




RULES OF THE GAME

Each game will be played under the following rules:

- 1. Each game will consist of two 20 minute halves.
- 2. Zone presses may be used but must end after first trap past half court.
- 3. Man-to-man defense must be played in the normal attack area.
- 4. Each player <u>must make an appearance in both halves.</u> Attempts should be made to give all 15 players equal playing time.
- 5. Dunking will be permitted during the pre-game warm-up.
- 6. All overtime periods shall be three minutes in length.
- 7. Each player is allowed six (6) personal fouls before he is disqualified.
- 8. Teams will be permitted one full time-out and two :30 time-outs per game.

Tug Robson - Union Local High School

No matter the event, no matter the time of the year at Union Local High School, Tug Robson's right there k to do what he can to help. Robson has been serving the Union Local Athletic Department in a bevy of ways for th 15 years and that's what made him the choice to receive the Bob Burton Distinguished Service Award at the Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Classic, which will be held Sunday, April 11 at Ohio University-Eastern. award means a great deal to me, but an award coming from (the OVAC) means even more," Robson said. "This biggest conference in the nation and includes the entire Ohio Valley, so that makes it an even bigger deal to me." R was almost in a state of shock when he heard about the award from Gene Ammirante, who is the assistant OVAC A Game director. "I remember it was Oct. 1 when Gene called me and I asked, "Didn't you have anyone else?," R recalled. "I'm confident there are people out there more worthy than me, but I am definitely honored."

Robson started working in the Jets' athletic programs during his high school days, serving under Bob L before his graduation in 1967. After a brief hiatus, Robson was asked to serve as equipment manager when Kevin was hired as the boys basketball coach. There was no definitive reason as to his gap in services other than no one him to help. "Right after I graduated, I was still involved," Robson said. "But, during the 80s and early 90s, no or asked me to help, so I wasn't really over (at the high school) too much." Robson has been a staple of both the footb-basketball programs since.

With his position of equipment manager, Robson's not ashamed to admit that he runs a tight ship wi uniforms and gear. He sometimes sleeps in the fieldhouse after football games, washing all of the players' uniforr if there's a home reserve game Saturday morning. He doesn't head home until it finishes.

"I've been known to be pretty strict every once in a while with the uniforms Robson joked. Football definitely tal most time." His efficiency and dedication to the youth of the Union Local School District also jumped out at now 1 Buckeye Trail head football coach Randy Thompson who coached and attended UL. During the 2008, OVAC A Game, Thompson asked Robson to join the Buckeyes' staff. "Working or being a part of the football all-star gar been on my to-do list since I was in high school Robson said. "It's just a special event and the way the OVAC treats kids and coaches during the week is unbelievable."

Along with his football and basketball duties, Robson has also been active for 19 years in the Union Diamond Sports. He also helps coordinate the baseball field for the annual Beast of the East Tournament.

Jim Dailer - Bridgeport/Wheeling Central/Bishop Donahue

When there's talk of comparing basketball or even sports on both sides of the river, Jim "Dubie" Daile speak with confidence. Dailer has been highly successful in both Ohio and West Virginia as a head basketball c serving lengthy terms of duties at both Bridgeport and Wheeling Central High Schools. Dailer is now being r nized for his efforts and work with the Earl Haberfield Boys Basketball Coach Award, which will be present today's annual Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Basketball Game. The award takes on a special meaning for I since he played for Haberfield at Wheeling Central. "I always had a great amount of respect for Coach Haberfiel followed his career pretty closely," Dailer said. "When he retired from coaching, he actually came back and helpe at Central and it was a great learning experience for me even at that time."

Dailer — a 1973 Bethany College graduate — got a teaching position at Bridgeport in 1975 and after spen five years as an assistant basketball coach, Dailer was hired as the head coach in 1980. He held that position until and during that time, he led the Bulldogs to the OVAC and district titles during the 1983 campaign. They event reached the regional final before bowing out. All told, he led the Bulldogs to four sectional championships. He ste down as the Bulldogs' coach in 1988 to accept the aforementioned position at Central which he held until 1998

"I am grateful that Bridgeport had enough confidence in me to take a shot," Dailer noted. "The success w there enabled me to take over the Wheeling Central position when they had such an impressive line of coa coming through there." During his nine-year run with the Maroon Knights, Dailer guided his alma mater to the championship in 1990 and 1996. The Knights were state runner-up in 1991. He was selected to coach West Virgin the OVAC All-Star Game four times (1983, 1990, 1992 and 1998) and coached the West Virginia North-South (

Ice (1990). All told, his teams won five sectionals and made four trips to Charleston. "Anytime you receive an honor a coach, it's the result of the athletes you had the opportunity to coach," Dailer said. "Plus, I had great assistants orking with me."

After being out of coaching for a few years, Dailer's urge returned and he coached the Bulldogs during the 103 and 2004 seasons before he retired from teaching in 2005. He wasn't retired long before he accepted a teaching sition at Bishop Donahue, which he currently maintains. He's also the Bishops' athletic director. "When I got out of aching, I really missed being around the kids and the other coaches," Dailer said.

During his career, Dailer also coached golf and led the Bulldogs to the 1977 OVAC title. He also served on the aching staff of his collegiate alma mater, Bethany, for a season. Dailer earns a Master's Degree in Child and Youth uidance from the University of Dayton.

Tom Wilson loves basketball.

He was a standout player at Wheeling High, helping the final Wildcats' squad win the West Virginia State ampionship in 1976. After playing for two years at West Liberty State College, Wilson gave up the playing career and rted officiating games in the college's intermural program. "I really liked (officiating) and it just stuck with me," lson said. At the urging of a couple of friends, Wilson registered for a class to become a certified basketball official I from there the rest is history.

Wilson is being recognized for his career with the Robert Dawson Basketball Official's Award, which will be sented during today's annual Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Basketball Classic. "I was very surprised and nbled when I received word that I had been chosen for this award," Wilson said. "I was shocked because I thought it s for guys who dedicated their entire careers to working in the OVAC." Wilson spent 24 years working in the OVAC ore he got out of the prep ranks when his two boys were playing and then stayed active as a collegiate official. "It just to be too much on the legs," Wilson said about stepping back from working high school games. "Instead of working nights a week, I went to working three nights a week. It just got to be too much of a time commitment." During his eer, Wilson was selected to work six West Virginia state tournaments, including three title games. He worked at the jonal level in Ohio. He was also selected to work three Mumley All-Star Classics.

Wilson entered the collegiate ranks of officiating in 1990 after attending a camp at Wheeling Jesuit University. was recommended by another official and then an observer offered him a contract. Along with his current WVIAC ies, Wilson also worked Division I in the Southern Conference. He's since cut his workload to just the WVIAC and worked three Division II tournaments. "I'd like to officiate five or six more years," Wilson said.

Along with traveling all over as an official, Wilson was a firefighter for the city of Wheeling for 30 years before retirement two years ago. "There are a lot of similarities between officiating and fighting fires," Wilson said. "Both 1 be chaotic at times, but there are definitely no life or death times in officiating."

Tom currently resides in the Springdale section of Wheeling with his wife of 26 years Susan and sons Ryan and sey.

Ron Smyth's coaching career indicates why it's good to pay attention to the advice of your parents Having no sire to really get into girls' basketball coaching, Smyth stopped at his parents house when he was just out of the llege and coaching the Springfield Local freshman squad. Smyth's dad told him the head girls' coaching job at anton was open and thought he should apply. He applied, was hired and since then has become one of the area's ost respected girls' basketball coaches after making stops at Jefferson Union, Edison South and Edison Local before pping down a few seasons ago. "I had some great players, great assistants and great support from the schools and rents," Smyth said. "It takes commitment from a lot of people to make a program work."

Smyth owns a career record of 251-182 and now he's added the Rich Saffield Girls Basketball Coach Award

to his resume. The award will be presented during today's Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Basketball Cl Smyth has had to undergo rebuilding jobs as well as taking over consolidated schools during his tenure as a head c When he was hired at Stanton, the Lady Raiders were coming off a 1-20 campaign and then when he took the J-I the Lady Yellow Jackets were 0-21. "It took a couple of years to get things turned around at both places," Smyth pc out. Smyth enjoyed his biggest success at Edison South and had expected a big season, but South and Edison 1 merged to Edison Local. "We took a step backward during the consolidation," Smyth said. Both South and Nort five seniors coming back plus a sprinkle of underclassmen, who were more than capable of contributing. "We ha see that happen through consolidation, so it was tough to find playing time for all of the players," Smyth said. "W couldn't put it together and mesh very well."

The 1975 Springfield High graduate led Edison to the 2003 OVAC title, which had been the school's only until this year's team captured the 3-A hardware.

His best year at Edison was in 2002 when the Lady Wildcats finished 21-2. Smyth was honored with Ea District and District V coach of the year honors. He was also chosen to coach the OVAC, District V and Ohio N South All-Star Games. Smyth hasn't ruled out returning to the bench at sometime during his career. "I still hav hunger to coach again," Smyth said. "I'm still very competitive." Smyth – who serves on the OVAC Basketball C pionship committee – is the Edison athletic director.

Ron and his wife Nancy have been married for almost 28 years and have two children. Their daughter Ki an undergrad at Akron and their son Mark is a sophomore at Edison.

"I've pr been doing it for too long now," Marinacci joked. "I really enjoy doing it. I figure I am going to be going to the anyway and it's a way to help the kids and coaches." Marinacci has been selected to receive the annual Tom Rat OVAC Scorekeeper's Award at today's Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Game. Ironically, Marinacci has sp entire tour of duty at the Big Reds' boys basketball scoring table sitting next to Rataiczak, who's kept the Big scorebook for many years. "Rat was actually the guy who called and told me I received the award," Marinacci said worked with him my entire time and I've always had a great deal of respect for him both as a teacher and now w OVAC. It's a thrill to win an award that's named after him." Former Big Reds' girls' basketball coach Gregg Boi Marinacci involved with running the scoreboard and he's had a permanent seat since. There's been some moments of trepidation at the table for Marinacci over the years, but not many. "I've only h coach ever question me on starting and stopping the clock," Marinacci said. 
Along the way, Marinacci's seen plenty of good players and teams come through the ranks. One of the gam sticks out was a 107-103 Big Reds' loss to Shadyside during the 1977 season. He also lists the 1994 season as one most exciting. That's when the Big Reds posted their first undefeated season. "You really feel like you're part game," Marinacci said. "You've got to pay attention closely or the people sitting behind you are yelling. As for the at the Bellaire table, Marinacci plays it year-to-year. "If they need me, I will continue to do it," Marinacci admitte actually like to retire from it, but if there's no one to do it, I will continue." Along with running the scoreboard, Ma has been the equipment manager at Bellaire for 25 years. He's also the public address announcer at the games. Ma coached the Lady Reds' softball team for 14 years and won four OVAC titles, two sectional titles and was named Softball Coach of the Year in 1984. Field design has become a passion for Marinacci as well. He's designed and plogos on fields for Bellaire, Meadowbrook, Barnesville, St. Clairsville, Shadyside, Union Local and Bridgeport. how, Marinacci has found time to serve the Village of Bellaire as a councilman for 30 years.




