The Samuel A. Mumley Basketball Classic

Back in 1977, four veteran Ohio Valley basketball coaches decided that the concept of a high school All-Star game, similar to the highly successful football contest, would be a very practical idea. And so, Earl Haberfield of Wintersville, Dick Potts of River, Henry "Herk" Lazasz of Tiltonsville, and Bobby Dawson of Wellsburg sat down and drew up the format of what would become the OVAC Basketball Classic.

Earl Haberfield was chosen as the game's first director. The committee enlisted the support of Ogden Newspapers to help underwrite the game, and booked the Wheeling Civic Center for the location, hoping to pack the house.

However, the only problem was that the game had to be played in June. Due to the rules of the West Virginia Secondary Schools Activities Commission, Mountain State athletes could not participate without losing their eligibility for spring sports. As the game was a novelty, the Classic did at one time see 1700 fans witness the Valley's finest, but the heat and the timing soon began to dwindle the interest of area spectators.

Over the years, due to expenses and availability of arenas, the game was played at St. John Arena, Wheeling Park High School, Bellaire High School, Wheeling College, East Liverpool High School, and Buckeye Local High School.

Although the game always showcased some outstanding hardcourt performers, other problems surfaced. The format underwent several changes, and as the interest in girls' sports became greater, the need to have two games for the boys and two games for the girls became apparent. However, West Virginia schools, being smaller in number, often had difficulty finding enough quality players, while Ohio schools had more players than they needed.

Another change in the program came in 1982 when Earl Haberfield left the area to coach in northern Ohio. Before leaving, however, the committee made a wise move in turning over the directorship to Gene Ammirante of Bellaire. Under his leadership, the game became more organized and competitive.

Ammirante ran the game until 1987 when, due to an increasing work load, he resigned the contest to Clyde DiAngelo of Steubenville Catholic Central who guided the Classic for two years. The game was then directed by John Bobalik of Wellsville. After a one-year tenure, the game faced serious problems, as no one wanted to assume the directorship. Also facing financial problems, the game more than ever needed strong leadership. With that in mind, only one man was obvious - Ammirante. Under his direction for the second time, the game made tremendous changes. First, the game was

placed back on strong financial footing.

The second change came in the form of strong involvement of the OVAC Executive Secretary, Sam Mumley, who took it upon himself, with the assistance of Vince Paoletti of Moundsville, to petition the WVSSAC to change the ruling, allowing the game to be played soon after the completion of the regular basketball season. After many trips to Charleston and hours of phone conversations and lobbying, the game was approved. Starting with the 1992 contest, the game would be moved to April.

Because of his dedication to the Conference and his unselfish support of the Classic, the committee decided to change the name of the Classic to the Samuel A. Mumley Basketball Classic.

The format was changed to one boys' game and one girls' game and a Conference cheering competition was added. Through the hard work and efforts, not to mention the enthusiasm, of Linda Alexander of Paden City, the contest never struggled like the game, but jumped right into successful the first year. Although all 44 OVAC schools chose not to participate, the Championship brought hundreds of cheerleaders before the Valley fans to show them that cheering was a bona fide sport also.


With the 1994 Classic, two more changes took place. First, Tom Rataiczak of Bellaire High School, who had served as program director for fifteen years, took over as Game Director. With this came the inception of a coaches' clinic held prior to the game and a luncheon for all the players and their parents. Perhaps the best decision made to date was permanently moving to the campus of Wheeling Jesuit College and their beautiful facilities that you are witnessing this evening. This change not only established a home for the Classic, but allowed its players and cheerleaders to enjoy a major college experience without leaving the Valley.

The 1995 Classic saw three more adjustments. First, the coaches' clinic was dropped, as its timing ran too close to the NCAA Tournament and the availability of quality college coaches. Second, it was decided to begin honoring a coach who pioneered in the establishment of girls' basketball as a sport. The third reason was perhaps the most noticeable. After three years, the cheerleading advisors decided to branch out on their own and moved their competition to November.

Even though the All-Star game has undergone and is still undergoing change, one fact remains constant: it continues to showcase the finest basketball talent the Ohio Valley has to offer.

We welcome you tonight and hope you enjoy the contests.

THE ROBERT DAWSON BASKETBALL OFFICIALS' AWARD

The seventh recipient of the Robert Dawson Basketball Officials' Award goes to John Hollister.

John began his basketball officiating in 1966 as a member of the West Virginia-Ohio Basketball Association located in Weirton, West Virginia. His last year to officiate was in 1991, giving him a quarter of a century of enjoyment and service to the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference.

During this period of time, Hollister worked all levels of competition, from grade school to college. He believed that all levels were equal because he realized the importance of each game to the girls or boys playing the contest.


During this time period, he was given the opportunity to work many tournament assignments, both boys and girls, in Ohio and West Virginia.

In 1968, he took over the duties of booking secretary for the Weirton Board. His responsibilities included making game assignments for all local schools within the Board's area, from junior college to boys' and girls' varsity and reserves to all levels of junior high. Officials were also assigned for summer and winter recreational leagues.

Hollister has had the opportunity to work with a very large group of individuals within the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference, seeing it grow into a strong and powerful Conference in both states. He has taken immense pride in doing this job, treating every equally and showing no favorites.

Hollister feels that both of these areas have played a very important part of his life. It took him 25 years to earn the title "The Ohio Valley's Worst Official," having a ball achieving this. His service allowed him not only to work with a large number of outstanding coaches but also many great officials.

Hollister resides in Weirton with his wife, Tura. The couple has three children who have been an inspiration to his career

OVAC BASKETBALL SCOREKEEPER/TIMER AWARD

Like so many people who perform this service, tonight's honoree is no different.

Gary Barkes graduated from Paden City in 1957. Playing football, basketball, and baseball, he was a member of one of Coach Bob Burton's early basketball squads. Upon graduation, he entered the U.S. Navy until he was discharged in 1962.

Returning to his hometown and working for Ormet, the opportunity arose for him to help Coach Burton out as a scorekeeper.

And there he stayed.

Not only a fixture at the Wildcats' scorers' table, Barkes also ran the football scoreboard for over twenty years. But his service to the athletic community didn't stop here. Gary was also a registered Ohio basketball official for over 12 years, working many games throughout the Valley but always being open the nights Paden City played.

In addition, his love for sports flowed into the community where he coached and assisted on various youth sporting teams. Athletics became a way of life, not only for Barkes but also for his family. As one of his

daughters recollects,

"Sports were always a part of our dad's life. From an early age we can remember sitting beside our dad as we watched many games. He always enjoyed telling us about the boys playing and had some suggestions of his own on how to use the talent he always saw in the boys from PCHS. He enjoyed being involved with all the teams, coaches, and fans. Dad kept the scorebook for Burton's Wildcats for 20 years, and the timeclock for the football team for several years as well. He took great pride in his association with sports in the Ohio Valley so he became a referee in 1985.

"Most families take a vacation away from it all, but to him, our mom, and us, the



tournaments in Charleston became an annual family vacation he really loved.

"We know that he is with us tonight if only in spirit because he would be very honored to be remembered in such a special way.

"We are very proud to carry on his memory and our family would like to thank Paden City High School, the fans, and the Ohio Valley for all of their kindness."

Gary Barkes died in 1994, leaving behind his wife, Rita, and two daughters, Kelli Anderegg and Karri Herrick.

The Earl Haberfield OVAC **Basketball Coaches' Award**

From the hardwood of Madison Gym to the lush greens of Oglebay Park, Ed Murphy never took on a challenge without intense enthusiasm and a desire to get the most out of his people, be they players or groundskeepers.

A 1946 graduate of Wheeling High School, Murphy was a football player and ran track. As a half-miler and miler, he was on Wheeling's state championship track team and was the first "T" quarterback for legendary coach Bob Roe. Although he did go out for basketball under V. Everett Brinkman, Murphy gave up the sport to work as a mail carrier during the winter months.

After two years in the navy, he enrolled at Bethany College where he played four years as a blocking back, quarterback, center, and

linebacker.

He almost began his coaching career at Martins Ferry under Fred Thomas, but when his former football coach offered him a job coaching football in 1953, Murphy returned to his alma mater. In addition to his football duties, he also saw action as a baseball coach for five years, ran the cross country program at the same time as he coached football, and coached the wrestling team to an "unofficial" state championship in his first year.

He continued to coach the wrestling team until 1956 when Brinkman retired. Once again, Bob Roe displayed faith in him and campaigned for him to replace the legenday court boss.

For 17 years, his teams terrorized area squads. His teams were trademarked for their hustling defense and full court pressure that resulted in 210 victories measured against 105 losses. The fiery coach directed the Blue and Gold into the State playoffs three times - in 1957, 1961, and 1968. He also captured the OVAC AAA Crown in 1969 with a 19-1 regular season record.

Hardwood greats such as Charlie Gordon, Dick Tomlinson, Tony Marvin, and D.J. Jebbia excited the Island fans while Murphy's voice exhorting the troops could be heard in

Bridgeport on clear nights.

During this time, Murphy continued to work as a scout and defensive coach in football for Bob Roe at West Liberty State College in 1964. His expertise allowed the Hilltoppers to gain back-to-back Conference championships in 1971 and 1972.

A self-taught coach, Murphy came upon his knowledge the hard way, reading everything he could lay his hands on and attending clinics. But regardless of the sport, his teams were always respected and respectable.

But golf was a love and passion for Murphy. In his summers for close to 20 years, he worked as the director of Oglebay Park's Caddy Camp training young boys to be caddies. And in the spring of 1969, he announced his retirement from both coaching and teaching to become the superintendent of the new Speidel Golf course that had just been designed by famed golf architect Robert Trent Jones.

His responsibilities included not only maintaining and conditioning the course but also running the Par 3 course. And as the fame and beauty of Oglebay's course grew, Murphy's 4 children all got involved in the sport and built

their lives around it.

Larry was a Michigan State golf star who worked as a teaching pro and managed some of the nation's finest golfing facilities; Tommy and Jim both worked as pros at various courses; and daughter Karen Waialae is a former West Virginia Amateur Golf Association state champion who served as a teaching pro and course manager at Oglebay and currently is the Speidel Pro Manager.

Still active on the links, Ed and his wife, Toni, spend their time visiting children and grandchildren and living in their condo at Myrtle

Beach, South Carolina.

OVAC BASKETBALL **GIRLS' COACH AWARD**

Tonight marks another first with the Samuel A. Mumley Basketball Classic as it honors for the first time a girls' basket-ball coach. With it being the first, there should be a tremendous amount of names to choose from, but the award needed to be given to one of the ploneers in girls' sports. A person who if you could only hire one girls' coach, could coach all sports and do it well. And as names were passed around the selection committee, one kept reappearing: Agnes Timmons of Barnesville.

Although a native of Scio, Timmons moved into Barnesville in 1946 and began a career that was to span five decades before she retired. Her early basketball squads were nothing more than encounters with area teams playing six-man basketball with the running center and four players not being able to cross halfcourt. There was one dribble, no three

pointers, and no one-on-one.

Then things changed in the early Sixties. Sports were considered as a part of the Girls' Athletic Association (GAA). Teams usually carried many members and all girls got to play. The main purpose was to have fun. The coaches would get together and arrange schedules, high school boys would officiate, and uniforms were unheard of. If lucky, they would get the gym for practice about an hour a week.

But what they lacked in respect and equipment, they

made up for in desire, dedication, and enthusiasm. At the conclusion of the "season," coaches joined team members for another contest. Tournaments were held and the trophy

awarded was just as cherished as the one presented at State.
"We had teriffic athletes," Timmons recalls, "girls who could have been First Team All-Ohio, but until 1975, the State had not sanctioned the sport. As I reflect on past seasons, I visualize teams who could have been State contenders. I remember outstanding players from my teams and the competition and eager, avid, giving coaches. We did things together."

After 1975, the girls did receive leather basketballs,

two real officials for their games, schedules, and even assistants, but they never could replace the fun and enthusiasm of the early years. Timmons' only assistant was a parent who gave his time and expertise to the team, as well as company on the bench. In 1980, she assisted Coach Sam Lucas, who now is the superintendent of Barnesville Schools.

Timmons also adventured into the world of officiating for a few years. Even though it was another challenge, she

loved it.

"I guess that's why I don't appreciate the verbal abuse officials receive. Boos and tirades came my way, but on several

occasions, I received a pat on the back.

Today, although retired, Timmons keeps the clock for the boys' reserves games, announces both the boys' and girls' line-ups, and sell tickets for the girls' games ("one way to get in freel").

But Timmons didn't just ploneer basketball. As a matter of fact, she paved the way in volleyball, track, and softball. At one time, in addition to coaching all three sports, she also had the envlable (?) position of coaching FOUR varsity sports. In 1989, she retired from coaching girls track, but never

was able to leave the Shamrock athletic program.

She has been honored by receiving the Fred D.

Bonvento Award for service to Barnesville High School, the Cal
Giffin Award for track, and was selected OVAC Coach-of the-

Year in Volleyball.

Reflecting on her award this evening, Agnes relates, "It has been rewarding to see the girls become recognized as athletes, to observe the changes in the game, the intensity and the skill level of the players and the enthusiasm of the spectators. This year, over 2000 people witnessed the semis at Meadowbrook High School in a standing room only gymnasium.

"I would like to thank the OVAC for making a place for the girls and for giving them a chance to be Ali-Stars through awards and recognition.

Thanks to all the parents for the sacrifices you have made to support and encourage your daughters to be a mem-

ber of a team.

Thanks to the many officials for working the games and seeing it as it is!
Thanks to all the coaches for accepting the job.

*Thanks to the players for playing the game.

*And thanks for this great honor. I accept it for all the girls who played on OUR teams. You played with spirit; you played with heart; you played with love. And that's the way you

l accept it on behalf of all the coaches who met, years ago, to provide opportunities for the girls to play the great game

of basketball.







RULES OF THE GAME

This game is sanctioned by the West Virginia Secondary Schools Activities Commission, The Ohio High School Athletic Association, and the National Collegiate Athletic Association and will be played under the following rules:

Each game will consist of two 20-minute halves.
 Zone presses may be used but must end after first trap past half court.

3. Man-to-man defense must be played in the normal attack area.

4. Each player must make an appearance in both halves. Attempts are to be made to give all 15 players equal playing time.
5. Dunking will be permitted during the pre-game warm-up.


6. In the event of a tie score at the end of regulation play, a three-minute overtime period will follow. If the game is tied after the first overtime period, a sudden death playoff will be held. The team that scores the FIRST TWO CONSECUTIVE POINTS will be declared the winner.

7. Each player is allowed SIX (6) personal fouls before he is disqualified.
