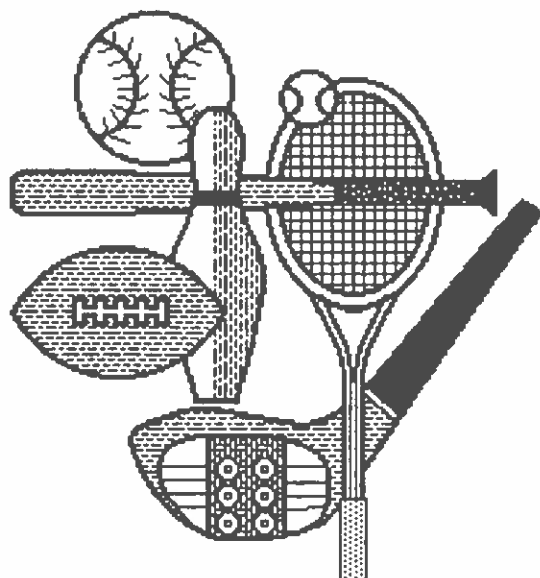

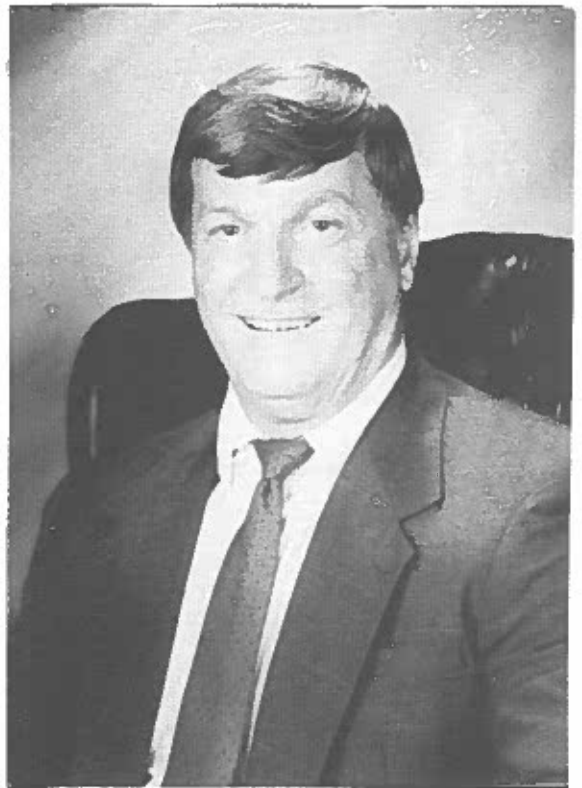
Come Join the Team
