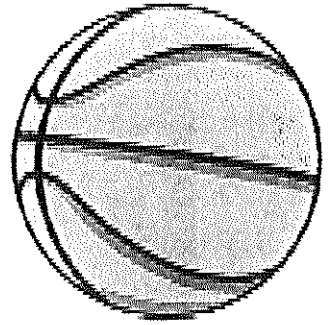

RULES OF THE GAME

1. Each game will consist of two 20 minute halves.
2. Zone presses may be used but must end after first trap past half court.
3. Man-to man defense must be played in the normal attack area.
4. Each player must make an appearance in both halves. Attempts should be made to give all 15 players equal playing time.
5. Dunking will be permitted during the pre-game warm-up.
6. All overtime periods shall be three minutes in length.
7. Each player is allowed six (6) personal fouls before he is disqualified.
8. Teams will be permitted one full time-out and two :30 time-outs per game. No one & one until the last two minutes of game. Double bonus will be shot on the 10th foul at all times. One & one will be shot on the 7th foul only in last 2 minutes of game.

Paul Vargo

The Ohio Valley has produced several talented officials in numerous sports over the years. However, have gone on to garner the acclaim -- and assignments -- that Paul Vargo has during his career.

The Linsly School graduate started his career working both basketball and football in the Cuyahoga Valley Athletic Conference and has since gone on to officiate in both sports at the highest levels of college football. For his service and accomplishments, Vargo will receive the Robert Dawson Officials Award at the Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Game. Vargo started blowing the whistle basically just out of high school working as a basketball official starting in 1975. He worked high school games in the OVAC for the next five years. He was chosen to work a West Virginia Class AAA state championship during his prep career. Five years into his officiating career, Vargo broke into the collegiate ranks. He worked in the West Virginia Conference from 1980-2006 and earned tournament assignments in 20 of those seasons. He didn't work at the Division II level. He has worked in the Big East, Southern and Atlantic 10 Conference.

Vargo started officiating football in 1979 and worked in the area for 10 years. He started in the collegiate level, working in the WVIAC. He got into the Southern Conference in 1989 and drew a Big East assignment in 2002. He worked with that league until its demise. He is still active in the Atlantic Coast Conference. He has worked the Division II National Championship game, three NAIA and FCS Playoff games. He's also worked five bowl games and last November he was assigned the Notre Dame at Stanford game. He also worked Florida State at Clemson last season.

Paul is currently the Director of Risk Management and Insurance in Monaca, Pa.

Larry Weekley

The Valley girls basketball program is very well respected around the area and state of West Virginia. The main reasons for that is the work of long-time head coach Larry Weekley. Weekley, who spent 15 years as the Lumberjills head coach, is being honored today as the recipient of the Richard Saffield Gungl honoree during the Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Game. In his time at the helm, Weekley won 298 games, while losing 298. He led his team to an OVAC championship in 1994. Along with the OVAC title, they won six Mason-Dixon Championships (1988, 1989, 2003, 2004, 2005 and 2006). The Lumberjills made eight appearances in the regional during Weekley's reign as head coach. They won four consecutive titles from 2003-2006. Not only did his teams get it done on the court, but they got it done with class. The Valley was named the winner of the Ohio Valley Sportsmanship Award. It claimed the award in both 2003 and 2007.

Weekley's teams' success led to accolades for the himself, too. He was recognized as WVSSAC National Coach of the Year in 1989, 2000 and 2005. Along with coaching the girls, Weekley also spent six years as the boys head coach.

Larry, who retired from teaching after 38 years, resides in New Martinsville with his wife, Donna. They have five children and 10 grandchildren.

Bob Weaver

Bob Weaver has been a fixture behind his barber shop chair in Bridgeport since 1971. He's been sitting at the Bridgeport High School gymnasium scorer's table since 1988, running the clock and score for boys and girls basketball games. Those years of dedicated service have earned him the Thomas Iczak Timer/Scorekeeper Award at today's Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Basketball Game. Weaver graduated from Bridgeport in 1962 and the Wheeling Barber College in 1963. He worked in Wheeling from 1963 until he opened his own shop. In 1995, he re-located to his current location in Bridgeport, which is located basically across the street from Perkins Field. Along with his work with the Bridgeport basketball program, Weaver is active with the school as a member of the alumni board of trustees, serves on the school's athletic hall/wall of fame selection committee and the superintendent's advisory board.

A member of the St. Paul Lutheran Church, Weaver has served as the congregation president, Elders' representative and Sunday School Superintendent and Treasurer. He also serves the village of Brookside as a trustee since 2008.

Bob and his wife, Cynthia, have been married since 1967. They have two children, David (Bridgeport Class of 1986) and Dr. Denise Stitt (Bridgeport Class of 1990). The couple has three grandchildren.

Dan Petri

Basketball has been in Dan Petri's blood since an early age. The long-time high school and college coach became hooked on roundball early, playing for coaches Tom Ackerman and Edgar Martin. Petri was recognized for his career achievements, which include more than 300 victories, during today's Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Game with the Earl Habberfield Boys Coach Honor.

Petri graduated from Triadelphia High School in 1964. He entered West Liberty State College and played three years of basketball. Immediately upon his graduation, Petri entered the coaching profession. He coached the final season at Wellsburg High School before it entered into consolidation to form Brooke. He was an assistant coach with the Bruins for seven years and then accepted the head coaching post for three. All told, he was in Brooke County from 1969-1980.

After his stint at Brooke, Petri accepted the job at Linsly where he spent 11 seasons on the bench. From there, he entered the collegiate ranks. He was hired at West Liberty State College and worked there for 15 years. After the 1996 season, Petri was named West Virginia Conference Coach of the Year. "Teaching and coaching has been my life's work," Petri said. "Throughout the years, I had the pleasure of working with and coaching young men. I am extremely honored to be chosen for this award."

Currently, Petri splits time between his home in Wheeling and Stuart, Fla. Dan and his wife Darlene have two sons -- Jeff and Justin. Jeff resides in Wheeling and Justin makes his home in Norfolk. The couple has three grandchildren, Tanner, Jenna and Christopher.

Bill Van Horne

BILL VAN HORNE, quite simply, was an icon in Ohio Valley sports media. The long-time sports editor of The Times Leader (25 years) and Wheeling News Register (28 years) spent basically his adult life covering and writing about area athletes and their achievements on and off the court. For his efforts, Van Horne, who died in June of 1995, has been chosen as the recipient of the Bob Burton Distinguished Service Award. His widow, Gladys, and stepson, Todd Fullerton, are expected to accept the award during today's Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Basketball Game.

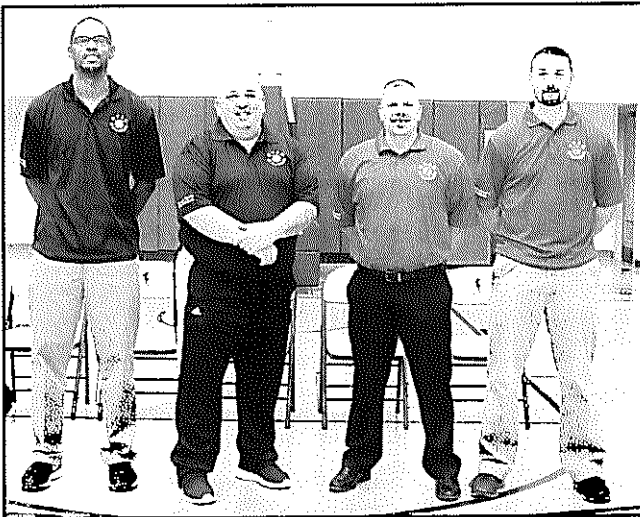
Van Horne graduated from Martins Ferry High School in 1939 and attended a six-week college journalism at Northwestern University. He got his start in Ohio Valley journalism when The Times Leader sports editor at the time was drafted for World War II in 1941. From there, there was no looking back for Van Horne. He spent the next 25 years in that position before accepting the same position at the Wheeling News Register. He maintained that position for 29 years.

During his career, he covered the likes of Bill Mazerowski, John Havlicek, Phil Niekro, Joe Niekro, Lou Groza, Alex Groza and Bobby Douglas, just to name a few. Van Horne's work within the OVAC has often been seen as a major contributor to the success of sports such as wrestling, track and field and basketball. He was the second recipient of the coveted Mr. Mat Award, which is presented during the OVAC Wrestling Tournament. He also received the Calvin Giffin Memorial Track Award.

Preps weren't his only passion. Ohio Valley sports, in general, were part of Van Horne's past. He covered events such as the Ogden Newspapers Half Marathon in its infancy stages. He also covered the West Virginia Tennis Open and the Wheeling LPGA Classic, which is no longer held.

Van Horne was a charter member of the OVAC Hall of Fame. That is one of five halls of fame that enshrine him.

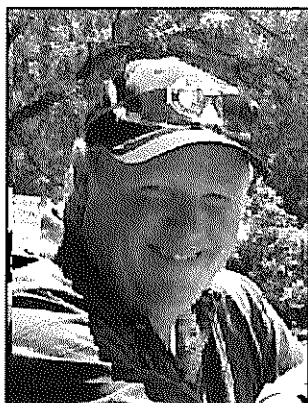


The 2016 OVAC Boys Coaches are L-R:

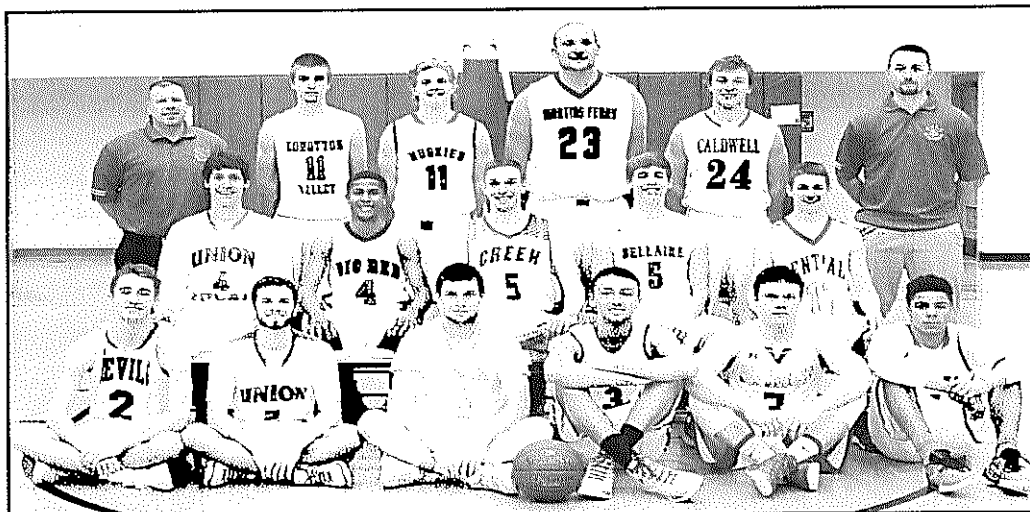
