

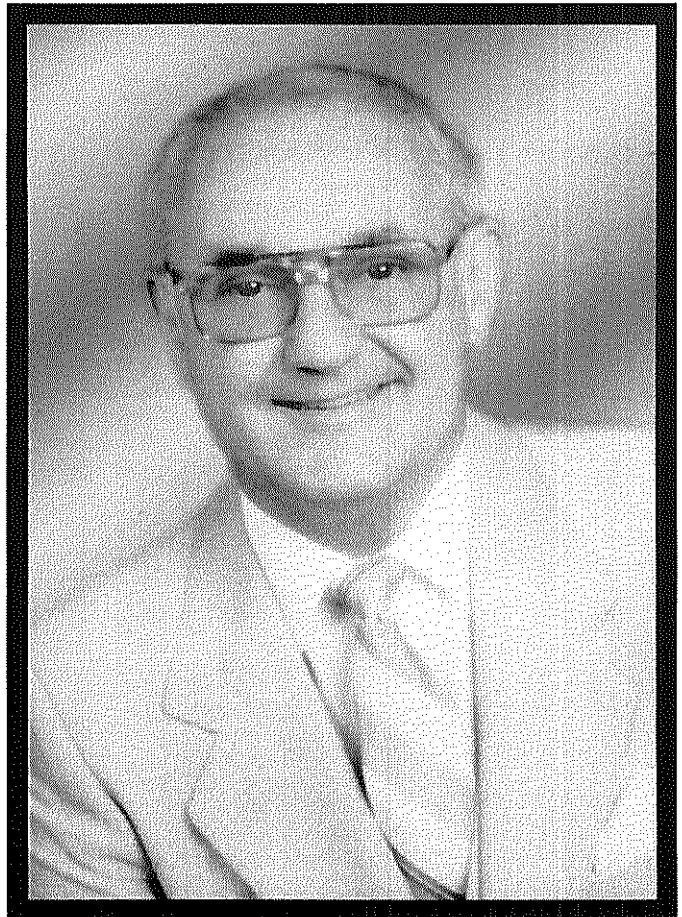

The Samuel A. Mumley Basketball Classic

Back in 1977, four veteran Ohio Valley basketball coaches decided that the concept of a high school All-Star game, similar to the highly successful football contest, would be a very practical idea. And so, Earl Haberfield of Wintersville, Dick Potts of River, Henry "Herk" Lazasz of Tiltonsville, and Bobby Dawson of Wellsburg sat down and drew up the format of what would become the OVAC Basketball Classic.

Earl Haberfield was chosen as the game's first director. The committee enlisted the support of Ogden Newspapers to help underwrite the game, and booked the Wheeling Civic Center for the location, hoping to pack the house.

However, the only problem was that the game had to be played in June. Due to the rules of the West Virginia Secondary Schools Activities Commission, Mountain State athletes could not participate without losing their eligibility for spring sports. As the game was a novelty, the Classic did at one time see 1700 fans witness the Valley's finest, but the heat and the timing soon began to dwindle the interest of area spectators.

Over the years, due to expenses and availability of arenas, the game was played at St. John Arena, Wheeling Park High School, Bellaire High School, Wheeling College, East Liverpool High School, and Buckeye Local High School.

Although the game always showcased some outstanding hardcourt performers, other problems surfaced. The format underwent several changes, and as the interest in girls' sports became greater, the need to have two games for the boys and two games for the girls became apparent. However, West Virginia schools, being smaller in number, often had difficulty finding enough quality players, while Ohio schools had more players than they needed.

Another change in the program came in 1982 when Earl Haberfield left the area to coach in northern Ohio. Before leaving, however, the committee made a wise move in turning over the directorship to Gene Ammirante of Bellaire. Under his leadership, the game became more organized and competitive.

Ammirante ran the game until 1987 when, due to an increasing work load, he resigned the contest to Clyde DiAngelo of Steubenville Catholic Central who guided the Classic for two years. The game was then directed by John Bobalik of Wellsville. After a one-year tenure, the game faced serious problems, as no one wanted to assume the directorship. Also facing financial problems, the game more than ever needed strong leadership. With that in mind, only one man was obvious - Ammirante. Under his direction for the second time, the game made tremendous changes. First, the game was placed back on strong financial footing.

The second change came in the form of strong involvement of the OVAC Executive Secretary, Sam Mumley, who took it upon himself, with the assistance of Vince Paoletti of Moundsville, to petition the WVSSAC to change the ruling, allowing the game to be played soon after the completion of the regular basketball season.

Because of his dedication to the Conference and his unselfish support of the Classic, the committee decided to change the name of the Classic to the Samuel A. Mumley Basketball Classic.

The format was changed to one boys' game and one girls' game and a Conference cheering competition was added. Through the hard work and efforts, mention the enthusiasm, of Linda Alexander of City, the contest never struggled like the game had jumped right into successful the first year. Although OVAC schools chose not to participate, the Championship brought hundreds of cheerleaders before the fans to show them that cheering was a bona fide activity also.

With the 1994 Classic, two more changes took place. First, Tom Rataiczak of Bellaire High School had served as program director for fifteen years and was named as Game Director. With this came the inception of a coaches' clinic held prior to the game and a luncheon for all the players and their parents. Perhaps the most significant decision made to date was permanently moving the game to the campus of Wheeling Jesuit College and their beautiful facilities that you are witnessing this evening. This change not only established a home for the Classic but also allowed its players and cheerleaders to enjoy a college experience without leaving the Valley.

The 1995 Classic saw three more adjustments. First, the coaches' clinic was dropped, as its timing was too close to the NCAA Tournament and the availability of quality college coaches. Second, it was decided to honor a coach who pioneered in the establishment of girls' basketball as a sport. The third reason was perhaps the most noticeable. After three years, the cheerleaders and advisors decided to branch out on their own and have their own competition to November.

In 1997, reaching its twentieth anniversary, the advent of a reunion team was created. Thirty athletes from the original all-star game returned to participate in an annual 20th-year reunion.

Although the committee thought the Classic was stabilizing, another big change came in 1998. Following the heels of the All-Star Football Game and the Wrestling Tournament, the game was broadcast on Channel 7. Now, instead of the athletes playing in front of 2,000 people, they went into over 50,000 homes throughout the Ohio Valley.

In 1999, the game was dealt a crushing blow when its namesake, Samuel A. Mumley, passed away. As such, the game became a Memorial Classic in honor. Sam's guidance, expertise, connection, support, and assistance left a void on the committee that would be difficult to fill.

Even though the All-Star game has undergone change and is still undergoing change, one fact remains constant: it continues to showcase the finest basketball talent the Ohio Valley has to offer.

We welcome you today, and hope you enjoy our contests.

THE RICHARD SAFFIELD GIRLS' COACH AWARD

"If I touched any lives and made a difference, what a lovely monument."

Such was the philosophy of Matilda "Tillie" Jolly Ulasiewicz, a Wheeling native who attended St. Joseph's Academy. For the record, St. Joseph's Academy was an all-girl school located close to their male counterpart, Wheeling Central, before the two schools merged.

Upon graduation, Tillie enrolled at West Liberty State College where she majored in physical education and English, and minored in social studies.

Her first teaching job was in the Steubenville public grade schools where she taught for five years before taking a sabbatical to start a family. Later she re-

turned to teaching at Cathedral Catholic grade schools before returning to Big Spring for another five years.

Tillie then moved across town to begin her tenure at Steubenville Catholic School, where she would remain for 10 years teaching health and physical education, in addition to coaching track and ketball.

Her Lady Crusaders won four OVAC banners (1977, 1982, 1983, 1984), including the first OVAC banner awarded in basketball in 1977. Her overall record stands at 173-86 (66%). She also had the pleasure of coaching two 1000+ scorers in Linda Straker and Tiffany Fingers, who happily to be assisting with the girls' Ohio team afternoons.

Additionally, Tillie was selected as coach in the 5th OVAC All-Star game in 1982, and was named District Five Coach-of-the-Year in 1983.

Married to Alex Ulasiewicz, she has five children: Gwyn Aldridge, Alex Mark, Greg, and Matt.

Retired? Not hardly. In addition to watching eight grandchildren, Tillie still has plenty of time to read, line dance, and volleyball.

THE TOM RATAICZAK OVAC BASKETBALL SCOREKEEPER/TIMER AWARD

They say you don't want to argue with a man in stripes because you'll never win, but when that man also happens to be an attorney, you have your work cut out for you. Back in 1976, Dan McGrew, Weirton's athletic director, was coaching at Dowbrook and needed some young folks to help out with junior high football contests. So he contacted George Bliss at Cambridge to see if anyone was available. Enter a young attorney named William T. Nicholson, a Cambridge graduate who, after receiving his law degree, returned home to work in the Guemsey County Auditor's office.

Bill started out helping out with the contests and, around 1980, passed his duties to become a varsity football official. In that post he still continues today. At the same time, Bliss needed someone to help out with basketball scorebooks, and asked Bill to fill in with reserve games and varsity contests when he couldn't be around. To this day, Bill is a fixture at the Cambridge Bobcat's scorer's table, ranking as one of the Valley's best scorekeepers.

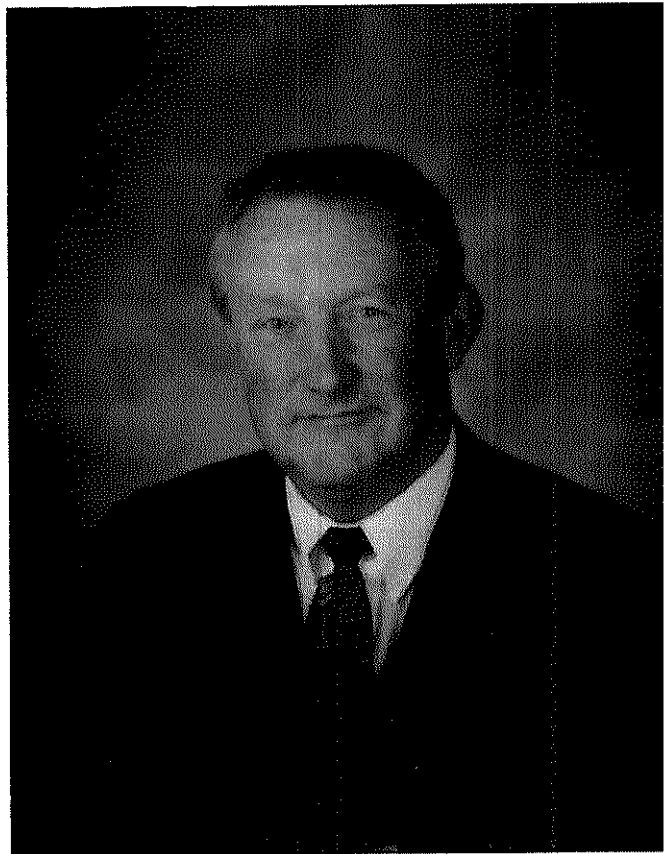
Starting out under Zip Joseph in 1976 and continuing under Gene Ford today, Bill has watched his Bobcats reach the State Scorer's table four years, having the honor of being #1 at the State scorers' table on five occasions.

During that time, he has witnessed a great talent, both from Cambridge and around the state. His first year was the senior year of Doug "White Lightning" Donley, later of the State and the Dallas Cowboys. He has seen some of his most memorable games while watching Geno Ford, "an extraordinary kid who lifted his team to a new level."

But like most veteran scorekeepers, Bill enjoys watching the sport. Of course, he wants his beloved Bobcats to win, but he contests, regardless of the outcome, even more.

Born in Cambridge, Bill is a graduate of Cambridge, Ohio State University, and Northern University College of Law.

He now runs his own private practice. Bill and his wife, Pam, have three children: Lisa Blass (whose father-in-law is the Voice of the Pirates, Steve Blass) of Pittsburgh, Bill of Long Beach, New York, and Cara Nicholson of Zanesville. THE ROBERT DAWSON BASKETBALL OFFICIALS' AWARD

Five decades of blowing the whistle! Chances are that if you've attended a football or basketball game between 1950 and now, you've run across the face of Bill Paolisso.

A graduate of Weirton High School in 1946, Bill was a standout athlete, being named First Team All-State in football, basketball, and baseball. Upon graduating, he enlisted in the army, serving in the special services in Japan for 18 months. While there from 1946-1948, he also managed to play basketball and baseball.

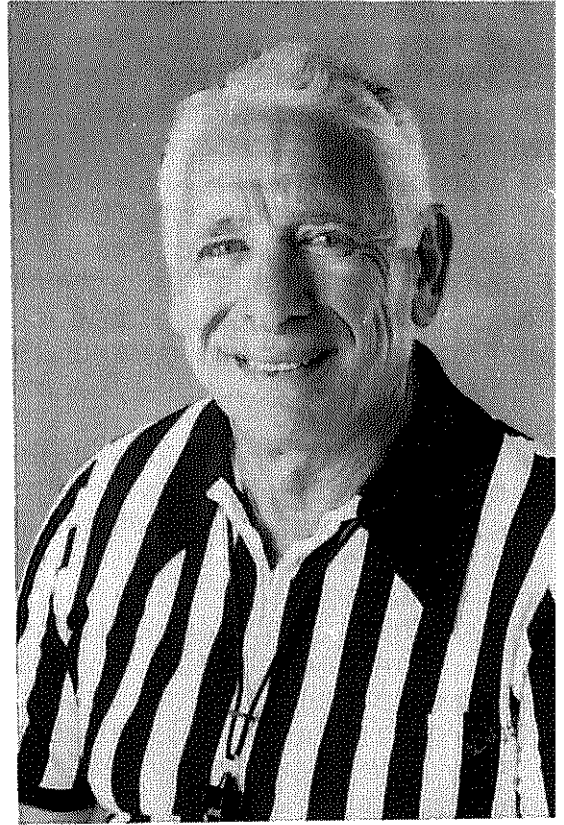
Returning home, he tried out for the St. Louis Cardinals' baseball team, playing from 1948 to 1961, eventually reaching the AA level. But it was also around this time that Paolisso began his remarkable career as an official in the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference. For the next fifty years, he became a fixture on the gridiron and the hardwood at schools throughout the Valley. His expertise and knowledge of the game of him noticed by the West Virginia Inter-Collegiate Conference where he again became the "Iron Man," working both football and basketball games for 25 years.

All told, Bill worked 35 Ohio Eastern District-State Basketball Tournament games, 15 Ohio Eastern District-State Playoff football games, 20 West Virginia State Basketball Tournament games, and 30 West Virginia State Football Playoff games. Not too shabby of a career.

In between all these games, Bill found time to put 30 years in at the Weirton Steel Company in plant security.

Bill and his wife of fifty years (!), Peggy, have two children. Maria Novey resides in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania where she works at the University of Pittsburgh as an administrative assistant to basketball coach Ralph Willard. His son, Bill, is a sales manager in the western region for Graphline, Inc., and lives in Los Angeles, California.

The Paolisso's enjoy two grandchildren, Michael (9) and Carolyn (3) Novey.

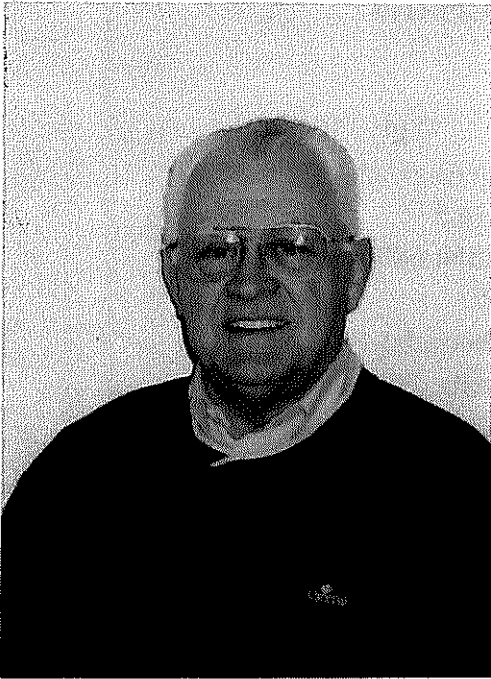

THE EARL HABERFIELD OVAC BASKETBALL COACHES' AWARD



**RICHARD W. MOORE
TRIADELPHIA HIGH SCHOOL**

Richard W. "Dick" Moore was a 1952 graduate of Warwood High School where he excelled in football, basketball, and baseball. He played in the West Virginia State Basketball Tournament in both 1951 and 1952, coached the legendary Jim Foti, who also served as a baseball coach. His 1951 football squad was also OVAC champions, under the direction of Earl Gaylor.

After graduation, he enlisted in the U.S. Army, serving from 1952 to 1956. During this time he also married his wife, Dolores Kadlic, in 1954. After his tour of duty, Moore enrolled at Liberty State College where he received his teaching degree.

Graduating in 1962, he began his teaching career at McKinley Vocational High School, where he served as assistant basketball coach and head baseball coach until 1964.

He then spent the next decade at Triadelphia, beginning his career in 1965. Once again, he served as assistant football and basketball coach and head baseball coach. During this time, Triadelphia sent two teams to the OVAC Tournament, the only ones in the history of the school. The first was in 1965, under the direction of Earl Gaylor.

In 1969, Moore was named the head basketball coach at Triadelphia. Under his direction, his teams fashioned a 66-54 record. Perhaps his greatest coaching accomplishment came in 1972, when his 9-14 Triads became the Cinderella team which was the second squad to make it to Charleston. This journey included two Sectional games and one Regional game, won by two points before bowing out.

His last year at Triadelphia High School saw his squad post a 19-2 record, with their only loss to Wheeling High School who eventually won the State championship.

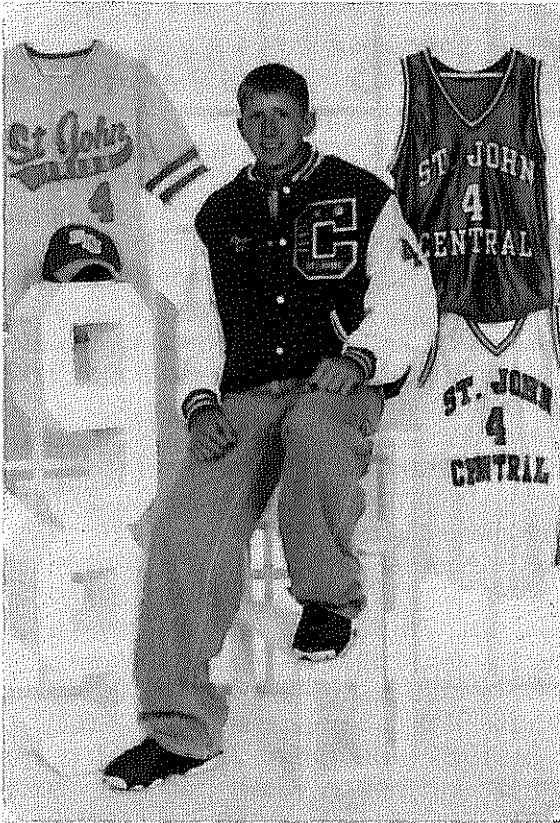
After the merger of Wheeling Triadelphia, and Warwood into Wheeling Park High School, Moore became the Patriot's varsity assistant coach in 1977. During their initial years, he helped guide Park to a 102-22 record including a State championship in 1980.

In 1981, the Ohio Valley lost a true gentleman and coach when Dick decided to retire from sports. He continued teaching at Park for seven more years, helping out whenever he could, until he retired from teaching in 1988 to accept a job at Oglebay Park Resort as the golf operations manager.

The Moores have four daughters: Cindy of Wheeling; Debbie Klein, also of Wheeling; Dianne Sandvik, of Orlando, Florida; and Pamela Holshey, of Cumberland, Maryland. They also enjoy three grandchildren: Alicia Klein, and Logan and Nolan Holshey.
