Ferry Retains OVAC Mat Crown

Having retained the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference championship with a decisive triumph in the annual conference tournement last Saturday at their home gym, Marina Ferry High's westlers will turn to a Tuesday night engagement with Whitehall, a power of the Central Ohio district.

Tuesday night's engagement will be the final dual meet of the campaign for the Purple which on Saturday of this week goes into the Eastern Ohio district fourmey as the defending champion and tabeled the team to beat."

In winning the conference crown for the second straight year, the Ferrians piled up 71 points, compared to 42 for runnerup 71 points, compared to 42 for runnering Bridgeport, which had won the OVAC title saven successive limes before being detinioned by the Purple last February, Steubenville finished third with 40 points while the defanding West Virginia state champion, Weirton, was a distant fourth with 21, Gelbawed by Moundsville with 12, Wheeling with 7, Brilliam with 3, and Wheeling Central and Powhatan's frat-year forces with 2 widers. Martins Ferry Coach John Vrotsos, whose energetic efforts have built the Purple Ridders into a mall power, saw his charges win berinks in the finals in ten of the 12 weight classes during Saturday's tourney eliminations, which started in the afternoon and ware concluded with the situate bouts on a night-lime program.

Actually, Ferry nad the conference championship sawed up even before the finals began but the Ridders added further luster to their crown when they copped five individual littles. Winning championships for the Purple were Alten Jackson at 103 jounds. Co-Captain Johnny Edwards at 127, Joe Reasbeck at 154, Johnny Scordos at 165 and Co-Captain Bill Yeager at 175.

Bridgeport had six finalists but only two

Bridgeport had six finalists but only two champs — Captain Jack Dyson at 120 pounds and Don Foriney at 145. Steubenville, with five finalists, produced three champs in Wilbert Williams at 133 pounds, Valentino Jackson at 138, and Heavyweight Ron Mazzaterro. Weinton was able to

eight hon Mazzaterro. Werton was able to qualify only two grapplers for the ultimate round but both of them, Mike Crain at 95 pounds and Pat Alesse at 112 won. Never in the history of the conference has its wrestling tournament produced more close matches. Three bouts, two of them finals went divertime before being decided. Two finals were decided by 1-0

scores and another by a referee's decision.

Upsets spiced the program, in at least the linias, the championships went to boys who avenged regular-season losses in the titular battles.

trular battles. There were 24 pins scored in the first round of the tourney and nine in the semi-finals but only two in the championship bouts, one of those being achieved by Jackson, the Martina Ferry junor who stopped Birdgeport frashman Ron Kasper in 1 min, 39 secs. of the second period of the 103-pound final and the other being attained by husty Mazzaferro when the Steubenville heavyeight trapped Neal Hartzell of Birdgeport early and avenged a regular-season defeat by scoring a pin in 28 secs. Mazzaferro had been forced to come from behind in the third period to climinate Welton's George Harvey In the semi-finale.

semi-finale.

There were only two 1981 individual utilists in the tournament and both repeated — atthough in different weight classes than last year. Ferry's Yeager, champ at 154 pounds last February, won at 175 this time, his final against Bridgeport's Ron Scott being halted at the end of the second period when Scott sustained a recurrence of a kneelingury Scott, behind a 8-0 score at the time, was forced to a default.

Ferry's other co-captain, Edwards was

Ferry's other co-captain, Edwards was the other repeater. He won at 138 as a junior and at 127 as a senior. His final with Steubenville's Clyde Putman was one of the thrillers of the night. Putman had deleated Edwards by one point during a regular-season encounter but the two grapplers were had at 5-5 when regulation graphers were ned at 5-5 when regulation time ran out Saturday night. They wrestled through a pair of one-minute overtime periods without a score but Edwards got the nod on a split decision — the referee and one of two judges voting for the Rider

The only wrestler to carry a perfect season's record into the tournament, Bridgeport's Dave Kovalick, saw his string analyse at 11 frumphs when he dropped a 3-1 nod to the ultra-promising Martins Ferry sophomore, Johnny Scordos, in an exciting final. Scordos scored a takedown and a riding time, scoroos scored a taxebown and a riding time point to get even for a 2-0 regular-season loss to the Buildog stand-out. In the semi-finals, Scorodos had a close call against Wexton's Gary Bepler but battled to a 3-2 overtime decision.

Ferry's other winner, Reasback, a fastimproving junior, piled up a 9-3 decision over Steubenville's 154-pounder. Dick over Statioshyllis s 154-pounder, Dick Tressler. However, two other Statioenville wreatters, Williams and Jackson, scored decisions over Ferry's Deaton brothers in the linels. Williams, at 133, nosed out Date Deaton, 2-0, while Jackson, at 138, topped Larry Deaton, 4-2, in a battle of spoho-

Weirton crowned the first champ of the night when little Mike Crain, a sophomore, took a 8-2 decision over Moundsville's Dan Pastillong in their 95-pound scrap. Weir's other winner was Alless who averaged a previous loss so Ferry's Floch Srider by nosing out the blond Rider junior, 1-0, in overtime, it was a heartbreaker for Srider as Alless scored the only point on an escape with just one second laft in the overtime of the 112 time!

Another 1-0 loser was Ferrian Bill Brown Another 1-0 loser was herrian bile brown, who saw Bndgeports Dyson reverse an earlier setback by achieving an escape point to gain the decision at 120.

Bndgeport's other champ, Fortney, also won from a Rider, Bob Lucas, 5-1, in the 145 limit.

Bridgeport Coach Ron Calovini, who had entered the fournament without representation at 112 or 138 pounds because several of his grapplers were it, said after the matches that he thought "the roof had caved in during the last three matches" as Kovalick and Hartzell were upset and Scott was forced to retire because of his leg minury. But the Bulldogs nevertheless staved off Steubenville by two points in the duel for runnerup honors.

Rich Gregor (Springfield): "With friends like you, Bender, I don't need enemies!"


Rick Link (Union Local): Now I know what the 'Kish-of-Death' is!"
