

#### RULES OF THE GAME

- 1. Each game will consist of two 20 minute halves.
- 2. Zone presses may be used but must end after first trap past half court.
- 3. Man-to man defense must be played in the normal attack area.
- 4. Each player <u>must make an appearance in both halves</u>. Attempts should be made to give all 15 players equal playing time.
- 5. Dunking will be permitted during the pre-game warm-up.
- 6. All overtime periods shall be three minutes in length.
- 7. Each player is allowed six (6) personal fouls before he is disqualified.
- 8. Teams will be permitted one full time-out and two :30 time-outs per game. No one & one until the last two minutes of game. Double bonus will be shot on the 10th foul at all times. One & one will be shot on the 7th foul only in last 2 minutes of game.

Gene Ammirante has seen his fair share of Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All- Star Basketball Classics. s also done a wide array of jobs. He's coached the game, directed the game and helped save the game finely many years ago. Heck, he even collected dirty uniforms after the games.

When the basketball stars of the Ohio Valley come out on Sunday, April 1, the only thing Ammirante w ecting is hardware. The former Bellaire Big Reds' head coach was selected to receive the Earl Haberfield A he game, which is slated for Sunday, April 1 at Ohio University Eastern.

"Being chosen for this award really means a lot," Ammirante said. "I can honestly remember (St. Clairs ad coach) Kim (Clifford) and I would go and clean up the uniforms after the game."

Both Ammirante and Clifford's careers have long surpassed the role of clean-up duty.

mirante called it quits after 30 seasons at the helm of the Big Reds, which included a 471-205 record. Amm Big Reds won 14 sectional titles, six district titles and the 2004 Division III regional crown along with 14 OV is and two perfect regular seasons.

All told, Ammirante won 70 percent of his games and had only four losing seasons.

"We were fortunate to have a lot of good players," Ammirante said. "I still like to emphasize that even t had a lot of good players, we had a lot of guys who were also willing to do the dirty work. They were just as e."

Ammirante has been involved with the all-star game basically from its start when he was approached the soft Hank Lasasz, Dick Potts and Habberfield to take the game over as basketball coaches fought to keep to the always popular football all-star game.

"Hank, Dick and Earl all came to my house and asked if I would be willing to take the game over," Amr te said. "It was tough to turn down three legends, who had been my idols."

Ammirante and his long-time buddy Tom "Bear" Bechtel currently spearhead the game. This marks An te's third tour of duty with the game.

"There were some guys who were nervous about the future of the (all-star) game because of our finan lation," Ammirante confessed. "But, we tightened our purse strings and there were some people mad at me out now we're in good financial shape."

#### **Bubba Kapral**

∋ St. John Central girls' basketball program has won more Ohio Valley Athletic Conference titles than any pr he conference with 14.

One of the main architects of the program will be honored at the annual Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-sketball Classic. Lady Irish head coach Bubba Kapral will receive the Richard Saffield Girls Basketball Coac and during the April 1 contest.

"I am both honored and deeply humbled to be the recipient of such a prestigious award," Kapral said. 'vious recipients are some of my coaching idols. In addition, Saff is a close friend, so receiving an award the ars his name makes it even more meaningful."

Kapral has been at the Lady Irish helm for the last 18 years. He's guided his teams to eight OVAC title ren trips to the district and a regional berth.

All told. Kapral has put together a strong 255-133 record.

Awards are nothing new for Kapral. He was named Ohio Division IV State Coach of the Year in 2001 at the 2007-08 season, he was named the Ohio High School Basketbal Coaches Association State Division ach of the Year.

He was also chosen to coach in the 2002 Ohio North-South Game.

"The awards are made possible by all of the tremendous players who have worn the Lady Irish uniforn I as quality assistants who have supported me along the way," Kapral said.

Before ascending to the head-coaching role, Kapral served as an assistant for six seasons under Kim i at SJC.

"I would be remiss if I didn't thank Kim," Kapral said. "She taught me the game of basketball and turne a program second to none. She's the gold standard of prep basketball coaches."

He's been named AP Eastern District Coach of the Year five times, four-times honored as District 12 C he Year, coached the Mumley Classic three times and is a member of the OVAC Basketball Championship tee as well as the OVAC Hall of Fame Committee.

While Kapral's basketball coaching success is well documented, his career as Irish track and field coal of fame worthy.

Kapral coached track for 21 years, winning 13 OVAC titles, two Division III state championships and tw shed as state runnerup.

Robinson got his start in coaching in New Martinsville with five and sixth grade leagues. He later coached ah school girls' AAU teams and was eventually chosen to coach the Magnolia boys' summer league team.

It was 19 years ago that Wheeling Central head girls' coach Penn Kurtz approached Robinson about joinidy Knights' staff. He accepted and basically, the rest is history other than a brief tenure as the girls' coach a DeChantal.

"As I look back, it's all been very special," Robinson said. I've been associated with so many fine young la Wheeling Central and Mount DeChantal.

Robinson has been a part of two state championship staffs and seven state tournament appearances. ssed his love of hoops onto his children, who were standout players in high school. s a player, Dierkes was a four-year varsity letterman and three-year starter. He was a member of the first gr lass of River High School in 1955.


