION, THE OHIO HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION, AND THE NATIONAL COLLEGIATE ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION, AND WILL BE PLAYED UNDER THE FOLLOWING SPECIAL RULES:

Each game will consist of four eight-minute quarters.

Zone presses may be used, but must end after the first trap pass on half court.

Man to man defense must be played in the normal attack area.

Each player must play one complete, uninterrupted quarter during the game. The only exceptions to this rule would be if a player suffers from an illness or injury or would have accumulated his third personal foul during the first half.

All players must be inserted into the game at least once at some other point in the game unless the player is ill, injured or ineligible.

Dunking will be permitted during the pre-game warm-up.

In the event of a tie score at the end of regulation play, a three minute overtime period will follow. If the game is tied after the first overtime period, a sudden-death playoff period will be held. The team that scores the first TWO CONSECUTIVE points will be declared the winner.

Each player is allowed six (6) personal fouls before he is disqualified.

The three-point goal will be in effect for all contests.

Even in the early days of his coaching career, you had an inkling that Dick Potts was destined for greatness.

Though he's only in his mid 50s, Potts has become a living legend in Ohio Valley basketball coaching circles.

He's the only coach in valley history to have achieved more than 500 victories. He's coached for 33 years, all in his native Monroe County and he's been at River High in Hannibal for the last 21 seasons.

The Ohio Valley Basketball Coaches Association and the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference is paying tribute this evening to Coach Potts for his many coaching achievements and contributions to his profession and for being one of the founders of the OVAC Cage Classic.

Numerous honors have been bestowed upon the Hannibal native who earned his bachelor's degree at Marietta College and has his master's in guidance and counseling.

He's been Eastern Ohio, Eastern District and Ohio Valley coach-of-the-year and has received several special achievement awards from the Dapper Dan Club of the Upper Ohio Valley.

His most prestigious honor, however, was receiving the Paul Walker Award, the highest honor presented by the Ohio High School Basketball Coaches Association. He was only the seventh coach to receive the award named after the long-time and highly-successful Middletown coach.

Coach Potts' first assignment was at little Bethel High nestled in the hills of southwest Monroe County.

It was here that he first gained



state-wide recognition at the state's smallest (total enrollment in grades was 29, including boys), he guided the team past several powerhouses into the OVA A Tournament in Columbus. Those days, there were few classes in Ohio, so the state tournament was more difficult.

As the Blackhawk story soon received attention and Coach Potts' kids swept the heat throughout much of the state. The Cinderella story, however, as the Bethel point to Gratis.

When Bethel was chosen to become part of Skyway, Coach Potts became the head coach. Success continued to come his way. From Skyway, he moved to his present position.

Coach Potts has a reputation of taking his successes to the next level. But, he has always been surrounded by the young men who play for him and went on to achieve their own success in the profession. Most notable group has been Ed Boyer and his standouts at Bethel. Coach Potts coached at Strasburg for nearly 300 career victories. Another member of the Blackhawk team, Gary is now his loyal assistant at River High.

Coach Potts and his former Ruth Allen of E. Point, are parents of a daughter, Linda Bessel, and three grandchildren.

For more than three decades, Richard Potts has been an integral part of the Ohio Valley coaching fraternity. We join many friends, fellow coaches and former players in saying thank you to a man who is truly a living
