ther change in the program came in 1982 when arfield left the area to coach in northern Ohio. ving, however, the committee made a wise move over the directorship to Gene Ammirante of Jnder his leadership, the game became more and competitive.

nirante ran the game until 1987 when, due to an work load, he resigned the contest to Clyde of Steubenville Catholic Central who guided the two years. The game was then directed by John Wellsville. After a one-year tenure, the game ous problems, as no one wanted to assume the p. Also facing financial problems, the game more needed strong leadership. With that in mind, only vas obvious - Ammirante. Under his direction for d time, the game made tremendous changes. ame was placed back on strong financial footing. ne second change came in the form of strong ont of the OVAC Executive Secretary, Sam who took it upon himself with the assistance of many trips to Charleston and hours of phone conversatior and lobbying, the game was approved. Starting with th 1992 contest, the game would be moved to April.

Because of his dedication to the Conference and h unselfish support of the Classic, the committee decided change the name of the Classic to the Samuel A. Mumle Memorial Basketball Classic.

The format was changed to one boys' game and on girls' game and a Conference cheering competition wa added. Through the hard work and efforts, not to mentio the enthusiasm, of Linda Alexander of Paden City, th contest never struggled like the game, but jumped rigi into successful the first year. Although all 44 OVAC schoo chose not to participate, the Championship brough hundreds of cheerleaders before the Valley fans to sho them that cheering was a bona fide sport also.

With the 1994 Classic, two more changes took place First, Tom Rataiczak of Bellaire High School, who ha served as program director for fifteen years, took over a Game Director. With this came the inception of a coacher clinic held prior to the game and a luncheon for all th players and their parents. One of the best decisions mad was moving the game to the campus of Wheeling Jesu College and their beautiful facilities. The game was hel there for seven years. This change not only established home for the Classic, but allowed its players and cheer leaders to enjoy a major college experience without leavin the Valley.

The 1995 Classic saw three more adjustments. Firs the coaches' clinic was dropped, as its timing ran too clos to the NCAA Tournament and the availability of qualit college coaches. Second, it was decided to begin honorin a coach who pioneered in the establishment of girls basketball as a sport. The third reason was perhaps the most noticeable. After three years, the cheerleading advisors decided to branch out on their own and move their competition to November.


In 1997, reaching its twentieth anniversary, the advent of a reunion team was created. Thirty plus athlete from the original all-star game returned to initiate an annua 20th-year reunion.

Although the committee thought the Classic was stabilizing, another big change came in 1998. Following on the heels of the All-Star Football Game and the OVAC Wrestling Tournament, the game was broadcast live of Channel 7. Now, instead of the athletes playing before 2,000 people, they went into over 50,000 homes throughou the Ohio Valley.

Even though the All-Star game has undergone and is still undergoing change, one fact remains constant it continues to showcase the finest basketball talent the Ohio Valley has to offer.



Brinkman was a master coach. Resourceful, apetitive, and a strict disciplinarian, he was d of his time in his coaching strategy and the game of basketball.

" became a legendary figure in state high etic circles as he took Wheeling High Basketo the state tournament on seven occasions and me five championship trophies.

er, the South Wheeling native was an outotball coach and teams he piloted laid claim to rowns in the autumn sport--at Union High, in 1928 and '31 and at Wheeling High in '34 ough there were no playoffs in football to official championships in those days.

e, the Brinkman name was well-established in ity before he ever coached his first game. He standing athlete at Wheeling High and won 13 ers-four each in football, basketball, baseball, rack. He won all-state honors in both football ball his senior year of 1922-23 and established ord of 54 points in a basketball game against it.

only a 155-pounder, "Brinkie" went on to mainstay in three sports at West Virginia college, which at that time played a big-time hedule. Wesleyan's 1925 basketball, with it forward, captured the West Virginia Interitle.

n, Brinkman's football teams won 40 games, d tied four in six seasons. Both his 1938 and '31 ted perfect records.

Brinkman returned to Wheeling High, as I basketball coach. In eight years as football cord was 47-23-11, and he never had a losing 1934 gridders were undefeated, though twice tarts. He coached the first Wheeling football and the fast break. His combined Union-Wheeling basketball record was 405 victories against 193 losses. His Wheeling basketeers captured state championships in 1936, '38, '40, and '50. His 1949 team was runner-up. Two of his aggregations—1939 and '50—went undefeated and two others (1940 and '43) sustained only one loss.

Brinkman's last team, that of 1955, established an Ohio Valley Scoring record (since broken) with 146 points in one game.

After retiring from coaching, he devoted himself to school administration field. He had his master's degree from the University of Pittsburgh.

Coach Brinkman died on July 20, 1972.

4. Each player must make an appearance in both halves. Attempts are to be made to give all 15 players equal playing time.


5. Dunking will be permitted during the pre-game warm-up.
