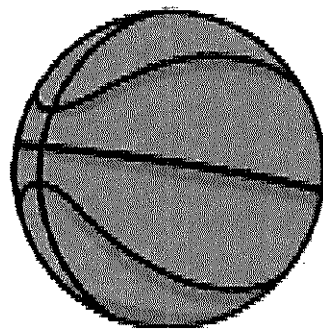

RULES OF THE GAME

1. Each game will consist of two 20 minute halves.
2. Zone presses may be used but must end after first trap past half court.
3. Man-to man defense must be played in the normal attack area.
4. Each player must make an appearance in both halves. Attempts should be made to give all 15 players equal playing time.
5. Dunking will be permitted during the pre-game warm-up.
6. All overtime periods shall be three minutes in length.
7. Each player is allowed six (6) personal fouls before he is disqualified.
8. Teams will be permitted one full time-out and two :30 time-outs per game.
No one & one until the last two minutes of game. Double bonus will be shot on the 10th foul at all times. One & one will be shot on the 7th foul only in last 2 minutes of game.

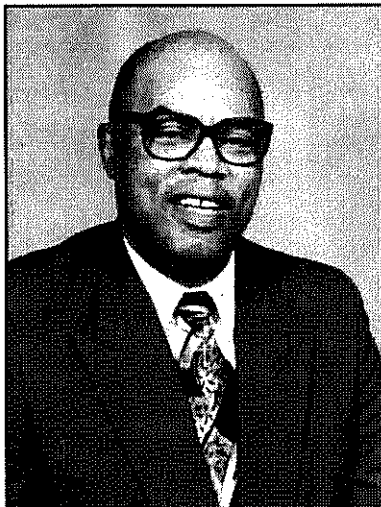

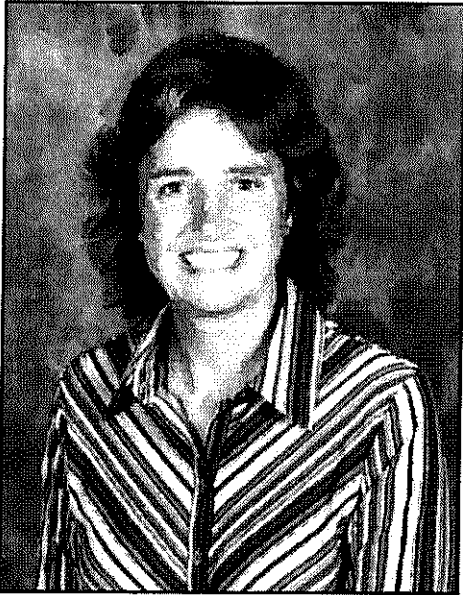

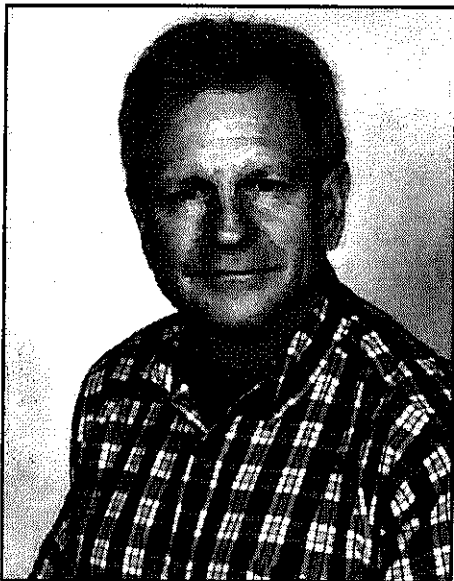

Dee Davis is down in history as one of the finest girls' basketball players to ever grace the area courts a career at Wheeling Park. Her thirst and passion for basketball carried over to the coaching ranks. For 14 seasons, Davis was one of the area's premier girls' coaches, leading her alma mater. Four years into her retirement from roundball coaching, Davis is set to receive one of the conferen

vis will receive the annual Rich Saffield Girls Basketball Coaches Award during today's Samuel A. Mumley All-Star Classic.

"I sincerely appreciate the recognition of my contributions to girls' basketball," Davis said in her letter to the OVAC All-Star Basketball Committee. "The Rich Saffield Girls Basketball Coaches Award is certainly a great honor for her playing career in which she scored 1,890 points and pocketed the West Virginia High School Player of the Year award, Davis went to Division I Tennessee Tech University.

Davis, who holds the single-game scoring record in the regular season (55) and state tournament (41) for the OVAC and Wheeling Park Halls of Fame, played two seasons in Tennessee before she transferred to West Virginia University and completed her playing career and finished her degrees in general science, biology and education.

Davis was hired by the Ohio County Schools and cut her coaching teeth in 1987 as a basketball and volleyball coach at Wheeling Junior High.

After a stop at Bridge Street Junior High, Davis was hired as the head girls' basketball coach at Park. She led the Patriots to back-to-back Class AAA state championships in 1998-99.

The 1999 title made Davis the first-ever female recipient of the coveted OVAC Coach of the Year Award. Davis resigned from coaching after the 2007 season with 225 victories, five OVAC titles, nine sectional titles and 11 titles.

The 1965 Weir High graduate was just out of college when his alma mater called and asked him if he'd like to be the timer and scorekeeper for basketball.

Lahr accepted and hasn't looked back.

Lahr is being recognized for his more than 40 years of service with the OVAC Thomas E. Rataiczak Scorer's Award, which will be presented at today's Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Basketball Classic.

"To be honest, I really didn't even know there was an award for this category," the humble Lahr said. "I've been ignored. I really enjoy the game and staying active in the sport."

Lahr, who is the golf coach at Oak Glen and won a state volleyball title with the Lady Golden Bears, was a Weir High head coach Hoot Bailey.

Lahr points out the ability to get involved in the game at the table as his favorite part, but that also led to some gettable moments during his career.

"I remember a game during the 70s against Steubenville when I got so involved in the game that I forgot to turn the style clock on and I thought Chuck Watt was going to blow a gasket," Lahr said. "We then had to figure out how much time should be on there and it was tough because we had to let the clock run down and it took a long time. Along with running the clock and keeping the book, Lahr has also done the public address announcing for the boys games when needed.

an observer for the Big East Conference at West Virginia University home games. "I thought I was done with everything that had to do with officiating when I retired as an observer," Nevels said. "I got a lot of memories back some nice memories."

Nevels became a registered official and joined the Ohio Valley Board of Officials in 1972. Five years later, however, he moved to Dallas, Texas, which is a suburb of Dallas. There he worked high school games as well as working games in the Southwest Conference. He also worked for the National Officiating Service Agency, which also included the Atlantic Coast Conference.

Despite his work in Texas, which included a Texas State Tournament assignment in 1979, and as a college official, he also worked on an assignment in the NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament, it was working in the OVAC where Nevels' friends were formed.

"I was blessed to be able to work some great games," Nevels said.

Nevels worked the West Virginia State High School Tournament from 1985-87 and was selected as a honorary member of the Ohio Valley Board in 1994.

Nevels gave up his whistle because of a higher calling. "I got into the ministry and I just didn't have the time to officiate anymore," Nevels noted. "It hurt me at first, but it was definitely the most important thing."

Nevels, who will turn 75 in June, still watches a ton of games and finds himself from time to time calling games from the front of his living room.

"When it comes to watching college basketball, I can't get enough," Nevels admitted.

According to Nevels, he never misses a game when his prized pupil, Ted Valentine, works. "I tutored him and I thought he'd be good," Nevels said. "He's really matured and now he's one of the best officials in the country."

Nevels is the pastor at the Morning Star Baptist Church in Weirton and resides in Wheeling with his wife Loma. Nevels and Loma, who have been married 34 years, have six children.

Tom O'Connell

The late Tom O'Connell's contribution to the sport of basketball can be felt in several schools on several levels. It alone made him a no-brain choice to receive the 2011 Bob Burton Distinguished Service Award at today's OVAC All-Star Game.

O'Connell's widow, Patty, will accept the award in his behalf.

O'Connell, who passed away in July of 2008 at the age of 75, had coaching stints at West Liberty State College, Buckeye Local and Wheeling Central. All told, his career lasted more than 40 years.

At Wheeling Central and West Liberty graduate coached football, basketball and actually started the first baseball team.

At West Liberty, O'Connell was a standout football player under the late Dr. Al Blatnik and Dr. Joseph Bartell. He was once a Hilltoppers' captain during his senior season.

During his stint as football coach, O'Connell posted a 43-49 record and led the Bishops to the OVAC title in 1963. In runner-up finishes. His 1971 team was the West Virginia Catholic runnerup.

O'Connell coached basketball for the Bishops for 10 seasons, posting a 119-117 record. He guided the Bishops to a pair of OVAC titles (1964, 1972) and twice posted records of 18-4.

The aforementioned baseball program was solid with O'Connell as skipper. He was the head coach for 13 seasons at West Virginia Catholic titles (1963, 68, 72, 73 and 74).

O'Connell also coached on the hilltop, working under John Westenhaver and Larry Shank. Working as a defensive coordinator, O'Connell coached Mark Murphy, who later played for the Green Bay Packers.

After his stay with the Hilltoppers, O'Connell returned to the prep ranks in the now Buckeye Local School District. He came in 1988-89 at Buckeye North when he guided it to a school record 16-5 record and a sectional title.

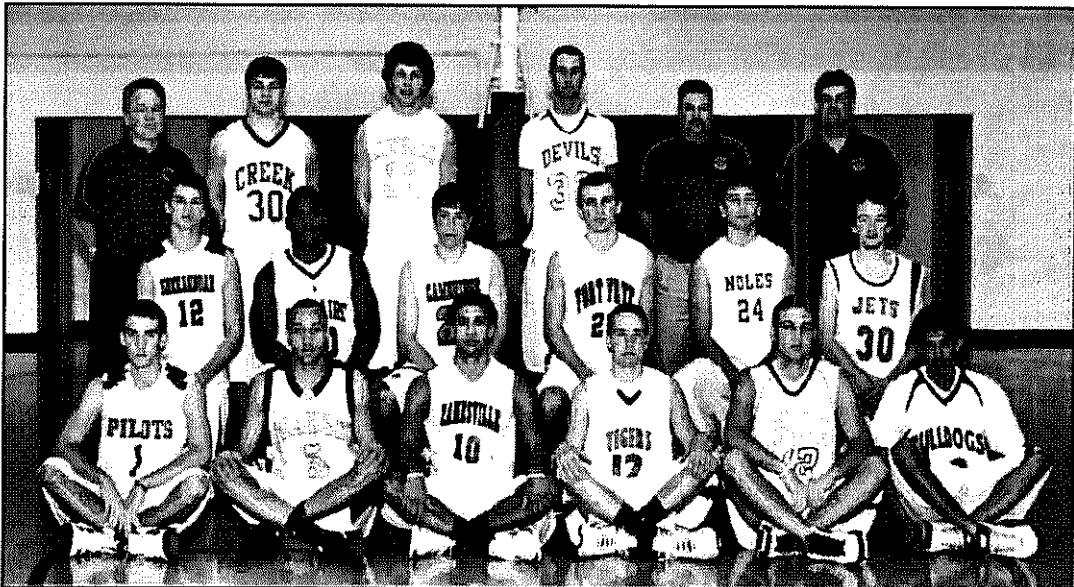

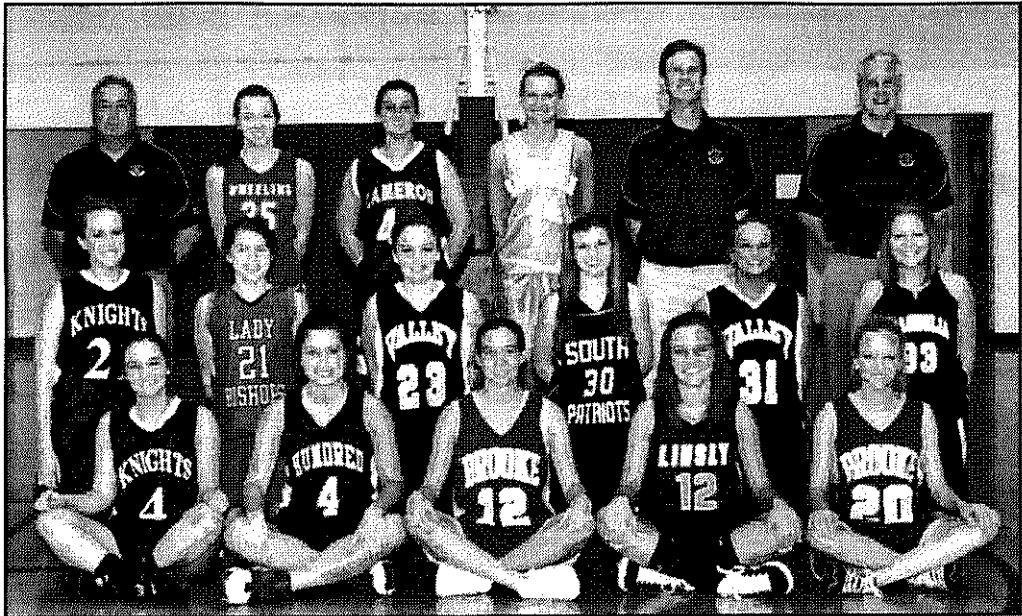
