The Samuel A. Mumley Basketball Classi

Back in 1977, four veteran Ohio Valley basketall coaches decided that the concept of a high school I-Star game, similar to the highly successful football intest, would be a very practical idea. And so, Earl aberfield of Wintersville, Dick Potts of River, Henry ferk" Lazasz of Tiltonsville, and Bobby Dawson of 'ellsburg sat down and drew up the format of what would ecome the OVAC Basketball Classic.

Earl Haberfield was chosen as the game's first rector. The committee enlisted the support of Ogden ewspapers to help underwrite the game, and booked e Wheeling Civic Center for the location, hoping to pack e house.

However, the only problem was that the game ad to be played in June. Due to the rules of the West irginia Secondary Schools Activities Commission, Mounin State athletes could not participate without losing leir eligibility for spring sports. As the game was a ovelty, the Classic did at one time see 1700 fans witness le Valley's finest, but the heat and the timing soon began dwindle the interest of area spectators.

Over the years, due to expenses and availability i arenas, the game was played at St. John Arena, /heeling Park High School, Bellaire High School, Wheelg College, East Liverpool High School, and Buckeye ocal High School.

Although the game always showcased some utstanding hardcourt performers, other problems suriced. The format underwent several changes, and as ie interest in girls' sports became greater, the need to ave two games for the boys and two games for the girls ecame apparent. However, West Virginia schools, eing smaller in number, often had difficulty finding nough quality players, while Ohio schools had more layers than they needed.

Another change in the program came in 1982 hen Earl Haberfield left the area to coach in northern hio. Before leaving, however, the committee made a rise move in turning over the directorship to Gene mmirante of Bellaire. Under his leadership, the game ecame more organized and competitive.

Ammirante ran the game until 1987 when, due to n increasing work load, he resigned the contest to Clyde liAngelo of Steubenville Catholic Central who guided ne Classic for two years. The game was then directed y John Bobalik of Wellsville. After a one-year tenure, ne game faced serious problems, as no one wanted to ssume the directorship. Also facing financial problems, ne game more than ever needed strong leadership. Vith that in mind, only one man was obvious - Ammirante. Inder his direction for the second time, the game made emendous changes. First, the game was placed back n strong financial footing.

The second change came in the form of strong volvement of the OVAC Executive Secretary, Sam lumley, who took it upon himself, with the assistance of 'ince Paoletti of Moundsville, to petition the WVSSAC to hange the ruling, allowing the game to be played soon fiter the completion of the regular basketball season. Ifter many trins to Charleston and hours of phone

to April.

Because of his dedication to the Conference his unselfish support of the Classic, the committe cided to change the name of the Classic to the Same Mumley Basketball Classic.

The format was changed to one boys' gam one girls' game and a Conference cheering compe was added. Through the hard work and efforts, I mention the enthusiasm, of Linda Alexander of P City, the contest never struggled like the game jumped right into successful the first year. Although OVAC schools chose not to participate, the Charr ship brought hundreds of cheerleaders before the \ fans to show them that cheering was a bona fide also.

With the 1994 Classic, two more changes place. First, Tom Rataiczak of Bellaire High School had served as program director for fifteen years, over as Game Director. With this came the incept a coaches' clinic held prior to the game and a lunc for all the players and their parents. Perhaps the decision made to date was permanently moving campus of Wheeling Jesuit College and their bea facilities that you are witnessing this evening. change not only established a home for the Classi allowed its players and cheerleaders to enjoy a college experience without leaving the Valley.

The 1995 Classic saw three more adjustrr First, the coaches' clinic was dropped, as its timin too close to the NCAA Tournament and the availab quality college coaches. Second, it was decided to honoring a coach who pioneered in the establishm girls' basketball as a sport. The third reason was pe the most noticeable. After three years, the cheerle advisors decided to branch out on their own and rr their competition to November.

In 1997, reaching its twentieth anniversar advent of a reunion team was created. Thirty athletes from the original all-star game returned to it an annual 20th-year reunion.

Although the committee thought the Classi stabilizing, another big change came in 1998. Folon the heels of the All-Star Football Game and the (Wrestling Tournament, the game was broadcast li Channel 7. Now, instead of the athletes playing t 2,000 people, they went into over 50,000 homes thr out the Ohio Valley.

Even though the All-Star game has unde and is still undergoing change, one fact remains stant: it continues to showcase the finest bask talent the Ohio Valley has to offer.

THE RICHARD SAFFIELD GIRLS' COACH AWARD



JOANNE C. HESS ST. CLAIRSVILLE HIGH SCHOOL

Many can say they coached basketball, andful can say they pioneered the sport, but ry few can say they impacted the sport for all to followed.

Such is Joanne Hess.

Her 24-year old coaching career saw nures at Ravenna High School and Oak Hills gh School before she came to the Valley and ttled in at St. Clairsville High School.

Over these years, her teams racked up 9 wins against 75 losses and two ties. Her dy Devils saw a nine-year-in-a-row Sectional 1, from 1976 to 1984. She made it to the strict finals in 1976, 1979, and 1984, and was hked in the top ten girls' teams in the State on e occasions. Sandwiched in these years But in 1979, she impacted girls' bask ball, not only in St. Clairsville but also in all ot OVAC schools. It was then that she won a T IX and Title VIII arbitration for equal equipme equal time, equal uniforms, equal publicity, a equal salary. This win allowed coaches girls'teams throughout the Valley to gain eq treatment for girls and for themselves from t point forward.

Over her career, Hess racked up nur ous personal coaching awards. Twice she v selected OVAC Coach-of-the-Year. In 19 she was named to the Basketball Hall of Fa in Ohio and was selected as one of the Top coaches among men **AND** women in the St of Ohio. She holds the third highest total w for girls' coaches in the State.

She retired in 1997 after 31 years a guidance counselor and coach. Joanne I two children, Lori and Kent, and currently sides in Columbus, Ohio.


With that much dedication to the winter , you would think that Ron would enjoy his g and fall off.



THE EARL HABERFIELD OVAC BASKETBALL COACHES' AWARE



BOB BURTON PADEN CITY HIGH SCHOOL

In 1957, when Bob Burton received his ploma from Magnolia High School, little did he nk that forty years later he would be the ean" of Ohio Valley basketball coaches. Iring those years, he was too busy playing ptball, basketball, and baseball. His football pwess earned him All-State honors in 1955. Id little did he think that someday he would be nember of the prestigious Blue Eagle Hall of ime.

So he went to Kent State University, but er transferred to West Liberty State College here he graduated in 1961. And little did he alize then, that his wife and two daughters build also all be Hilltopper alumnae, a fact that eases him immensely. He was too busy playg football, basketball, and tennis.

Instead, he was glad to graduate and get ob in the area he loved, settling in at Paden ty High School.

The next 36 years was, as they say, story. Thirty-five years as the head boys' sketball coach, 18 years as an assistant otball coach, 20 years as the boys' track ach, 10 years as the girls' track coach, 2 ars as the cross country coach, 1 year as the ball coach, not to mention 12 years as athletic director. You see, in a small school, y have to wear a lot of hats.

But his love and forte was baskett Over the past four decades, he led the Wildc to:

21 Sectional Championships,

8 Regional Championships,

2 State Runner-Up Titles, and

2 State Championships.

He captured 5 OVAC titles, saw nine win seasons, and coached 26 winning s sons. All tolled: 519 wins against 286 loss

But any coach who's been around long will tell you that you don't make it alone his words:

"I have never missed a game in 36 year I consider myself lucky to have met the macoaches, officials, and school person throughout the Valley."

Rewards have been sweet also. football teams he assisted were State chan ons in 1970 and 1979. He coached the OV football game in 1977, and four times led Mountaineers in the OVAC All-Star Basket Classic. In 1987, in addition to coaching West Virginia North-South Game, he was lected as the Coach-of-the-Year.

Burton also gives much of his succes his family who has been patient with him o the years. He and his wife, Sharon [Palm have two daughters, Tricia Shannon and Eli beth Burton. Will things slow down any wl Bob retires from Paden City? Think again. is now the proud grandfather of Jake Shann

THE ROBERT DAWSON ASKETBALL OFFICIALS' AWARD

Walter Heil, one of the deans of Ohio / officials, had an officiating career that red three decades and embraced three 3.

It all started on the baseball diamond, the then native of Bellaire became ind in that sport as an umpire back in 1926. tarted officiating football in 1928 and bas-II in 1929, and continued for 38 years hanging up his whistle at the age of 62. When he started officiating basketball in

Over the years, Mr. Heil worked football asketball games at the high school, coland professional levels. His expertise id him officiating spots in five West Virligh School State Tournaments, five West ia Catholic High School State Tournas, and three West Virginia Intercollegiate arence Tournaments.


Heil was also an official for the Continenotball League, which featured the Wheelonmen. He was a member of the Ohio / Officials' Association, the State Organi-1, and the International Association of oved Basketball Officials. Over the years, orked with other Valley legends, such as Camilletti, Warren Pugh, Don Hamill, Jack II, Earl Klevins [the 1992 recipient], and tie Clutter

After retiring, his love for officiating didn't He assumed the role of the commissioner h basketball and football officials in 1965, ition he held until March 1, 1970.

Walter was a 1922 graduate of Bellaire School, where he was one of the first class uctees into their Wall of Fame. He worked /eirton Steel Company and resided in /ille, Ohio, with his wife, Margaret "Peg" until his death on November 27, 1970.

His wife now resides in Martins Ferry. daughter, Mary Kay, married Rob sberger and resides in Yorkville. Like her r, Mary Kay is active with the OVAC, ng as one the directors of the Cheering petition.


