THE ESSENCE OF SPORTS...manship

At the West Virginia State Wrestling Tournament a few years ago, I had the pleasure to witness a reare display of sportsmanship at its highest level. During the semi-finals of the AAA Division, I was working with Roger Jefferson from Charleston, WV, alternating as referee and assistant referee for each weight class. Nothing out of the ordinary had happened until I heard the announcer call on deck at our mat two 189-pound wrestlers. I was all too familiar with them, and it would be my turn as head official.

As Wheeling Park's Darryl Wise and Kirby Barbour of John Marshall stepped on the mat, I asked Roger if he wouldn't mind taking the match. He said that would be great because next on deck at our mat was a heavyweight from the school where Roger t and coached.

What I didn't tell Roger was the fact that I had officiated these two boys three times during the course of the year. The first time was at a dual meet where both matment tied (2-2), and twice in tournament competition where both bouts ended in low scoring nightmares for yours truly. I didn't want Roger to be influenced by history of their previous matches. Poor Roger, he had no idea what was in store for him.

As Roger's assistant, I observed both wrestlers go at it hot and heavy during the first period. However, at the end of the stanza the score remained 0-0. At the start of the second period, Roger said that he hoped it wouldn't be a close one. I just nodded and prayed that Roger would be spared the ordeal that I encountered throughout the year.

Well, he wasn't. Wise scored and escape in the second period and so did Barbour during the third period. At the conclusion of the regulation match, the score was 1 - 1 and the bad dream was repeating itself, only this time Roger was experiencing it.

The overtime match was a repeat of the regular bout, with the score 2-2 in the third period and 15 seconds left. By this time, all the other matches had ended, and all eyes — fans, officials, wrestlers, and table workers — were directed toward our mat. Rogers's only comment as he circled the mat, praying for a takedown, was "Why me, Lord?"

As the match was coming to a close, some of our fellow officials, who were observing the bout, sarcastically whispered "No. 12" as we passed by during the action. They were referring to Overtime Criteria #12, which stated in the event of a tie, the referee and his assistant must determine the winner based on aggressiveness and superior wrestling ability. No referee wants to be in this predicament (and thank goodness for the new sudden death procedure), but of course we were as the final buzzer blared in our ears.

Roger and I directed the two wrestlers to the center of the mat, while we discussed the match away from everyone. Actually, we really wanted somehow to rid ourselves of this dilemma. But such is the life of an offical — sometimes you get the bear and sometimes he gets you. We could almost see the claws of pressure shredding us to pieces as we finally came to a decision.

As Roger raised Barbour's hand, I explained to both matmen how we arrived at our verdict. Most of the crowd cheered while others jeered the outcome. Those in the know realized what a difficult job we had and applauded our efforts. And when both boys hugged each other as they walked off the mat, Roger and I know we made the right choice.

After accepting the complimentary "good job" from our peers in the officiating ranks and explaining our decision to each coach, we finished the night with the final heavyweight bout. But we were not prepared for what happened as we began walking to the shower room following the last match.

As we left the mat area, we were confronted by Barbour and West again. They graciously shook our hands and apologized for putting us through the agony of their match. Furthermore, they let us know that they could live with the outcome of the match and would learn from it. We truly respected these remarks of two truly mature young adults. And they walked away, arm in arm, to the amazement of those watching this display of sincere sportsmanship. As a matter of fact, those still present in the arena who observed their encounter with us, applauded both of them.

I believe that I will never forget that moment. It restored my faith in the ideals of competitive sports — and it says a lot for today's scholastic athletes as well as the coaches who molded them into young men of character.

I should mention here that Barbour went on to win the 189-pound state championship the next day and Wise also placed. But their actions of the night before made them both champions in my eyes.


Oh, by the way, I finally told Roger Jefferson and my fellow officials later that night — "the rest of the (Barbour and West) story."







WE SALUTE WPHS PAST OVAC CHAMPIONS

MAJOR WILLIAM H. TAGGART (USMC)

"A CHAMPION IN LIFE"


Bill Taggart grew up on Wheeling Island, wrestled for the old Wheeling High "Wildcats," but never won an OVAC Championship. Still, if you were to ask Major Taggart today, "What prepared you the most for adult living in this highly complex and dangerous world?"

Taggart would simply reply, "WRESTLING!"

After graduating from high school in 1973, Bill Taggart joined the Corps, was selected as Honor Man at Basic Training (Boot Camp), and meritoriously moted to Private First Class and Corporal. He was discharged in 1976 and returned home to continue his education at West Liberty State College where he earned a bachelor's degree.

Bill Taggart returned to the Marine Corps as a commissioned 2nd Lieutenant in 1980, and from there nothing could stop him. As a reconnaissance officer, Major Taggart's clandestine assignments have taken him around the world ... to Japan, to the Pacific Ocean region, and most recently, to Kuwait during the Gulf War. It was after the liberation of Kuwait that Bill Taggart was awarded the rank of Major. But this is only the tip of the iceberg.

As a qualified parachutist and Combat scuba diver, Major Taggart is now and inspectorinstructor. Not only has he trained hundreds of proud Marines, but he has also assisted other governmental agencies as well. Taggart and his staff have taught urban assult courses to officials in the FBI, NASA, US Customs, State Dept., and police SWAT teams from New Jersey, Virginia, Maryland, Louisiana, and Washington, D.C.



Furthermore, Major Taggart has planned and supervised four Counter Drug Operations along the United States borders in support of State and Federal Law Enforcement Agencies in their efforts to eradicate international trafficking of illegal drugs.

Most recently, Major Taggart and his team of expert divers volunteered to perform and assignment that nobody else wanted to do. On Wednesday, September 22, 1993, the Sunset Limited Amtrak Train derailed from a bridge over a remote bayou outside of Mobile, Alabama. Many passengers were rescued, but what about the dead who were still trapped under the muddy, oily, snake-infested waters?

It was Major Taggart and his men who risked their lives to bring the remaining 47 victims back to their loved ones for proper interment. The task was a gruesome one. Moreover, there was no visibility below the surface, as Taggart and his men dived for three days into the submerged train cars and engines to retrieve the bodies. In the end, they accomplished their goal and went on their way without fanfare.

For his efforts in this nationally-publicized accident, Major William H. Taggart was awarded his second "Navy Commendation Medal with Gold Star." In fact, Bill Taggart has received numerous honors and decorations over the years, which include:

As his coach, I can testify that Bill Taggart was a dedicated wrestler in high school. And as you can plainly see, the positive traits this real-life American patriot learned from wrestling did not shine through until after his competitive years were over. Today, Bill Taggart resides in Mobile, Alabama with his lovely wife Cathy Jo and their daughter Courtney, 10.

Many coaches wonder if any of thier effords really have an effect on their wrestlers. In my 10 years of coaching, I never had an OVAC Champion. I was luckier; I helped to mold the character of Major William H. Taggart (USMC) – "A Champion in Life."
