

The Samuel A. Mumley Basketball Class

Back in 1977, four veteran Ohio Valley basketball coaches decided that the concept of a high school All-Star game, similar to the highly successful football contest, would be a very practical idea. And so, Earl Haberfield of Wintersville, Dick Potts of River, Henry Herk" Lazasz of Tiltonsville, and Bobby Dawson of Wellsburg sat down and drew up the format of what would become the OVAC Basketball Classic.

Earl Haberfield was chosen as the game's first director. The committee enlisted the support of Ogden Newspapers to help underwrite the game, and booked he Wheeling Civic Center for the location, hoping to pack he house.

However, the only problem was that the game nad to be played in June. Due to the rules of the West Virginia Secondary Schools Activities Commission, Mounain State athletes could not participate without losing heir eligibility for spring sports. As the game was a novelty, the Classic did at one time see 1700 fans witness he Valley's finest, but the heat and the timing soon began to dwindle the interest of area spectators.

Over the years, due to expenses and availability of arenas, the game was played at St. John Arena, Wheeling Park High School, Bellaire High School, Wheelng College, East Liverpool High School, and Buckeye Local High School.

Although the game always showcased some outstanding hardcourt performers, other problems surfaced. The format underwent several changes, and as the interest in girls' sports became greater, the need to have two games for the boys and two games for the girls became apparent. However, West Virginia schools, being smaller in number, often had difficulty finding enough quality players, while Ohio schools had more players than they needed.

Another change in the program came in 1982 when Earl Haberfield left the area to coach in northern Ohio. Before leaving, however, the committee made a wise move in turning over the directorship to Gene Ammirante of Bellaire. Under his leadership, the game became more organized and competitive.

Ammirante ran the game until 1987 when, due to an increasing work load, he resigned the contest to Clyde DiAngelo of Steubenville Catholic Central who guided the Classic for two years. The game was then directed by John Bobalik of Wellsville. After a one-year tenure, the game faced serious problems, as no one wanted to assume the directorship. Also facing financial problems, the game more than ever needed strong leadership. With that in mind, only one man was obvious - Ammirante. Under his direction for the second time, the game made tremendous changes. First, the game was placed back on strong financial footing.

The second change came in the form of strong involvement of the OVAC Executive Secretary, Sam Mumley, who took it upon himself, with the assistance of Vince Paoletti of Moundsville, to petition the WVSSAC to change the ruling, allowing the game to be played soon after the completion of the regular basketball season. to April.

Because of his dedication to the Conferen his unselfish support of the Classic, the committ cided to change the name of the Classic to the San Mumley Basketball Classic.

The format was changed to one boys' gar one girls' game and a Conference cheering comp was added. Through the hard work and efforts, mention the enthusiasm, of Linda Alexander of City, the contest never struggled like the gam jumped right into successful the first year. Althoug OVAC schools chose not to participate, the Chai ship brought hundreds of cheerleaders before the fans to show them that cheering was a bona fide also.

With the 1994 Classic, two more change place. First, Tom Rataiczak of Bellaire High Schoo had served as program director for fifteen year over as Game Director. With this came the incep a coaches' clinic held prior to the game and a lur for all the players and their parents. The 1995 Classic saw three more adjust First, the coaches' clinic was dropped, as its tim too close to the NCAA Tournament and the availa quality college coaches. Second, it was decided to honoring a coach who pioneered in the establish girls' basketball as a sport. The third reason was p the most noticeable. After three years, the cheerl advisors decided to branch out on their own and their competition to November.

In 1997, reaching its twentieth anniversa advent of a reunion team was created. Thir athletes from the original all-star game returned to an annual 20th-year reunion.


Although the committee thought the Class stabilizing, another big change came in 1998. Fo on the heels of the All-Star Football Game and the Wrestling Tournament, the game was broadcast Channel 7. Now, instead of the athletes playing 2,000 people, they went into over 50,000 homes th out the Ohio Valley.

In 1999, the game was dealt a crushin when its namesake, Samuel A. Mumley, passec As such, the game became a Memorial Classic honor. Sam's guidance, expertise, connection port, and assistance left a void on the committ would be difficult to fill.

Even though the All-Star game has und and is still undergoing change, one fact remain stant: it continues to showcase the finest bas talent the Ohio Valley has to offer.





MATILDA ULASIEWICZ STEUBENVILLE CATHOLIC CENTRAL **HIGH SCHOOL**

"If I touched any lives and made a lifference, what a lovely monument."

Such was the philosophy of Maltilda Tillie" Jolly Ulasiewicz, a Wheeling native who attended St. Joseph's Academy. For he record, St. Joseph's Academy was an all-girl school located close to their male counterpart, Wheeling Central, before the wo schools merged.

Upon graduation, Tille enrolled at Nest Liberty State College where she maored in physical education and English, and ninored in social studies.

Her first teaching job was in the Steubenville public grade schools where she taught for five years before taking a sobbotical to start a family. Later she returned to teaching at Cathedral Catl arade schools before returning to Big for another five years.

Tillie then moved across town to gin her tenure at Steubenville Catholic School, where she would remain fo years teaching health and physical ed tion, in addition to coaching track and ketball.

Her Lady Crusaders won four O banners (1977, 1982, 1983, 1984), inc ing the first OVAC banner awarded basketball in 1977. Her overall record sta at 173-86 (66%). She also had the plea of coaching two 1000+ scorers in | Straker and Tiffany Fingers, who hap to be assisting with the girls' Ohio team afternoon.

Additionally, Tillie was selecte coach in the 5th OVAC All-Star gar 1982, and was named District Five Coach-of-the-Year in 1983.

Married to Alex Ulasiewicz, the cc has five children: Gwyn Aldridge, Ale Mark, Greg, and Matt.

after receiving his law degree, rehome to work in the Guernsey County cutor's office.



Five decades of blowing the whistle! hances are that if you've attended a footall or basketball game between 1950 and ow, you've run across the face of Bill aolisso.

A graduate of Weirton High School in 946, Bill was a standout athlete, being amed First Team All-State in football, basetball, and baseball. Upon graduating, he nlisted in the army, serving in the special ervices in Japan for 18 months. While tere from 1946-1948, he also managed to lay basketball and baseball.


Returning home, he tried out for the t. Louis Cardinals' baseball team, playing om 1948 to 1961, eventually reaching the AA level. But it was also around this time nat Paolisso began his remarkable career s an official in the Ohio Valley Athletic conference. For the next fifty years, he ecame a fixture on the gridiron and the ardwood at schools throughout the Valley. lis expertise and knowledge of the game ot him noticed by the West Virginia Interollegiate Conference where he again beame the "Iron Man," working both football nd basketball games for 25 years.

All tolled, Bill worked 35 Ohio Eastern)istrict-State Basketball Tournament James, 15 Ohio Eastern District-State Plaviff football games, 20 West Virginia State Basketball Tournament games, and 30 West /irginia State Football Playoff games. Not po shabby of a career.

In between all these games, Bill found ime to put 30 years in at the Weirton Steel Company in plant security.

Bill and his wife of fifty years (!), ²eggy, have two children. Maria Novev esides in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania where she works at the University of Pittsburgh as an administrative assistant to basketball coach Ralph Willard. His son, Bill, is a sales nanager in the western region for Graphline, nc., and lives in Los Angeles, California.



THE EARL HABERFIELD OVAC ASKETBALL COACHES' AWARD



RICHARD W. MOORE TRIADELPHIA HIGH SCHOOL

Richard W. "Dick" Moore was a 1952 Jate of Warwood High School where he ed in football, basketball, and baseball. ayed in the West Virginia State Basketball nament in both 1951 and 1952, coached e legendary Jim Foti, who also served as aseball coach. His 1951 football squad also OVAC champions, under the direction rl Gaylor.

After graduation, he enlisted in the U.S. , serving from 1952 to 1956. During this he also married his wife, Dolores Kadlic, in

. After his tour of duty, Moore enrolled at Liberty State College where he received aching degree.

Graduating in 1962, he began his teachbaching career at McKinley Vocational High ol, where he served as assistant basketoach and head baseball coach until 1964.

He then spent the next decade at elphia, beginning his career in 1965. Once i, he served as assistant football and basill coach and head baseball coach. During ime, Triadelphia sent two teams to the Tournament, the only ones in the history is school. The first was in 1965, under the In 1969, Moore was named the hear basketball coach at Triadelphia. Under hi direction, his teams fashioned a 66-54 recorc Perhaps his greatest coaching accomplishmer came in 1972, when his 9-14 Triads became the Cinderella team which was the second squad to make it to Charleston. This journey include two Sectional games and one Regional game won by two points before bowing out.

His last year at Triadelphia High Schoo saw his squad post a 19-2 record, with their onl loss to Wheeling High School who eventual won the State championship.

After the merger of Wheeling Triadelphia, and Warwood into Wheeling Par High School, Moore became the Patriot's var sity assistant coach in 1977. During their initia years, he helped guide Park to a 102-22 recorc including a State championship in 1980.

In 1981, the Ohio Valley lost a true gentleman and coach when Dick decided to retire from sports. He continued teaching a Park for seven more years, helping out when ever he could, until he retired from teaching in 1988 to accept at job at Oglebay Park Resort as the golf operations manager.


