# HALL OF FAME/WALL OF FAME CRITERIA

## 1994 HALL OF FAME/ WALL OF FAME INDUCTIONS

Today, September 17, 1994, is a very special day for Bellaire High School. This afternoon is the 12th Annual Bellaire High School Hall of Fame/Wall of Fame Inductions. At halftime, members of the HOF/WOF, Class of 1994, will be introduced. They were officially inducted into the HOF/WOF at ceremonies occurring at the high school gymnasium at 9:00 this morning.

### CRITERIA FOR THE HALL OF FAME

1. A member must have been a Bellaire High School student.
2. Any individual or team winning a State championship.
3. Any "First Place Team" AP or UPI All-American selection. This will include all NCAA and NAIA divisions.
4. Any top six place winners (tournaments). This will include all NCAA divisions, including NAIA.
5. Any individual who rates in the top six places of a statistical category of the NCAA or NAIA at the conclusion of the season. (Added in 1993, this criteria is left to the discretion of the Committee to determine the validity of the category.)
6. Any member of the United States Olympic Team.
7. Any established member of any of the major professional teams sponsored by the United States. ("Established Member" is to be interpreted as two or more years of registered participation, unless injured.)

**NOTE:** Not more than TWO members not meeting the above criteria selected through **UNANIMOUS VOTE** of the Committee may be elevated to the HOF upon a written letter of recommendation.

**NOTE:** No person or team will be considered for induction until five years after their graduation date.

1. All Regional, District, and OVAC Championship teams.
2. All athletes who made All-State, First Team.
3. A student who has distinguished himself/herself in some area of athletics and has brought credit to Bellaire High School will be considered by the HOF/WOF Committee for induction through recommendations made to the Committee.
4. Consideration will be given to non-Bellaire High School graduates who have distinguished themselves in some area of athletics which has brought credit to Bellaire High School, as recommended to the HOF/WOF Committee.
5. The Wall of Fame can include persons for any area of service to Bellaire High School athletics: booster, coach, newspaper writer, etc.

# Hall of Fame - Class of 1994

**PAUL MARCHESE, Class of 1974**  
**53451 Key-Bellaire Road, Bellaire, OH 43906**

If you mention kickers to a BHS football aficionado, the name Marchese has to be one of the first called to mind. Coming from a family of kickers, Marchese played four years of football at BHS and earned two letters. Post-season honors following his senior season included First Team placekicker All-OVAC, All-Valley, and All-Eastern Ohio. However, it was at Kent State University that Marchese developed into an outstanding booter. Playing four years and lettering two, he was selected First Team All-Conference MAC his junior and senior years. His career field goal record was 35 out of 55 for a .636 percentage. During his senior year, playing only 10 of the 11 games due to an injury, Marchese won the NCAA Division I field goal championship by booting 18 out of 27 attempts for a .667 percentage or 1.80 FG's per game. Included in this was a school record-setting 51-yard field goal against Bowling Green, which still stands today. Upon graduating from KSU in 1978 with a BS in education, Marchese had a brief tryout with the Oakland Raiders. Returning to the Valley, he began teaching at the School of Hope, where he established a productive Special Olympic Program. After ten years of work, he was responsible for developing a one-fifth mile paved track for the school. In 1982, along with Mary Rataiczak, Marchese started Rat & Cheese Photography. Marchese was a 1992 Inductee into the BHS Wall of Fame.

**GLENN NELSON FITCH, Class of 1956**  
**32 Aaron Woods, Wheeling, WV 26003**

A four-year performer in football and a three-year member of the track team, Glenn Fitch earned three varsity letters in football and one in track. As a junior, he was instrumental in helping the Big Reds, coached by the legendary Reyman "Bud" Bonar, earn an OVAC championship. Earning numerous post-season accolades from his end position, Fitch earned a full ride to Bowling Green State University where he performed all four years, earning three letters. Although he was recruited as an end, during his sophomore year, after three centers went down, he was moved to the center spot and remained there for his career. In an era which was redefining college football, Fitch was also the team's punter his senior year! Having to play both ways, he found himself utilized in several different positions on defense. During his senior year, the BGSU squad won the Mid-American Conference Championship and was also crowned National Champions in the small college division. Moving to Dundee, Michigan, in 1960, Fitch coached five consecutive high school league championship teams at Dundee High School from 1963-1967. He left coaching in 1968 and returned to the Valley to work at Ormet Corporation. He was recently promoted to Division Manager of Ormet's Reduction Facility at Hannibal, Ohio. Fitch has three sons, all who played football for BHS from 1974-1981: Rory, Dirk (who coaches football and track at Martins Ferry), and

## **THOMAS J. HEMSLEY, Class of 1937** **Deceased**

Thomas Hemsley was a three-sport performer for the Big Reds, playing football, basketball, and softball. At the end of his senior season, he was named First Team All-Eastern Ohio and Second Team All-Valley. A stellar pitcher, Hemsley led the Reds to three consecutive OVAA softball championships. During World War II, he served in the Marine Corps and then went to work for the Goodyear Rubber and Tire Company until he retired. He also served as Secretary of Local Union #2.

## **MICHAEL IMBROSCIO, Class of 1986** **35 West 65th Street, #1D, New York, NY 10023**

If good things come in small packages, then Mike Imbroscio is a great one. A four-year member of the wrestling team, lettering three years, Imbroscio wrestled in the lightweight classes and displayed tremendous dedication to the mat sport. Wrestling in the OVAC Wrestling Tournament, the largest high school meet in the nation, he placed 8th his sophomore year, fourth his junior year, and capped off a brilliant senior career by not only taking the championship honors in the 112-pound class but also being selected the Dave Bierkorte Outstanding wrestler. His records (13-3, 25-9, and 27-1) allowed him to establish BHS standards for nearfalls (2 point) for both the season and his career. The team captain and MVP his senior year, he was rewarded with the George Kovalick Memorial Scholarship. He entered Ohio State University where he wrestled in intramurals, winning the 135-pound weight class, before graduating in 1990, summa cum laude in pre-law. From there he moved to Harvard Law School, graduating magna cum laude in 1993. He currently works for Judge John M. Walker, U.S. Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit, New York.

## **ROBERT W. "BUD" MARLING, Class of 1936** **Deceased**

In a time when you jumped center after every basket and high scoring games weren't the norm, Bud Marling was the Reds' all-time scorer up until the late forties. A four-year member of the basketball team and three-year letterwinner, Marling captained the Big Reds his senior year, earning All-OVAC honors. He also played on the undefeated softball teams of 1935 and 1936 winning 25 straight games under Coach Jim Dixon. He was awarded a basketball scholarship to Washington & Jefferson College. Deciding to return to the Valley, Marling went to work for Wheeling-Pittsburgh Steel at the Martins Ferry Plant. In 1943, he enlisted in the Air Force, serving in the Eastern Mandates, the Western Pacific, and Air Offensive Japan. He was awarded the Asiatic-Pacific Theater Ribbon with three Bronze Stars, and the Air Medal with two Oak-Leaf Clusters. Flying a total of 32 missions, Marling was honorably discharged on November 3, 1945. Returning to Wheeling-Pitt, he worked his way up to General Manager, retiring in 1980 with 44 years experience. Marling was very instrumental in establishing the Bellaire Junior Sports Program and coaching Little League. He also served for years as a basketball official in the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference.

**SAM A. MARZELLA, Class of 1941**  
**11443 Flint Lane, Pine Island, Bokeelia, FL 33922**

Considered to be one of the greatest defensive centers that the Ohio Valley produced in over a decade, Sam Marzella earned three varsity letters for the Big Reds. In his senior year against Martins Ferry, Marzella blocked two punts in the game, a record that still stands today. Selected to four All-Valley teams, Marzella was also chosen for All-State honors. Upon graduation, he accepted a full scholarship to the University of Miami in Florida, passing up offers from Ohio State, Notre Dame, Capital, and Wittenburg. During his sophomore season, he had the unique distinction of intercepting a pass and running 35 yards for a score over Furman in the Orange Bowl Stadium. His career was interrupted by World War II when he enlisted in the Marine Corps, serving in Okinawa, Saipan, Tinian, and Japan. He returned to Miami in 1946 to earn his third numeral. Graduating in 1948, he stayed in Miami and Cape Coral where he taught physical education for 35 years. Three times named Teacher-of-the-Year, Marzella reared six sons and remains active in community affairs in Pine Island.

**JOHN "DIXIE" PURTIMAN, Class of 1959**  
**4500 Jefferson Avenue, Shadyside, OH 43947**

Although he participated in cross country, basketball, and track at BHS, John "Dixie" Purtiman graduated in 1959 with his best years ahead of him. Lettering twice in cross country and track and once in basketball, Purtiman enlisted in the US Navy upon graduation. During his three-year tour, he made the FIBLANT All-Star Basketball team each year. After his discharge he attended Findlay College before returning to graduate from West Liberty State College in 1970. A two-year performer and letterman in cross country, basketball, and track, he received All-Conference accolades his senior year, establishing the school record in the 880 (1:58). He returned to teach at his alma mater in 1972 and took over the track program and leadership of the Bellaire Relays. In 1979, he started the girls' track program and the following year established the Touchdown Club Invitational. His team won the Shadyside relays six times, District honors two times, and twice won the OVAC crown. Receiving Coach-of-the-Year honors in 1978 and 1980, Purtiman coached State finishers Tom Shunk, Vince Mehl, and Mike Chirpas and saw his 1978 shuttle hurdle quartet capture first place honors in the giant Bellaire Relays. Purtiman retired from coaching in 1981 and was named Honorary Referee of the Bellaire Relays in 1991.

**JOHN S. SABINSKI, Class of 1984**  
**712 Howard Street, Bridgeport, OH 43912**

Establishing the All-Time Valley record for the 110M high hurdles in 1984 (14.1 seconds) which still stands today, John Sabinski made a name for himself on the Nelson Field track. Running track for four years and lettering three, Sabinski received All-OVAC, All-Valley, and All-Eastern Ohio honors both his junior and senior years. During his senior year he established seven meet standards in the 110HH, placed third at the State meet and was named All-State in track. The captain his senior year, Sabinski qualified for the Junior Olympic Nationals in Baton Rouge, Louisiana, where he made it into the finals before being eliminated. He received recognition from the Upper Ohio Valley Dapper Dan Club for his accomplishments in track in 1985. He attended college in Hagerstown, Maryland, where he received All-Conference honors. He currently is employed by Rechrome Service, Inc.

# Wall of Fame - Class of 1994

## **GARY SECHREST, Class of 1965** **117 Wagner Avenue, Bellaire, OH 43906**

Considered by many to be one of the best defensive ends to play at Bellaire High School, Gary Sechrest played three years of football under Don Ault, lettering twice. At the conclusion of his senior year, Sechrest was named All-OVAC, All-Eastern Ohio, All-District, All-Valley, and special mention All-State. His senior season saw the Reds winning the OVAC championship, a crown that wouldn't be gained again until 1993. He was also a two-year starter on Coach Claire Cribbs' basketball team. Selected to represent BHS in the OVAC All-Star game, Sechrest also had stints with two area semi-pro football teams -- the Washington Generals and the Ohio Valley Panthers. A two-year veteran of the Marine Corps, he served 1 1/2 years in Viet Nam, being cited for bravery during the 1968 Tet offensive in Phu Bi. Sechrest is credited with starting the seventh grade football program at Bellaire and spent years coaching grade school football and basketball. He also served as a track official for 20 years, from 1969 to 1989. Sechrest is an employee of Consolidation Coal.

## **ANDREW MICHAEL SIMKO, Class of 1948** **Deceased**

A four-year member of the football team, Andy Simko lettered twice and ended a rather quiet career at BHS. Upon graduation, he received an appointment to the United States Military Academy at West Point and an academic scholarship to West Nottingham Prep School. At West Nottingham, he lettered in three sports, captained the football team, and set the highest scholastic average of any student ever to attend West Nottingham. From there he moved to West Point, but because of his small stature, he was unable to compete on the varsity level. He did, however, coach and play three years on the Cadets' intramural squad. Simko served two tours of duty in Viet Nam. On the second tour, while serving as Battalion Commander, 4th Infantry Division, he was killed in a helicopter crash enroute to assisting an engaged company. Simko is buried at West Point.

## **DICK SKETEL, Class of 1979** **56949 West 53rd Street, Shadyside, OH 43947**

Earning nine varsity letters and contributing to SIX OVAC Championships, Dick Sketel was one of the ultimate competitors. He ran track for four years at BHS and participated in cross country and basketball three years each. In cross country, Sketel earned All-OVAC, All-Valley, All-Eastern Ohio, and All-State honors, capping his career by placing 32nd out of seventy runners in the State meet. Leading the harriers to two OVAC titles, he was in the top ten runners 22 out of 25 career races, 10 times being first or second. In basketball, Sketel was a member of the first team to make it to the Regionals and again anchored two OVAC Championships. A gutty point guard, his unselfish ball-handling allowed him to give out 123 assists, a record that still stands today. Track found Sketel earning All-Valley honors twice while again garnering two OVAC Championships. In 45 career races, he finished first or second 22 times. Upon graduation, he attended Ohio University where he ran cross country for the Bobcats his freshman and junior years. He is employed as an auditor by the State of Ohio.

## **PETE WOODS, Class of 1988** **9263 Liberty Road, Cambridge, OH 43725**

Pete Woods was a standout on the BHS football and baseball teams from 1984 to 1988. Earning three varsity letters in football, Woods received All-Eastern Ohio, All-OVAC, and All-Valley honors as well as being named All-State in both the AP and UPI polls. The captain of the '87 Big Reds, Woods also was selected defensive MVP. In baseball, he was a four-year letterwinner, starting as catcher both his freshman and sophomore years. His senior year rewarded him with All-OVAC, All-Valley, and All-Eastern Ohio honors. He helped lead the diamond squad to two OVAC Championships (1985, 1989). Upon graduation, Woods went to Marshall University and earned four varsity letters, serving as snapper on extra points and long punts all four years. Redshirted his sophomore year for medical reasons, Woods returned to center the Thundering Herd to two National Playoffs, ending up runner-up in 1991, and becoming National Champions in 1992. His efforts not only got him the Tom Stark Award for overall athletic and academic achievement but also double recognition from the Upper Ohio Valley Dapper Dan Club in 1988 and 1993. Woods is employed as a teacher in the Meigs Local Schools.

## **SCOTT WOODS, Class of 1989** **9263 Liberty Road, Cambridge, OH 43725**

Starting as the quarterback his sophomore year, Scott Woods quickly established himself as one of Bellaire's premier passers. Earning letters and All-OVAC honors three years, Woods also was recognized as All-Valley twice and All-District and Honorable Mention All-State his senior year. As a sophomore, he was recognized by the *Wheeling Intelligencer* as their Sophomore-of-the-Year. He set 18 school standards during his career, many still standing today. Woods was selected to play in and captained the 1989 OVAC Ohio All-Stars. He also was a valuable performer on the Big Reds basketball and baseball squads. He went to Marshall University as a freshman but was red-shirted. The following year he played and lettered but then decided to transfer to Indiana University of Pennsylvania. As with Bellaire, Woods immediately established himself as one of the nation's best small-college quarterbacks. In 1992, he received Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference Offensive Player-of-the-Week, was 2nd team PSAC, and received the IUP Morrel Trophy. During his senior season, Woods led his team to the NCAA Division II Championship where they finished runner-up. Receiving All-American quarterback honors, Woods set IUP passing records for most passing yards in a season (2850) and total offense in a season (2872). For two consecutive years, he finished in the top ten in the nation for passing efficiency. Woods is currently employed at the Cambridge Savings Bank.
