## The Samuel A. Mumley Basketball Classi

Back in 1977, four veteran Ohio Valley basstball coaches decided that the concept of a high shool All-Star game, similar to the highly success-I football contest, would be a very practical idea. and so, Earl Haberfield of Wintersville, Dick Potts of iver, Henry "Herk" Lazasz of Tiltonsville, and Bobby awson of Wellsburg sat down and drew up the rmat of what would become the OVAC Basketball assic.

Earl Haberfield was chosen as the game's st director. The committee enlisted the support of gden Newspapers to help underwrite the game, id booked the Wheeling Civic Center for the cation, hoping to pack the house.

However, the only problem was that the me had to be played in June. Due to the rules of a West Virginia Secondary Schools Activities Comission, Mountain State athletes could not particite without losing their eligibility for spring sports. The game was a novelty, the Classic did at one ne see 1700 fans witness the Valley's finest, but a heat and the timing soon began to dwindle the terest of area spectators.

Over the years, due to expenses and availility of arenas, the game was played at St. John ena, Wheeling Park High School, Bellaire High shool, Wheeling College, East Liverpool High shool, and Buckeye Local High School.

Although the game always showcased some tstanding hardcourt performers, other problems rfaced. The format underwent several changes, d as the interest in girls' sports became greater, need to have two games for the boys and two mes for the girls became apparent. However, est Virginia schools, being smaller in number, en had difficulty finding enough quality players, lile Ohio schools had more players than they eded.

Another change in the program came in 82 when Earl Haberfield left the area to coach in rthern Ohio. Before leaving, however, the comtee made a wise move in turning over the direcship to Gene Ammirante of Bellaire. Under his idership, the game became more organized and mpetitive.

Ammirante ran the game until 1987 when, e to an increasing work load, he resigned the ntest to Clyde DiAngelo of Steubenville Catholic ntral who guided the Classic for two years. The me was then directed by John Bobalik of Wellsville. er a one-year tenure, the game faced serious blems, as no one wanted to assume the directorp. Also facing financial problems, the game more in ever needed strong leadership. With that in

placed back on strong financial footing.

The second change came in the for strong involvement of the OVAC Executive Setary, Sam Mumley, who took it upon himself, wit assistance of Vince Paoletti of Moundsville, to tion the WVSSAC to change the ruling, allowing game to be played soon after the completion or regular basketball season. After many trip Charleston and hours of phone conversations lobbying, the game was approved. Starting witl 1992 contest, the game would be moved to A

Because of his dedication to the Conference and his unselfish support of the Classic, the contee decided to change the name of the Classic to Samuel A. Mumley Basketball Classic.

The format was changed to one boys' g and one girls' game and a Conference chee competition was added. Through the hard work efforts, not to mention the enthusiasm, of L Alexander of Paden City, the contest never strug like the game, but jumped right into successfu first year. Although all 44 OVAC schools chose to participate, the Championship brought hund of cheerleaders before the Valley fans to show that cheering was a bona fide sport also.


With the 1994 Classic, two more char took place. First, Tom Rataiczak of Bellaire I School, who had served as program director fifteen years, took over as Game Director. With came the inception of a coaches' clinic held printhe game and a luncheon for all the players and parents. Perhaps the best decision made to a was permanently moving to the campus of Whing Jesuit College and their beautiful facilities you are witnessing this evening. This change only established a home for the Classic, but allow its players and cheerleaders to enjoy a major lege experience without leaving the Valley.

The 1995 Classic saw three more adj ments. First, the coaches' clinic was dropped, a timing ran too close to the NCAA Tournament the availability of quality college coaches. Sect it was decided to begin honoring a coach pioneered in the establishment of girls' baskel as a sport. The third reason was perhaps the n noticeable. After three years, the cheerlead advisors decided to branch out on their own moved their competition to November.

Even though the All-Star game has ungone and is still undergoing change, one fact mains constant: it continues to showcase the fir basketball talent the Ohio Valley has to offer.





# The Earl Haberfield OVAC Basketball Coaches' Award



Another product of Triadelphia High School, Tom Ackerman graduated in 1949 after lettering four years in baseball and two years in basketball. Before ending his scholastic career, he was named first team All-OVAC and honorable mention All-State in basketball.

But his athletic career took off at West Liberty State College. Ackerman spent two years on the Hilltopper golf team. He was a WVIAC Medalist in 1955 and played on championship teams both in 1955 and 1956.

In basketball, Ackerman was outstanding. He started every game for the Toppers for four years, leading the team in scoring every year. His 1857 points made his West Liberty's third all-time scorer. In 1955, he led the nation in free throw shooting with a blistering 92.5%.

He was named All-Tournament in '52, '55, and 56, All-Tournament in '52 and '56, and honorable mention NAIA All-American in 1956. His 1952 team won the NAIA tournament championship in Kansas City, posting WLSC's best-ever record of 22-6.

For those of you who are paying close attention, you're probably wondering about the accuracy of the years. Ackerman served a two-year stint in the army during the Korean War from 1952-1954, thereby interrupting his stay at West Liberty. In 1953, he played for the Camp Breckenridge, Kentucky, basketball team. He was drafted by the Minneapolis Lakers in 1952, but went into the service instead. During the spring at West Liberty, Ackerman served as a four-year starter at shortstop for

After graduation, he spent a year at Mt. Pl serving as head basketball and baseball coach. 1959, he had the chance to return to his alma m serve as head basketball and baseball coach. Du tenure, his teams won 2 OVAC championships, tional championships, and 1 Regional champion

Ackerman entered the college coaching r Bethany College in 1966, serving 2 years as heaketball coach and winning the PAC champions 1967 and 1968. He then moved down Route 88 t Liberty in 1969 where he assumed the reins basketball team there. That year he won the Hall o Tournament in Springfield, Massachusetts, and in won the WVIAC Championship by upsetting #1 and undefeated Fairmont State. Leaving West Lil '75, Ackerman would return in 1988 to end his 3 teaching/coaching career in 1993.

In between stints, he served as head bas coach at John Marshall for five years and one Maysville High School in the same capacity.

On a personal note, Ackerman was induct the West Liberty Hall of Fame in 1981, and was to player in the WVIAC to be named to THREE A teams of the past 50 years in basketball, basebe golf.

Since his graduation from West Liberty ir Ackerman has been an avid amateur golfer. He w Bernhardt's Championship in 1974, was a thre champion at the Cooey Bentz Tournament, but his est moment came in 1984. Teaming up with h Danny, he won the United States' Father-Son T ment at Pinehurst, North Carolina. In 1996, h inducted into the Ohio Valley Legends of Golf.

Tom has been married to his wife, Susan years. The couple have four children: Danny, director of golf at Quail Hollow Country Club in Pain Ohio; Vicki Jo Kennedy; Jenny McCartle; and Evans.

The Ackermans enjoy the company of five children.

Two years later, Koehler and Walters took over heeling Post #1 American Legion Team. That year, von the State Runner-Up title, and came back the ing year to win the State Championship.

And that started the dynasty. In 1982, his Legion won SEVEN CONSECUTIVE State championa record that still stands. In 1993, the Legion team over the 500 win mark. Over the years, many area tall greats got a chance to "sharpen the saw" before up on to professional careers.

Twenty-one years later, Chuck is still managing



Chester Grossi is a graduate of Weirton ligh School and West Liberty State College, where e received his Bachelor's Degree in political scince and physical education in 1947.

He became a teacher/coach at his alma nater for fourteen years. During this time, he aceived Master's Degrees in secondary adminisation, health and physical education, recreation administration.

He left education to enter the investment nd insurance business with Waddell and Reed, ic., serving for twenty years as the Divisional lanager of the Weirton office. He later became ssociated with Offerman & Co., Inc., an investment anking and brokerage firm from Minneapolis, Minesota, serving as Divisional Manager, until his stirement four years ago.

His love for sports saw him enter the world fofficiating, where he worked his way up to officiting 12 West Virginia State Basketball Finals and ve West Virginia State Football Playoffs.
