MIKE IMBROSCIO

Mike Imbroscio epitomizes the truest example of a "student athlete." But more than that, Mike Imbroscio has faced adversity after adversity in his life - and prevailed!

At the spry young age of seven, Mike Imbroscio early lost his left leg (which was impaled by an iron-fenced fence) while playing near his home. After several operations and the loss of muscle, Mike was faced with the realization of a deformed leg.

Just accepting such an unfortunate ordeal and leading a sedentary life would have been enough for most of us; however, Mike Imbroscio didn't see it that way. Not only did he excel as a student the remainder of his elementary school years, but in fourth grade he decided to take a shot at pee-wee wrestling. Look out, world!

By his sophomore year at Bellaire High School, Mike was wrestling varsity as a 98 pounder. Even though his left leg was still weak, Imbroscio was able to achieve a 13-13 record that season - and his confidence was growing by leaps and bounds.

Still, Mike and his family were plagued with tragedy. After his first year as an aspiring varsity performer, his loving mother, Donna, passed away. Supporting each other, Mike Imbroscio and his immediate family survived the crisis and devoted their lives to excellence as a tribute to a fine lady.

It was full steam ahead his junior year. Mike Imbroscio lined up like an athlete possessed at wrestling practice; following workouts, he exercised to strengthen his left leg. That season, he went 25-9, placing 4th in the OVAC Tournaments at 105 pounds.

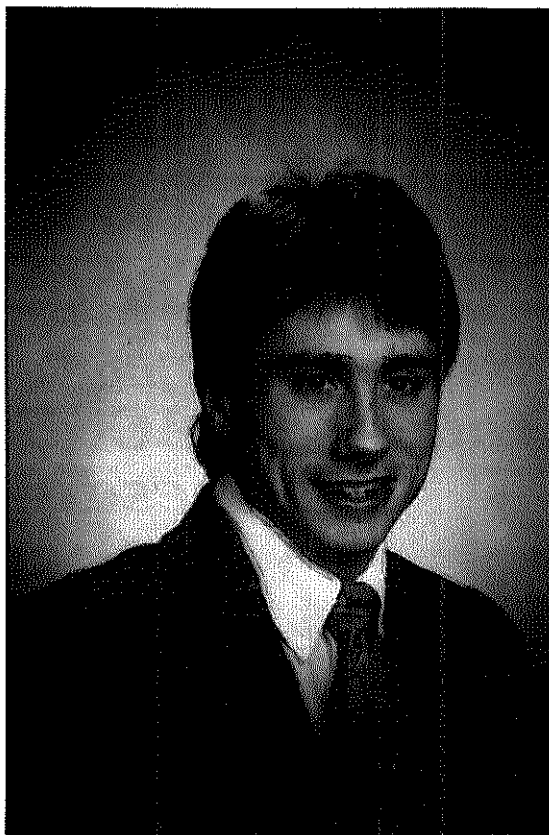
By his senior year, there was no stopping him. Mike Imbroscio was crowned the 1986 OVAC Champion in the 112-pound weight category, defeating Oak Glen's victorious multiple state and OVAC champ, John Crain, 6-1 in the finals. Many thought it was a miracle, but Mike viewed it as self-ordained destiny.

Mike ended his brilliant wrestling career with nearly 70 victories over a three-year span, which included championships in the Barnesville, Watkins Memorial, OVAC, and Sectional Tournaments by the end of his senior season. But his success doesn't end on the mats.

Mike Imbroscio is also a whiz in the classroom. In his efforts as a student, Mike was the 1986 recipient of the George Kovalick Scholarship for his astute academic abilities. He graduated from Bellaire High School in 1986 as a "tri-valedictorian" in the college preparatory curriculum. Mike matriculated to Ohio State University, studying pre-law and graduating Magna Cum Laude (with high honors) in the spring of 1990. Because of his excellence in academics, Mike Imbroscio was accepted last fall to the most prestigious law school in the country - Harvard University. Not bad for an Ohio Valley product who never forgot his roots.

Mike Imbroscio has no room for excuses or self-pity in his life. His story of personal determination and perseverance in overcoming adversity should be an inspiration to us all. There are individuals in this world who exemplify the highest ideals of the human psyche - and Mike Imbroscio is truly one of those "special few."

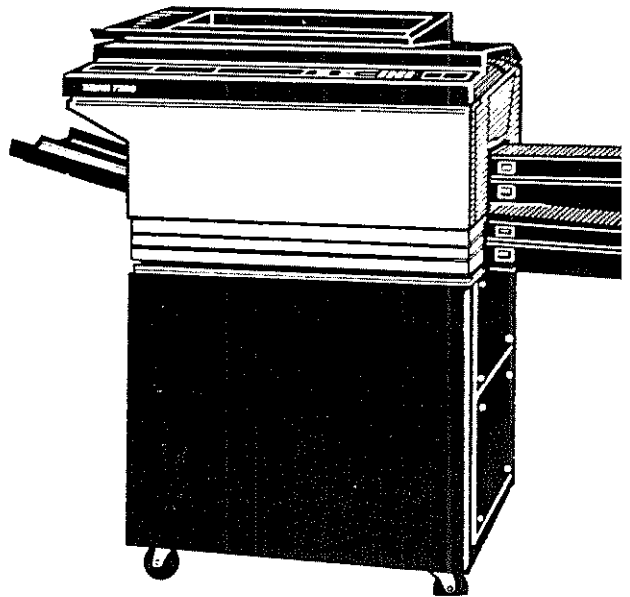

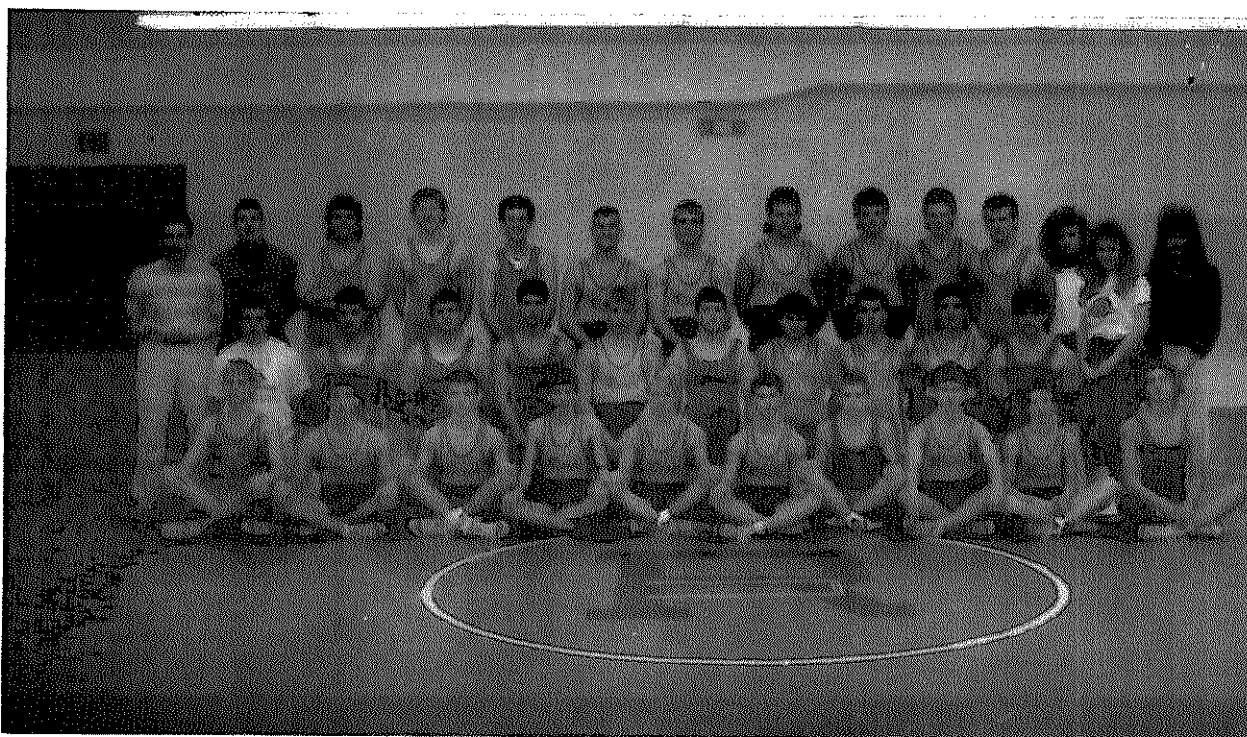
