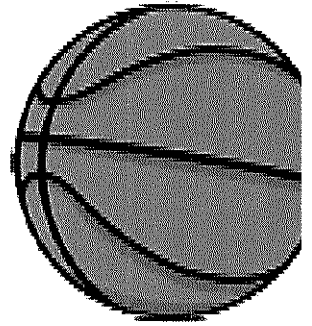

RULES OF THE GAME

1. Each game will consist of two 20 minute halves.
2. Zone presses may be used but must end after first trap past half court.
3. Man-to man defense must be played in the normal attack area.
4. Each player must make an appearance in both halves. Attempts should be made to give all 15 players equal playing time.
5. Dunking will be permitted during the pre-game warm-up.
6. All overtime periods shall be three minutes in length.
7. Each player is allowed six (6) personal fouls before he is disqualified.
8. Teams will be permitted one full time-out and two :30 time-outs per game.
No one & one until the last two minutes of game. Double bonus will be shot on the 10th foul at all times. One & one will be shot on the 7th foul only in last 2 minutes of game.

Gene Ammirante "Coach A"

Gene Ammirante has seen his fair share of Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Basketball Classics. He's also done a wide array of jobs. He's coached the game, directed the game and helped save the game finally many years ago. Heck, he even collected dirty uniforms after the games.

When the basketball stars of the Ohio Valley come out on Sunday, April 1, the only thing Ammirante wanting is hardware. The former Bellaire Big Reds' head coach was selected to receive the Earl Habberfield Award for the game, which is slated for Sunday, April 1 at Ohio University Eastern.

"Being chosen for this award really means a lot," Ammirante said. "I can honestly remember (St. Clair's head coach) Kim (Clifford) and I would go and clean up the uniforms after the game."

Both Ammirante and Clifford's careers have long surpassed the role of clean-up duty. Ammirante called it quits after 30 seasons at the helm of the Big Reds, which included a 471-205 record. Ammirante's Big Reds won 14 sectional titles, six district titles and the 2004 Division III regional crown along with 14 OVAC titles and two perfect regular seasons.

All told, Ammirante won 70 percent of his games and had only four losing seasons.

"We were fortunate to have a lot of good players," Ammirante said. "I still like to emphasize that even though we had a lot of good players, we had a lot of guys who were also willing to do the dirty work. They were just as good as we were."

Ammirante has been involved with the all-star game basically from its start when he was approached by legends of Hank Lasasz, Dick Potts and Habberfield to take the game over as basketball coaches fought to keep the always popular football all-star game.

"Hank, Dick and Earl all came to my house and asked if I would be willing to take the game over," Ammirante said. "It was tough to turn down three legends, who had been my idols."

Ammirante and his long-time buddy Tom "Bear" Bechtel currently spearhead the game. This marks Ammirante's third tour of duty with the game.

"There were some guys who were nervous about the future of the (all-star) game because of our financial situation," Ammirante confessed. "But, we tightened our purse strings and there were some people mad at me but now we're in good financial shape."

Bubba Kapral

St. John Central girls' basketball program has won more Ohio Valley Athletic Conference titles than any program in the conference with 14.

One of the main architects of the program will be honored at the annual Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Basketball Classic. Lady Irish head coach Bubba Kapral will receive the Richard Saffield Girls Basketball Coach Award during the April 1 contest.

"I am both honored and deeply humbled to be the recipient of such a prestigious award," Kapral said. "Previous recipients are some of my coaching idols. In addition, Saff is a close friend, so receiving an award that carries his name makes it even more meaningful."

Kapral has been at the Lady Irish helm for the last 18 years. He's guided his teams to eight OVAC title wins, seven trips to the district and a regional berth.

All told, Kapral has put together a strong 255-133 record.

Awards are nothing new for Kapral. He was named Ohio Division IV State Coach of the Year in 2001 and in 2007-08 season, he was named the Ohio High School Basketball Coaches Association State Division Coach of the Year.

He was also chosen to coach in the 2002 Ohio North-South Game.

"The awards are made possible by all of the tremendous players who have worn the Lady Irish uniform and all the quality assistants who have supported me along the way," Kapral said.

Before ascending to the head-coaching role, Kapral served as an assistant for six seasons under Kim Clifford at SJC.

"I would be remiss if I didn't thank Kim," Kapral said. "She taught me the game of basketball and turned me into a program second to none. She's the gold standard of prep basketball coaches."

He's been named AP Eastern District Coach of the Year five times, four-times honored as District 12 Coach of the Year, coached the Mumley Classic three times and is a member of the OVAC Basketball Championship Committee as well as the OVAC Hall of Fame Committee.

While Kapral's basketball coaching success is well documented, his career as Irish track and field coach is also of fame worthy.

Kapral coached track for 21 years, winning 13 OVAC titles, two Division III state championships and twice named as state runnerup.

Bob Robinson

Most people around the Ohio Valley know the name Bob Robinson. However, they probably think about automobiles first and foremost. However, if you're around the sport of basketball, you think of Robinson as a hoops guy. Robinson became a basketball junkie at a young age and his passion has not faded one bit.

For his years as a coach, support and friend to the game, Robinson has been selected to receive the Bob Robinson Distinguished Service Award, which will be presented during the annual Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Basketball Game, which is slated for April 1 at Ohio University Eastern.

"I was humbled when I found out about the award," Robinson said. "I don't know how I was chosen, but I was honored and was really surprised. I've been blessed to be able to continue with my love of the game for such a long time."

Making the award maybe even more special is the relationship that Robinson and the legendary former Steubenville coach Bob Burton maintain to this day. "I've known Bob since I was 16 years old, so to receive an award for him is really humbling," Robinson said.

Robinson got into the game of basketball when his mom took him to a game in New Matamoras, Ohio to watch his cousin play. He came away hooked. "Being from a small town, basketball was a big deal every winter," Robinson said. "I just fell in love with the game."

Robinson got his start in coaching in New Martinsville with five and sixth grade leagues. He later coached high school girls' AAU teams and was eventually chosen to coach the Magnolia boys' summer league team.

It was 19 years ago that Wheeling Central head girls' coach Penn Kurtz approached Robinson about joining the Wheeling Knights' staff. He accepted and basically, the rest is history other than a brief tenure as the girls' coach at Mount DeChantal.

"As I look back, it's all been very special," Robinson said. "I've been associated with so many fine young ladies at Wheeling Central and Mount DeChantal."

Robinson has been a part of two state championship staffs and seven state tournament appearances. He passed his love of hoops onto his children, who were standout players in high school. Both Jim and Robertta were standout players during their prep days. Robertta played Division I basketball at Virginia Commonwealth University.

Lynn Meyer – who is currently a teacher, assistant athletic director and coach at Steubenville High School last year – got her start coaching during the 1979-80 school year as a junior high coach at Stanton.

Her husband, Dave, kept the book for all of the girls' game. They then moved up to the book at Edison South High School when their oldest son, Josh, began playing.

They just continued in their roles, but Lynn kept the girls' basketball book and Dave kept the boys' scorebook.

Lynn now helps out with the scoring at Steubenville High where the couple's youngest child, Hannah, is a senior member of the basketball team.

All four of the Meyer children were active in sports. Josh and Caleb graduated from Edison, but Jordan graduated from Edison and Hannah will receive her diploma later this spring.

Joe Dierkes

High graduate Joe Dierkes took the path to officiating stardom that so many take.

He wrapped up a brilliant playing career, which was split between three seasons at Clarington High and the varsity season at River en route to more than 900 career points.

With a thirst for the game, six years after graduation and two years after serving in the United States Army, Dierkes got his officiating card.

He told Dierkes worked 20 years as an official in the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference.

For his efforts, Dierkes is being recognized at the annual Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Game with the Robinson Basketball Officials' Award.

As a player, Dierkes was a four-year varsity letterman and three-year starter. He was a member of the first graduating class of River High School in 1955.

After his junior and senior seasons, Dierkes received All East Ohio Class B honors.

Dierkes is a life-long Clarington resident. He's been married to his wife Janice since 1959.

The couple has four children and eight grandchildren, who round out Big Joe's Dream Team. Their sons named Ty, Jon and Kelly. Lee and his wife Donna have two daughters and resident in Roswell, Ga.. 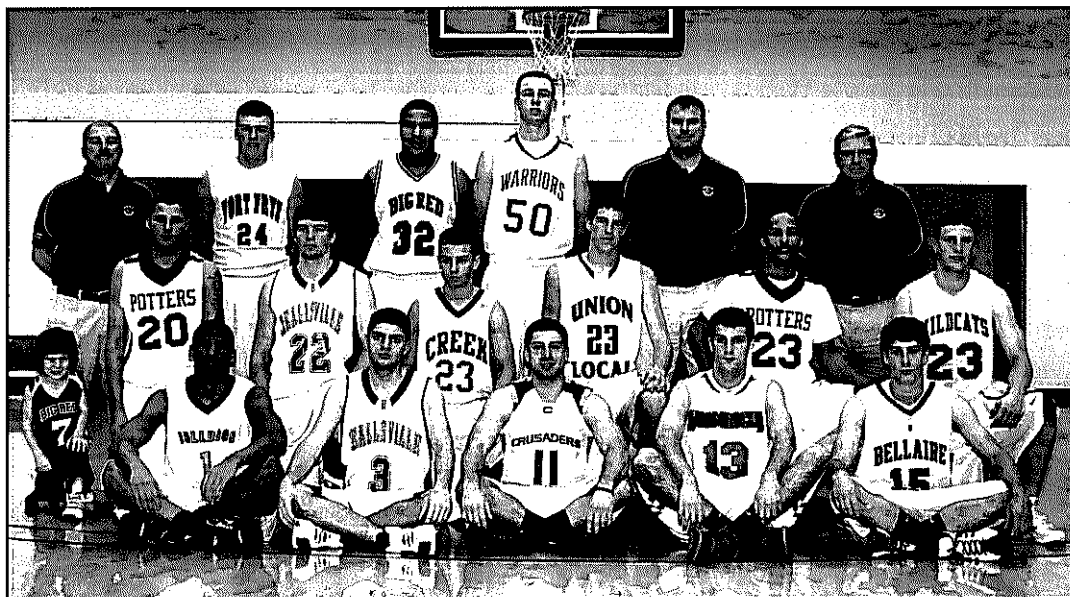
