## A Word of Welcome to All...



On behalf of the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference it is my privilege to welcome you to the 62nd Annual OVAC "Ron Mauck" Wrestling Championships.

No doubt you will leave this tournament with memories that will last a lifetime. During these three days of intense competitions let's not lose sight that one of the missions of interscholastic athletics is to provide opportunities for young people that will enhance their educational experience. We hope student-athletes are playing because they are having fun but there are lifelong lessons to be learned in athletic participation such as sportsmanship, citizenship, hard work, dedication, leadership and teamwork.

The past 61 years have brought many memorable milestones to OVAC Wrestling. Allow me to mention a few.

During the spring of 1970, we lost a phenomenal wrestler, David Bierkorte, to an untimely accident. Because of his athletic prowess, the Wheeling Central High School Booster's Club initiated the "David Bierkorte Award" for the outstanding wrestler in 1971.

In 1979 Frank Rodriguez the Wheeling Civic Center Manager, had a great deal of respect for those involved with OVAC wrestling, and was instrumental in OVAC wrestling finding a home at WesBanco Arena. Currently we are blessed with Dennis Magruder, who has given us the same positive support, along with the entire WesBanco Arena staff.

In 1980, OVAC wrestling initiated the first "George Kovalick Scholarship". Two years later Bob and Dolores Burke lost their son Danny, a Wheeling Park wrestler, in a tragic accident. Out of their love for him the "Daniel M. Burke Wrestling Scholarship" was initiated in 1983. In 1996 we lost a fantastic wrestling enthusiast from Marshall County affectionately named "Dead Eye". His devoted family established the "James H. Morris Sportsmanship Scholarship" in 1997, out of his love for the mat sport. In 1999, East Liverpool's two-time OVAC Champ and Hercules Award winner, Matt Salsberry, was lost in a tragic auto accident. In 2003, "Friends in Memory of Matt Salsberry" established an annual academic/wrestling scholarship. In 2003, Lucas "Luke" Sedgmer, a two-time OVAC Wrestling Champion from Cadiz High School tragically lost his life in an auto accident. In 2005, a committee in his community established The Lucas D. Sedgmer Memorial Scholarship. Currently \$5000.00 annually is awarded to five (5) deserving wrestlers to continue their educations. These five (5) permanently installed scholarship funds over the years have afforded deserving OVAC wrestlers over \$114,000 in college scholarships.

Without every the efforts of the workers, coaches, officials and wrestlers the tournament would not be the great event it is! These are the people who make the OVAC "Ron Mauck" Wrestling Tournaments the best in the nation. They deserve a great "Thank You!"

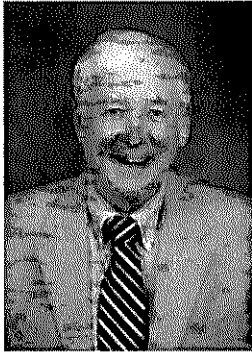

## THE RON MAUCK OVAC WRESTLING CHAMPIONSHIPS

### *"His Story"*



Educator, coach, administrator, and community leader – Ron Mauck has been the tournament director of the OVAC Wrestling Championships since 1979. Due to his total devotion to the event, it was renamed the Ron Mauck OVAC Wrestling Championships in 2006.

A protégé of the late, legendary George Kovalick, Ron Mauck also established the conference's dual meet championship standings in 1971 and directed five WV State Tournaments at the Wheeling Civic Center (now WesBanco Arena). On three separate occasions, he served as a volunteer on the staff for NAIA and NCAA Division II championships (hosted by West Liberty State College) held in Wheeling.

In addition to his mat sport duties for the conference, Mauck was a long-time member of the Rudy Mumley OVAC All-Star Football Classic. He was assistant game director and later served as game director from 1993 through 1998.

A Bridgeport High School and West Liberty State College (WLSC), who earned his master's in safety education, Ron Mauck began his teaching and coaching career in 1965 at Follansbee High School where he started the school's varsity wrestling program and coached the school's only individual state champion (Lou Daly). While at Follansbee, Mauck coached John Craig, a first-time wrestler as a senior in 1965, who later became an All-American at WLSC and developed into one of the most successful mat mentors in the Ohio Valley.

When the consolidated Brooke High School opened in 1968, Ron Mauck was named to coach the wrestling team where he tutored the Bruin's first WV Wrestling State Champion – Jim Suddoth. Before retiring after a 34-year career in education,

Mauck served as Brooke's Director of Driver Education Department. He also served as the school's Physical Plant Director, Assistant Athletic Director and Athletic Director. In fact, he was named the WV Athletic Director of the Year (1995) and was a past president of the WV Safety Association. He also served as the president of the Bridgeport High School Alumni Association. Promoting education in Ohio County, Mauck later served as president of the Warwood Junior High School Athletic Association.

Over the years, Ron Mauck received many, many accolades. In 1985, he received the prestigious OVAC Mr. Mat Award. He was also named the WV Wrestling Coaches Man of the Year in 1987 and *Wrestling USA Magazine's* WV State Man of the Year in 2013.

Mauck also received recognition awards from the Upper Ohio Valley Dapper Dan Club (1985 and 1997). He was twice named the Warwood Lions' Club Citizen of the Year, winner of the H.V. Corcoran, Sr. Award (2001) and was inducted into the Brooke County Wall of Fame (2006).

The OVAC Conference cannot thank Mr. Ron Mauck enough for his decades of dedication to the athletes and students of the Ohio Valley.

Now you know Ron Mauck's story – a humble man who has lived a "life of service" to his community, family, and God.

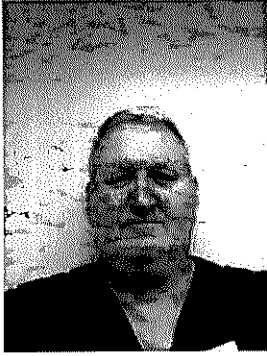

A 1971 graduate of Martins Ferry High School, Todd began his career as a student athletic trainer under the late Art "Bud" Simpson.

His summers were spent working for the Pittsburgh Pirate Minor League Baseball organization in Bradenton, Florida. He attended the University of Arizona and obtained a Master's Degree in Sports Medicine and Athletic Training. 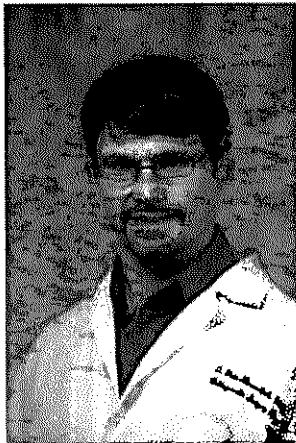

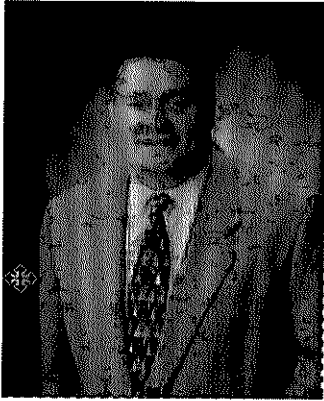

After enlisting in the military, Dr. Braunlich competed on the U.S. Army's wrestling team. He also played in European Football League. Furthermore, Dr. Braunlich coached wrestling in various European high schools prior to being deployed to combat zones in Bosnia, Iraq, and Afghanistan.

## Doctor Mike Kovalick



Mike Kovalick (Bellaire HS, Class of 1975) has been a fixture at the Ron Mauck OVAC Wrestling Championships for over 20 years as the head of the medical team.

Mike, the son of legendary coach George Kovalick, has the distinction of being a state champion in both West Virginia and Ohio.

The powerful wrestler was near-perfect his final two years on the mats. He won 27 out of 28 matches as a junior before running the table in all 28 bouts as a senior. He was an OVAC champion both winters after placing 5<sup>th</sup> as a sophomore.

He finished his illustrious scholastic wrestling career with a stellar 64-3-2 record.

Kovalick continued his mat success at the collegiate Division I level. He wrestled for Bobby Douglas at Arizona State University. He finished as a PAC-10 runner-up in his senior season.

The original award was in the amount of \$1,000 however in 2006, was increased to \$2,500 and is to be applied to college expenses. As each recipient is added to the list, it reads like a veritable "Who's Who Among Outstanding Young Men in the Upper Ohio Valley". It is our fond hope that the accomplishments of each successive recipient serves to honor and perpetuate Danny's memory in a manner fulfilling the wishes of his parents.

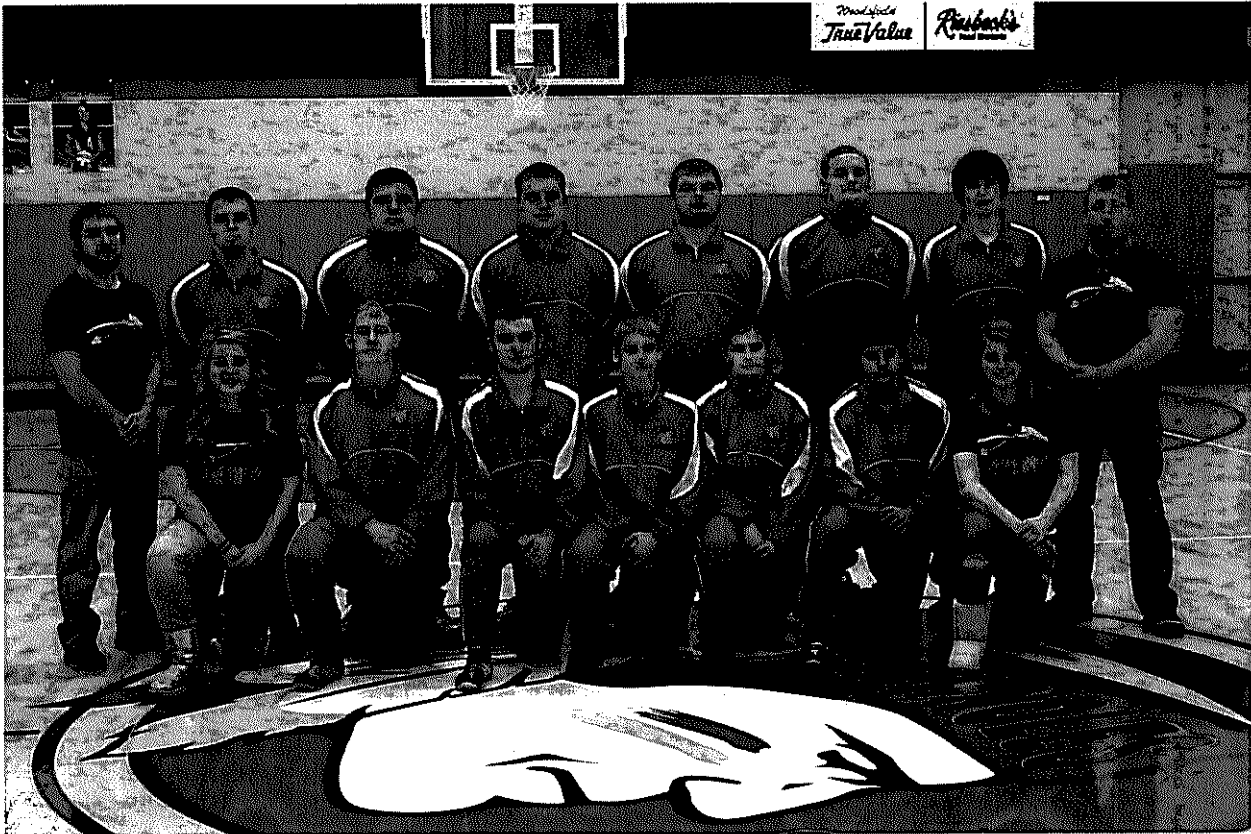

# MATTHEW SALSBERY SCHOLARSHIP

Within minutes after leaving for home from Ohio Northern University, where they had all just undergone freshman orientation, Matt Salsberry; his girlfriend, Emily Bickerton; and his best friend, Dan Aldrich, fell victim to tragedy. An inattentive and irresponsible teenage driver, in a moment of senseless exhilaration took the lives of all three and brought emotional devastation to the families and school community of a magnitude which can only be described as traumatizing and from which we are still laboring to recover.

Matt Salsberry had a lust for life that dictated success. The commitment and enthusiasm which he brought to the wrestling mat, the playing field, the stage and classroom, motivated and inspired teammates, classmates and fans. He was a humble winner and a gracious loser, who gained the respect of all who came to know him.

If any single incident defined his commitment and enthusiasm for whatever the project might be, surely it had to be his humorous show stealing portrayal of "Earthquake" McGoon in the school musical "Lil Abner".

Matt was a two-time OVAC champion and winner of the "Mr. Hercules Award" in '99, by pinning his way to the 215# championship in a cumulative time of less than a single match. He was 4<sup>th</sup> in the State of Ohio while compiling 124 wins. He was All-State in football for three years and started in 32 consecutive games. He earned 11 varsity letters, was River Valley League discus champion, served as Junior Class President and Senior Class Vice President, while maintaining a 3.5 GPA as a member of NH.

"Friends in Memory of Matts Salsberry" having a desire to perpetuate the positive impact of his young life, have deemed it a fitting and proper tribute to establish a \$1,000 scholarship to be considered annually and awarded to an OVAC wrestler who earned a varsity letter in one additional sport while likewise maintaining a 3.5 GPA.

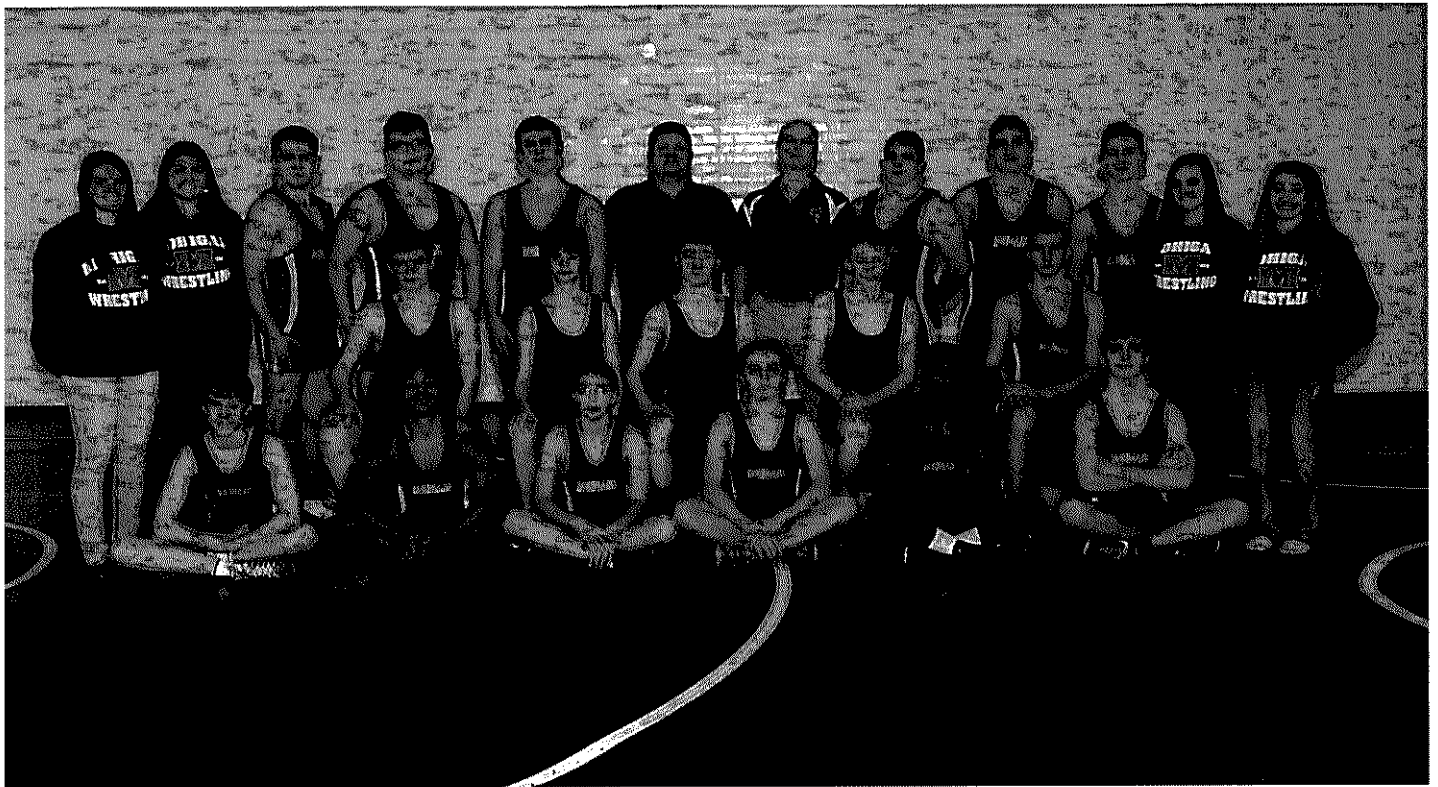

Tragically, he lost his life on Friday, May 9, 2003, in a head-on auto collision.

He had worked as a summer employee with the Harrison County Highway Department and served as an assistant wrestling coach at Wheeling Park High School.

He had finished school that very day and was to have graduated from West Liberty State College shortly thereafter.

The fulfillment of his dream would have been to teach and coach wrestling.

He was a member of New Athens Volunteer Fire Department and attended the United Methodist Church in New Athens.

A committee was established to provide two scholarships to perpetuate and honor Luke in memoriam. One scholarship is presented to a graduate of Harrison Central High School and the other to an OVAC member school wrestler.

The criteria for selection as a recipient are the qualities exhibited by Luke during his brief, but dynamic existence. They are academic achievement, athletic accomplishments and character.

Luke was greatly admired, widely respected and dearly loved by all who came to know him. It is our fond hope that by honoring him in this fashion, we will not only be perpetuation his memory, but more over aiding others in pursuit of their dreams.

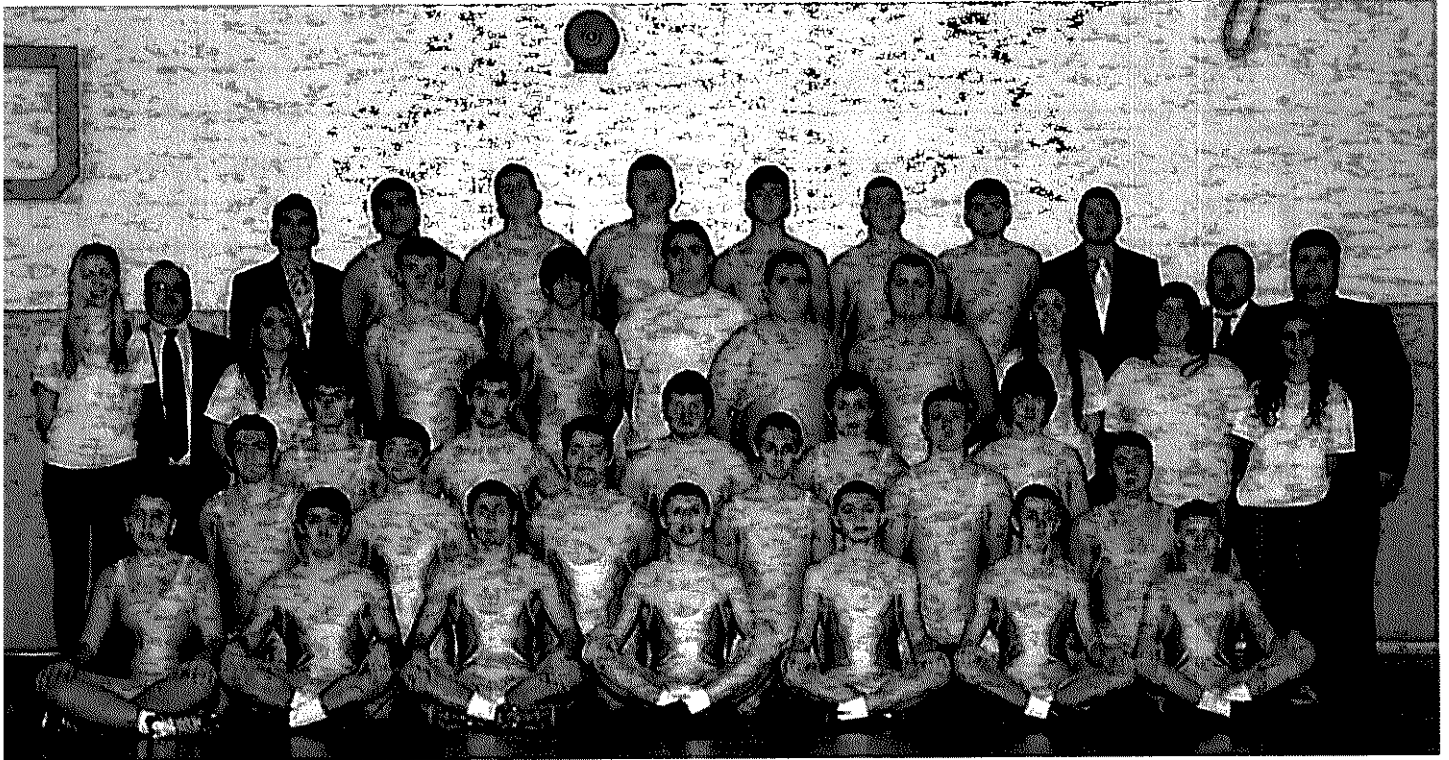

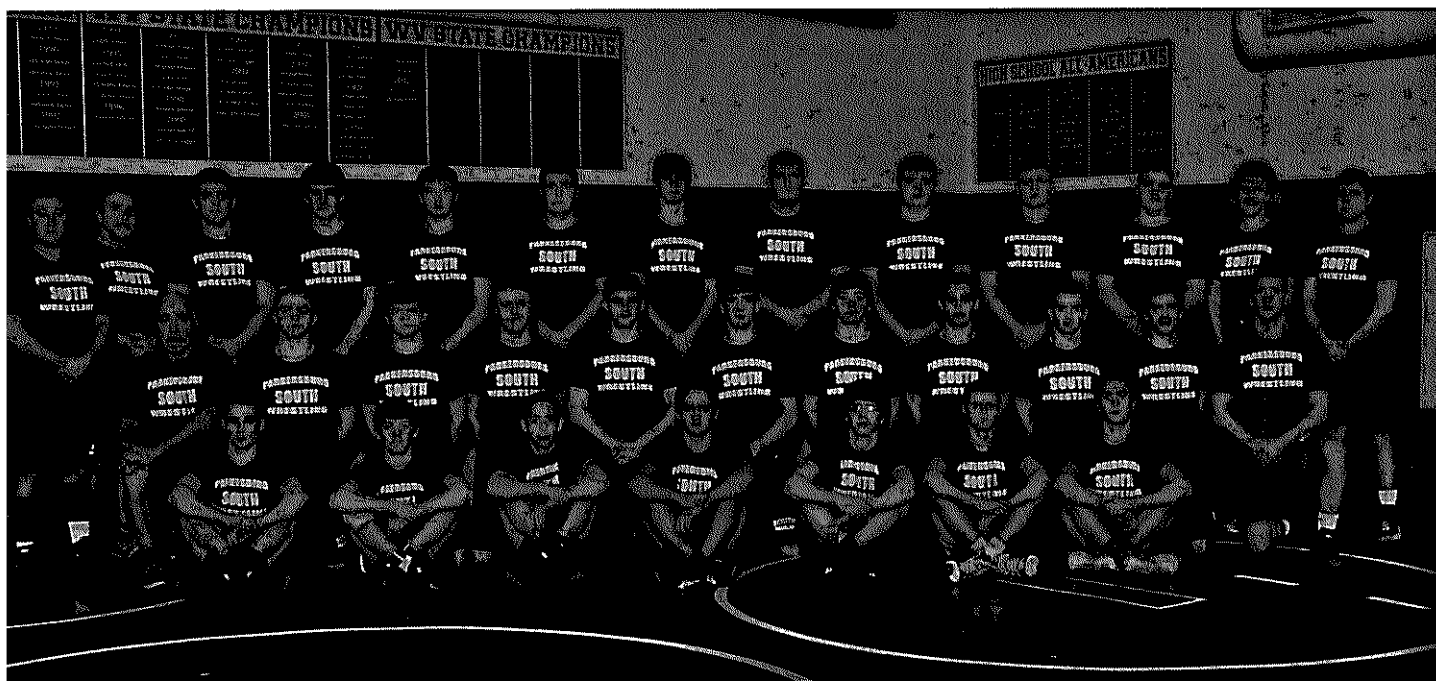

Teacher exceptional...competitive coach...gracious mentor...visionary, endowed with boundless energy and enthusiasm.

His accomplishments are legendary...his influence unparalleled.

A man whose profound influence on coaches and athletes is a legacy which will continue to have an impact on generations yet to come.

Standing as tangible proof of all that he epitomized is his enshrinement in four separate and distinct Athletic Halls of Fame; Kent State University, West Liberty State College, Ohio Wrestling Coaches Association and Ohio High School Athletic Directors Association.

In 1980, a scholarship was established to honor Coach Kovalick by the OVAC Wrestling Coaches Association. It is presented annually to a college-bound scholar/wrestler.

During opening ceremonies of the 1985 OVAC Wrestling Tournament, a bronze plaque was unveiled and now hangs in the lobby of the WesBanco Arena, inscribed in fitting tribute it reads;

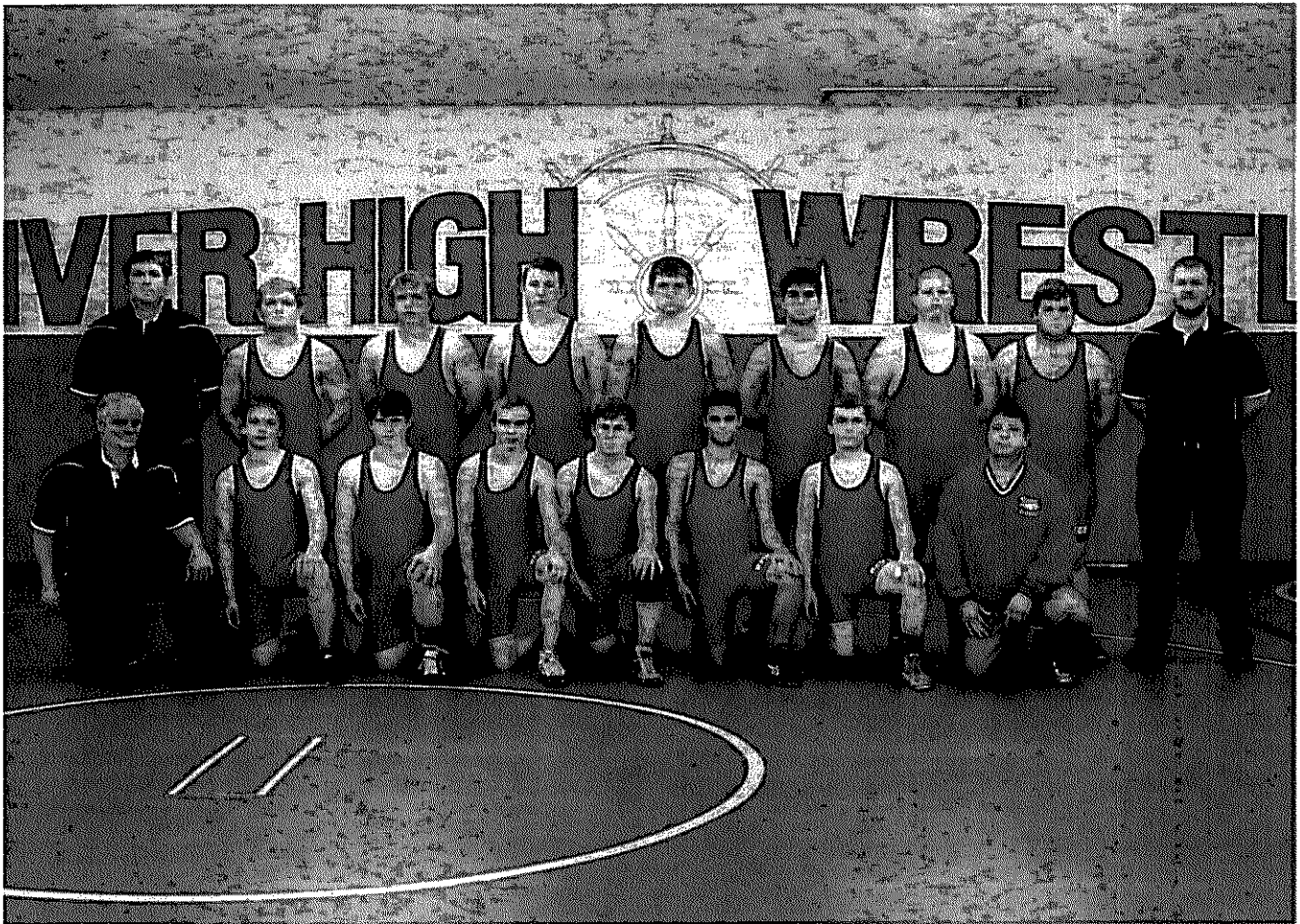

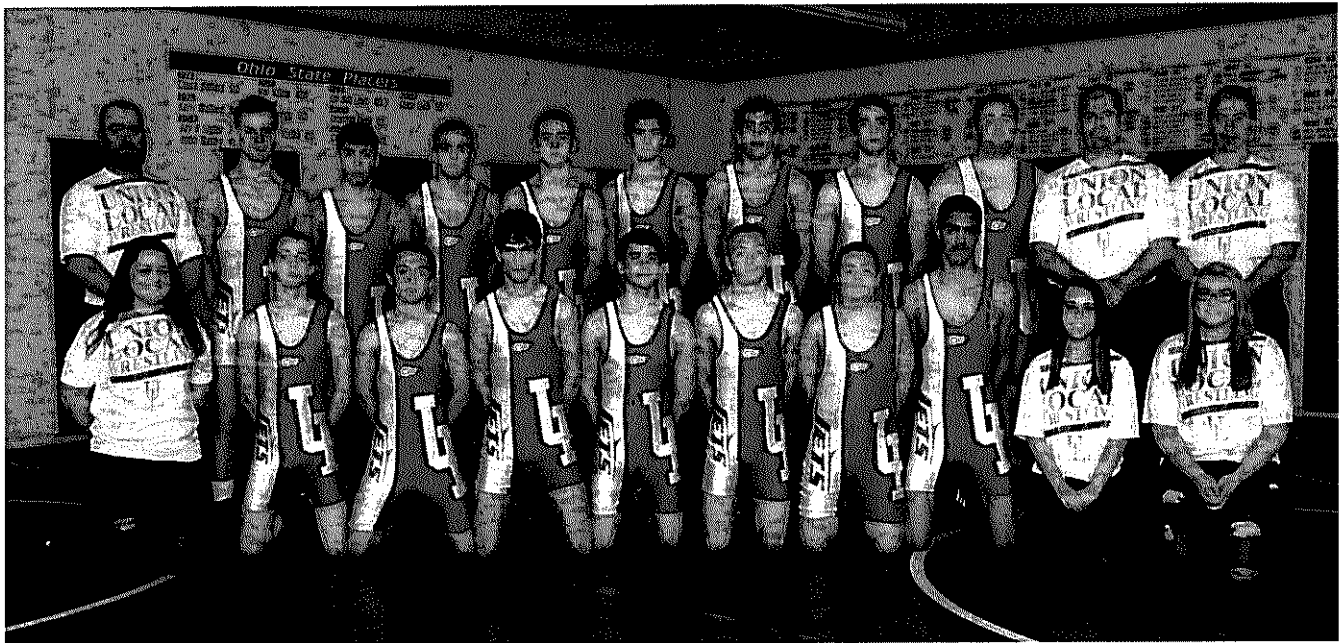
### **STEUBENVILLE CATHOLIC CENTRAL COACH AARON HENRY**
