





RULES OF THE GAME

- 1. Each game will consist of two 20 minute halves.
- 2. Zone presses may be used but must end after first trap past half court.
- 3. Man-to man defense must be played in the normal attack area.
- 4. Each player <u>must make an appearance in both halves.</u> Attempts should be made to give all 15 players equal playing time.
- 5. Dunking will be permitted during the pre-game warm-up.
- 6. All overtime periods shall be three minutes in length.
- 7. Each player is allowed six (6) personal fouls before he is disqualified.
- 8. Teams will be permitted one full time-out and two :30 time-outs per game. No one & one until the last two minutes of game. Double bonus will be sho on the 10th foul at all times. One & one will be shot on the 7th foul only in last 2 minutes of game.

Four times during his career, he was named Dis oach of the Year and twice was honored as Eastern District coach of the year. Several times during er, Schwieterman coached the District 12 and OVAC All-Star Games and led the South squad in t hio North-South Game. He received the 2010 OHSAA Sportsmanship, Ethics and Integrity Awar bys state tournament. While the honors are nice, it was the relationships with players, fellow coach als and teachers that stick out the most for Schwieterman, who is currently a volunteer assistant coa e Shenandoah girls. Gary and his wife Judith have been married for nearly 55 years. The couple has five children, 17 grann and nine great-grandchildren.


Nick Bedway

In 1967, I eturned to the staff of the News-Register and four years later was promoted to assistant sports editor ne the sports editor in 1995 and eventually ascended to executive sports editor in 2000, which he held tirement in 2005. "Basketball has been my passion since I first got into the newspaper business," Bed "And I can't think of a better way to end the season than by giving these youngsters the opportunit sent their school in this all-star game." In working with the OVAC, Bedway was the co-publicity d the Rudy Mumley OVAC All-Star Charity Football Classic from 1972 until 1990. He also served as rence's statistician for football, basketball and baseball for more than 30 years. "I enjoyed my early y rking with the all-star game, especially with Sam Mumley and the late Cal Pokas," Bedway said. 
