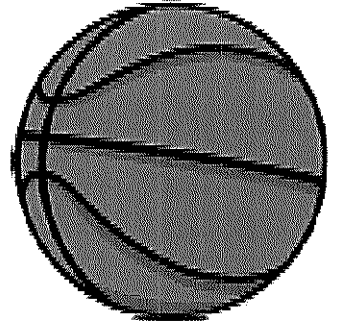

2. Zone presses may be used but must end after first trap past half court.
3. Man-to man defense must be played in the normal attack area.
4. Each player must make an appearance in both halves. Attempts should be made to give all 15 players equal playing time.
5. Dunking will be permitted during the pre-game warm-up.
6. All overtime periods shall be three minutes in length.
7. Each player is allowed six (6) personal fouls before he is disqualified.
8. Teams will be permitted one full time-out and two :30 time-outs per game.
No one & one until the last two minutes of game. Double bonus will be shc on the 10th foul at all times. One & one will be shot on the 7th foul only in last 2 minutes of game.

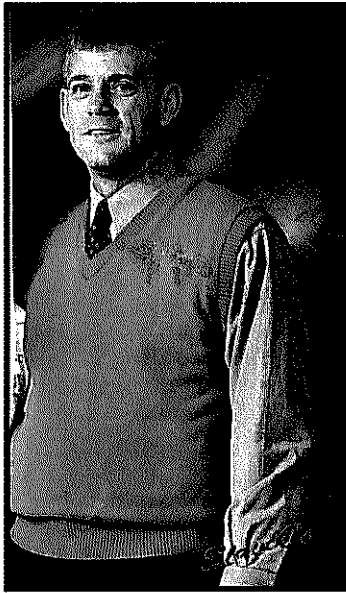

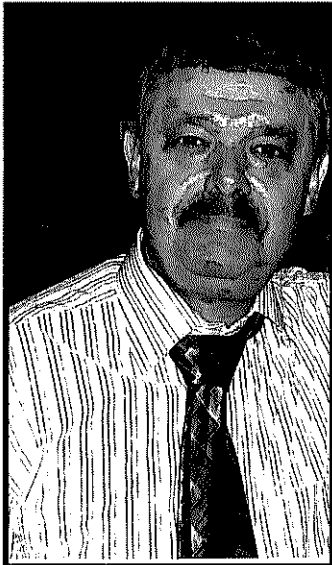

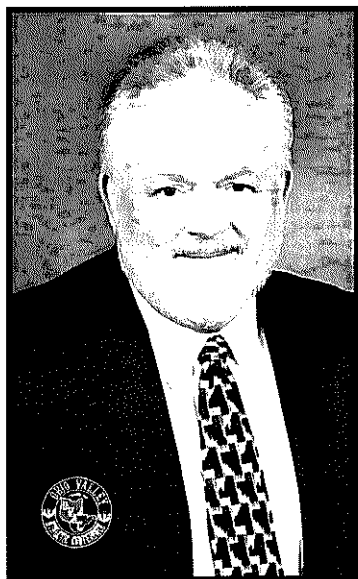

Jim Miller

The Shadyside Lady Tigers have been one of the area's premier girls' basketball programs for quite some time. One of the program's chief architects is being recognized with the Rich Saffield Girls Basketball Coaching Award during the annual Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Classic, which is slated for Sunday, November 7 at Ohio University Eastern in St. Clairsville.

Long-time girls' basketball coach Jim Miller has been chosen as this year's recipient of the award. The award is named for the long-time Union Local mentor. Miller held the Shadyside girls' post for nine years and accomplished unmatched success. He led the Lady Tigers to more than 160 victories, including four district titles of more than 20 wins. The Lady Tigers were always well-drilled and well-schooled under Miller. Miller showed during the tournament. Miller led Shadyside to the district tournament seven times during his career. Twice, Shadyside advanced to the regional tournament in Pickerington and won the title there two other times to advance to the coveted 'Final 4' in Columbus. In 2002, Miller's Lady Tigers advanced to the state tournament for the first time and took down South Charleston Southeastern in the state semifinals to advance to the state title game. However, it fell short, 50-32, in the state final to Delphos St. John.

The following season, Shadyside went back to Columbus and fell, 53-50, in the state semifinals. After both trips to the state tourney, Miller was named a finalist for the OVAC Coach of the Year. Miller's teams won four OVAC titles. His first crown came in 1998. Along with the honor from the OVAC, Miller was named District 12 Coach of the Year four times. Prior to coming to Shadyside, where he has coached for 25 years, Miller served as head coach at Buckeye Trail and was also an assistant at Bellaire.

Miller and his wife Cheri have been married for 41 years. The couple has two children and six grandchildren.

Tom Tribett

When it comes to West Virginia small-school basketball, Tom Tribett etched quite a resume at Donahue High School. Taking over the Bishops' program in 1984, Tribett served as the program's head coach until 2000 and was one of the most successful coaches in the school's history. Tribett will be recognized for winning the annual Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Classic with the Earl Haberfield Boys Basketball Club as the MVP. The all-star game will be held on Sunday, April 7 at Ohio University Eastern in St. Clairsville.

Prior to ascending to the head coaching position, Tribett was the chief assistant to John Stanfield, who was also highly successful with the Bishops. He led them to a Class A state title in 1981. It didn't take long for Tribett to make his presence felt with the Bishops. He led Donahue to the 1985 state title and then back to the title game in 1989, but were overruled in the title game. The 1985 season didn't go unrec- ognized by his peers. Tribett was named W.Va. State Coach of the Year by the West Virginia Coaches Association. All told, Tribett guided the Bishops to six appearances in the West Virginia state tournament. The aforementioned 1989 squad claimed the OVAC Class 1A title. Tribett guided the Mountain State in the 1985 and 1986 OVAC All-Star Games and worked with the North squad in the West Virginia North-South game in 1987. Along with boys' basketball, Tribett served as the Lady Bishops' softball coach and was highly successful. He led Donahue to a pair of state titles during his tenure.

Tom and his wife Cindy reside in McMechen. They're the parents of one daughter, Julie, who lives in Jacksonville, Florida.

Al Glitch

To do something for 40 years is a long, long time. However, when it's a labor of love, the time doesn't seem to pass. This is the case for Al Glitch, who has been a fixture at the St. Clairsville gymnasium scorer's table for numerous levels for the extended period of time. His work as a timer, scorekeeper and even public address announcer has earned him the Thomas E. Rataiczak Timer and Scorekeeper Award, which will be presented during the Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Basketball Games, which will be held on Sunday, April 7 at Ohio University Eastern in St. Clairsville. Glitch taught at St. Clairsville High School for 32 years and worked in sports in numerous capacities. For seven years, Glitch was the Red Devils' head basketball coach and earned District 12 Coach of the Year in 1980. He was the head coach of the Ohio squad in the 1981 All-Star Game in 1981.

After stepping down as head coach, Glitch served under current head coach Kim Clifford as a freshman coach and then jayvee coach. All told, he worked as an assistant basketball coach at St. Clairsville for 22 years. On top of hoops, he was an assistant baseball coach for nine years and served on the coaching staff for five years.

While doing all of that, Glitch still served as public address announcer or scorekeeper for a number of levels and he also oversaw the annual St. Clairsville Junior High Boys Basketball Tournament, which was named for him during the 50th annual event last year.

Along with his duties at St. Clairsville, Glitch has been the public address announcer at boys and girls Wheeling Hospital OVAC Basketball Championships since their inception. He's also a voice of the OVAC All-Star Game. Away from basketball, Glitch served as the OVAC Baseball director for 5 years.

The 1969 Bridgeport High School graduate was a member of state runner-up squads in both football and baseball during his senior year. He then went to West Liberty State College where he played baseball. He was an all-WVIAC selection in 1973. Glitch was active in the Ohio Valley Baseball I League for 24 seasons.

Al, who is currently a teacher at the Belmont Correctional Institute, and his wife Phyllis have three children.

John L. Howell

You name the aspect of high school basketball officiating and John Howell has been involved. The Shadys t and Lancaster Fairfield Union graduate worked in a bevy of capacities for the Ohio Valley Board of Basketball for 38 years and remains involved to this day despite his retirement from actually blowing the whistle. In less efforts and lengthy list of accomplishments, Howell has been chosen for the Robert Dawson Basketball Award, which will be presented during the annual Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Game on Sunday, April 10 at Ohio University Eastern in St. Clairsville. Howell began officiating in 1972 and got the call for his first varsity game in 1974 when Paden City took on St. Mary's. From that point, until March 11, 2009 when Howell called his final game which was a West Virginia Class AA Regional at Phillip Barbour, Howell has almost seen and done it all on his own. Howell's expertise landed him 75 regional tournament assignments between Ohio and West Virginia. Of those, he worked 22 boys regionals and 20 girls in Ohio. He worked 18 boys and 16 girls in the Mountain State. The coaches used Howell on 27 state tournaments in his career.

He made his state tournament debut in 1983 in the West Virginia girls' tournament. His first boys' state tournament came at St. John Arena in Columbus in 1987. His first West Virginia boys' state tournament came in 1988 and after he worked his second straight state tourney in the Buckeye State. Howell worked his final state tournament at the Jerome Schottenstein Center in 2008. In between, he worked 14 Ohio boys, five girls; six West Virginia boys and five girls.

In 1993, Howell worked a West Virginia state semifinal game in the morning and then that evening he headed to Columbus and worked an Ohio State Semifinal girls' game. During his 1996 Ohio State assignment, he worked the state title game with three officials. He was a part of that history in West Virginia the following season.

Howell, who was elected to the Ohio Officials Hall of Fame in 2003, was named District V Official of the Year in 1991, District 12 Official of the Year in 1992 and West Virginia Official of the Year in 1994. He received the NFHS Official of the Year Award for West Virginia in 1992 and Ohio in 1997. Howell worked games involving several top athletes for both boys and girls. Some of the players he officiated games involving include: LeBron James, Carmelo Anthony, Jason Williams, Kevin Martin, Randy Moss, Joey Galloway, Geno Ford, Shaun Stonerook, Katie Strömme, and Meeka Randall just to name a few.

In 1995, Howell took over the position of OVAC Basketball Commissioner. He still maintains that job to this day and is responsible for scheduling of all boys' basketball officials for conference games. Prior to ascending to commissioner's duties, he was the assistant commissioner from 1983-94. Along with officiating, Howell served as a 3 class instructor for 16 years and, from his class, 15 officials have went on to work a state tournament in either Ohio or West Virginia.

On top of basketball, Howell has become a staple at area track meets as a registered official and clerk. He started helping at area track meets in 1972.

Dave Ice

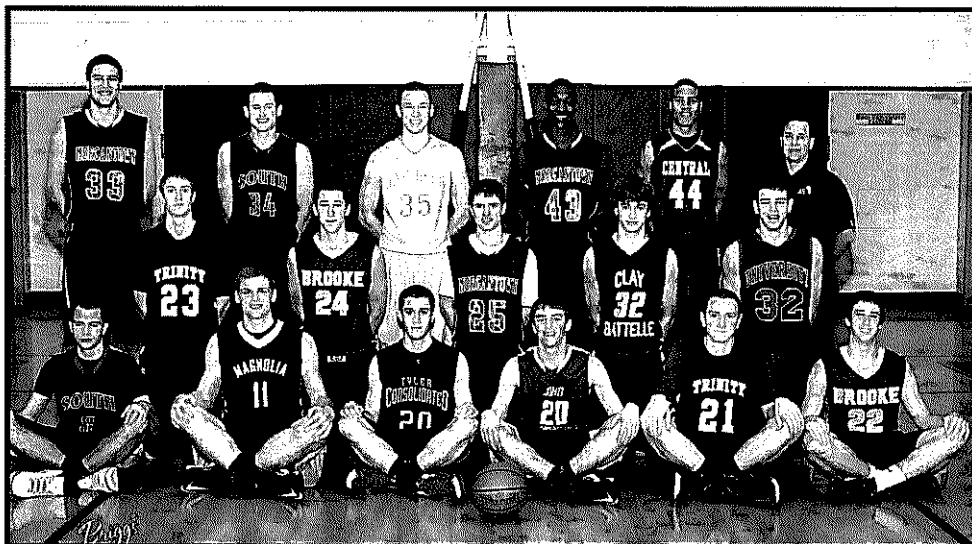
Dave Ice loved sports. More specifically, Ice loved Bellaire Big Reds' sports. One of his greatest passions was playing basketball at the junior high and freshman level. Working under highly successful head coach Gene Amadio was a job that Ice took very seriously and carried out quite well. For his years of service and dedication, Ice passed away in 2011, will be honored posthumously with the Distinguished Service Award during today's Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Classic.

Ice was a 1964 graduate of Bellaire High School and was a standout in both football and track. He was selected to play in the OVAC All-Star Football Game and was just the second shot putter in Bellaire High history to eclipse the cover of the record book. After his graduation, Ice didn't stray far from Bellaire or Big Reds' athletics. You name the sport, Ice played a big role. He served as the president of the Bellaire Touchdown Club for 10 years and was a big player in helping to get the all-weather track at Nelson Field installed. He also worked tirelessly with the Bellaire Sports Foundation, which has since renamed the girls' track meet that Ice brought to Bellaire in his honor as the Dave Ice track and field scholarship it presents each year.

Ice was recognized by Bellaire in 1989 when he was formally inducted into the schools "Wall of Honor" for his contribution to athletics. Outside of his work within the support groups, Ice also oversaw and organized annual tag days and supported the junior high football program. Ice coached track, both at the high school and junior high level, for 20 years. He specialized in the shot put and produced several all-Ohio throwers. Working under Amadio, Ice coached for 20 years at the junior high and freshman level. He remained active on the staff until the time of his death. Dave is survived by his wife, Annette, and their son, David, a 1991 Bellaire High graduate. David and his wife have a daughter Madison and reside in Plain City.



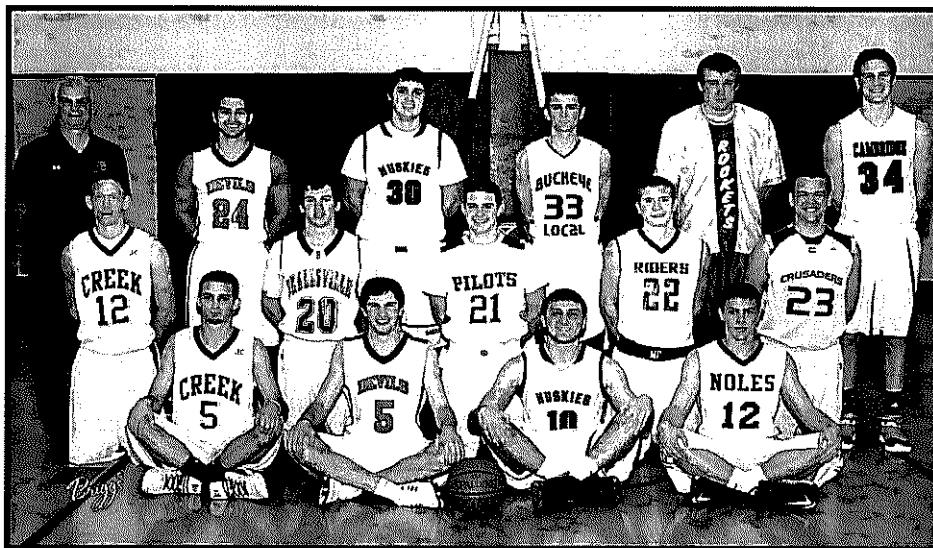
