We do not hesitate to say the tournament is actually a demonstration of high character, good conduct, under the rules of the game, and on ethical relationship with one's opponent.

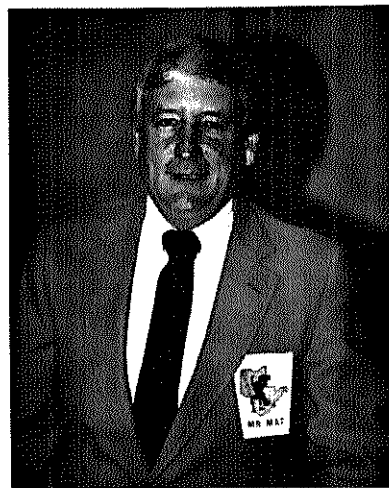

"A TIME FOR REFLECTION"

"I was a senior seeded first, I placed fourth; what does that mean? Since I didn't reach the highest goal, was my college career not a success? Does it mean that I am a failure?"

Failing to reach a goal does not make one a failure. I need to focus on the positive aspects of my career. Originally what I wanted from myself was *maximum effort*, I was not so concerned with winning. Somewhere my goal changed to maximum achievement which is an *extrinsically motivated goal*. Maximum effort is an *intrinsic goal* which is to say that reaching that goal is possible regardless of help or hindrance from other people; I am the only variable, only I can judge if I've given maximum effort.

Establishing a goal of maximum achievement is neither practical nor desirable. Maximum achievement is the standard used by other people to evaluate me. One significant variable in this case is the ability of my opponents. Good opponents may defeat me and keep me from succeeding. By those standards, whether I reach my goal or not depends on two other groups of people 1) my opponents and 2) those from whom I seek recognition.

Since my college career is over, I must evaluate myself. Do I think I was successful? By the standards of *maximum achievement* probably not; but Blaine Walters [Ft. Lewis College (CO)] and Tom Trujillo [Adams State (CO)] are good wrestlers and good friends of mine. I can't call myself a failure and hate them simply because they defeated me in a wrestling match.

Was I successful by the standards of *maximum effort*? Absolutely! I trained and competed with every ounce of intensity within me. My mental and physical training was so intense that it often drove me to

silent tears of exhaustion. This mentality of maximum effort is what has made me what I am and has earned the approval of the man I see in the mirror each morning.

The other person whose opinion I value most is my father, who also happens to be my college coach and my best friend. Ever since my very first match, he has emphasized maximum effort. "Give 100% and winning will take care of itself!" still rings in my head as I reflect on my career. Dad was ecstatic about the way I competed in the 1992 NAIA Nationals. Regardless of the scores of my matches, he was proud of me!

My dad and I both learned the importance of maximum effort from the same person--Jesus Christ. Jesus taught that the principles of *maximum achievement* are like a house built on shifting sand--destined to fail. But, *maximum effort* is like the house built on a big rock--stable and destined to survive!

Now, as I evaluate my wrestling career, I thank the Lord for blessing me with a career of maximum effort. I gave it everything I had! I trained hard and made great friends. I didn't worry about winning, yet reaped the benefits sought by those who do. I reached my goal! My career was a success, not because of my achievements, but because I gave maximum effort!
