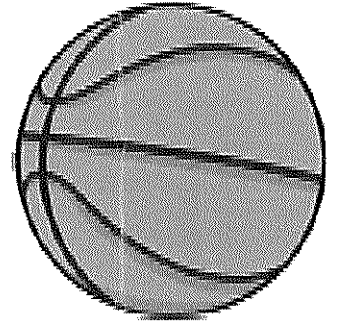

RULES OF THE GAME

1. Each game will consist of two 20 minute halves.
2. Zone presses may be used but must end after first trap past half court.
3. Man-to man defense must be played in the normal attack area.
4. Each player must make an appearance in both halves. Attempts should be made to give all 15 players equal playing time.
5. Dunking will be permitted during the pre-game warm-up.
6. All overtime periods shall be three minutes in length.
7. Each player is allowed six (6) personal fouls before he is disqualified.
8. Teams will be permitted one full time-out and two :30 time-outs per game.
No one & one until the last two minutes of game. Double bonus will be shown on the 10th foul at all times. One & one will be shot on the 7th foul only in last 2 minutes of game.

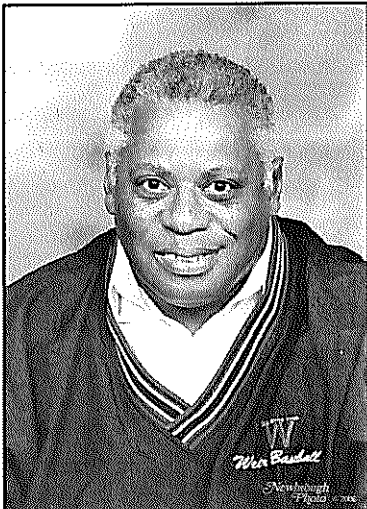

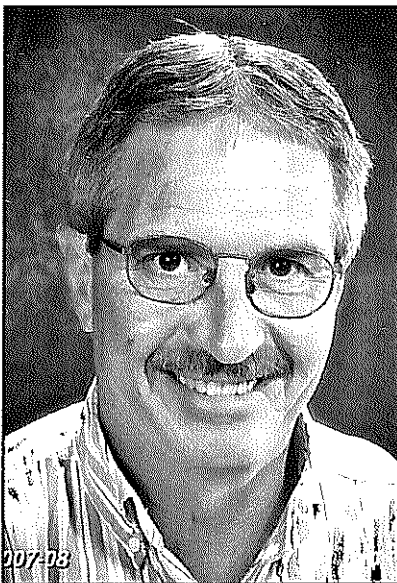

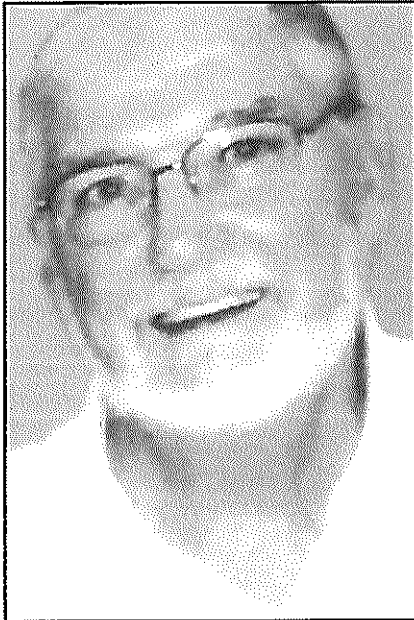

Bill Smith

For Bill Smith, coaching basketball is fun. When it becomes anything less than that, that's when Weir High head coach will step aside. However, don't look for that anytime soon. Smith, who has been the head girls' basketball coach of the Lady Red Riders since 1993, will receive the Rich Saffield Coaching Award at the annual Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Game.

"I have been very fortunate in my 40.5 years of educational experience," Smith said. "I have been able to build rapport with my teaching peers and my students." Smith, who graduated from Kingwood High School in 1966, earned his bachelor's degree in social studies in 1970 from Fairmont State. He completed his master's degree in secondary classroom instruction from West Virginia University and in 1982, he completed his master's thesis on 30 hours. Along with being a standout in the classroom, Smith was a standout in athletics both at the high school and collegiate level. He lettered four times in baseball at Fairmont, starting for three of those seasons. He has coached at Weir High by the Hancock County Schools and has been there ever since. He's also been coaching baseball throughout his career. He spent 17 years as a freshman basketball coach and three years as an assistant basketball coach. Smith was the head baseball coach at Weir High from 1977-95. He won four sectional titles and the regional championship in 1982. In 1994, the Red Riders claimed the OVAC Class 4A title. Smith took over the girls' basketball position at Weir in 1993. He's won three sectional titles and been to the state tournament (2008 and 2011). In 1996, his Lady Red Riders finished 19-3 and he was recognized as Class 4A coach of the year as given by the Ohio Valley Coaches Association. "Athletics has always been an integral part of my life," Smith said. "Education is a powerful tool; however, I feel that those lessons learned while sitting at the classroom table have also been rewarding."

Dan Schwieterman

It's hard to quietly win 452 boys basketball games. But, former Shenandoah Zeps' head coach Dan Schwieterman did just that during his 34-year stint as the head man in Sarahsville. Schwieterman will be honored for his success and dedication to the sport of basketball in the Ohio Valley during the annual Samuel Mumley OVAC All-Star Basketball Classic with the Earl Haberfield Boys Basketball Coaching Award. "It's certainly an honor to be recognized by the OVAC," Schwieterman said. "I knew Coach Haberfield when he was coaching at Meadowbrook, so to receive an award named for him makes it even more special." Schwieterman isn't from the Ohio Valley originally. He graduated from Bryant High School in Jay, Indiana. However, shortly after earning his education degree at Ohio University, Schwieterman moved to the Ohio Valley. He spent the 1976-77 school year at Madison Consolidated School system in Gibson County and coached basketball, baseball and served as the athletic director. The following school year he accepted the post with the Zeps and basically the rest is history. He originally taught physical education and served as a teacher's training, but since 1988, he's served as the Shenandoah guidance counselor at the elementary school. Schwieterman coached the boys basketball team for 34 seasons, winning five PVC titles, 11 sectional titles, 10 district titles and took one team to the Elite 8. Four times during his career, he was named District Coach of the Year and twice was honored as Eastern District coach of the year. Several times during his career, Schwieterman coached the District 12 and OVAC All-Star Games and led the South squad in the Ohio North-South Game. He received the 2010 OHSAA Sportsmanship, Ethics and Integrity Award at the boys state tournament. While the honors are nice, it was the relationships with players, fellow coaches and teachers that stick out the most for Schwieterman, who is currently a volunteer assistant coach for the Shenandoah girls. "The variety of people you get to meet, come in contact with and become friends is the greatest reward," Schwieterman said. "I have had the opportunity to form positive relationships with many people and I still consider those people my friends. There are just so many positive memories from my career."

Schwieterman and his wife Shelly, who will celebrate their 30th anniversary in June, are the parents of three children, Braun (26), Caleb (24) and Renee (20).

Janice Tisher

Janice Tisher bleeds red and gray. River's red and gray to be exact. So, when legendary basketball coach Dick Potts needed a scorekeeper, she was more than willing to help out. Fast forwarding to the present, Tisher is still the Pilots' scorekeeper now 28 years later. That kind of dedication to the sport of basketball doesn't go unnoticed. Thus, Tisher has been chosen as the recipient of the Thomas E. Rataiczak Tishler Scorekeeper Award, which will be presented at the annual Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Game. "It's an honor to keep the book," Tisher said.

During the course of her career as the scorekeeper, Tisher has not only kept score for the varsity team, she also kept score for the girls varsity and freshman teams. Over the course of the many games, fouls and points, Tisher has come in contact with many people from different avenues of the sport. "I've been fortunate to meet many people, from referees, coaches and several players from area schools over the years," Tisher said. "I love what I do and would continue to do it here else as long as God is willing for me to do so," Tisher said. "I will always stay true to my school and River High School."

Janice and her husband, Terry, reside in Hannibal. They have two daughters and four grandchildren.

Gary Cochran

The goal of every official, in any sport, is to enforce the rules, keep the game under control and let it decide the outcome. Long-time basketball official Gary Cochran was able to demonstrate those at an early point in his career. It led to more game assignments and bigger assignments. Add up all of them and it leads to Cochran -- a Paden City High School graduate -- receiving the Robert Dawson Office at the annual Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Game. Cochran, who began officiating in 1964, just to help out and work some reserve games at Paden City. "I was doing a game and an official named Pell was doing the varsity game and asked me why I wasn't officiating at the varsity level," Cochran said. Having really never thought about it prior to that, Cochran decided to give it some thought. "Pell asked me to get into the Ohio Valley Basketball Board and do games through them, Cochran said. "I decided to listen to Pell's advice and, basically, the rest is history. He made his varsity basketball debut at Paden City High School, working with Bob Montgomery. "Wilson Murray was watching us at that game and he said he didn't need to watch the second half because we had the game under control and he let me go," Cochran said. "I received three more assignments the next week to go along with eight that I already had. I worked primarily in the Ohio Valley, Cochran spent 27 years as an official and earned several sectional titles at various tournaments along the way. He also was honored to work a West Virginia State Girls Basketball Tournament. "Working as many sectional and regional games as I did was the highlight of my career," Cochran said. After graduating from Paden City, Cochran was a member of the United States Navy, serving from 1958-1961. He worked as a Boilerman Technician in the oil shack on the USS Intrepid. During his free time, Cochran was playing basketball on the ship. He was named MVP when he led his team to a title at the Naples Christmas Tournament in 1961.

Gary and his wife Judith have been married for nearly 55 years. The couple has five children, 17 grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren.

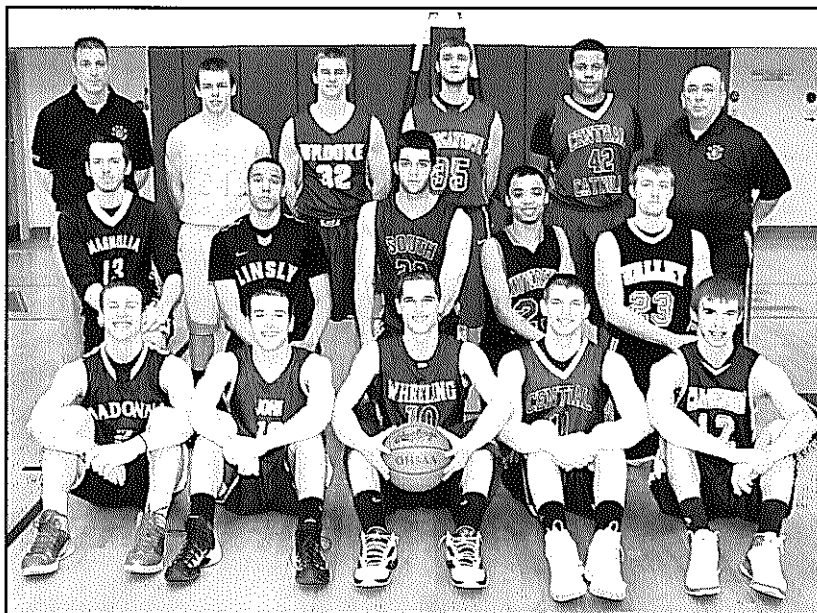
Nick Bedway

When you chronicle the events of an area for better than 50 years, you definitely have a feeling of ownership of the area. Such was the case for Nick Bedway. The retired Wheeling News Register sports editor covered OVAC sporting events since the 60s. During the course of his career, he covered all sports, but he had a special strong love for the game of basketball. His impact was felt on both sides of the river and read in the papers daily, but the relationships he built with the coaches and players far outweighed any individual achievements. Bedway's contribution to the OVAC and basketball, in particular, has led to yet another honor. A member of multiple Halls of Fames, including the OVAC's, Bedway is adding the Bob Burton Distinguished Service Award to his lengthy resume. The 1958 Wheeling Central graduate will be formally recognized at the upcoming Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Game on Sunday, April 6 at Ohio University Eastern in Athens, Ohio. "I am totally humbled by this honor because of whom it was named for," Bedway said. "Cochran is a person I have admired since the first time I met him." Bedway joined the staff of the Wheeling News-Register in 1960 and then later that year joined The Intelligencer staff as a sports writer. In 1967, he returned to the staff of the News-Register and four years later was promoted to assistant sports editor. He became the sports editor in 1995 and eventually ascended to executive sports editor in 2000, which he held until his retirement in 2005. "Basketball has been my passion since I first got into the newspaper business," Bedway said. "And I can't think of a better way to end the season than by giving these youngsters the opportunity to represent their school in this all-star game." In working with the OVAC, Bedway was the co-publicity director for the Rudy Mumley OVAC All-Star Charity Football Classic from 1972 until 1990. He also served as the press conference's statistician for football, basketball and baseball for more than 30 years. "I enjoyed my early years working with the all-star game, especially with Sam Mumley and the late Cal Pokas," Bedway said. A member of the aforementioned OVAC Hall of Fame, Bedway is also a member of the Wheeling Nailers and Ohio Valley papers 20K Halls of Fame. Bedway is also active in the community through his work with the Wheeling Sports Hall of Fame and the Wheeling Lions Club. Bedway remains active in the Ohio Valley sports scene as an announcer for WKKX Radio in Wheeling.

Nick has been married for more than 50 years to the former Judy Katona. The couple had four children.
