




There are many words to describe the life of Rudolph Mumley, but perhaps the most appropriate would be service.

For most of his 80-plus years, Mumley, known as "Rudy" to his legion of friends, worked on behalf of many causes. None were more important to him than the youth of the Ohio Valley.

It is befitting that the game which fans are witnessing this evening is named in his honor. If it hadn't been for Rudy's willingness to step forward, the Ohio-West Virginia All-Star Game would not have existed the last 28 years, and it now appears to be a fixture that will carry it well into the next millennium.

The game's history goes back to the early 1940s and, for many years after that, it was sponsored by booster club associations from Eastern Ohio and the West Virginia northern panhandle.

However, the game could not receive NCAA sanction and consequently was held during the spring to allow players who had received scholarships to NCAA schools an opportunity to participate.

When it became apparent that the booster club organizations could no longer sponsor the game, it ceased to exist. An idea was presented to Sam A. Mumley Sr. that the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference® could assume sponsorship of the game and apply for NCAA sanction.

One of the requirements toward receiving NCAA sanction was that only 60 percent of game proceeds could be spent to cover expenses and the other 40 percent had to be used for charitable purposes.

Once the game received sanction, the OVAC® had another problem. It was experiencing financial problems and did not have the resources to provide "seed" money that would be needed to purchase uniforms, pay for training camp and other start-up expenses such as insurance.

Sam Mumley, who was the executive secretary of the OVAC®, appealed to his uncle, Rudy, to provide the financial help. The story has become legend on how Rudy, a bachelor who lived with his beloved sister, Lillian, in the Warwood area of Wheeling, mortgaged their home to receive a loan. The rest, as the saying goes, is history.

There was more adversity to overcome for this inaugural OVAC® venture. The Ohio Valley experienced damaging floods during June of 1972. Wheeling Stadium sustained considerable damage and the facility would not be available for the early August game.

Sam Mumley called his longtime friend, the late Edmund Joseph, who was then athletic director at Martins Ferry High School and asked if the OVAC® could use Ferry Stadium. Once Joseph took the request to school officials and received permission, the game was finally on.

However, on the day of the game, the area was hit hard by a rainstorm. More adversity. By this time, you could not fault Rudy Mumley, who agreed to serve as game director, if he was feeling a bit jinxed. Several hours before kickoff was scheduled, the rain stopped and the sun came out. It turned into a beautiful evening, and the game went off like clockwork before a capacity audience.

The OVAC® was in business as far as renewal of the Ohio-West Virginia midsummer classic was concerned.

However, that's not the end of the story. Over the next two decades-plus that Rudy Mumley served as game director, he made numerous improvements to the game. He turned it from just an all-star game into an extravaganza.

He took the all-star gridders to camp at West Liberty State College, his alma mater, and a place where he had long-standing ties. Each year, Mumley added activities for the players to help them pass the time and provide some relief from the rigors of training camp.

He enlisted the help of the Osiris Shrine and this group gave the game a more meaningful

purpose as it would eventually gain the lion's share of the charity proceeds.

Through his good friend, the late George Strager, another mid-week event, "An Evening With the Stars," was initiated and handled with impeccable care by two other longtime friends, Mike Young and Pete Cuffaro.

From the time the OVAC® assumed sponsorship of the game, Mumley brought back the Stone & Thomas "Queen of Queens" Pageant which had been a part of the All-Star Game series when it was sponsored by the booster club associations. Stone & Thomas continued to sponsor the event over the next two decades-plus. In recent years, the queen's pageant has continued under the sponsorship of Kaufman's of Wheeling and WTOV-9.

In the meantime, Mumley enlisted the help of Glenn Didriksen and his family, which owned and operated several McDonald's Family Restaurants in the area, to form the McDonald's All-Star Band. This has become an increasingly popular feature of the game.

Mumley's innovative mind produced a game that would help kick off the Ohio Valley football season, a classic that would involve some 60 to 70 football players annually and several hundred bandsmen. Add to that some 25 to 30 queen candidates and a myriad of volunteers who helped make the 10-day to two week experience a memorable part of their lives.

For a number of years, Rudy and his nephew Sam, along with other OVAC® officials and the dedicated men from the Osiris Shrine, would hold a pep rally at Russek Field on the campus of West Liberty State College. Several thousands of people attended these events and, of course, it was Rudy who usually stole the show.

From his days at old Wheeling High to those at West Liberty State College, Rudy was always there to help. Following a stint in the military service, he spent the next three decades or so as an educator, primarily in Eastern Ohio. He was principal at Buckeye South High when he retired.

His service to the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference® was ongoing for more than three decades, and he served as president on two different occasions.

Through his efforts and those of his many friends who joined with him to work on various facets of the all-star classic, more than \$600,000 has been provided to Ohio Valley charitable groups.

Several years before his death, which came in early February of 1999, Mumley relinquished directorship of the game to his longtime associate and close friend, Ron Mauck.

Nonetheless, Rudy still remained a familiar figure on the sidelines. His walk had slowed considerably although he had bounced back from a series of illnesses. But, the enthusiasm was as great as ever. He had seen the game reach new heights last year when it was televised live by WTOV-9 and the game still drew a near-capacity crowd.

It was a fitting tribute that OVAC® officials several years ago renamed the contest as the Rudy Mumley OVAC® Charity All-Star Game.

Rudy was to become one of the most recognizable sports figures the Ohio Valley had ever produced. He was honored as the Dapper Dan's "Man of the Year" in 1992, and earlier was inducted into the Athletic Hall of Fame at his beloved West Liberty State College, following in the footsteps of his late brother, Eli, Rudy was the first non-athlete or non-coach to earn this honor, and in recent years, he became a prominent benefactor to the school.

Educator, humanitarian and philanthropist. That's the legacy of a guy who wanted to be known simply as Rudy. And as long as this game can survive, fans of the Ohio Valley for the coming generations will be able to look skyward and say, "Thanks, Rudy!"





For more than three decades, Samuel A. Mumley served the youth of this area as executive secretary of the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference.

Last February, "Sammy" was called home by his maker to receive his just reward for a lifetime spent in service to others.

Perhaps the greatest compliment one can pay Sam Mumley following his passing is to say that he made his world a much better place to live because he once walked among us.

Mumley devoted nearly five decades to working for the youth of our Ohio Valley. In addition to his time as executive secretary of the OVAC®, which is still believed to be the largest high school athletic conference of its kind in the United States, Mumley was an athletic trainer, coach, basketball official, teacher and a school administrator.

If that wasn't enough time to give, Mumley joined Eric Carder, an assistant principal and director of activities at Wheeling Park High School, in serving as co-director for the West Virginia Super Six state high school football championships, which they brought to Wheeling Island Stadium six years ago.

Additionally, the pair helped secure the West Virginia state soccer championships held last year at the brand new athletic facility at Wheeling Jesuit University.

Sam also played a major role in the wonderful mid-summer football spectacle you are attending tonight at Wheeling Island Stadium. Renamed several years ago to honor his uncle, who also passed away earlier this year, the Rudy Mumley Charity All-Star Football Classic was revived in 1972 under the sponsorship of the OVAC®.

In those days, the NCAA made things difficult for sponsors seeking sanction to hold various all-star contest. The local Ohio-West Virginia All-Star game had been dormant for many years after having been a fixture on the Ohio Valley gridiron scene since the early 1940s. Both Mumley's spent hundreds of hours putting together the formula for a program that the NCAA found acceptable. Today, the game is more vibrant and popular than ever among the area football fans, who nearly pack the Island Stadium each and every July to kick off a new gridiron campaign.

They also helped turn this event into more than just a football game. It has become a mid-summer spectacular complete with an All-Star Band, cheerleaders and the pageantry of a Queen of Queens contest.

It also helped raise hundreds of thousands of dollars for charitable organizations in the Ohio Valley over the past 26 years.

Much of these wonders have been achieved because Mumley refused to take "no" for an answer from anyone and because he dared to dream what many of us have considered to be impossible dreams.

Who would have believed that the state high school football championships could ever be lured out of Charleston to the Northern Panhandle?

Sam did.

And Wheeling will host the state title games for the sixth straight year the first weekend of December.

Through his fund-raising efforts and the help of countless corporate sponsors and Super Six volunteers from up and down the Ohio Valley, the state football finals have been raised to a level that may never be matched in the Mountain State.

When Mumley came back to take over a second time as executive secretary of the OVAC®, the league was in dire financial straits.

Through Mumley's efforts and the backing of other leaders in the community, an OVAC® Foundation Board was formed to serve as a fund-raising arm of the bi-state league. That board is still in existence today.

The sports programs at the various schools were improved immensely. All-star games are now held each year in football, boys' and girls' basketball, baseball, softball and boys' and girls' soccer. The OVAC® sponsors championship tournaments in wrestling, swimming, tennis, golf, volleyball, baseball, softball, boys' and girls' soccer, boys' and girls' cross country, boys' and girls' track, cheerleading, etc.

Girls sports have risen to equal importance because Sam had the foresight and the courage to support each and every program offered by the OVAC®. His efforts with girls' sports earned Mumley a seat on the equity panels for both the Ohio High School Athletic Association and the West Virginia Secondary School Athletic Commission.

The scholarship program also has been enhanced by Sam's ability to involve the corporate sector of the various communities within the extensive OVAC® map. At last May's OVAC® Banquet of Champions held at the Wheeling Civic Center, more than \$15,000 in scholarship money was awarded to deserving OVAC® student-athletes.

That money wasn't just found on the street corner; it was obtained largely through tireless efforts of the late executive secretary.

Sam put the OVAC®'s "kids" first in all his dreams and work for the conference. "What can we do for the 'kids'? How can we make things better for them?" Those were the first questions he posed whenever the OVAC® or Super Six would discuss changes in their programs.

He took great pains to involve everyone in conference business. He was constantly in touch with media members, keeping them updated on matters and seeking their opinions.

When important final decisions had to be made, Sam didn't mind being the one to make them. But he did so after many discussions among his constituents and his own private soul-searching. And, of course, his main concern was making sure that the decisions were in the best interest of the OVAC® student-athletes.

From a personal standpoint, if Sam became your friend, he was your friend for life. He was always there with a kind word, a bit of advice if it was asked for, and encouragement when any of his friends were in a difficult situation.

I once wrote in a column that Sam was no saint, but that he was sent to us by angels to perform good works and turn our impossible dreams into reality.

He dearly loved his wife, Nancy, who remained by his side through good times and rough times. No different from the rest of us, Nancy became part of the OVAC® family as well, taking care of the conference's financial books, a role she continues to handle today.

They were married just 11 years when Sam passed away. But, as Nancy once said, they crammed 40 years of happiness into that short time.

A long bout with cancer terminated Mumley's life at the too young age of 67. But, as this writer has stated before, you won't make me believe "Sammy" lost that fight with cancer. Nothing defeated Sam Mumley in his lifetime. God, whom Sam believed in with all his heart, simply decided it was time to call him home.

Sam Mumley was one of a kind.



In the beginning... "1940" The First All★Star Game

West Virginia's senior All-Star schoolboys today held a 13 to 17 victory as the aftermath of their first meeting with the eastern Ohio team in the maiden football contest played under the new lighting system at the Island Stadium.

The victory of the mountain state youths, who had trailed from the opening quarter until the last seven minutes of the ball game, 7-0, came as a mild surprise as two well-drilled and highly efficient combinations delighted an early season crowd of some 8,000 fans.

The Ohioans drew first blood in the spectacular contest. A Mallery-Shackleford pass, late in the first period, moved the Buckeyes from midfield to the West Virginia 25. Sadlowski, another Bellaire back, took a pass that planted the ball on the nine, from where Sadlowski scored in two plays.

The remainder of the half was devoid of a distinct threat on the part of either team although the Rowe-Howell coached combine had advanced to the Ohio 25 when the intermission arrived.

The mountaineer sturdy rush line battled the equally effective Ohio forwards on fairly even terms into the final period before Johnny August, a Shadyside youth, who shared the starting role for the Bucks, was hit hard on his own 30 and Joe Corba, a Follansbee back, seized the white leather for the eventual winners.

Charlie Helinski, Union product, became a ball of fire at this stage. He wheeled off tackle to the Ohio 19 and then lugged the leather to the five aided by a too many times out penalty. Helinski picked up a yard and Mike "Punchy" Dimitro punched his way into the payoff zone. Dimitro cracked the line for the extra point and the issue was deadlocked.

Passes Decide Battle

The West Virginia stands settled back after this furious display satisfied with a 7-7 standoff, but the mountaineers were fired with the idea of victory when one of Joe Mallery's passes was intercepted near the 50 shortly after the succeeding kickoff.

Helinski niched successive passes to Phil Saseen and after the second toss to the Central Catholic back had planted the ball on the Ohioans nine. Helinski and Dimitro required three tries before the former had found the pay dirt and the West Virginia youths had a 13-7 lead.

The remaining time allowed for another kickoff and the West Virginians successfully negotiated an onside kick, recovering the ball as the fray ended.

Coaches Bill Kerns of WVU and Don C. Pedden of Ohio University were the honorary mentors and in addition to sitting on the benches of the contesting squads, both spoke over the P.A. system at halftime. The trio departed today for Charleston and tonight's North-South Game, although Kerns had an opportunity to talk to some local prospects.

Bill Stobbs, the Wheeling native who tutors the Wittenberg athletic teams, was one of the spectators in the stands. Another was George Roark, coach of W & J's Presidents, and probably there were others.

Carl Hamill, Weirton's cagey tutor was in the dressing room to minister to a pair of his former Red Riders. Tony Brown aggravated an old should injury while Luke Tomasovich received a cracked rib.

The West Virginians showed big Sedor due respect while the prospective Ohio State youth was in the game. His Shadyside backfield mate, August despite his costly fumble, was one of the big guns in the Bucks' effort and the Niemiec-Hartwig combinations thrusts left the West Virginia fans worried.

Lou Caffaro; recovering from a nasal operation, held the sticks for the West Virginians but felt the call of battle in his impassive role. Paul Bricker, Weirton end who handled the kicking for Howell and Rowe, and did an effective job although one of his boots slipped off the side of his foot and out of bounds.

"1967" All-Star Game - 50 Years Ago

West Virginia defeated Ohio both with the lights out and lights on Saturday night in the Valley All-Star football game at Wheeling Stadium.

Scoring once in the first half, when the lighting system at the Island park was on the blink, the Mountaineers added a pair of touchdowns after the electricity began working in the second half and presented the veteran Warwood coach, Jim Foti, with an 18-0 decision in his fianl appearance as a grid mentor.

Thus, the West Virginians broke an Ohio domination of the series that had extended back through 1964 and reduced the Buckeye margin in the interstate rivalry to four, at 14-10.

The electricians were unable to get the lighting system working until after intermission but the crowd of 7,500 which showed up on a pleasantly warm evening was surprisingly patient through a first half which saw the Mountaineers go ahead on a 12-yard sweep of left end by their starting quarterback, Gene Weltz, of Union, late in the second period. A 37-yard punt return by Wheeling's Bob Volga set up the tally.

The aroused Buckeyes came on like gangbusters at the outset of the third period and drove from their own 20 to the WV 8 before yielding the pigskin on downs. The Barnesville combination of little Johnny Merrill, at quarterback, and tall Dallas Adkins, at end, clicked on a 39-yard pass play and Bellaire's Rich Gianangeli reeled off a 17-yard run during the foray.

Follansbee's Terry Kidder, who did a tremendous job of punting throughout the game, extricated WV from the hole with a 53-yard boot out of his own end zone.

In the opening seconds of the fourth quarter the Mountaineers

jumped their lead to 12-0 when Pet Giglio hit his former Follansbee High teammate, Tim Stefan, on a 54-yard pass play. Stefan was wide open at the Buckeye 25.

Ohio advanced to the WV 30 after the next kickoff but the alert Vogler thwarted the bid with an interception in his own end zone.

Late in the gamee another interception by Vogler, followed by his 28-yard return to the Buckeye 2, set up the final TD, which the Wheeling High grad made himself on a plunge with the 1:25 left inthe fray.

Vogler was stopped short on the point try but his outstanding performance won him an award as the Most Valuable Player onthe winning side. Gianangeli was picked as Ohio's MVP

The Mountaineers produced their three touchdown margin although garnering only 62 yards by rushing during the contest. They added 90 yards in the air with three completions in seven tries and had bu five first downs.


Ohio made 114 yards rushing and hit on six of 19 passes for 103 but suffered four interceptions. The Bucks had seven first downs. They were penalized 40 yards to WV's 20.

Ohio was presented with an early opportunity to move the ball in WV territory when Mike Hostasa, tackle from Shadyside, covered a Mountaineer fumble on the first scrimmage play at the WV 43. However, three plays later the Buckeyes returned the favor as Chuck Boniti, of Weirton Madonna, confiscated an Ohio bobble at the 36.

The Bucks forced a WV punt but Dave Grandstaff, defensive back from Magnolia, subsequently picked off a pass thrown by Barnesville's Johnny Merrill and returned from the Mountaineer 45 to the Ohio 42. Helped by a holding penalty against the Bucks, the Blue and Gold penetrated to the 11 but yielded the oval on another bobble, this one covered by Bellaire's Larry Holloway at the 14.

Two long punts by Terry Kidder of Follansbee, put Ohio in the hole in the second period. One with the aid of a good roll traveled 56 yards from scrimmage and the second was good for 58 yards to push the Ohioan back to their seven.

The Bucks were forced into a punting situation but Rich Gianangeli's kick was nullified by offsetting penalties. Standing in his end zone in the darkness Gianangeli boomed the ball outto the 49 but Wheeling High's speedy Bob Vogler returned to the Ohio 12. On the next play Weltz circled left end on a keeper for the score, which came with 2:21 left in the half. Kidder attempted a drop kick for the extra point but it was wide.



"2007" All-Star Game - 10 Years Ago

While it had to be one of the lowest scoring games in its 62nd year history of the Rudy Mumley OVAC All-Star Football Classic, the 2007 contest also had to have been one of the most exciting endings.

The Sunday night encounter at Wheeling Island Stadium pitting the favored Ohio team against all-stars from West Virginia ended up with only nine points being scored.

Through 46 minutes and 58 seconds of play the only scoring in the game had been a second period 36 yard field goal by Matt Deel from John Marshall, and it looked like West Virginia was about to chalk up a win, as the Ohio team was on its own eight yard line with no time outs left and the clock showing 1:02 remaining.

If Ohio was going to win, or tie the game, it was going to take a few big plays to either get a touchdown or within field goal range.

Well as it turned out Ohio decided on the first play to go for ``the bomb'' instead of a few short aerials.

Thus the only touchdown of the game turned out to be a 92 yarder from All-Ohioan quarterback Nick Rocchio of Bellaire to Steubenville speedster Maurice Bougard, the latter just so happened to have been Ohio's

Division II top 100 and 200 meter his senior year, not only that for the past two years he had been a member of the Big Red's state champions.

Rocchio and Bougard said after the game that the game winning TD was to be a pass thrown to a spot with Bougard running underneath the ball, and then sprinting into the end zone.

While everything worked with Bougard adding another touch, that being leaping head first into the end zone.

One thing that didn't work for Ohio, that being a missed extra point, which had West Virginia made a field goal on its last possession it could have tied the game.

The Ohio defense took care of that with a third down pass interception.

The game had another statistic which doesn't happen very often, that being West Virginia's offense had Zero yards rushing. That being on 21 carries. WV actually did gain 37 yards rushing but lost that same amount.

While West Virginia did gain 126 yards passing, 13 completions on 21 attempts by Cy Mozingo, Ohio was racking up more yardage both passing and rushing than the Mountaineers. Passing yards for Ohio being 273 while rushing totalled 159.

Stephen Ford of Cambridge was the game's top running back with 84 yards on 24 caries, while Bougard had 51 yards on seven carries

The top receivers for Ohio were Bougard seven for 120 yards and Jayson Keyser of Bellaire five for 73 yards.

First downs were 27-9 in favor of Ohio.

Total offense was Ohio 432, West Virginia 126. Penalties were six for 62 by Ohio, an two for 18 for West Virginia. Both teams lost their own fumbles.

First downs favored Ohio 27-9.

St. Clairsville's Brett McLean was the winning coach, while Mark Batton of Magnolia coached West Virginia.

Dr. Robert Jones is a native of Scribner, Nebraska where he attended West Point High School as a multi-sport athlete in football, basketball, track and baseball. After an outstanding high school football career, he received a scholarship to the University of Nebraska where he played for the great college coach, Bob Devaney.

After college, he was selected by the Washington Redskins to start his professional career. He spent a year with the team on the taxi-squad. From the Redskins, Jones went to the Wheeling Ironmen where he played from 1964 to 1967.

While playing and teaching in the Ohio Valley, he started medical school at West Virginia University. He graduated from medical school in 1972, graduating third in his class. After surgical residency and internships from 1972 to 1979, he came to Wheeling and started his practice where he continues to treat patients to this day. Jones is one of the prominent surgeons in the Ohio Valley and is licensed in Ohio and West Virginia.

He and his wife Rita live in Wheeling and have six children.

Dr. Jones has been involved with the game since 1984. Dr. Luis Vasquez was the Ohio team doctor invited him to become the West

Virginia team doctor. He has as a simple self-diagnosis to explain his affliction for football. "The game is in my blood and I know of no antibiotic, pill or shot that can get it out of my system. I got involved because of the game of football. The appeal is the game itself ... it doesn't matter what aspect it is."

Many of the games he has seen and worked were good. But one – the 1987 Classic – stands out as great because of the luminous stars that who played in the contest. Ohio – featuring St. Clairsville's duo of Shawn Vincent and John Spencer - defeated the Alex Shook led West Virginia team 13-11 in the All-Star game played at Steubenville because of the renovations to Wheeling Island Stadium.

Of course, the main purpose of football and other sports is to teach the participants qualities they can take with themselves throughout their lives. Football was no different for Jones. He says he learned self-discipline – a necessary component in any surgeon's mental make-up – by playing football all his life. "The discipline of football pushed me to be into the medical field and to be a surgeon," Jones said.

Ensuring that the teams have plenty of supplies, from medical tape to ice packs.


Telling coaches if players injured during the game are healthy enough to return to action.

Masters Degree in exercise physiology from the University of Arizona.



Melanie Cheek is a certified athletic trainer with a MS Degree from Bloomsburg University. Currently working part time as a trainer at West Liberty University


She will be serving as the Trainer for the Ohio squad in this year's All-Star game.

and Fitness Center in Morgantown. He received his certification as Athletic Trainer in July 2010.






MARTINS FERRY -- John Durdines isn't sure what his coaching future holds

Here's a capsule look at the West Virginia coaches:

JOHN DURDINES, Bishop Donahue -- This veteran coach spent the last 15 seasons as the head coach for the Bishops and was on the coaching staff for two years prior. Durdines guided the Bishops to three OVAC Class 1A championships. He was named the Mason-Dixon Conference coach of the year five times and twice received the Big 22 Class A Coach of the Year. He was also named the Intelligencer/News Register Coach of the Year after the 2014 season. All told, he finished his career with a 90-68 record. Along with football, Durdines spent two years coaching baseball and six seasons coaching wrestling. John and his wife, Michelle have two daughters, Anatasia Klemm and Ashley Durdines.

L.A. HAMPTON, Bishop Donahue – This former Bishopsá standout has been coaching football for four seasons, including the 2016 campaign with the Bishops. Prior to joining Durdines, he was on the staff at Linsly. Hampton, who is a B.D. and West Liberty graduate, also has coaching experience in basketball and track.

CURT MELE, Bishop Donahue -- This long-time Bishop worked with the Donahue football program for each of the last five years. All told, he has 10 years of experience at his alma mater. Along with serving on the football staff, Mele also served as the Bishops' softball coach and was an assistant boys basketball coach. A graduate of Wheeling Jesuit and West Virginia Northern, Mele and his wife, Dana, have three daughters, Ashley, Alexis and Abbey.

ZACHARY KLEMM, Bishop Donahue -- This former Linsly School standout spent two years working with Durdines and the Bishops. Klemm, who graduated from Linsly in 2010 and West Liberty in 2014, has four years of total experience in football coaching. He also has coaching experience in wrestling. Zach, who is married to Coach Durdines' daughter, Anastasia, played football, golf, hockey and swimming.

HOWARD STAMP, Bishop Donahue -- This veteran assistant coach has been on the Bishops' coaching staff since Durdines took over the reins of the program. Stamp was part of all three OVAC championship and four Mason-Dixon title winning coaching staffs. A graduate of Austintown Fitch High School and West Liberty, Stamp played football and baseball. Howard and his wife, Pam, have four children, Tim, Todd, Katie and Emily.

MICHAEL ANGALICH, Bishop Donahue — A former Bishops' athletic standout, Angalich has been in the coaching ranks for the past five years at his alma mater. Angalich graduated from Donahue in 2008 after an all-state, all-OVAC and all-Valley senior season. He's served on the coaching staff that's won two OVAC titles. James has also three stepchildren, Jordyn, Ryan and Morgan.

BOB KRAMER, Madonna — This veteran mentor helped turn the Blue Dons' program around after it had reached the brink of extinction. Kramer, who owns 37 years of coaching experience, guided the Blue Dons to the 2009 state championship and a pair of runnerup finishes in 2004 and 2008. He was named OVAC Coach of the Year in 2010 and was also named the Dapper Dan Man of the Year. He was named Mason-Dixon Coach of the Year five times. Kramer, who is a graduate of Steubenville High School and Jefferson Community College, spent five years working as an assistant coach before taking over the head-coaching duties.
