




IN MEMORY OF ROBERT "PEAR" SADLER AND SIDNEY A. "SID" STOLZ





Mat Talk with Dr. Bill Welker

I have been writing 'Mat Talk'' since 1978, but this is the roughest column I have ever had to put into words for public inspection.

I guess it's because Ohio Valley wrestling has lost its best friend in the sportwriting world last June - the late, great Bill Van Horne.

Not since the passing of George Kovalick have we in the mat sport felt so empty. Bill Van Horne represented everything positive in the athletic realm, but we in wrestling can only explain our appreciation of Bill's dedication to our sport.

I had known Mr. Van Horne since 1970. The things he taught me over the years have made me a more compassionate coach, referee, and writer.


It was Bill Van Horne who opened the door to my writings (Mat Talk) on these pages. And even though it was just an avocation on my part, Bill made it perfectly clear that if I was going to write on his sports pages, it had better be high-quality material.

I have tried to live up to his standards. However, it hasn't been easy. Whenever I wrote a column that I really liked, Bill would show me how I could have done better, or what I forgot to mention. It was always a personal learning experience with Bill.

At times, Bill was unrelenting in his criticism of my writing. "You're preaching, Bill" or "That was corny." And I must admit, it often hurt the pride. But Bill did not care about my pride. Though I didn't always appreciate his candid comments, I did comprehend where he was coming from. His main concern was to make me a better writer. Hopefully, he succeeded.

Bill's basic philosophy as a writing mentor was "You have to be cruel, sometimes, to be kind." I understood this doctrine very well because the best coaches I ever had were made of the same stuff. And note, although Bill never coached a sport in his life, he epitomized all those outstanding qualities that make for coaching greatness. Maybe that's why his penned perceptions of sports over the last 50 years were always on target.

Bill Van Horne was fiery, moody, demanding, uncompromising, and often overbearing. I guess that's why I loved him so. Words can not tell how much I will miss him and his critical comments of my columns. He cared enough to give me heck when it was warranted - just like my father and all the inspirational coaches I have had as an athlete. One last sincere thank you, Bill.



In closing, allow me to share the following poem I wrote about Bill for his 1989 testimonial dinner at the Wheeling Civic Center on the evening of Dec. 10. It sums up his love for sports, a love that will surely be missed by all of us who knew this fantastic human being.

Unquestionably, Bill Van Horne is one of a kind.


During a memorable newspaper career now approaching five decades, the esteemed sports editor of the Wheeling News-Register has become a giant in his field and a role model for aspiring writers.

Above all, he is a man to be admired and respected for his integrity, dedication, fairness, knowledge and compassion. People from all walks of life whether they be a baby-faced high school athlete competing in his or her first track meet or a Pro-Football Hall of Famer - can be assured of one thing. Bill Van Horne, our man for all sports seasons, will impartially treat each individual with respect and consideration. Their accomplishments will be chronicled accurately and receive the recognition each one deserves.

There was never an event too small for his time, nor has there been one too big for him to cover.

Elsewhere in the program you will find a resume of Bill's outstanding and ongoing career. Listed are the numerous and very deserved awards his fellow men and women have bestowed upon him. You can also read about the hundreds and, yes, even thousands of sporting events he has covered through the years. And you'll find the names of many of the Ohio Valley's athletic greats, all of whom Bill has followed from their beginnings on the sandlot to the major league arenas.

But in this special tribute to the man and his life, we prefer to focus on the accomplishments of Bill Van Horne and what his work and



what his efforts of love have meant to the thousands of us who have read the fruits of his labors these many years.

His columns have often been masterpiece chronicles of the lives of others. His support of the 13 Elby's Distance Races and the annual West Virginia Tennis Opens have earned him wide acclaim and also permitted these events to reach the prominence they deserve.

Bill's hand also was a factor in the popularity and success enjoyed by the Wheeling Ironmen and Wheeling Blues' professional football and basketball teams during their heydays. The same goes for the Wheeling LPGA Classics, which were a fixture for 11 years at Oglebay Park and the Speidel championship golf course. You could say the same thing about literally hundreds of other events that have surfaced in our grand Ohio Valley during his 25 years as the sports editor of the Times Leader and his (then) 23-year association at the News-Register.

That's one reason why many of you are here tonight: to say thank you to someone who has been so responsive and cooperative in supporting events that have meant so much in your respective communities.

Bill likes to joke about the fact that he's always been a sports editor. He's never been demoted or promoted in all this time. You can bet there have been numerous opportunities for promotions, but leaving the sports scene in his beloved Ohio Valley is something he'd never seriously consider. Of course, you don't demote somebody who is irreplaceable:

Athletes and coaches who have left the area and were successful on the collegiate and professional level have found that they really are as close to home as the newspaper that is tossed up on the porch of their family's, friends' and fans' residences.

All are kept abreast of these sports figures' career highlights because of Bill's intense interest in them both as athletes and as men or women. When one or more of them reaches the end of a career, Van Horne provides still another fitting tribute to their past and a look at their future plans.

And Bill's remembrances of those who have been called from this earth are journalistic classics. His ability to recall minute details of things that took place decades ago is legendary. His descriptions of those events come from the heart, like the rest of his work, and they provide great comfort to the families at a time when it is most needed.

His knowledge and expertise about the past also have proven valuable as he serves on hall of fame boards for the West Virginia Sports Writers Association, the city of Wheeling and the Upper Ohio Valley Dapper Dan Club.

No one can touch Bill when he's at the microphone either while he's inducting one of his long-time friends in a Hall of Fame; introducing the winner of the News-Register award that goes to the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference's coach of the year; announcing a track meet on a raw, bone-chilling Saturday afternoon; or serving as a toastmaster as he has done at countless athletic banquets.

It would be easy to go on and on while on the subject of Bill Van Horne the sports editor, humanitarian, concerned citizen, loyal friend, beloved husband of Gladys, father of Linda Van Horne Ellis and grandfather of Chrissy Ellis.

Bill's career is like that of the successfull long distance runner. He's running the great race of his life, God willing, his race is far from over.




