At the sprite young age of seven, Mike Imbroscio arly lost his left leg (which was impaled by an ironiked fence) while playing near his home. After several erations and the loss of muscle, Mike was faced with

Just accepting such an unfortunate ordeal and ing a sedentary life would have been enough for most us; however, Mike Imbroscio didn't see it that way. ot only did he excel as a student the remainder of his mentary school years, but in fourth grade he decided take a shot a pee-wee wrestling. By his sophomore year at Bellaire High School,

ke was wrestling varsity as a 98 pounder. Even though left leg was still weak, Imbroscio was able to achieve 13-13 record that season - and his confidence was

owing by leaps and bounds.

Still, Mike and his family were plagued with gedy. After his first year as an aspiring varsity permer, his loving mother, Donna, passed away. Sup-rting each other, Mike Imbroscio and his immediate nily survived the crisis and devoted their lives to ellence as a tribute to a fine lady.

It was full steam ahead his junior year. Mike ined like an athlete possessed at wrestling practice; I following workouts, he exercised to strengthen his I leg. That season, he went 25-9, placing 4th in the AC Tournament at 105 pounds.


By his senior year, there was no stopping him. ke Imbroscio was crowned the 1986 OVAC Champion he 112-pound weight category, defeating Oak Glen's ulous multiple state and OVAC champ, John Crain, 6-1 the finals. Many thought it was a miracle, but Mike wed it as self-ordained destiny.

Mike ended his brilliant wrestling career with orly 70 victories over a three-year span, which included impionships in the Barnesville, Watkins Memorial, 'AC, and Sectional Tournaments by the end of his ior season. But his success doesn't end on the mats.

Mike Imbroscio is also a whiz in the classroom. his efforts as a student, Mike was the 1986 recipient of George Kovalick Scholarship for his astute academic lities. He graduated from Bellaire High School in 1986 ı "tri-valedictorian" in the college preparatory curricu-n. Mike matriculated to Ohio State University, studypre-law and graduating Magna Cum Laude (with h honors) in the spring of 1990. Because of his excelce in academics, Mike Imbroscio was accepted last fall the most prestigious law school in the country rvard University. Not bad for an Ohio Valley product o never forgot his roots.

Mike Imbroscio has no room for excuses or self-, in his life. His story of personal determination and severance in overcoming adversity should be an in-ration to us all. There are individuals in this world o exemplify the highest ideals of the human psyche l Mike Imbroscio is truly one of those "special few."






