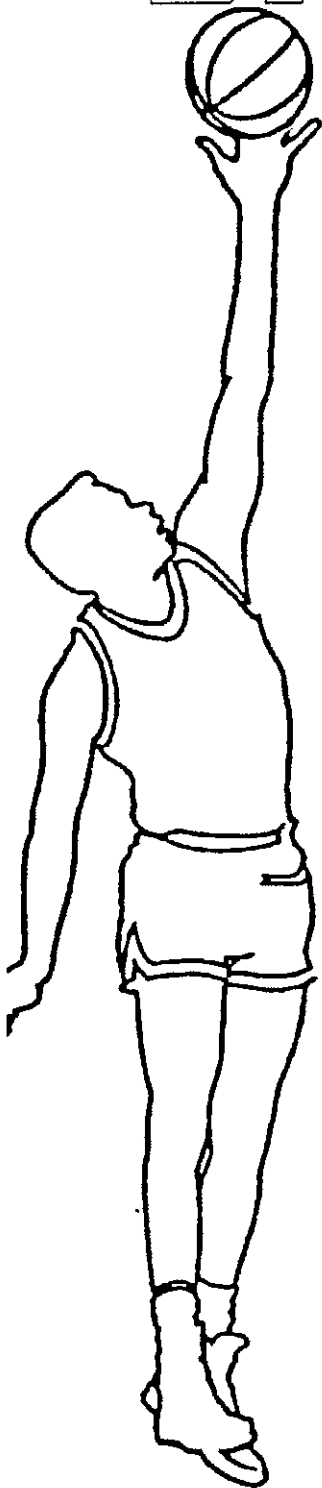

# *The Samuel A. Mumley Basketball Classic*

Back in 1977, four veteran Ohio Valley basketball coaches decided that the concept of a high school All-Star game, similar to the highly successful football contest, would be a very practical idea. And so, Earl Haberfield of Wintersville, Dick Potts of River, Henry "Herk" Lazasz of Tiltonsville, and Bobby Dawson of Wellsburg sat down and drew up the format of what would become the OVAC Basketball Classic.

Earl Haberfield was chosen as the game's first director. The committee enlisted the support of Ogden Newspapers to help underwrite the game, and booked the Wheeling Civic Center for the location, hoping to pack the house.

However, the only problem was that the game had to be played in June. Due to the rules of the West Virginia Secondary Schools Activities Commission, Mountain State athletes could not participate without losing their eligibility for spring sports. As the game was a novelty, the Classic did at one time see 1700 fans witness the Valley's finest, but the heat and the timing soon began to dwindle the interest of area spectators.

Over the years, due to expenses and availability of arenas, the game was played at St. John Arena, Wheeling Park High School, Bellaire High School, Wheeling College, and East Liverpool High School.

Although the game always showcased some outstanding hardcourt performers, other problems surfaced. The format underwent several changes, and as the interest in girls' sports became greater, the need to have two games for the boys and two games for the girls became apparent. However, West Virginia schools, being smaller in number, often had difficulty finding enough quality players, while Ohio schools had more players than they needed.

Another change in the program came in 1982 when Earl Haberfield left the area to coach in northern Ohio. Before leaving, however, the committee made a wise move in turning over the directorship to Gene Ammirante of Bellaire. Under his leadership, the game became more organized and competitive.

Ammirante ran the game until 1987 when, due to an increasing work load, he resigned the contest to Clyde DiAngelo of Steubenville Catholic Central who guided the Classic for two years. The game was then directed by John Bobalik of Wellsville. After a one-year tenure, the game

faced serious problems, as no one wanted to assume the directorship. Also facing financial problems, the game more than ever needed strong leadership. With that in mind, only one man was obvious - Ammirante. Under his direction for the second time, the game made tremendous changes. First, the game was placed back on strong financial footing.

The second change came in the form of strong involvement of the OVAC Executive Secretary, Sam Mumley, who took it upon himself, with the assistance of Vince Paoletti of Moundsville, to petition the WVSSAC to change the ruling, allowing the game to be played soon after the completion of the regular basketball season. After many trips to Charleston and hours of phone conversations and lobbying, the game was approved. Starting with the 1992 contest, the game would be moved to April.

Because of his dedication to the Conference and his unselfish support of the Classic, the committee decided to change the name of the Classic to the Samuel A. Mumley Basketball Classic.

The format was changed to one boys' game and one girls' game and a Conference cheering competition was added. Through the hard work and efforts, not to mention the enthusiasm, of Linda Alexander of Paden City, the contest never struggled like the game, but jumped right into successful the first year. Although all 44 OVAC schools choose not to participate, the Championship brings hundreds of cheerleaders before the Valley fans to show them that cheering is a bona fide sport also.

With the 1994 Classic, two more changes took place. First, Tom Rataiczak, who had served as program director for fifteen years, took over as Game Director. With this came the inception of a coaches' clinic held prior to the game and a luncheon for all the players and their parents.

And perhaps the best move made to date can be seen tonight. The game was permanently moved to the campus of Wheeling Jesuit College and their beautiful new facilities that you are witnessing. This change not only established a home for the Classic, but allowed its players and cheerleaders to enjoy a major college experience without leaving the Valley.

We welcome you tonight and hope you enjoy the contests.

# The Robert Dawson Basketball Officials' Award

The sixth recipient of the Robert Dawson Basketball Officials' Award goes to the "Black Cat," **Albert M. Cerullo** of St. Clairsville, Ohio.

During one of Cerullo's seasons in the late 60's, 75% of his games ended up in either overtime or double overtime. The late Jimmy Stewart, then Executive Secretary of the local board, dubbed Cerullo "the Black Cat." For years thereafter, the official having the most close games was presented the award.

Al Cerullo spent 27 years in basketball officiating with the Ohio Valley Board of Approved Basketball Officials. It all started in 1947, when he was coaching a game in the 5th-6th grade church league. As is all so common, the officials failed to show for one of the games, so the coach of the opposing team requested Cerullo assist him in officiating the contest.

It just so happened that at the same time, the Executive Board of Officials was returning from a meeting and dropped by to watch the game and, naturally, observe the officiating. Afterwards, the Board approached Cerullo and asked if he'd like to officiate high school games. Although he was not interested, he did agree to read the rule books. Several years later, his schedule was filled with Class A games.

In February of 1952, Cerullo was sent from Korea to Japan to await his orders to go stateside. As he was unpacking, he heard his name being called on the PA system and reported to the Captain's quarters. There he was told that his records had been reviewed. He was being reassigned to Special Services to work under Arnold Guiliffa, West Point graduate and All-American quarterback. After working the tournaments for a

month, he was selected to be one of the four officials to work the final games, ending up calling the championship game.

Back in the states, Cerullo began working a heavier slate of games, being selected to work quite a few Regional games in West Virginia. At that time, officials were required to work two games a night, with only a twenty-minute break between. Cerullo wrote to Sam Williams, West Virginia Secretary of Secondary Schools, explaining the disparity of the rule. The players, who were much younger and in better shape, only played a game a night, yet the older officials were expected to run two games with only a short break.

The rule was changed to allowing officials only one game a night, but also enabled more qualified officials to participate in the tournaments.

In 1974, Cerullo and the late Charles "Moe" King were appointed to attend the International Board Conference in Washington, D.C. for the purpose of having the Ohio Valley Board recognized so that their officials would be eligible to officiate major college games. Several years later, this was accomplished.

Cerullo was best known throughout the Valley for singling out a small child in the crowd to hold the ball for him during timeouts. Before long, kids at every school awaited the opportunity to be recognized.

Besides officiating, he served on the Executive Board for many years, acting as President, Vice-President, and Rules Interpreter.

Cerullo, who resides at 129 Westminster Drive with his wife Bonnie, has two children - Michelle and A. Michael Jr. - both who live in St. Clairsville, and one granddaughter. He retired in 1990 from the Wheeling-Pitt Main Office after 42 years of service.

Today, his number one concern is golfing five days per week and staying active in St. Mary's Catholic Church.

# The Earl Haberfield OVAC Basketball Coaches' Award

Charles "Hank" Morus, the 12th recipient of the Earl Haberfield OVAC Basketball Coaches' Award, holds a unique place in our list of honorees: he also was inducted into the Ohio High School Basketball Coaches Hall of Fame today.

After attending McKeesport High School in Pennsylvania, Morus enrolled in Salem College where he played basketball for four years and baseball for three years. In addition to serving as co-captain and later captain in basketball, he was selected as the Outstanding Senior Athlete.

He started his head coaching career in Augusta, Missouri, where from 1950 to 1955, his girls' basketball teams compiled a record of 77-31. At this time, the girls played the preliminary game before the boys.

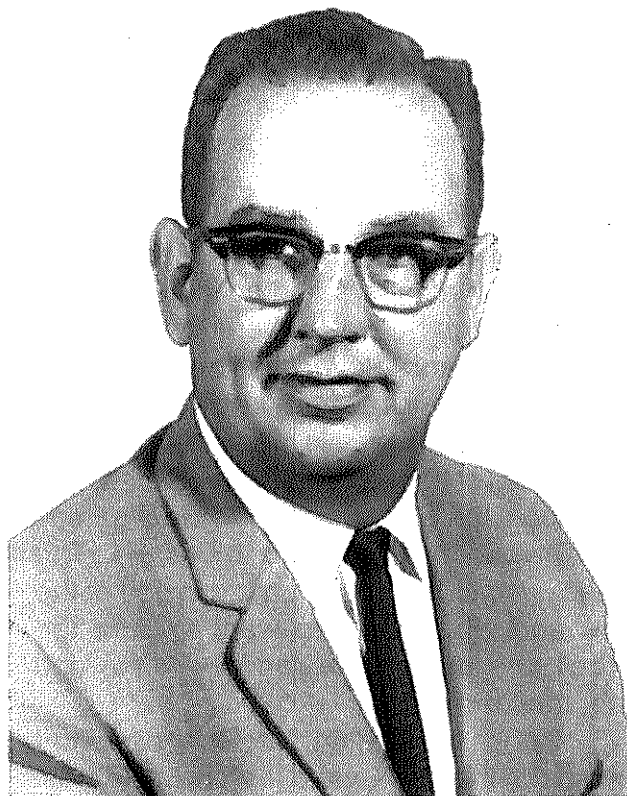
From there he moved to Newport, Ohio, coaching basketball and baseball from 1955-1968. His basketball squads compiled a 167-121 record while winning two Sectional titles. His baseball squads won 94 games while losing 57 from 1956 to 1967. They were League champions 4 times, Sectional champs 3 times, District champs once, and played in the Regional finals in 1964.

At the same time, he served as Athletic Director for Newport from 1956 to 1967. In 1968, he moved to Frontier High School where his 13 basketball teams compiled a record of 165 wins against 95 losses while racking up 11 League championships, 5 Sectional titles, 2 OVAC crowns, and two District titles.

Individually, Morus was named League Coach-of-the-Year 7 times, District 12 Coach-of-the-Year in 1974, and Eastern District Coach-of-the-Year in 1969 and 1981. In the same year (1981), Morus was tapped as coach of the Ohio Basketball All-Stars. He also served Frontier High School as their Athletic Director from 1968 to 1983.

Retiring after 31 years as a head coach, Morus posted a lifetime record of 409-247. A 31-year member of the Ohio High School Basketball Coaches Association, Morus was named an honorary member prior to his induction into the group's Hall of Fame.

Morus resides in Newport, Ohio, with his wife of 43 years, Geneieve. Their only son, Greg, has followed in his father's footsteps, finishing up his 9th season at Frontier.



In addition to owning over 100 victories, Greg also holds the school's best record (22-1) and piloted their only undefeated (20-0) season.

Hank spends much of his time on the golf course, where he proudly claims 7 career holes-in-one, including **TWO In ONE NINE** in 1966!

# OVAC BASKETBALL SCOREKEEPER/TIMER AWARD

You see it a lot today. Kids who like to be around sports and, upon graduation, stick around their alma mater and volunteer in some capacity. But for 64 years?

That's the case for **Henry McCue**, the second recipient of the Samuel A. Mumley Basketball Classic Scorekeeper/Timer Award. McCue attended Martins Ferry High School in the early thirties, graduating in 1932.

Although he was a member of the '29 football team and played on the basketball team, McCue wasn't actively involved in sports in high school. He recalls the street cars they used to run for the Bellaire-Ferry games, and remembers the '29 team beating the Big Reds 2-0 at the old dog track in north Bellaire. The games used to be played on the inside of the track, and when Bellaire went to punt the football, the punter stepped out of the end zone, thus the safety.

Upon graduation, McCue did what many did in the 30's -- went to work in the steel mills. This occupation saw him moving from mill to mill in Ohio and Pennsylvania until he returned to Martins Ferry to work for Sylvania Electric, where he worked until the firm closed down in 1951.

It was here that McCue began his work for the Riders. In football, he started while still in high school, serving as scoreboard operator, timer, and member of the chain gang in 1930. Although he spent 17 years travelling the Valley as a football official, any time he wasn't officiating he was at the Rider's field working. This past season saw him complete **63 years** of gridiron service to Martins Ferry.

In 1942, McCue discovered that it was extremely difficult getting into the old Rider gym for basketball games, as the gym only sat a few hundred fans. With standing room only crowds, he found that the best way to be guaranteed a seat at center court was to volunteer as a scorekeeper. Thus began another area of dedication which, with this

season, has lasted **52 years**. Henry worked both sides of the table during these years as the timer and the scorekeeper. He has broken in over a dozen Rider hardwood bosses and has worked all levels of tournament play. As the Sectional tournaments used to be played at Martins Ferry, McCue worked hundreds of Sectional and District contests, in addition to working three Regional contests and one State tournament.

As Spring arrived, McCue didn't slow down at all. When the Bellaire Relays started in 1955, McCue again jumped in as a track official, a position that he worked throughout the Valley. And when there weren't track meets, there were always plenty of softball games throughout the area to umpire. As a matter of fact, McCue still officiated some slo-pitch softball in Martins Ferry **LAST YEAR**, not bad for a man in his eighties!

He also helped out with wrestling as a scorekeeper and timer from 1957 until the seventies.

McCue, who resides in Martins Ferry with his wife, Edna, worked for the City Water Department for 19 years until his retirement in 1987. The couple has three children: Deborah, Carla, and Patrick.

So has he slowed down? Henry still plans to work with the Riders next season and remains busy as a gopher for Whiteside Chevrolet, helping them with title work.

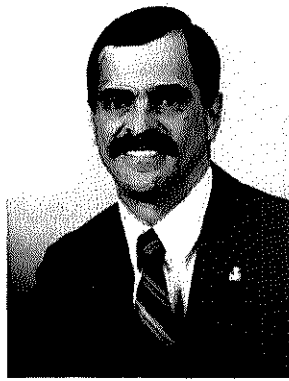
A lot of people start out as volunteers and helpers, but McCue's **sixty plus years** of service and dedication will be matched by few, past or present.

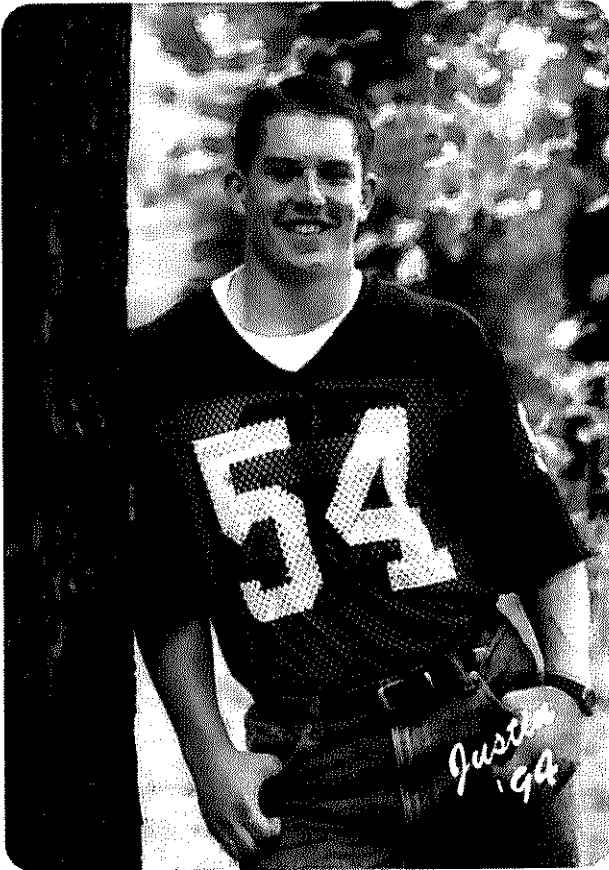
# RULES OF THE GAME

This game is sanctioned by the West Virginia Secondary Schools Activities Commission, The Ohio High School Athletic Association, and the National Collegiate Athletic Association and will be played under the following rules:

1. Each game will consist of two 20-minute halves.
2. Zone presses may be used but must end after first trap past half court.
3. Man-to-man defense must be played in the normal attack area.
4. Each player must make an appearance in both halves. Attempts are to be made to give all 15 players equal playing time.
5. Dunking will be permitted during the pre-game warm-up.
6. In the event of a tie score at the end of regulation play, a three-minute overtime period will follow. If the game is tied after the first overtime period, a sudden death playoff will be held. The team that scores the **FIRST TWO CONSECUTIVE POINTS** will be declared the winner.
7. Each player is allowed SIX (6) personal fouls before he is disqualified.
