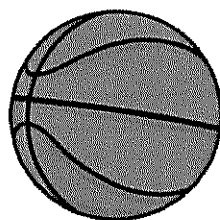

The Samuel A. Mumley Memorial Basketball Classic

In 1977, three veteran Ohio Valley basketball coaches decided that the concept of a high school All-Star game similar to the highly successful football contest, was a very practical idea. And so, Earl Haberfield of Wheeling, Henry "Herk" Lazasz of Tiltonsville, and Bobby Johnson of Wellsville sat down and drew up the format of what would become the OV AC Basketball Classic.

Earl Haberfield was chosen as the game's first director. The committee enlisted the support of Ogden coaches to help underwrite the game and booked the Youngstown Civic Center for the location hoping to pack the arena.

However, the only problem was that the game would be played in June. Due to the rules of the West Virginia Secondary Schools Activities Commission, Mountain State athletes could not participate without losing their eligibility for spring sports. As the game was a novelty, they did it at one time see 1700 fans witness the Valley's athletes out the heat and the timing soon began to dwindle the interest of area spectators.

Over the years, due to expenses and availability of venues, the game was played at St. John Arena, Wheeling Park High School, Bellaire High School, Wheeling Jesuit University, East Liverpool High School, and Buckeye High School.

Although the game always showcased some outstanding hard court performers, other problems surfaced. The format underwent several changes, and as the interest in sports became greater, the need to have two games for the boys and two games for the girls became apparent. However, West Virginia schools being smaller in size, often had difficulty finding enough quality players, and Ohio schools had more players than they needed.

Another change in the program came in 1982 when Earl Haberfield left the area to coach in northern Ohio. Before leaving, however, the committee made a wise decision by turning over the directorship to Gene Ammirante of Youngstown. Under his leadership, the game became more competitive and successful.

Ammirante ran the game until 1987 when, due to an increasing work load, he resigned the contest to Clyde Johnson of Steubenville Catholic Central who guided the game for two years. The game was then directed by John Johnson of Wellsville. After a one-year tenure, the game experienced serious problems, as no one wanted to assume the directorship. Also facing financial problems, the game more and more needed strong leadership. With that in mind, only Johnson was obvious - Ammirante. Under his direction for the second time, the game made tremendous changes. The game was placed back on strong financial footing. A second change came in the form of strong involvement of the OVAC Executive Secretary, Sam Mumley, who took over himself, with the assistance of Vince Paoletti of Wheeling, to petition the WVSSAC to change the ruling, allowing the game to be played soon after the completion of the regular basketball season. After many trips to the state capital, it would be moved to April. Charleston and hours of

Starting with the 1992 contest because of his dedication to the Conference and his unselfish support of the Classic, the committee decided to change the name of the Classic to the Samuel A. Mumley Memorial Basketball Classic.

The format was changed to one boys' game and one girls' game and a Conference cheering competition was added. Through the hard work and efforts, not to mention the enthusiasm of Linda Alexander of Paden City, the cheering clinic was a success from the first year. Although all 44 OVAC schools chose not to participate, the Championship brought hundreds of cheerleaders before the Valley fans to show them that cheering was a bona fide sport also.

With the 1994 Classic, two more changes took place. First, Tom Rataiczak of Bellaire High School, who had served as program director for fifteen years, took over as Game Director. With this came the inception of a coaches' clinic held prior to the game and a luncheon for all the players and their parents. One of the best decisions made was moving the game to the campus of Wheeling Jesuit University and their beautiful facilities. The game was held there for seven years. This change not only established a home for the Classic, but allowed its players and cheerleaders to enjoy a major college experience without leaving the Valley.

The 1995 Classic saw three more adjustments. First, the coaches' clinic was dropped, as its timing ran too close to the NCAA Tournament and the availability of quality college coaches. Second, it was decided to begin honoring a coach who pioneered in the establishment of girls' basketball as a sport. The third reason was perhaps the most noticeable. After three years, the cheerleading advisors decided to branch out on their own and move their competition to November.

A big change in 1998 was the game being broadcast on Channel 7 live TV. The live broadcast continued through 2003. In 2005, the game came under the direction of Tom Bechtel, Recreation Director for the City of Wheeling and veteran football official and softball umpire. Tom also serves as Softball Commissioner for the OVAC.

The 2007 edition of the OVAC All Star Game will see several significant changes. First the game was moved to a Sunday to avoid conflict with spring sports. Secondly the initiation of the Bob Burton Distinguished Service Award in honor of the legendary OVAC Boys Coach at Paden City HS. This award honors assistant coaches or other behind the scenes people who have made significant contributions to OVAC Hoops.

On March 9, 2007 the All Star basketball Classic lost one of its pioneers as Coach Earl Haberfield passed. The game will be forever indebted to Coach Haberfield for his vision in starting a game which allowed the boy and girl basketball players of the OVAC to showcase their talent.

Ohio University Eastern Gym now offers us a beautiful facility in Eastern Ohio to carry on the tradition. We welcome you today, and hope you enjoy the contests. Sixty of Ohio and West Virginia's best senior basketball players of the class of 2008 are ready to showcase their

1. Each game will consist of two 20-minute halves.
2. Zone presses may be used but must end after first trap past half court.
3. Man-to-man defense must be played in the normal attack area.
4. Each player must make an appearance in both halves. Attempts should be made to give all 15 players equal playing time.
5. Dunking will be permitted during the pre-game warm-up.
6. All overtime periods shall be three minutes in length.
7. Each player is allowed six (6) personal fouls before he is disqualified.
8. Teams will be permitted one full time-out and two :30 time-outs per game.

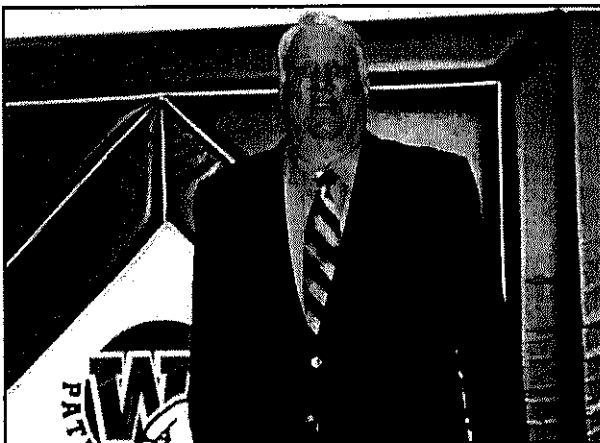

John Mallett - Wheeling Park High School

Doing something for 40 years takes a lot of dedication, effort, desire and most importantly a passion. Wheeling resident John Mallett has all of those qualities and several more, which go a long way both how and why he's been involved with Ohio Valley Athletic Conference athletics for 40 years.

These qualities and longevity made Mallett a no-brain choice to receive this year's Bob Burton Award Service Award at this year's Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Basketball Classic slate at Ohio University-Eastern.

Receiving this award definitely surprised me," Mallett said. "I wasn't even really aware of the award until I was quite proud and honored to receive it. Coach Burton was a great coach and receiving an award named after him."

Whether as a player or coach, Mallett was extremely successful in the realm of athletics. As a player, he was a standout at now defunct Wheeling High School where he graduated in 1968. In his prep career, Mallett lettered twice in football, three times in both basketball and track. He was a three-time performer in football and twice in basketball.

After graduation, Mallett went to Marshall University where he played basketball and lettered there while earning his degree to become a history teacher. While playing for the Thundering Blue Devils, he was a member of two teams, which played in the National Invitation Tournament.

With his degree in hand, Mallett returned to the Ohio Valley and accepted a teaching and coaching position at Coldspring Junior High where he served as freshman coach in both football and basketball for two years. He then shifted to Triadelphia High School where he served on the varsity football and basketball staff. He was a football coach for a year and served the hoop team for four seasons.

In 1976, Mallett shifted to Wheeling Park High School where he served on Sam Andy's staff for 10 years. The first six of that was as the Patriots' reserve coach and then in 1976, he became Assistant Coach and the varsity assistant.

During the course of their run at Park, Mallett served on two coaching staffs that won West Virginia Championships. The first came in 1980 and the second was the most exciting moment of his career when the Patriots knocked off Beckley Woodrow Wilson in triple overtime to claim the 1995 title. What set that title apart from the first was the fact that Mallett's son, Shane, was a senior and the best player on the team.

That was definitely my most exciting moment, but to be honest I am surprised I survived that game. "Being both an assistant coach and a father was tough enough, but then to have the game go into triple overtime was really tough."

Mallett stepped away from the bench after the 2002 season, citing it was just time to go. "I had been coaching for 33 straight years and I had just retired from teaching, so the time was right. "I wouldn't say I was tired. I miss the one-on-one relationships with the kids, but I don't always want to be somewhere all the time."

Staying around athletics for that long and dealing with the time constraints takes a very understanding family, according to Mallett he's that every step of the way. He and his wife Stephanie have been married for 35 years and have the one son.

"I was very fortunate to have the wife I did," Mallett explained. "She's a total sports junkie who loves coming to all of the games."

Warren Hood - Martins Ferry HS

Warren Hood has seen a lot of basketball over the course of his lifetime.

Whether it was as a fan, athletic administrator or for the reason he's being honored today at the OVAC Samu basketball Game, as an official, Hood's been to a lot of games.

However, most of his time was spent at hoop games as an official. It's a capacity he served in for 22 year , Inter-Valley, Muskingum Valley and Cardinal Conferences. However, it's his work in the OVAC that earns on Basketball Officials Award.

"I am honored to receive this award," Hood said. "I knew Robert Dawson and actually worked a few games t makes it even more special to receive this award."

Hood worked a lot of games over the course of his career in the stripes. However, when he able to work r Jimmy on a varsity game was one of the highlights of his career, which has seen him work several regional

"Being able to work with my brother was very exciting for me," Hood said. "We probably officiated 25 gar were some of the best games I ever worked."

A lot of area officials are divering out of the area today to work games in the Canton arena and into the other worked in years ago. It was actually Hood and former Dawson honoree Gene Joseph who broke the barrier a s.

"Gene and I kind of opened the doors for the officials to work in other leagues," Hood said.

The final game that Hood worked was a girls' regional final between Garfield Heights Trinity and Toledo Urs A little less than a week earlier, Hood worked his final boys' game, which was between Lakeland and Strasbu e.

Hood opted to get out of officiating when he became Martins Ferry's athletic director, which was a positio Also during the span of his 30-year teaching career, Hood coached junior high football for 22 years and grade ions.

Hood is currently up for a spot in the Officials Hall of Fame in Columbus, which is chosen through the Easte Iso a life-time member of the Ohio-West Virginia Official Association.

His work as athletic director didn't go unnoticed. He was the Eastern District's Athletic Director of the year ng year he was Ohio's Athletic Director of the Year.

Along with basketball, Hood was a talented umpire, spending 25 years working baseball games. He wo iments and worked 10 state tournaments during his baseball career.

"The best thing about officiating and being involved in sports was the friendships you build," Hood noted.

Currently, Hood serves as the voice of the Purple Riders in both football and basketball.

Paul Reed - Barnesville HS

For Paul Reed the time has just flown. And needless to say he's loved every minute of it.

Reed has spent every winter for the past 25 years planted behind the scoring table at Barnesville Shamro s running the clock.

That much time alone made him a no-brain choice to receive this year's Tom Rataiczak OVAC Scorekeeper ward at today's annual Sam Mumley OVAC All-Star Basketball Game.

"I am just a sports nut and when they asked me to keep the clock it was an honor," Reed said. "I just love c

Reed — who graduated from Moundsville High School in 1960 — arrived in western Belmont County in 1962 Sandy, on his arm. He came to Barnesville to work for the Y&O Coal Mine.

After arriving, he immediately became involved in the little league program and ran the tournament at Mem 20 years.

Then Barnesville athletic director Dave Johnson approached Reed about keeping the clock at Shamrock s, which he quickly accepted. He did the younger Shamrocks for 20 consecutive years and then took over the v so runs the clock still to this day for Shamrocks' football games. During his era as timer, Reed h

ock for girls's games, but he has since given that up and does strictly boys games.

Reed didn't keep the clock this season for the Shamrocks as he continues to battle back from a stroke h nber. Not being at that table really took its toll on Reed.

"I was able to make about half of the games this year in the crowd," Reed said. âl definitely missed not beir ock.ã

Along with his role of timer, Reed also served the Barnesville athletic community through his work as an as e Lady Shamrocks softball team under the late Paul Burkhart. He served as the chief assistant for 10 years.

Keeping his love for being around the diamond alive, Reed serves as the field director each summer at M the Beast of the East Baseball Tournament arrives for four days around the Fourth of July.

Ohio Valley and national basketball world is in a state of shock today.

of the "good guys in the business" left us Thursday afternoon.

er Ohio Valley prep head coach and Wake Forest men's basketball coach Skip Prosser died of an apparent heart attack while jogging in Winston-Salem.

tragedy sent ripples through the Ohio Valley as many current and former coaches worked with or played for Prosser during his tenure in the area, which saw him serve as the head coach at both Wheeling Central and Linsly. The consensus amongst everyone we talked to: Skip Prosser was a great guy who never forgot where he came from.

the guys saying it couldn't have been more sincere.

er Bishop Donahue and Shadyside head coach John Stanko was fighting back tears when we talked to him Thursday afternoon.

Stanko and Prosser worked together at Linsly School for two years before each went their separate ways.

However, that short span of time was long enough to build a lasting bond.

"Skip Prosser, first and foremost, was a teacher and a friend," Stanko said through a prepared statement. "He was the person who got the most out of people he encountered, including myself.

When Stanko and Prosser left Linsly, Stanko went to Bishop Donahue where he eventually won a state championship. Prosser left for Wheeling Central where he began to build his prep legacy.

"Coach Prosser challenged people to be better than they should be and got remarkable results," Stanko said. "When he was on the court, the court was a classroom without desks. Wake Forest is losing a tremendous person filled with integrity. Ohio Valley basketball is losing one of the good guys who played by the rules."

Prosser – who graduated from Carnegie High School near Pittsburgh – came to the Ohio Valley in 1971 as an assistant coach at Linsly. He served in that capacity for four years before serving as the reserve coach in 1976-77. In 1977, the position he took over as the head coach at Linsly for two seasons.

Then he went to Wheeling Central where he was the head coach for five years.

"I met Skip when he was painting a barn at Linsly, and I had just gotten hired as the freshman coach," Stanko said. "We've been friends ever since."

Stanko expressed his deepest sympathies for Prosser's family.

"I know both of his boys and they are great kids," Stanko said. "His mother, Jo, is a wonderful lady and his father is a great lady as well. I'm just having a really hard time with this because he had such a great influence on the person he was."

While serving as head coach at Linsly, Prosser taught ancient history on the campus as well.

One of his former Cadet players, Mike Schuetz, remembers his ex-coach as one of the finest teachers he ever had.

"Coach Prosser was as good in the classroom as he was on the court," Schuetz said. "He was a natural teacher. You would always get materials from him because you wanted to please him so much."

Schuetz played under Prosser during his sophomore and junior seasons, but Skip left for Central prior to his senior season. However, at Central, he coached Mike's brother, Mark, for the Maroon Knights.

"There aren't enough words to describe the kind of guy Coach Prosser was," Schuetz said. "This is just a very hard loss."

Central Buckeye Local head boys basketball coach Joel Nau was surfing the Internet Thursday afternoon when the tragedy broke.

"I was just looking around the Internet and saw this, I am totally shocked right now," Nau said during a phone interview. "I was not even sinking in. He taught me so much about basketball and work ethic. This is like losing a member of my family."

Nau was a 1983 Central graduate, meaning he was a freshman when Prosser arrived from Linsly.

"I had been struggling at Central, but when he came it was like an immediate turnaround," Nau offered. "I was treated all of his players the same no matter whether they were the first or last guy."

After college, Nau got into coaching and eventually became the head coach of his alma mater before taking over at Buckeye Local. No matter where either coach was, they never lost touch.

"I would pick up the phone at anytime and call Coach Prosser to get advice," Nau said. "This isn't just a huge loss for me, but it's a loss for the entire Ohio Valley coaching fraternity."

While serving as a Maroon Knight coach, Nau coached Prosser's sons Scott and Mark.

"I got back into coaching, he did whatever he could to help me," Nau said. "He never forgot where he is the epitome of a coach. He was honest and straight forward. He really cared about you, and he showed how much he helped me with coaching."

Current Bellaire head coach Gene Ammirante remembers Prosser being right there along with himself when the Wheeling Recreation Department started its basketball camps years ago.

"He never forgot where he started," Ammirante said. "When we started those camps, he was right there. Ammirante remembers fondly a time when he and Skip were watching their sons, Jerry and Scott, do a lot of one-on-one.

"We were at Wheeling College watching this game and Skip and I were talking wondering if the game was about to end," Ammirante said. "Not many guys who coached at Linsly have risen to the level of being ACC members."

Ammirante – who spearheads the OVAC Basketball Coaches Clinic each fall – got Prosser as one of his mentors.

"He's one of those guys who loved basketball and would do anything for anybody at anytime," Ammirante said. "He was always jumping at the bit to get back and help the people where he started."

The stories about Prosser could go on all night. He was just that good of a guy and a guy who was really admired by his peers.

The Ohio Valley and basketball world have lost one of the good guys.

Again, we would like to send our deepest sympathies to his mom Jo, wife Nancy, sons Scott and Matt, and the Prosser family.

Kim Appollini has been around the sport of basketball either as a player or coach for the better part of her life and whether it was as a player or coach success always followed.

Recognizing her accomplishments in the sport of basketball in the Ohio Valley, Appollini is the latest recipient of the Rich Saffield Girls Basketball Coach Award. She'll be officially presented her award during the upcoming Plumley OVAC All-Star Basketball Classic set for April 30 at Ohio University-Eastern.

"I'm very humbled to receive this award," Appollini said. "I've been associated with this (OVAC) program as a player and as a coach, and it's a great experience."

The award takes on added meaning for Appollini seeing that the man for which the award is named was one of her first mentors in the game of basketball, which convinced her to get into prep coaching.

"I learned a lot about class and poise from Saff," Appollini pointed out. "It has a real special place in my heart because Saff is one of my father's closest friends."

Needless to say, there was no nepotism involved because Appollini's resume speaks for itself.

After a highly productive playing career at St. John Central in Bellaire where Appollini was named an All-Ohio, District 12 Player of the Year and first-team all-Valley after her senior campaign in 1982 at The Ohio State University.

She earned her bachelor's degree in biology and then returned to the Ohio Valley and taught at Donahue for three years. While teaching at Donahue, Appollini was hired as the head girls coach at the same time she held that position for six years and coached arguably the best girls player to ever come out of the area, Johanie Petho who went on to play at the University of Pittsburgh.

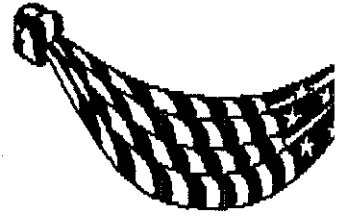
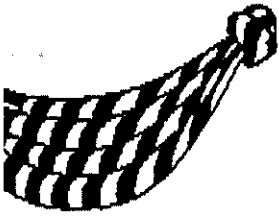
At St. John, Appollini rang up a mark of 106-20, which included five OVAC titles, two sectional championships and a district championship.

After the 1994 season, Appollini landed a teaching job at Martins Ferry High School as well as a basketball job. Success followed once again. She spent 10 years in charge of that program and compiled a 377-77 mark with two OVAC titles, three sectional crowns and a district championship.

All told, she owns a mark of 264-97 at the high school level.

After being with the Purple, Appollini moved to the collegiate ranks. She spent three years as an assistant for Joe Key with the Wheeling Jesuit women's basketball team and was on the staff when the Cardinals claimed the 2005 WVIAC title. This season, Appollini returned to Ferry and served on Jeff Salvo's staff.

"I believe that a coach receives awards like this because they have had outstanding players and

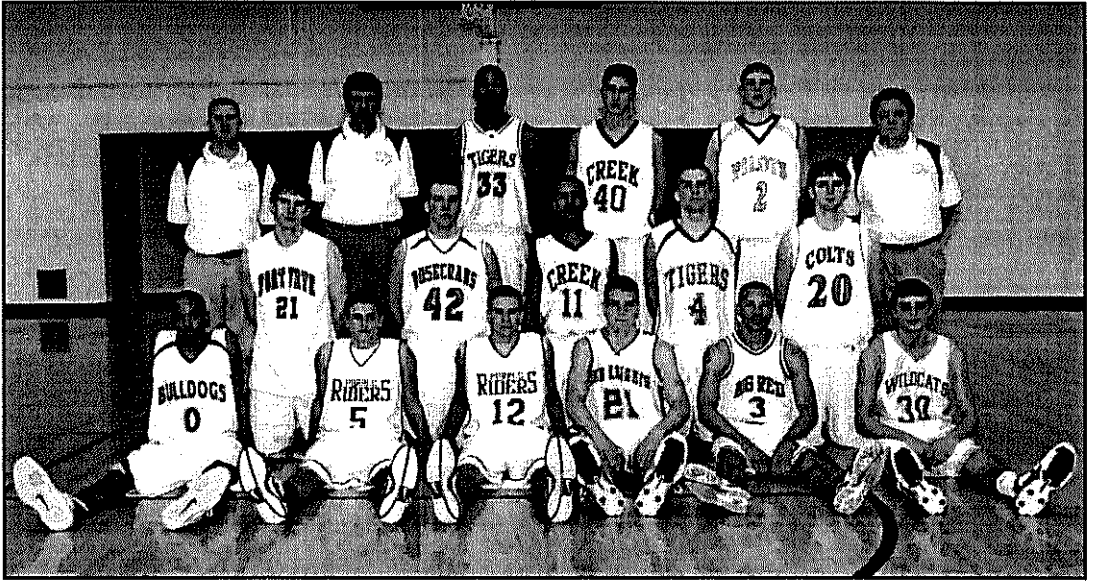
