We in the Bellaire School System view athletics as an extension of the classroom and, as such, are responsible for promoting a positive learning experience for our students/athletes.

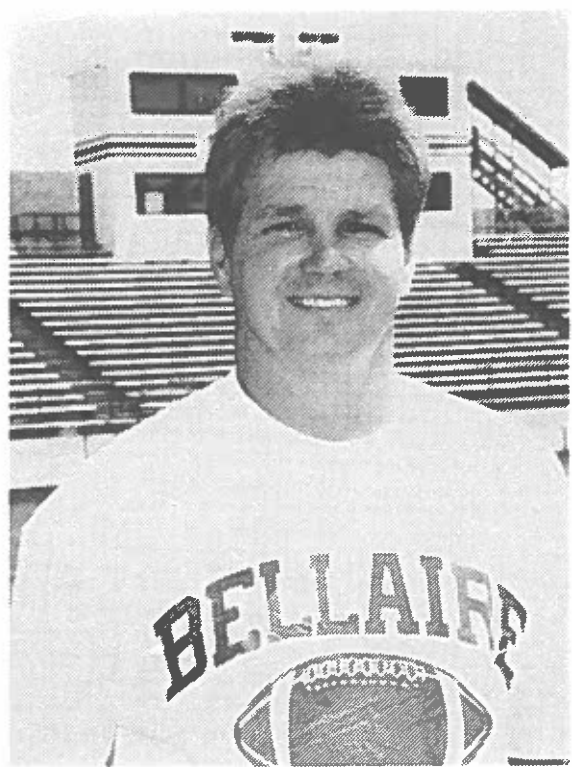
