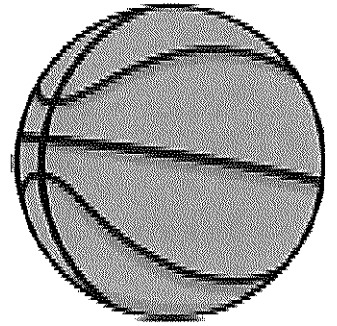

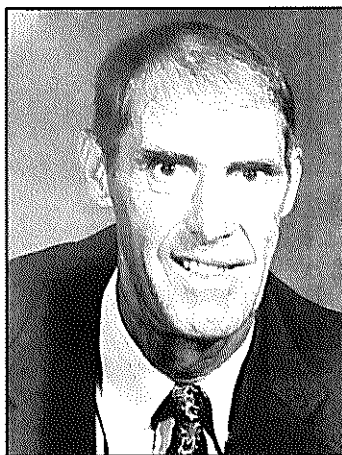

# ***SAMUEL A. MUMLEY***

## ***ALL STAR BASKETBALL CLASSIC***

### ***RULES OF THE GAME***

1. Each game will consist of two 20 minute halves.
2. Zone presses may be used but must end after first trap past half court.
3. Man-to man defense must be played in the normal attack area.
4. Each player must make an appearance in both halves. Attempts should be made to give all 15 players equal playing time.
5. Dunking will be permitted during the pre-game warm-up.
6. All overtime periods shall be three minutes in length.
7. Each player is allowed six (6) personal fouls before he is disqualified.
8. Teams will be permitted one full time-out and two :30 time-outs per game. No one & one until the last two minutes of game. Double bonus will be shot on the 10th foul at all times. One & one will be shot on the 7th foul only in last 2 minutes of game.

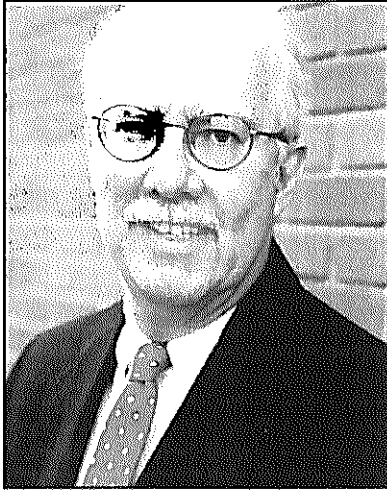

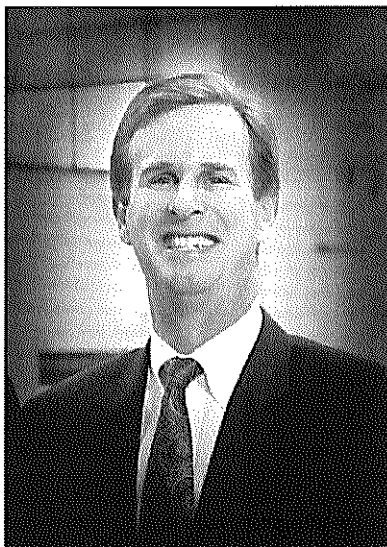

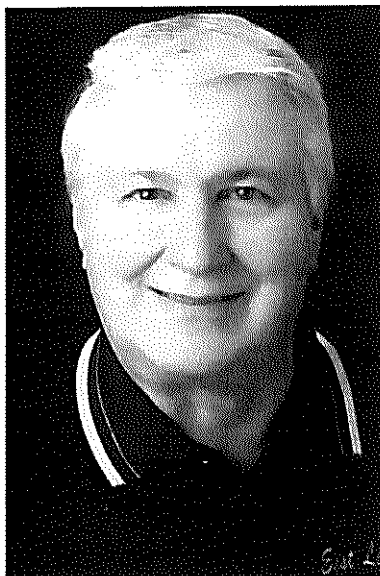

## Doug Huff

To say Doug Huff has seen his fair share of prep basketball games in the Ohio Valley wouldn't be justifying it. When you work for 48 years as a member of the sports media, there are plenty of opportunities to catch a few games. And Huff, who spent 46 years of his career with the Wheeling Intelligencer, has seen almost all of them, too. For his efforts and contributions to basketball in the Ohio Valley, Huff has been chosen for the Bob Burton Distinguished Service Award, which will be presented during today's Sam Mumley OVAC All-Star Charity Basketball Classic. "Any recognition from the people who know you is very meaningful," Huff said. "This award is extra special because of the name on it -- Bob Burton -- I've known since childhood and is a friend and the late Sam Mumley, for whom I have the highest respect."

During Huff's career, he worked as the Intelligencer Sports Editor for 32 years and 12 as a columnist. After returning to the Ohio Valley, the Magnolia High School graduate, worked at the Fairmont Times-Record and the Martintown Dominion-News. Huff, who originated the All-Valley teams in 1968 for boys basketball and has compiled numerous stats and leaders, both in the Ohio Valley and for the state of West Virginia. Huff has been a consistent attendee at the OVAC Game.

"After nearly four decades of (All-Star) games, I think there have been a couple of common themes that stand out. Those are high-scoring contests and several exciting games with overtimes and/or last-second shots." One of Huff's fondest memories of the OVAC Game was the 1978 contest when Ohio prevailed 101-91 in the A/AA game. The 1991 games also jump out with scores of 126-94 and 128-94.

"It's an event for the fans and a showcase for the athletes," Huff said. "It's about memories, memories for the kids taking part." Though he's retired, Huff continues to serve as the executive secretary and treasurer, of the West Virginia Sports Writers Association and is on the all-state boards for basketball and baseball. Huff, who is a member of the National High School Sports Hall of Fame and the West Virginia Sports Hall of Fame, was named West Virginia Sports Writer of the Year nine times.

Along with his work in newspapers, Huff authored a book and also wrote for Street & Smith's magazine from 1975-2008 and Parade magazine from 2001-10. He also worked for ESPN as the senior editor of espn.com Huff has remained active on the area sports scene through his work on five Hall of Fame boards. He's a member of the OVAC, City of Wheeling, West Virginia Sports Writers Association, West Virginia University and Magnolia High Alumni. He was also a charter member of the McDonald's All-American Basketball Game.

## Penn Kurtz

A lot of ingredients go into making a successful coach. Wheeling Central girls basketball coach Penn Kurtz knows the recipe well because he's been producing success at a high rate for the last 22 seasons. He's been fortunate to have a lot of success and it goes back to being able to put a great team around you. "That includes at home, school administrations, parents, assistant coaches and obviously players. I'm surrounded by a lot of really great people." Because of his success, which includes more than 40 state titles, two state titles, eight state runnerups and nine OVAC titles, Kurtz will be recognized during today's Samuel A. Mumley All-Star Basketball Classic with the Richard Saffield Girls Coach Award. Kurtz, the long-time basketball coach at Union Local, recently passed away, which adds to the meaning of the award. "Rich did a tremendous amount for basketball, the OVAC and the all-star game, so that adds a little meaning," Kurtz said. Kurtz and his Maroon Knights just wrapped up the season a few weeks ago by winning the West Virginia Class A state championship game to Huntington St. Joseph's. "We had some real seniors, but we were lucky to have a good group of underclassmen coming up," Kurtz said. "You find out anytime you're able to get to the state tournament and then into the finals. It's a pretty good year. A special thing is that each year, each group puts its own mark on things." Kurtz, who began his coaching in 1986 as an assistant, remained in that role until taking over the program prior to the 1993 season. In that time, 21 sectional and regional championships have followed. The Maroon Knights have only lost the semifinal round in Charleston six times under Kurtz' watch. "Anytime a coach gets an award, you have to think about who he's coaching," Kurtz said. "We've been fortunate to have a lot of young ladies willing to work every day on the game." On top of the players, Kurtz had high praise for his coaching staff, which includes Paul Kurtz, Bob Robinson and Suzie Dailer. "In my opinion, my assistant coaches are the best," Kurtz said. "Surrounding yourself with really great people is the key." This is by no means the first time Kurtz has been honored for coaching. He was the National Federation of High School Coaches West Virginia Coach of the Year in 2010 and he was a finalist for OVAC Coach of the Year in 2008. As for when he'll be able to retire from coaching, Kurtz plans on continuing for "as long as it's still fun." The length of his career is still to be determined," Kurtz said. "I hope we can be around a little while longer." Kurtz and his wife, Jean, have three children, Julia, Molly and Abby.

## John Edwards

John Edwards remembers the day well. Bill Owings, who was Oak Glen's Athletic Director at the time, approached him in 1975, needing a favor. It turned into more than just a favor. It turned into a permanent fixture. On that day on, Edwards has been a steady fixture at the scoring table at Oak Glen basketball game as the scoreboard operator. "I enjoy the job very much," Edwards said. "I enjoy being around the kids." Through his efforts, Edwards will receive the Thomas E. Rataiczak Timer and Scorekeeper Award at today's Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Classic. Since taking over the scoreboard duties, Edwards has expanded his role. He's the public address announcer for basketball. Taking it a step further, he still sings the National Anthem prior to Golden Bears' home games. "John does a great job," Oak Glen Athletic Director Penn Kurtz said. "He's very reliable and efficient. I would be lost without him." When Edwards accepted the original offer, it didn't take him long to learn that it would be for the long haul. "Our A.D. later explained that passing away was the only way to escape from the job," Edwards said. Edwards is a Weir High and West Liberty graduate. He taught social studies at Oak Glen for 30 years prior to retiring in 2006. Though he retired from the classroom, Edwards, who had a seven-year tenure as Golden Bears' Athletic Director, remains actively involved in Oak Glen sports. On top of running the scoreboard for hoops, he does so for volleyball and wrestling, too. He's also the public address announcer for those sports. According to Rujak, Edwards sings the National Anthem for every event he runs the scoreboard for.

## Nick Aloï

Nick Aloï's resume speaks for itself. The long-time East Liverpool basketball coach took a rich program and put it on the map statewide during his 20-year career. Because of his remarkable work with the Potters, Aloï has been chosen for the Earl Habberfield Boys Basketball Coaches Award, which was presented at today's annual Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Basketball Classic. Aloï accomplished one of the unthinkable dreams in Ohio prep basketball when he guided his Potters to the 1999 Division I State tournament. They fell in the state semifinals, 71-63, to Shaker Heights. All told, Aloï's career record is 1,326 wins and 326 losses, which is the most in East Liverpool history. His teams won nine sectional championships and played in five regional tournaments. Aloï's work didn't go unnoticed. He was named Associate Eastern District Coach of the Year seven times and named Division I State Coach of the Year twice (1998 and 1999). Since Aloï's retirement, he's been inducted to the OVAC Hall of Fame, the District V Coaches Association Hall of Fame and the East Liverpool High School Sports Hall of Fame.

## Jim Murray

Jim Murray saw a little bit of everything on the basketball court. What he saw -- and called -- was especially important since he spent 27 seasons wearing the stripes as an official. Whether it was at the prep or collegiate level, Murray was a highly respected official. He will be honored for his work and service on today during the Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Basketball Classic with the Robert Habberfield Basketball Officials Award.

"It is a very pleasant humble feeling in which I accept this honor to be able to join the previous officials who have preceded me with this award," Murray said. Murray entered the officiating realm of basketball in 1965. He has officiated in both Ohio and West Virginia.

During his prep officiating career, he worked in the West Virginia State Tournament eight times and had numerous sectional and regional assignments. He also worked as high as the regional level. Murray was assigned the West Virginia Catholic Tournament title game twice.

As a college official, Murray worked in the West Virginia Intercollegiate Conference and worked the title game 12 times. He climbed into the Division I ranks, too.

He worked in the Atlantic 10 for six years and worked its conference championship game twice. He worked in the Southern Conference for three seasons. On top of his conference tournament duties, he worked twice in the National Invitation Tournament and officiated the NAIA Tournament national final.

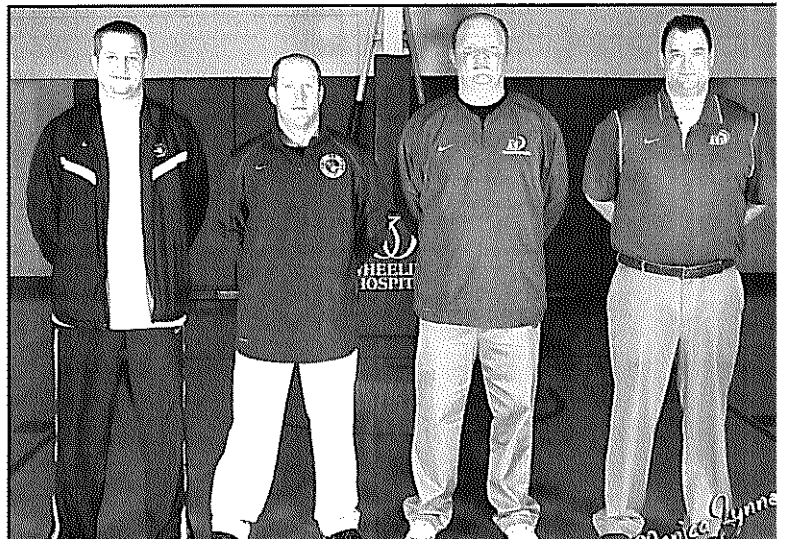
Murray contributed to officiating by serving as an observer for the OVAC, WVIAC and Atlantic 10. He's a member of the International Association of Approved Basketball Officials and a honorary member of the Ohio Valley Board of Approved Basketball Officials.

"I would like to thank the OVAC, which puts in long, tireless hours to give the young men and women of our valley the opportunity to play and be recognized," Murray said. "One thing I have remembered was something Sam Mumley told me, 'Kids, kids, kids ... they are our future.'"
