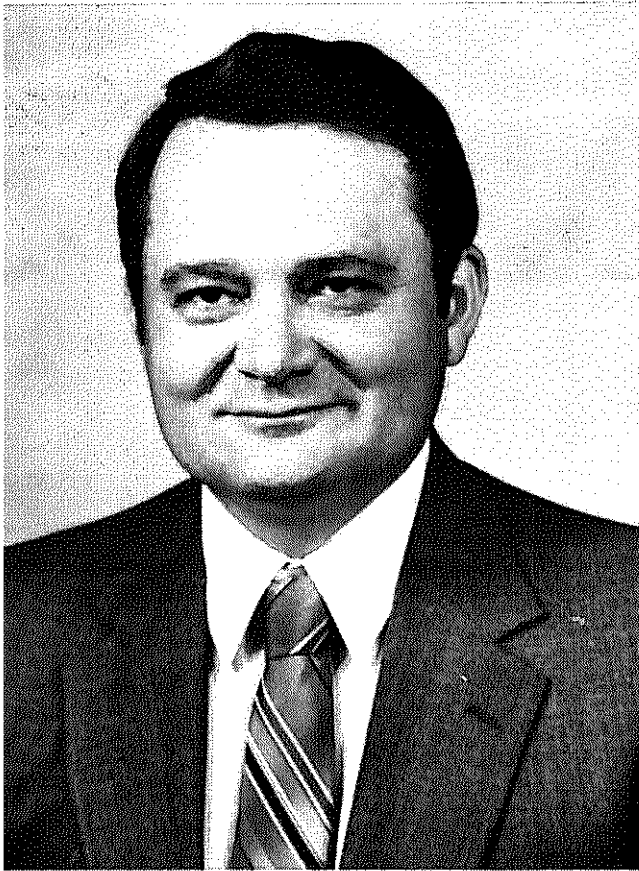

We do not hesitate to say the tournament is actually a demonstration of high character, good conduct, under the rules of the game, and an ethical relationship with one's opponent.

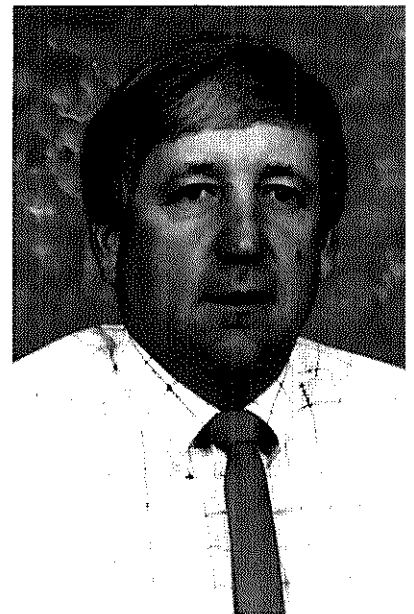
