The Samuel A. Mumley Basketball Classic

Back in 1977, four veteran Ohio Valley basketball coaches decided that the concept of a high school All-Star game, similar to the highly successful football contest, would be a very practical idea. And so, Earl Haberfield of Wintersville, Dick Potts of River, Henry "Lerk" Lazasz of Tiltonsville, and Bobby Dawson of Wellsburg sat down and drew up the format of what would become the OVAC Basketball Classic.

Earl Haberfield was chosen as the game's first director. The committee enlisted the support of Ogden newspapers to help underwrite the game, and booked the Wheeling Civic Center for the location, hoping to pack the house.

However, the only problem was that the game had to be played in June. Due to the rules of the West Virginia Secondary Schools Activities Commission, Mountain State athletes could not participate without losing their eligibility for spring sports. As the game was a novelty, the Classic did at one time see 1700 fans witness the Valley's finest, but the heat and the timing soon began to dwindle the interest of area spectators.

Over the years, due to expenses and availability of arenas, the game was played at St. John Arena, Wheeling Park High School, Bellaire High School, Wheeling College, East Liverpool High School, and Buckeye Local High School.

Although the game always showcased some outstanding hardcourt performers, other problems surfaced. The format underwent several changes, and as the interest in girls' sports became greater, the need to have two games for the boys and two games for the girls became apparent. However, West Virginia schools, being smaller in number, often had difficulty finding enough quality players, while Ohio schools had more players than they needed.

Another change in the program came in 1982 when Earl Haberfield left the area to coach in northern Ohio. Before leaving, however, the committee made a wise move in turning over the directorship to Gene Ammirante of Bellaire. Under his leadership, the game became more organized and competitive.

Ammirante ran the game until 1987 when, due to an increasing work load, he resigned the contest to Clyde "Angelo" Steubenville Catholic Central who guided the Classic for two years. The game was then directed by John Bobalik of Wellsville. After a one-year tenure, the game faced serious problems, as no one wanted to assume the directorship. Also facing financial problems, the game more than ever needed strong leadership. With that in mind, only one man was obvious - Ammirante. Under his direction for the second time, the game made tremendous changes. First, the game was placed back on strong financial footing.

The second change came in the form of strong involvement of the OVAC Executive Secretary, Sam Mumley, who took it upon himself, with the assistance of Prince Paoletti of Moundsville, to petition the WVSSAC to change the ruling, allowing the game to be played soon after the completion of the regular basketball season. After many trips to Charleston and hours of phone

to April.

Because of his dedication to the Conference, his unselfish support of the Classic, the committee decided to change the name of the Classic to the Samuel Mumley Basketball Classic.

The format was changed to one boys' game, one girls' game and a Conference cheering competition was added. Through the hard work and efforts, I mention the enthusiasm, of Linda Alexander of Park City, the contest never struggled like the game jumped right into successful the first year. Although OVAC schools chose not to participate, the Championship brought hundreds of cheerleaders before the fans to show them that cheering was a bona fide activity also.

With the 1994 Classic, two more changes took place. First, Tom Rataiczak of Bellaire High School had served as program director for fifteen years, and was now over as Game Director. With this came the inception of a coaches' clinic held prior to the game and a luncheon for all the players and their parents. Perhaps the most significant decision made to date was permanently moving the game to the campus of Wheeling Jesuit College and their beautiful facilities that you are witnessing this evening. This change not only established a home for the Classic but also allowed its players and cheerleaders to enjoy a college experience without leaving the Valley.

The 1995 Classic saw three more adjustments. First, the coaches' clinic was dropped, as its timing was too close to the NCAA Tournament and the availability of quality college coaches. Second, it was decided to honor a coach who pioneered in the establishment of girls' basketball as a sport. The third reason was perhaps the most noticeable. After three years, the cheerleaders decided to branch out on their own and run their own competition to November.

In 1997, reaching its twentieth anniversary, the advent of a reunion team was created. Thirty athletes from the original all-star game returned to participate in an annual 20th-year reunion.

Although the committee thought the Classic was stabilizing, another big change came in 1998. Following on the heels of the All-Star Football Game and the Wrestling Tournament, the game was broadcast live on Channel 7. Now, instead of the athletes playing to 2,000 people, they went into over 50,000 homes throughout the Ohio Valley.

Even though the All-Star game has undergone change and is still undergoing change, one fact remains constant: it continues to showcase the finest basketball talent the Ohio Valley has to offer.

THE RICHARD SAFFIELD GIRLS' COACH AWARD



JOANNE C. HESS
ST. CLAIRSVILLE HIGH SCHOOL

Many can say they coached basketball, and many can say they pioneered the sport, but very few can say they impacted the sport for all to follow.

Such is Joanne Hess.

Her 24-year old coaching career saw victories at Ravenna High School and Oak Hills High School before she came to the Valley and coached in at St. Clairsville High School.

Over these years, her teams racked up 99 wins against 75 losses and two ties. Her Lady Devils saw a nine-year-in-a-row Sectional title, from 1976 to 1984. She made it to the state final in 1976, 1979, and 1984, and was ranked in the top ten girls' teams in the State on several occasions. Sandwiched in these years

But in 1979, she impacted girls' basketball, not only in St. Clairsville but also in all of OVAC schools. It was then that she won a Title IX and Title VIII arbitration for equal equipment, equal time, equal uniforms, equal publicity, and equal salary. This win allowed coaches to lead girls' teams throughout the Valley to gain equal treatment for girls and for themselves from that point forward.

Over her career, Hess racked up numerous personal coaching awards. Twice she was selected OVAC Coach-of-the-Year. In 1984 she was named to the Basketball Hall of Fame in Ohio and was selected as one of the Top 100 coaches among men **AND** women in the State of Ohio. She holds the third highest total wins for girls' coaches in the State.

She retired in 1997 after 31 years as a guidance counselor and coach. Joanne has two children, Lori and Kent, and currently resides in Columbus, Ohio.

OVAC BASKETBALL SCOREKEEPER/TIMER AWARD

That's longer than most of us have been doing high school basketball games.

Starting out under the legendary R. L. Tolzda, Ron also served as the timer for coaches Tolzda and Mark Romick. A novice for the basketball teams, he has worked for Tim Romick's Lady Pilots for the past eleven years, kept the freshman clock for four years.

And when the season ends, does Ron stay behind the gym? No way. For eighteen years, he's been behind the table for the 7th and 8th grade basketball tournament, and was honored to be the timekeeper for the 1985 and 1990 Division III Sectional Tourney as well as the Division III State's Tournament in 1993 and 1994.

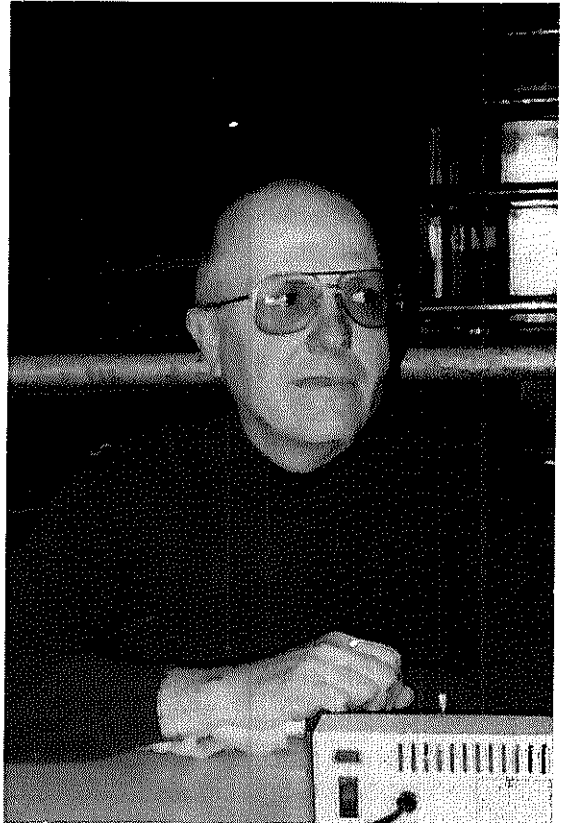
With that much dedication to the winter sport, you would think that Ron would enjoy his summer and fall off.

For 34 years again, Sebring has been a member of the River Pilot chain crew for home basketball games, serving under head coaches Tom Flannery, Charles Thomas, and Terry Hilly.

The couple has two children: Craig, a teacher and coach at Randolph High School; and Tamara, a teacher and coach at Cambridge High School. When he isn't busy watching his beloved basketball play, he's traveling to the other schools to support his children's squads.

THE EARL HABERFIELD OVAC BASKETBALL COACHES' AWARDS



**BOB BURTON
PADEN CITY HIGH SCHOOL**

In 1957, when Bob Burton received his diploma from Magnolia High School, little did he think that forty years later he would be the "Dean" of Ohio Valley basketball coaches. During those years, he was too busy playing football, basketball, and baseball. His football prowess earned him All-State honors in 1955. And little did he think that someday he would be a member of the prestigious Blue Eagle Hall of Fame.

So he went to Kent State University, but later transferred to West Liberty State College where he graduated in 1961. And little did he realize then, that his wife and two daughters would also all be Hilltopper alumnae, a fact that pleases him immensely. He was too busy playing football, basketball, and tennis.

Instead, he was glad to graduate and get a job in the area he loved, settling in at Paden City High School.

The next 36 years was, as they say, a long story. Thirty-five years as the head boys' basketball coach, 18 years as an assistant football coach, 20 years as the boys' track coach, 10 years as the girls' track coach, 2 years as the cross country coach, 1 year as the

ball coach, not to mention 12 years as athletic director. You see, in a small school, you have to wear a lot of hats.

But his love and forte was basketball. Over the past four decades, he led the Wildcats to:

- 21 Sectional Championships,
- 8 Regional Championships,
- 2 State Runner-Up Titles, and
- 2 State Championships.

He captured 5 OVAC titles, saw nine win seasons, and coached 26 winning seasons. All tolled: 519 wins against 286 losses.

But any coach who's been around a long while will tell you that you don't make it alone in his words:

"I have never missed a game in 36 years. I consider myself lucky to have met the many coaches, officials, and school personnel throughout the Valley."

Rewards have been sweet also. The football teams he assisted were State champions in 1970 and 1979. He coached the OVAC football game in 1977, and four times led Mountaineers in the OVAC All-Star Basketball Classic. In 1987, in addition to coaching the West Virginia North-South Game, he was selected as the Coach-of-the-Year.

Burton also gives much of his success to his family who has been patient with him over the years. He and his wife, Sharon (Palm) have two daughters, Tricia Shannon and Elizabeth Burton. Will things slow down any when Bob retires from Paden City? Think again. He is now the proud grandfather of Jake Shannon.

THE ROBERT DAWSON ASKETBALL OFFICIALS' AWARD

Walter Heil, one of the deans of Ohio officials, had an officiating career that spanned three decades and embraced three sports.

It all started on the baseball diamond, where the then native of Bellaire became involved in that sport as an umpire back in 1926. He started officiating football in 1928 and basketball in 1929, and continued for 38 years before hanging up his whistle at the age of 62.

When he started officiating basketball in 1929, one man officiated the game, with a jump ball being held after each field goal. One official was required to work the pre-game also and received a fee of \$7.50. Compare that to \$124 today!

Over the years, Mr. Heil worked football and basketball games at the high school, college and professional levels. His expertise earned him officiating spots in five West Virginia High School State Tournaments, five West Virginia Catholic High School State Tournaments, and three West Virginia Intercollegiate Conference Tournaments.

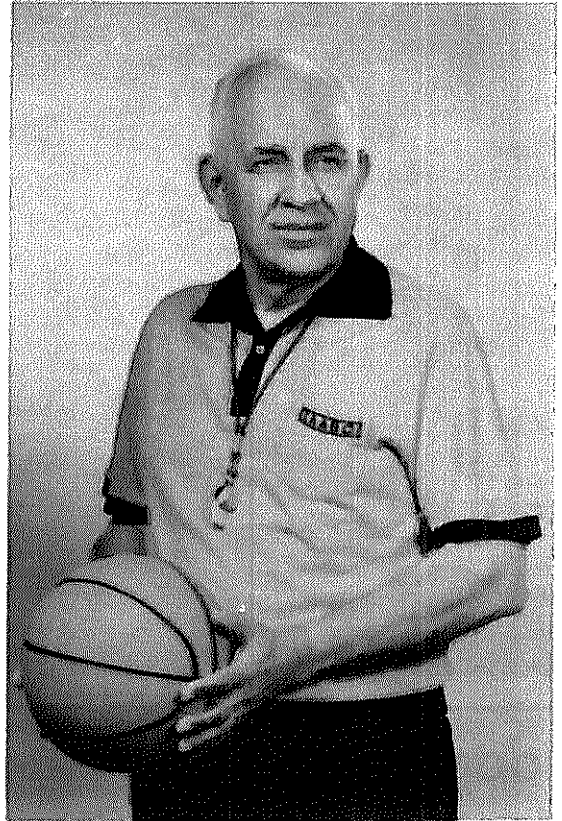
Heil was also an official for the Continental Football League, which featured the Wheeling Ironmen. He was a member of the Ohio Officials' Association, the State Organization of Basketball Officials, and the International Association of Basketball Officials. Over the years, he worked with other Valley legends, such as Camilletti, Warren Pugh, Don Hamill, Jack Hill, Earl Klevins [the 1992 recipient], and Gene Clutter.

After retiring, his love for officiating didn't end. He assumed the role of the commissioner of basketball and football officials in 1965, a position he held until March 1, 1970.

Walter was a 1922 graduate of Bellaire High School, where he was one of the first class inductees into their Wall of Fame. He worked for the Leighton Steel Company and resided in Yorkville, Ohio, with his wife, Margaret "Peg" Heil until his death on November 27, 1970.

His wife now resides in Martins Ferry. His daughter, Mary Kay, married Rob Berger and resides in Yorkville. Like her mother, Mary Kay is active with the OVAC, serving as one of the directors of the Cheering Competition.

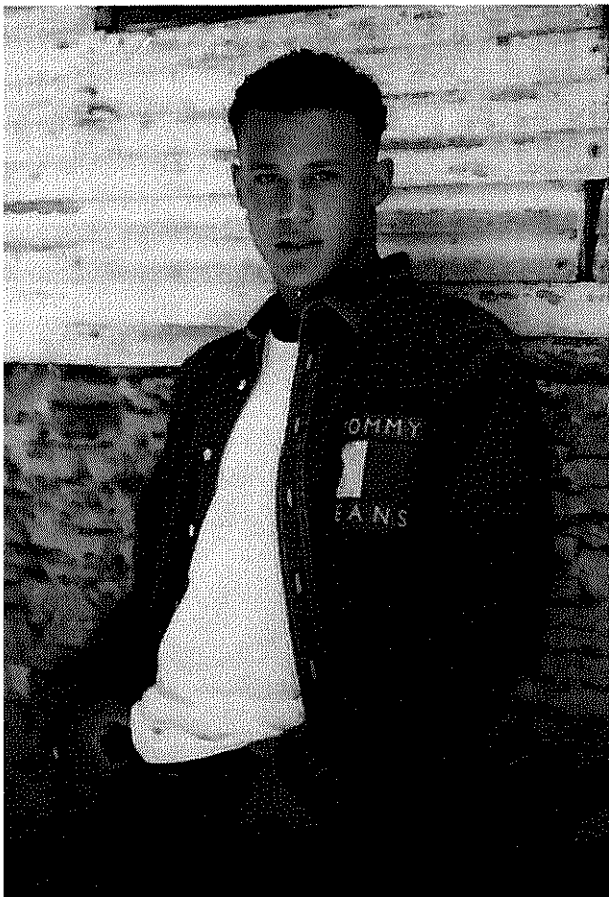
