The Samuel A. Mumley Basketball Classic

Back in 1977, four veteran Ohio Valley basketball coaches decided that the concept of a high school All-Star game, similar to the highly successful football contest, would be a very practical idea. And so, Earl Haberfield of Wintersville, Dick Potts of River, Henry "Herk" Lazasz of Tiltonsville, and Bobby Dawson of Wellsburg sat down and drew up the format of what would become the OVAC Basketball Classic.

Earl Haberfield was chosen as the game's first director. The committee enlisted the support of Ogden Newspapers to help underwrite the game, and booked the Wheeling Civic Center for the location, hoping to pack the house.

However, the only problem was that the game had to be played in June. Due to the rules of the West Virginia Secondary Schools Activities Commission, Mountain State athletes could not participate without losing their eligibility for spring sports. As the game was a novelty, the Classic did at one time see 1700 fans witness the Valley's finest, but the heat and the timing soon began to dwindle the interest of area spectators.

Over the years, due to expenses and availability of arenas, the game was played at St. John Arena, Wheeling Park High School, Bellaire High School, Wheeling College, East Liverpool High School, and Buckeye Local High School.

Although the game always showcased some outstanding hardcourt performers, other problems surfaced. The format underwent several changes, and as the interest in girls' sports became greater, the need to have two games for the boys and two games for the girls became apparent. However, West Virginia schools, being smaller in number, often had difficulty finding enough quality players, while Ohio schools had more players than they needed.

Another change in the program came in 1982 when Earl Haberfield left the area to coach in northern Ohio. Before leaving, however, the committee made a wise move in turning over the directorship to Gene Ammirante of Bellaire. Under his leadership, the game became more organized and competitive.

Ammirante ran the game until 1987 when, due to an increasing work load, he resigned the contest to Clyde DiAngelo of Steubenville Catholic Central who guided the Classic for two years. The game was then directed by John Bobalik of Wellsville. After a one-year tenure, the game faced serious problems, as no one wanted to assume the directorship. Also facing financial problems, the game more than ever needed strong leadership. With that in mind, only one man was obvious - Ammirante. Under his direction for the second time, the game made tremendous changes. First, the game was

placed back on strong financial footing.

The second change came in the form of strong involvement of the OVAC Executive Secretary, Sam Mumley, who took it upon himself, with the assistance of Vince Paoletti of Moundsville, to petition the WVSSAC to change the ruling, allowing the game to be played soon after the completion of the regular basketball season. After many trips to Charleston and hours of phone conversations and lobbying, the game was approved. Starting with the 1992 contest, the game would be moved to April.

Because of his dedication to the Conference and his unselfish support of the Classic, the committee decided to change the name of the Classic to the Samuel A. Mumley Basketball Classic.

The format was changed to one boys' game and one girls' game and a Conference cheering competition was added. Through the hard work and efforts, not to mention the enthusiasm, of Linda Alexander of Paden City, the contest never struggled like the game, but jumped right into successful the first year. Although all 44 OVAC schools chose not to participate, the Championship brought hundreds of cheerleaders before the Valley fans to show them that cheering was a bona fide sport also.

With the 1994 Classic, two more changes took place. First, Tom Rataiczak of Bellaire High School, who had served as program director for fifteen years, took over as Game Director. With this came the inception of a coaches' clinic held prior to the game and a luncheon for all the players and their parents. Perhaps the best decision made to date was permanently moving to the campus of Wheeling Jesuit College and their beautiful facilities that you are witnessing this evening. This change not only established a home for the Classic, but allowed its players and cheerleaders to enjoy a major college experience without leaving the Valley.

The 1995 Classic saw three more adjustments. First, the coaches' clinic was dropped, as its timing ran too close to the NCAA Tournament and the availability of quality college coaches. Second, it was decided to begin honoring a coach who pioneered in the establishment of girls' basketball as a sport. The third reason was perhaps the most noticeable. After three years, the cheerleading advisors decided to branch out on their own and moved their competition to November.

Even though the All-Star game has undergone and is still undergoing change, one fact remains constant: it continues to showcase the finest basketball talent the Ohio Valley has to offer.

We welcome you tonight and hope you enjoy the contests.

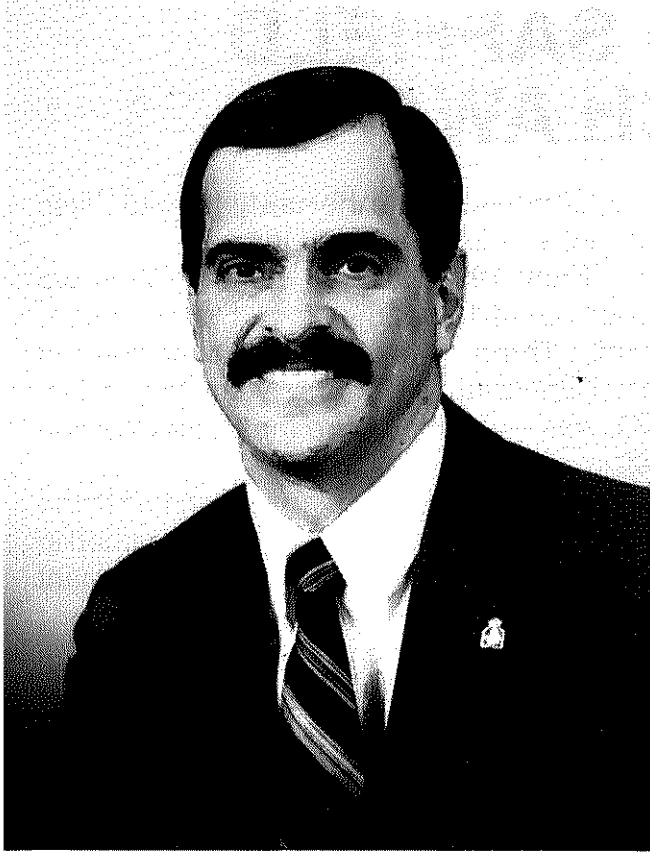
RULES OF THE GAME

This game is sanctioned by the West Virginia Secondary Schools Activities Commission, The Ohio High School Athletic Association, and the National Collegiate Athletic Association and will be played under the following rules:

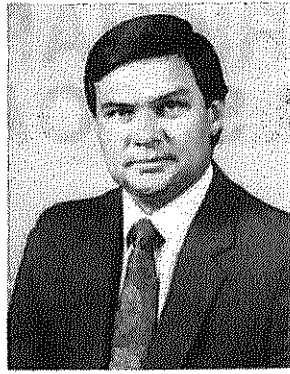
1. Each game will consist of two 20-minute halves.
2. Zone presses may be used but must end after first trap past half court.
3. Man-to-man defense must be played in the normal attack area.
4. Each player must make an appearance in both halves. Attempts are to be made to give all 15 players equal playing time.
5. Dunking will be permitted during the pre-game warm-up.
6. In the event of a tie score at the end of regulation play, a three-minute overtime period will follow. If the game is tied after the first overtime period, a sudden death playoff will be held. The team that scores the **FIRST TWO CONSECUTIVE POINTS** will be declared the winner.
7. Each player is allowed SIX (6) personal fouls before he is disqualified.

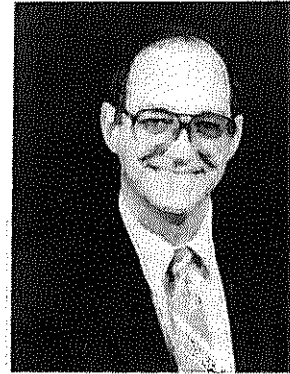

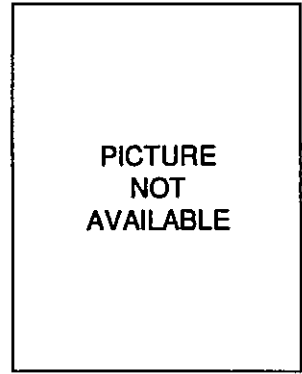

THE RICHARD SAFFIELD GIRLS' COACH AWARD

Last year, the Samuel A. Mumley Basketball Classic decided to honor a girls' coach for his/her contribution to girls' basketball in the OVAC. The first honoree was Agnes Timmons of Barnesville, considered by many to be one of the pioneers of girls' athletics in eastern Ohio.

This year's honoree, although only a coach for 11 years, also greatly impacted the sport by drawing statewide attention to a little OVAC school just a few miles west of Barnesville.

Dave Linn graduated from Zane Trace High School in 1971 and went on to get his teaching degree from Rio Grande College in 1975. Like many coaches, he returned to his alma mater in 1976 and became the head girls' basketball coach. Although they made it to the Sectional finals, their record was a mere 8-4. However, the next season saw the team go undefeated until being beat in the Regional finals.

That season, Zane Trace consolidated with a few other small schools in the area and formed Buckeye Trail. And in their next four

years, Ohio heard from the newly-formed Class A school and Coach Dave Linn.

From 1978 to 1981, the Lady Warriors won 94 out of 102 games for a blistering 92% record. Three of those years, they finished State Runner-up. The only year they didn't, 1979, was when they were the State Champions!

Not only did Linn bring recognition to the little community, but the entire OVAC bathed in their success as girls' basketball took giant strides forward.

For the next five years, his girls won the District finals twice, were District semi-finalists, and Sectional finalists twice.

At the end of the 1986 season, Dave decided to "retire" from coaching with an overall record of 211-37 over 11 seasons for an 85% win factor. During his tenure, he coached in the OVAC All-Star Game twice, the District 12 All-Star Game twice, and the North-South All-Star Game once. He was honored by being selected Class A Coach-of-the-Year for Ohio in 1979.

At the end of this season, Linn also decided to retire from teaching altogether and entered the farming profession which he still does today. He and his wife, Cathy, have two children: Jennifer, 13, and Jason, 11.

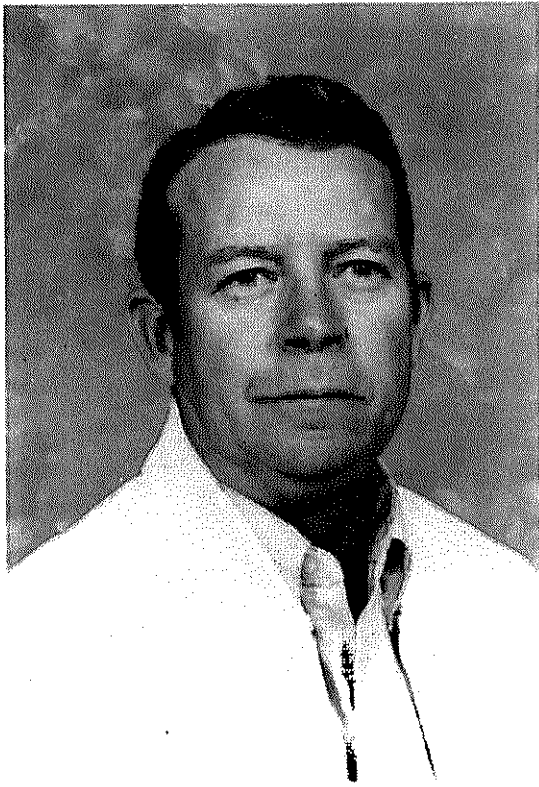
Dave Linn's contribution to OVAC girls' basketball in the early years of their becoming involved in State competition and earning respect for their programs was monumental, and his efforts can still be seen today as you walk into the Warrior gym, see the banners still proudly hanging, and witness the program that he started as one of the best Class A programs in the Conference today.

The Earl Haberfield OVAC Basketball Coaches' Award



Having a coaching career that spanned over two decades and covered two newly-consolidated OVAC schools, Bethany's Russ Schwertfeger becomes the 14th recipient of the Earl Haberfield OVAC Boys' Basketball Coaches' Award.

Graduating from the old West Liberty High School in 1946, Schwertfeger served three years in the army, stationed in Korea. Upon his discharge, he returned to West Liberty where he played basketball for two years and baseball for four years before graduating in 1952.

He started his teaching career at the newly-consolidated Conotton Valley High School, although at that time they were not members of the giant OVAC conference. He served as basketball and baseball coach but also spent two years as the school's football coach of six-man football. Their basketball record was 48-33, including a Harrison County championship in 1955.

In 1956, he moved to Bethany High School to become the basketball and baseball coach there. A small Class A school, Bethany was forced to play many of the larger Class AA and AAA teams. Over his fourteen-year career, Schwertfeger compiled a 160-118 record, win-

ning the OVAC title in 1958 and 1969. His teams won the West Virginia Sectional four times, were Regional Runner-up and Regional Champion, and his 1957 squad made it into the State finals, ending Runner-up that year.

In 1969, Bethany was incorporated into the Wellsburg and Follansbee communities to form the newly-consolidated Brooke High School, a state of the art high school.

Schwertfeger was named boys' basketball coach for the Bruins and went on to compile a 75-53 record from 1969 to 1975, when he retired from coaching. His 1970-1971 Bruins' squad scored 100 or more points on eight occasions. Four times the Bruins were Sectional Champions.

Over his career, he compiled a 283-204 record before he retired from teaching in 1987.

For his accomplishments, Schwertfeger was honored by the Upper Ohio Valley Dapper Dan in 1967, and the West Virginia State Basketball Tournament (West Virginia Coaches' Association of Retired Coaches) in 1989.

But his greatest honor was having the privilege of coaching his three sons: Rusty, Mark, and Jay, all who wore the green and gold (Rusty also played two years at Bethany High School). Russ and his wife of 45 years, Jean, also have two daughters, Kris (who played ball for Brooke) and Dawn. The Schwertfegers are kept busy with 13 lucky grandchildren.

In his retirement, Russ enjoys traveling, fishing, hunting, and volunteering as a playground supervisor at Bethany.

You can bet his courtside seat is extra special tonight also, as his nephew will be playing on the West Virginia squad. Ryan's dad played on the Bethany team that went to the State finals in 1957.

THE ROBERT DAWSON BASKETBALL OFFICIALS' AWARD

Strange game, basketball. You meet a lot of people, travel a lot of miles, work a lot of gyms. And you never know when you will be reunited with one of those acquaintances.

Take "Peck" Pell, for instance. June 24, 1978, he hung up his whistle after 22 years of officiating basketball. His last game? The first OVAC All-Star game, begun, in part, by a good friend, Earl Haberfield of Wintersville. Another founder of the Classic was the late Dick Potts, former coach of River High School. In 1956, Potts was then coaching at Bethel High School. Although he was not yet a registered official, Pell traveled to the game with former Wheeling teammate Don Hinton. Potts saw no problem with him officiating the reserve contest, and so a career was started.

And tonight, the OVAC once again honors David "Peck" Pell for his service to the OVAC over the years.

A 1948 graduate of Wheeling High School, Pell played football under Bob Roe and basketball under the late Everett Brinkman. After graduation, he spent most of his life working at Standard Sand and Gravel before becoming a postman in 1966. His miles of walking each day kept him in good shape for officiating.

His interest in sports also saw him spend 15 seasons on the football field, usually as a head linesman. Working two State championships, he retired from football at the end of the 1976 season.

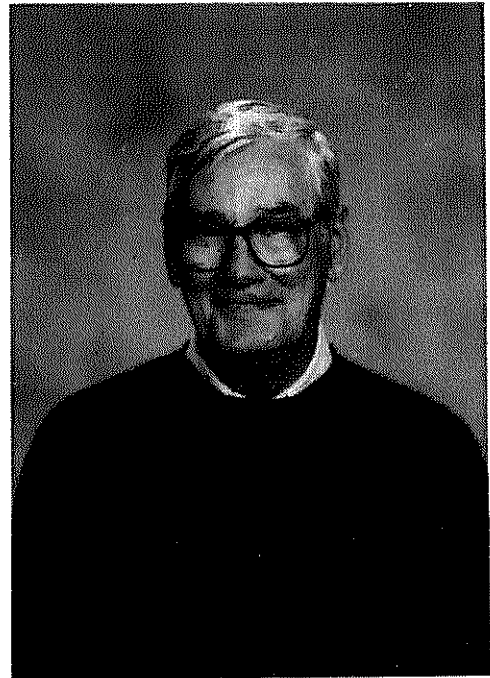
His fairness, common sense, and control of the game made him respected by many OVAC coaches.

"An official walks a fine line. He can't allow himself to be intimidated but he can't afford to over-react either. I've always felt that common sense is just as important as sound mechanics and a thorough knowledge of the rules. Physical conditioning is important too because you can't do a good job when you don't feel well. I've always tried to realize the position of the coaches and recognize that they are under terrific pressure and that emotional things are said in the heat of the game that would not be said otherwise."

The sport changed drastically during Pell's tenure. When he started, there were a lot more small schools throughout Ohio and West Virginia. Most of them used the foul lines as the backcourt lines, and many of the out-of-bounds lines were brick walls. During his first two years, many of the games were called with one official.

"Usually I would leave home at 5:00 and return at midnight or later. The pay was terrific (\$3.00)! This was for reserve games. The varsity officials usually provided the transportation. During those lengthy rides, the basketball rules were discussed and knowledge from experience traded. We learned from them."

Pat Donahue of Wheeling took Pell under his wing and is credited with helping him develop his officiating technique and attitude. His first varsity game was in 1957. The varsity official was Bill Davies, noted area journalist, who gave Pell a number of tips in regard to the sport. The list goes on. Plennie Clutter, Albert Cerullo, Earl Clevins, Jack Prettyman, Gene Britt.



Doing a lot of his early games in the Wetzel/Tyler County area, Pell recalls a game at Middlebourne where he had an apple core tossed at him during the contest. He later learned that it was one of the reserve officials who was displeased with his call.

Throughout the years, Pell took his job seriously. "I always tried to stay level-headed. Having played both football and basketball myself, I know how hard the kids and coaches work and I never wanted to be the cause of a team winning or losing a game."

Dave and his wife, Ruth, have two sons, Gary and Doug, and now are kept busy with seven grandchildren.

"Officiating took me away many evenings while my boys were growing up, but some sacrifices have to be made if a man is serious about being an official. I shall always value the friendships I made through officiating. I certainly enjoyed the experience."

OVAC BASKETBALL SCOREKEEPER/TIMER AWARD

Out of the 44 OVAC conference schools, there are only a handful that you can name a school and a person instantly comes to mind. Such is the case with "Mr. Shadyside," Ray Ponzio.

A Pittsburgh native and graduate of Carnegie Mellon University, Ponzio, although usually associated with music, has served as an announcer, scorekeeper, and coach for the Tiger community.

For his first few years in the Valley, Ponzio was associated with the old Benwood Union High School where he taught music from 1957-1965. During this time, his musicians were selected to perform for President John F. Kennedy. He also got involved with the basketball program, serving as the basketball scorekeeper.

In 1965, he moved to Shadyside, and established one of the finest music programs in the Ohio Valley. Noted for their patriotic and community-focused shows, the Tiger band twice received notoriety when West Virginia Governor Arch Moore recognized them for their band's donation toward the Marshall University football team after their tragic plane crash.

The band also received recognition from President Richard Nixon for their promotion of patriotism during their halftime shows. His "God and Country" show, which unveiled one of the largest handmade flags around, will long be remembered in the Valley. This show was used to kick off the first OVAC All-Star football game. In 1972, when the All-Star game was held at Martins Ferry stadium, Ponzio served as the first band director.

But Ray's involvement goes beyond the music program. As with Benwood, Ponzio became the scorekeeper for Shadyside in 1965, and has held the position since, giving him 39 total years behind the table. Ponzio also served as the seventh grade boys' basketball coach for 17 years, and coached the girls' varsity and reserve teams for four years.

He has also served as the Shadyside track announcer, including the initial Shadyside Relays. Tutored by the late Bill VanHorne,

Ponzio has announced the Bellaire Relays for 20 years.

His speaking talents also made him the Master of Ceremonies for the old Eastern Ohio Athletic Banquet when Bo Schembechler was guest speaker, and the 1976 OVAC Banquet when Lou Holtz was the guest speaker.

Ponzio was recently honored by Samuel A. Mumley at his retirement banquet for his years of service to the OVAC. He currently serves on Mumley's committee for the Easter Seals Telethon and continues with his teaching career at the University of Steubenville and substitutes in Marshall County.

Ponzio and his wife, Bette Anne, have two daughters, Raeanne and Melanie, and one grandchild, Nathan.



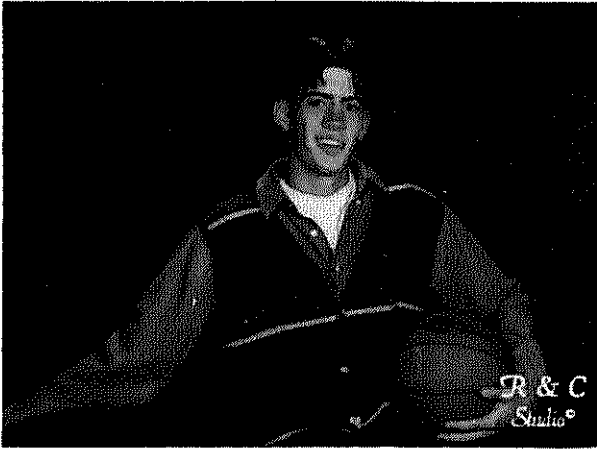
