
RULES OF THE GAME

- 1. Each game will consist of two 20 minute halves.
- 2. Zone presses may be used but must end after first trap past half court.
- 3. Man-to man defense must be played in the normal attack area.
- 4. Each player <u>must make an appearance in both halves</u>. Attempts should be made to give all 15 players equal playing time.
- 5. Dunking will be permitted during the pre-game warm-up.
- 6. All overtime periods shall be three minutes in length.
- 7. Each player is allowed six (6) personal fouls before he is disqualified.
- 8. Teams will be permitted one full time-out and two :30 time-outs per game. No one & one until the last two minutes of game. Double bonus will be shot on the 10th foul at all times. One & one will be shot on the 7th foul only in last 2 minutes of game.







Nat Sabatino

Basketball was simply a family affair for the Sabatino's.

Before Jeff was a highly successful coach at Martins Ferry, his father, Irwin, was involved in the sport in many different capacities. In the Ohio Valley, however, Irwin, who was called "Nat," was most known as an official, which led to him being chosen for the Robert Dawson Officials Award. Nat Sabatino officiated from 1956 until the time of his death in 1978.

Before he got into officiating, Nat Sabatino was a standout player at Wheeling Central. He helped guide the Maroon Knights to four state championships. They also won the OVAC title in each of those seasons. After high school, Nat was involved with several local travelling semi-pro basketball teams during the 1950s and 60s as a player and coach. Nat married the former Alberta Albertine. The couple had one son, Jeff. Nat never met his two grandchildren, Tony and Kayla.

Jeff Sabatino

Jeff Sabatino and Martins Ferry basketball became a fixture.

That's what happens when you couple success and longevity. Sabatino served as the head coach at his alma mater from 1992 until 2016, experiencing all sorts of success. Add all of that up and it equates to Sabatino being named the recipient of the Earl Haberfield Boys Basketball Coach Award. During the course of his tenure, Sabatino guided the Purple Riders to astounding 350 victories, 13 sectional titles, four district titles and three OVAC titles. He was also chosen to coach in the Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Game six times. Prior to returning to Ferry, Sabatino spent one season as the head coach at Cadiz High School. He cut his coaching teeth at Meadowbrook High School as an assistant basketball, football and track coach. After a stint with the Colts, which last two seasons, Sabatino accepted a position at Bellaire, which he held for 12 years. He worked as an assistant basketball, football and track coach there, too.

Sabatino owns a bachelor's degree from West Liberty and earned his master's degree in education from Walden University. Jeff and his wife, Susan, have two children – Tony and Kayla.

Bob Phillips

Beallsville's athletic tradition is rich in all sports.

One of the key pieces in helping to build the girls' basketball tradition is long-time head coach Bob Phillips, who guided the Lady Blue Devils for 13 seasons. A part of unquestioned success during his stint, Phillips has been named the recipient of the Richard Saffield Girls Basketball Coach Award. Phillips was on the Blue Devils' sidelines from 1983 until 1996, winning OVAC and PVC titles along the way, while racking up more than 100 wins. During his career, he was named District 12 Coach of the Year and received several OVAC and district awards for coaching and sportsmanship. His teams' sportsmanship was fully recognized when he was named the winner of the OHSAA's Award for for Ethics, Integrity and Sportsmanship.

Bob and his wife, Barb, have been married for 39 years. They are the parents of three children, Heidi Meade, Matthew (Danielle) Phillips and Sarah (Trey) Schmidt. The couple has five grandchildren and are expecting their sixth in May.

Jim Welsh

Jim Welsh has been a fixture at the scoring table for Bishop Donahue basketball games for basically his entire adult life. Welsh – a life-long Marshall Countian – has been named the recipient of the Thomas E. Rataiczak Timer/Scorekeeper Award.

A 1953 graduate of Central Catholic High School, Welsh has been involved with Bishop Donahue High School, basically from the ground up. He was working for the Byrum Construction Company for two summers while that company built Donahue in McMechen. Since the school's opening, Welsh has worn many hats for the Bishops. He has served on the school's athletic board, worked as a ticket taker, fund raiser, worked on the chain gang for football, ran the clock at basketball and has done the boys and girls varsity scorebooks for several years.

Jim and his wife, Rosemary, have been married for 55 years. They have eight children and 13 grandchildren. All eight of the Welsh's sons graduated from Bishop Donahue. Their sons names are Kevin, David, John, Dan, Tom, Chris, Jeff and Brendan.

Dave Gaudino

Dave Gaudino has two passions ... helping kids and basketball.

Thus, the long-time Marshall County educator, coach and hoop junkie has certainly done his fair share to help promote and grow the game to area youths. For those reasons, Gaudino has been chosen as the recipient of the Bob Burton Distinguished Service Award. Gaudino has taught in the Marshall County School system for nearly 40 years. He's worked at Union Junior High (1977-82), John Marshall High School (1982-2007) and he currently serves the county as a career counselor. During those stops, he's been able to implement basketball in some capacity. He coached six years at Union and spent 12 seasons as a volunteer with the Monarchs, including the 1982 season in which JM claimed the West Virginia AAA state title.

Away from Marshall County Schools, he's also done his part in helping to promote and grow the game. He's spent 34 years as the director of the West Virginia Coaches Association Girls Basketball Poll and has oversaw the West Virginia Players to Watch Poll since he founded it 33 years ago. Gaudino also oversees the Marshall County AAU Basketball Club as well as the Marshall County Dribble Team. He's done those for 27 and 18 years, respectively. According to Gaudino, he's coached more than 2,100 games. The basketball club sponsors four to seven teams per season in grades 4-8.

Along with basketball, Gaudino has coached golf and has been active in several school groups, including Faculty Senate, John Marshall Scholarship Trust Fund, math day and the West Virginia Math League. He's also served as a track and cross country official.
