

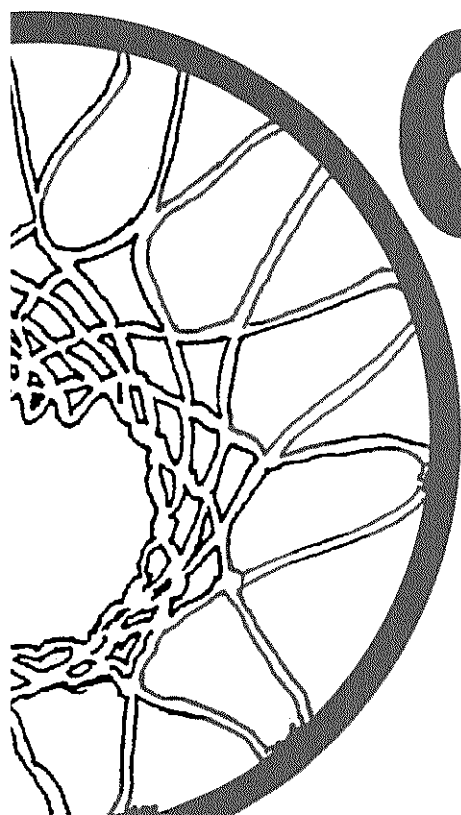

The Samuel A. Mumley Basketball Classic

Back in 1977, four veteran Ohio Valley basketball coaches decided that the concept of a high school All-Star game, similar to the highly successful football contest, would be a very practical idea. And so, Earl Haberfield of Wintersville, Dick Potts of Dover, Henry "Herk" Lazasz of Tiltonsville, and Bobby Lawson of Wellsburg sat down and drew up the format of what would become the OVAC Basketball Classic.

Earl Haberfield was chosen as the game's first director. The committee enlisted the support of the *Wheeling News* and *Intelligencer* newspapers to help underwrite the game, and booked the Wheeling Civic Center for the occasion, hoping to pack the house.

However, the only problem was that the game had to be played in June. Due to the rules of the West Virginia Secondary Schools Activities Commission, Mountain State athletes could not participate without losing their eligibility for spring sports. Since the game was a novelty, the Classic did at one time see 1700 fans witness the Valley's finest, but the heat and the timing soon began to dwindle the interest of area spectators.

Over the years, due to expenses and availability of arenas, the game was played at St. John Arena, Wheeling Park High School, Bellaire High School, Wheeling College, East Liverpool High School, and Buckeye Local High School.

Although the game always showcased some outstanding hardcourt performers, other problems surfaced. The format underwent several changes, and as the interest in girls' sports became greater, the need to have two games for the boys and two games for the girls became apparent. However, West Virginia schools, being smaller in number, often had difficulty finding enough quality players, while Ohio schools had more players than they needed.

Another change in the program came in 1982 when Earl Haberfield left the area to coach in northern Ohio. Before leaving, however, the committee made a wise move in turning over the directorship to Gene Ammirante of Bellaire. Under his leadership, the game became more organized and competitive.

Ammirante ran the game until 1987 when, due to an increasing work load, he resigned the contest to Clyde DiAngelo of Steubenville Catholic Central who guided the Classic for two years. The game was then directed by John Bobalik of Wellsville. After a one-year tenure, the game faced serious problems, as no one wanted to assume the directorship. Also facing financial problems, the game more than ever needed strong leadership. With that in

placed back on strong financial footing.

The second change came in the form of the strong involvement of the OVAC Executive Secretary, Sam Mumley, who took it upon himself, with the assistance of Vince Paoletti of Moundsville, to petition the WVSSAC to change the ruling, allowing the game to be played soon after the completion of the regular basketball season. After many trips to Charleston and hours of phone conversations and lobbying, the game was approved. Starting with the 1992 contest, the game would be moved to August.

Because of his dedication to the Conference and his unselfish support of the Classic, the committee decided to change the name of the Classic to the Samuel A. Mumley Basketball Classic.

The format was changed to one boys' game and one girls' game and a Conference cheerleader competition was added. Through the hard work and efforts, not to mention the enthusiasm, of Larry Alexander of Paducah, the contest never struggled like the game, but jumped right into successful territory the first year. Although all 44 OVAC schools chose to participate, the Championship brought hundreds of cheerleaders before the Valley fans to show that cheering was a bona fide sport also.

With the 1994 Classic, two more changes took place. First, Tom Rataiczak of Bellaire High School, who had served as program director for fifteen years, took over as Game Director. With him came the inception of a coaches' clinic held prior to the game and a luncheon for all the players and their parents. Perhaps the best decision made to date was permanently moving to the campus of Wheeling Jesuit College and their beautiful facilities you are witnessing this evening. This change not only established a home for the Classic, but allowed its players and cheerleaders to enjoy a major league experience without leaving the Valley.

The 1995 Classic saw three more adjustments. First, the coaches' clinic was dropped, a timing ran too close to the NCAA Tournament to allow the availability of quality college coaches. Secondly, it was decided to begin honoring a coach who pioneered in the establishment of girls' basketball as a sport. The third reason was perhaps the most noticeable. After three years, the cheerleader advisors decided to branch out on their own and moved their competition to November.

Even though the All-Star game has unfortunately gone and is still undergoing change, one fact remains constant: it continues to showcase the finest basketball talent the Ohio Valley has to offer.

The Earl Haberfield OVAC Basketball Coaches' Award



Another product of Triadelphia High School, Tom Ackerman graduated in 1949 after lettering four years in baseball and two years in basketball. Before ending his scholastic career, he was named first team All-OVAC and honorable mention All-State in basketball.

But his athletic career took off at West Liberty State College. Ackerman spent two years on the Hilltopper golf team. He was a WVIAC Medalist in 1955 and played on championship teams both in 1955 and 1956.

In basketball, Ackerman was outstanding. He started every game for the Toppers for four years, leading the team in scoring every year. His 1857 points made him West Liberty's third all-time scorer. In 1955, he led the nation in free throw shooting with a blistering 92.5%.

He was named All-Tournament in '52, '55, and '56, All-Tournament in '52 and '56, and honorable mention NAIA All-American in 1956. His 1952 team won the NAIA tournament championship in Kansas City, posting WLSC's best-ever record of 22-6.

For those of you who are paying close attention, you're probably wondering about the accuracy of the years. Ackerman served a two-year stint in the army during the Korean War from 1952-1954, thereby interrupting his stay at West Liberty. In 1953, he played for the Camp Breckenridge, Kentucky, basketball team. He was drafted by the Minneapolis Lakers in 1952, but went into the service instead. During the spring at West Liberty, Ackerman served as a four-year starter at shortstop for

After graduation, he spent a year at Mt. PI serving as head basketball and baseball coach. In 1959, he had the chance to return to his alma mater to serve as head basketball and baseball coach. During his tenure, his teams won 2 OVAC championships, 3 national championships, and 1 Regional championship.

Ackerman entered the college coaching ranks at Bethany College in 1966, serving 2 years as head basketball coach and winning the PAC championships in 1967 and 1968. He then moved down Route 88 to West Liberty in 1969 where he assumed the reins of the basketball team there. That year he won the Hall of Fame Tournament in Springfield, Massachusetts, and he won the WVIAC Championship by upsetting #1 West Virginia and undefeated Fairmont State. Leaving West Liberty in '75, Ackerman would return in 1988 to end his 30-year teaching/coaching career in 1993.

In between stints, he served as head basketball coach at John Marshall for five years and one year at Maysville High School in the same capacity.

On a personal note, Ackerman was inducted into the West Liberty Hall of Fame in 1981, and was the first player in the WVIAC to be named to THREE All-Time Teams of the past 50 years in basketball, baseball, and golf.

Since his graduation from West Liberty in 1949, Ackerman has been an avid amateur golfer. He won the Bernhardts Championship in 1974, was a three-time champion at the Cooney Bentz Tournament, but his greatest moment came in 1984. Teaming up with his son, Danny, he won the United States' Father-Son Tournament at Pinehurst, North Carolina. In 1996, he was inducted into the Ohio Valley Legends of Golf.

Tom has been married to his wife, Susan, for 40 years. The couple have four children: Danny, director of golf at Quail Hollow Country Club in Paineville, Ohio; Vicki Jo Kennedy; Jenny McCartle; and Andrew Evans.

The Ackermans enjoy the company of five children.

OVAC BASKETBALL SCOREKEEPER/TIMER AWARD

Born and raised in the Wheeling area, Chuck Koehler's name and face have been associated with the scene from his high school years. He attended Wheeling public schools and graduated from Wheeling High School in 1954.

At Triadelphia, he played varsity football for four years, starting three of them. During his senior year, he was co-captain of the "Little Reds," made first team All-Valley, and led the Ohio Valley in scoring with 10 points.

During the winter, Chuck played three years of basketball, starting two years and becoming All-Valley his junior year. But one of his lifelong loves was golf, a sport that he still works with to this day. A four- varsity starter, Chuck's team went to the State tournament in his junior year where he was selected All-Valley team.

Koehler was also active in high school, serving as senior class treasurer and being selected into the National Honor Society.

In January, 1955, he joined the army and served two years, being discharged in 1958 with a rank of SP-4. While in the army, he married his high school sweetheart, Patsy Minger. The couple will be married 42 years in August.

After getting out of the service, Chuck worked as a member for Local Union #91. He first started out with the Wheeling Ruch Company (his uncle). In 1967, Chuck and his friends went together and formed the Wheeling Rating Company where he worked until his recent retirement.

He started his coaching career in 1966 with the Cubs of the Wheeling Midget League as co-manager with his good friend, Ted Velas. After coaching the club and ten-year olds for nine years, he moved up into the major league with Bill "Wally" Walters in 1975.

Two years later, Koehler and Walters took over the Wheeling Post #1 American Legion Team. That year, they won the State Runner-Up title, and came back the following year to win the State Championship.

And that started the dynasty. In 1982, his Legion team won **SEVEN CONSECUTIVE** State championships, a record that still stands. In 1993, the Legion team broke over the 500 win mark. Over the years, many area ball greats got a chance to "sharpen the saw" before going on to professional careers.

Twenty-one years later, Chuck is still managing the team.

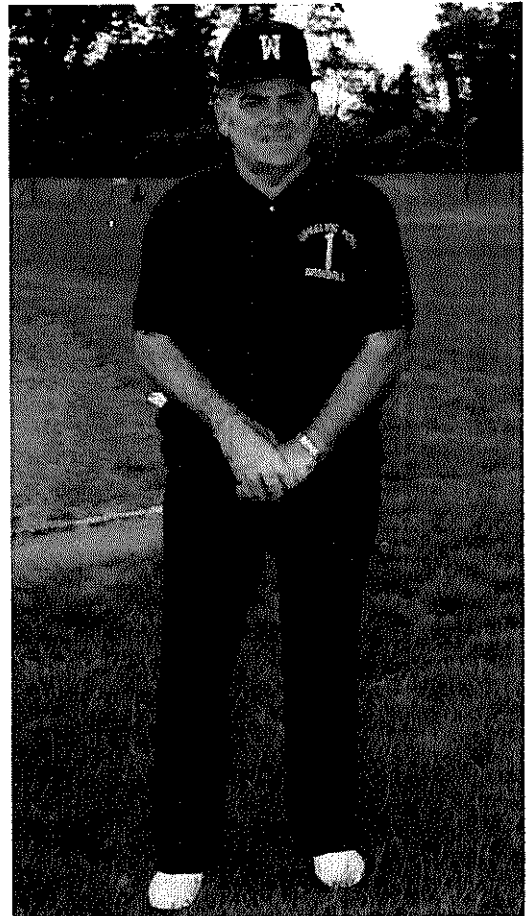
His association with basketball and scorekeeping began in 1972 when his son, Jim, was playing. Triadelphia coach Dick Moore asked him to keep the book, and he has stayed in touch with his boys, Koehler agreed. In 1981 when Triadelphia, Warwood, and Wheeling merged into Wheeling Park, his youngest son, David, was a member of the Park team that won 22 straight games

was long-time rivals with Wheeling coach Sam Anderson. Koehler took the Patriot job of scorekeeping and has been there ever since.

And after he ran out of sons, he enjoyed the contact with the kids so much that he has continued to stay, 25 years in all, making him one of the "Deans" of the Ohio Valley score tables.

Chuck and his wife have four children: Jim, a three-sport Triadelphia standout who has worked with his dad as a painter for the last 20 years; Doug, who works and lives in Tampa, Florida; David, a Regional Sales Manager for Cameron Coca-Cola; and Lori, who works in the advertising field.

What keeps him busy today? The Elm Grove Lions Club, the Elm Grove Civics, the Wheeling Park Boosters, the American Legion, the Edgewood Lutheran Church, and eight grandchildren!

THE ROBERT DAWSON BASKETBALL OFFICIALS' AWARD

Chester Grossi is a graduate of Weirton High School and West Liberty State College, where he received his Bachelor's Degree in political science and physical education in 1947.

He became a teacher/coach at his alma mater for fourteen years. During this time, he received Master's Degrees in secondary administration, health and physical education, recreation and administration.

He left education to enter the investment and insurance business with Waddell and Reed, Inc., serving for twenty years as the Divisional Manager of the Weirton office. He later became associated with Offerman & Co., Inc., an investment banking and brokerage firm from Minneapolis, Minnesota, serving as Divisional Manager, until his retirement four years ago.

His love for sports saw him enter the world of officiating, where he worked his way up to officiating 12 West Virginia State Basketball Finals and five West Virginia State Football Playoffs. He officiated football and basketball for the OVAC and the West Virginia Intercollegiate Conference as a member of the Ohio Valley Board and the West Virginia/Ohio Basketball Officials for 45 years, until his retirement in 1988.

Grossi was inducted into the West Liberty Sports Hall of Fame, where he played football for the late Coach Joseph Bartell.

Grossi is currently President of the Weirtonian Lodge #183, Order Italian Sons and Daughters of America, a board member of the ISDA Fraternal Association, and National Councilor of the Order. He is also a director on the Upper Ohio Valley Italian Festival Board, representing Hancock County and the Weirtonian Lodge.

He has served the Knights of Columbus as Past Grand Knight for Council 3734 in Weirton and as also District Deputy for the First District of West Virginia.

His memberships also include the American Legion Post 10, the Weirton Elks, and the United Way, Inc. Grossi is a life member of the West Virginia Education Association and the National Education Association. He is also a life member of several alumni associations of West Liberty State College and West Virginia University and is very active

He is a member of St. Paul's Catholic Church, their Holy Name Society, and treasurer of the church's finance committee. In addition, he served on the finance committee for the Weirton Chapel Camp Fire, Inc.

Grossi is married to the former Rose Pauley. They have two children: Tom, a finance professional with Linsco/Private Ledger, who is married to the former Lisa Bettino, and Monica, who is a nurse at the Weirton Medical Center.
