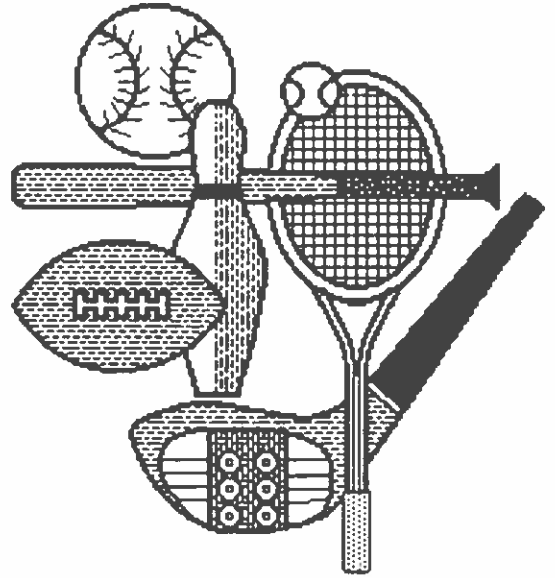

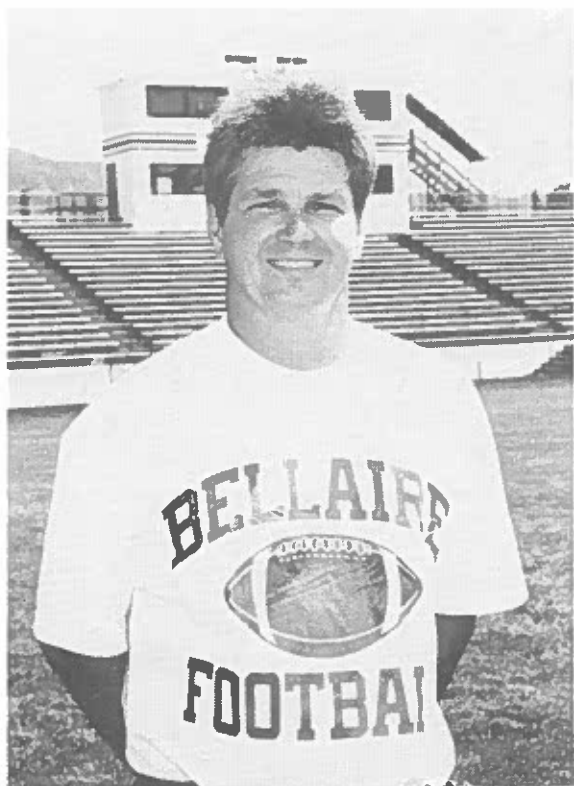
On behalf of the Board of Education, administration, faculty, and students, we welcome you to Bellaire High School and tonight's athletic contest.
