The Samuel A. Mumley Memorial Basketball Class

Back in 1977, four veteran Ohio Valley basketall coaches decided that the concept of a high school II-Star game, similar to the highly successful football ontest, would be a very practical idea. And so, Earl laberfield of Wintersville, Dick Potts of River, Henry Herk" Lazasz of Tiltonsville, and Bobby Dawson of Vellsburg sat down and drew up the format of what would recome the OVAC Basketball Classic.

Earl Haberfield was chosen as the game's first lirector. The committee enlisted the support of Ogden lewspapers to help underwrite the game, and booked ne Wheeling Civic Center for the location, hoping to pack ne house.

However, the only problem was that the game ad to be played in June. Due to the rules of the West /irginia Secondary Schools Activities Commission, Mounain State athletes could not participate without losing heir eligibility for spring sports. As the game was a lovelty, the Classic did at one time see 1700 fans witness he Valley's finest, but the heat and the timing soon began o dwindle the interest of area spectators.

Over the years, due to expenses and availability of arenas, the game was played at St. John Arena, Vheeling Park High School, Bellaire High School, Wheelng College, East Liverpool High School, and Buckeye .ocal High School.

Although the game always showcased some sutstanding hardcourt performers, other problems suraced. The format underwent several changes, and as he interest in girls' sports became greater, the need to have two games for the boys and two games for the girls became apparent. However, West Virginia schools, being smaller in number, often had difficulty finding shough quality players, while Ohio schools had more blayers than they needed.

Another change in the program came in 1982 when Earl Haberfield left the area to coach in northern Dhio. Before leaving, however, the committee made a vise move in turning over the directorship to Gene Ammirante of Bellaire. Under his leadership, the game became more organized and competitive.

Ammirante ran the game until 1987 when, due to an increasing work load, he resigned the contest to Clyde DiAngelo of Steubenville Catholic Central who guided he Classic for two years. The game was then directed by John Bobalik of Wellsville. After a one-year tenure, he game faced serious problems, as no one wanted to assume the directorship. Also facing financial problems, he game more than ever needed strong leadership. Nith that in mind, only one man was obvious - Ammirante. Jnder his direction for the second time, the game made remendous changes. First, the game was placed back an strong financial footing.

The second change came in the form of strong nvolvement of the OVAC Executive Secretary, Sam Jumley, who took it upon himself, with the assistance of /ince Paoletti of Moundsville, to petition the WVSSAC to change the ruling, allowing the game to be played soon after the completion of the regular basketball season. to April.

Because of his dedication to the Conferenc his unselfish support of the Classic, the committe cided to change the name of the Classic to the Sam Mumley Memorial Basketball Classic.

The format was changed to one boys' gam one girls' game and a Conference cheering compwas added. Through the hard work and efforts, mention the enthusiasm, of Linda Alexander of F City, the contest never struggled like the gam jumped right into successful the first year. Although OVAC schools chose not to participate, the Chan ship brought hundreds of cheerleaders before the ' fans to show them that cheering was a bona fide also.

With the 1994 Classic, two more change place. First, Tom Rataiczak of Bellaire High Schoo had served as program director for fifteen years over as Game Director. With this came the incep¹ a coaches' clinic held prior to the game and a luni for all the players and their parents. After three years, the cheerle advisors decided to branch out on their own and r their competition to November.


In 1997, reaching its twentieth anniversal advent of a reunion team was created. Thirty athletes from the original all-star game returned to i an annual 20th-year reunion.

Even though the All-Star game has unde and is still undergoing change, one fact remain stant: it continues to showcase the finest basi talent the Ohio Valley has to offer.



Coach Frank Savarese is a native of /orkville, Ohio, where he still resides. He teaches Jusiness education at Buckeye Local High School.

Frank was a three-sport athlete at Yorkville High School, and received a football scholarship to Augustana College in Rock Island, Illinois, where he played fullback and linebacker, lettering all four rears and playing alongside pro football player, Kenny Anderson, Cincinnati Bengal quarterback.

Coach Savarese holds a Bachelor's Degree n Business and Vocational Studies and a Master's Degree in Secondary Administration.

He began his coaching career in 1970 at Fiffin Calvert High School and returned to the Ohio Valley in 1973 to coach and teach in the Buckeye Local School system. He started the girls' basketball program at Buckeye West High School in 1977 and was head girls' basketball coach at Buckeye Viest High School from 1977 through 1987; at through 1989; at Buckeye Local High School 1990 through 1994; and at Bridgeport High Sc from 1995 through 1999.

During his career, Coach Savarese's te enjoyed a 67% winning record, with 338 wins 168 losses in 506 games.

His teams won 7 OVAC Champions one at Buckeye Local, one at Buckeye Southv and five at Buckeye West; seven <u>Harrison I</u> <u>Herald</u> Championship trophies; seven Ohio tional Championships, and four River Valley Le Championships.

Coach Savarese was also honored t ceive 11 "Coach-of-the-Year" Awards. He selected to coach in eight all-star games incli five OVAC Ohio - West Virginia Classics and District 5 all-star games. His Ohio teams won a OVAC Classics and he won two District 5 all games.

Coach Savarese believes his gre achievement would be the strong work ethic team philosophy he taught his young ladies d his coaching career.

Coach Savarese is very pleased wit awards his players received during his coa career which included one girl selected 1st⁻ All-Ohio-All Academic; 23 girls receiving cc basketball scholarships; 24 girls receiving All-Honors; and numerous other OVAC, All Valle District Honors, plus 24 girls who have play today's OVAC All-Star Classic.





Along with his teaching and aching duties, Leggett was Bucka Trail 's athletic director. He now ves as guidance counselor at enandoah High School.


