Bridgeport wins state wrestling championship



Bulldogs Tolarchyk, Hehr, Douglas triumph

A richly-deserved reward for nine years of sweat, work and perserverance came to Coach George Kovalyk and Bridgeport High School Saturday night at St. John Arena as a magnificent Bridget wrestling team broke the Cleveland area's stranglehold on the state schoolboy championship.

Winning three individual titles, one runner-up spot, and a third-place medal, the battling Bulldogs piled up 60 points to capture top honors in the two-day meet concluded at Col-

umbus Saturday night. They finished 15 points in front of second-place Maple Heights, which nosed out Cleveland John Marshall by two points for the runner-up trophy.

Garfield Heights finished fourth with 28 points, followed by Bedford with 26; and Lakewood with 25; Fremont with 24; Whitehall with 19; Euclid's defending champs and Cleveland South with 18 apiece; Huron, Cleveland West Tech and Martins Ferry with 15 each; Beaver Local, Toledo Rogers and Mayfield with 14 apiece; Willoughby North with 13; and Mantua with 11. In all 59 teams took part in the state meet and

Bridgeport stood head and shoulders above them all at the finish.

Bridgeport is the first state wrestling champion to be crowned outside the Cleveland area since Wadsworth, near Akron, was the winner in 1942 and only the second non-Cleveland school to win since the state meet was inaugurated in 1938.

The Bulldogs had experienced a near miss in 1955, when the Kovalick matmen were runners-up to Bedford. They were third in '56 when Maple Heights began a two-year regime, but it wasn't until Saturday night that they succeeded in breaking through the Cleveland barrier.

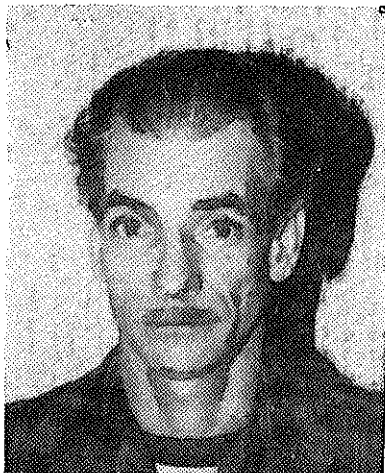

Bridgeport repeats as OVAC mat champ

After winning the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference championship for the sixth straight year, Bridgeport High's wrestlers looked forward to the defense of their Eastern Ohio district championship in a two-day tournament at East Liverpool.

Bridgeport was clearly the class of the field in the OVAC tourney last Saturday at Martins Ferry gym but the Bulldogs may find stiffer opposition at the Pottery City, where some 15 schools are expected to send grapplers into competition Friday and Saturday.

Seven Bulldogs won OVAC crowns and two more took runner-up honors in their respective weight classes as Coach George Kovalick's squad piled up a total of 70 points.

Martins Ferry, loser only to Bridgeport in 16 dual meets this season, made an impressive

showing in finishing second to the Blue in the conference meet. Like the Bridgets, Ferry qualified nine grapplers for the finals. Three members of the John Vrotsos-coached team won titles.

Bridgeport and Ferry far out-distanced the rest of the field. Weirton finished third, Barnesville was fourth, Steubenville was fifth, Wheeling was sixth while Linsly Institute, with its previously undefeated Johnny Dezio being edged by Bridgeport's Ted Wierzbicki in the first round, failed to score.

Four members of the unbeaten Bridgeport squad repeated as OVAC titlists. Captain Art Hehr became a three-year conference titlist as the defending state champion ran his victory string to 39 in a row. The complete summary of the conference finals follows:

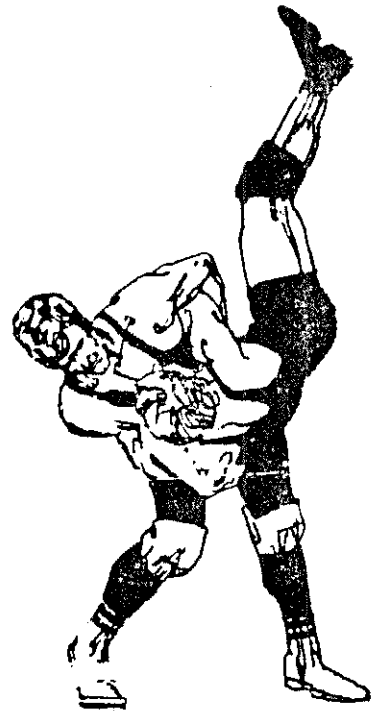
