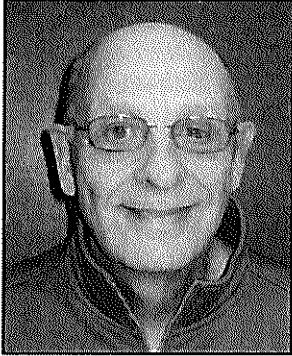
RULES OF THE GAME

1. Each game will consist of two 20 minute halves.
2. Zone presses may be used but must end after first trap past half court.
3. Man-to man defense must be played in the normal attack area.
4. Each player must make an appearance in both halves. Attempts should be made to give all 15 players equal playing time.
5. Dunking will be permitted during the pre-game warm-up.
6. All overtime periods shall be three minutes in length.
7. Each player is allowed six (6) personal fouls before he is disqualified.
8. Teams will be permitted one full time-out and two :30 time-outs per game.
No one & one until the last two minutes of game. Double bonus will be shot on the 10th foul at all times. One & one will be shot on the 7th foul only in last 2 minutes of game.

Dan DeLande

Dan DeLande simply had a knack for officiating. Whether it was in basketball or softball, enforcing the rules was simply in this Bridgeport High School graduate's blood. In basketball, DeLande's presence was felt for 23 years and his success and tenure in the sport has led to him receiving the Robert Dawson Basketball Officials Award at today's Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Basketball Game.

During the course of his career of working games in both Ohio and West Virginia, DeLande began his career in 1977 and worked post-season games in both states. He worked in the West Virginia State Tournament, too. In softball, DeLande recently retired after 29 years of calling the balls and strikes. He worked 12 state tournaments on the diamond and countless other tournament games -- at all levels -- in both states. He also worked collegiately at the Division II and III level. While he spent many of his evenings and late afternoons officiating, by day, DeLande was a long-time school administrator. He spent 48 years in education after achieving a bachelor's degree from Ohio University and a Master's Plus from the University of Dayton.

Dan and his late wife Connie were married for 45 years prior to her passing in 2016. The couple has one daughter, Gina Holmes, who also resides in Shadyside. DeLande also has four grandchildren, Alexa Coggins, Anthony Coggins, Collin Holmes and Aivreigh Holmes.

Dave Reitter

Dave Reitter loved coaching basketball and doing so at Brooke so much, he simply couldn't resist the opportunity to do it twice. After an initial tenure in which he guided the Bruins from 1985 until 2002, Reitter returned to the head-coaching post in 2005 and held it until 2016 when he formally retired.

Reitter's career with the Bruins, which included a 343-306 record, has earned him the Earl Haberfield Boys Basketball Coach Award, which will be presented today during the Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Game. In his first stint as the head coach, Reitter won 64 percent of his game, accumulating a 258-142 record. During that stint, he guided the Bruins to the 1987 Class AAA State Championship with an impressive 25-1 record. In all, the Bruins made five state tournament appearances under Reitter and never were eliminated in the quarter-final round in Charleston. Along with his success in the state tournament, Reitter's program notched five regional championships and 12 sectional titles to go along with two OVAC titles. Reitter also takes great pride in the fact that he helped to institute a Coaches vs. Cancer program at Brooke to help raise money for the local cancer society.

Reitter was chosen to the coach in the OVAC All-Star Game three times during his career, calling each opportunity "a pleasure." When Reitter returned to the basketball bench, he was also serving as the Brooke football coach. He guided the program to two playoff berths and never endured a losing season. On top of his coaching, Reitter didn't rest much in the spring either. He's a long-time baseball umpire, too.

Reitter gives the bulk of the credit for his success to his wife, family, assistant coaches and players.

Dave and his wife of 47 years, Victoria, have three children (Bryon, Jamie Lash and Brent) and six grandchildren.

Pat Clutter

A lot of people make contributions to the sport of basketball in the Ohio Valley. Few, however, are able to say they did so in as many ways as the late Pat Clutter. Whether it was as a coach or media member, Clutter made his presence felt.

Clutter is now being honored for his work by virtue of the Richard Saffield Girls Coach Award at today's Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Game. As a coach, Clutter won 299 games at Wheeling Park. That mark actually stood as a state record. He received OVAC Coach of the Year following the 1980, 1983 and 1985 seasons. He was named the West Virginia state coach of the year in both 1980 and 83.

A 1969 graduate of Oak Glen and 1973 alumnus of West Liberty, Clutter finished his master's degree at Marshall University in 1975 and was hired at Wheeling Park in its initial year, as an English teacher. He eventually transitioned into a communications teacher and became the director of broadcast communications program at the high school. Originally, the program focused on radio, but began to encompass television three years later.

Along with his teaching and coaching duties, Clutter was working part time for WWVA as an on-air personality and later accepted a position with WTRF in Wheeling as a weekend weather anchor. He later transferred to sports and is credited in creating what is known now as the 'Friday Night Sports Blitz.'

Clutter served on several boards throughout Wheeling and the Ohio Valley. He was voted 'Teacher of the Year' in 1992.

Pat is survived by his wife, Angie (Chiazza) and three children – Crissy, Kelly and Patrick.

Randy Shepherd

Sometimes finding people to run the clock at sporting events can be a tough task for athletic directors. Wheeling Park doesn't have such issues.

And the chief reason why is because of the work and dedication of Randy Shepherd.

A veteran of both the clock inside the 'Palace on the Hill' at Wheeling Park High School and the clock at Wheeling Island Stadium, Shepherd has held those roles for 30 and 27 years, respectively.

For his efforts, Shepherd is being recognized today at the Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Game as the recipient of the Thomas E. Rataiczak Timer/Scorekeeper Award winner.

Shepherd was hired by the Ohio County Schools as a substitute teacher upon his graduation from West Liberty State College in 1977. He was then hired as a full-time teacher and still works as a social studies teacher at Triadelphia Middle School.

Along with his work on the clock at Park's two athletic venues, Shepherd also found time to coach. He coached both basketball and football for many years at Bridge Street, Wheeling and Triadelphia Middle Schools. He also served on the staff at Wheeling Park.

Randy, who has also ran the clock for 24 years at the West Virginia Super Six Football Championships, is married to Libby Shepherd, who is the OVAC Cheering Director. The couple has two children, Shawna Shepherd and Shannon Conley. They also have a granddaughter, Madilyn.

Jerry Liberatore

Jerry Liberatore has four main passions in life.

Those are ... his family, St. John Central High School, Notre Dame and basketball. Because of St. John Central and basketball, Liberatore has been able to work with players since 1993 at a myriad of levels.

His tireless dedication and commitment to the school and sport hasn't gone unnoticed. Today, at the Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Basketball Classic, Liberatore will receive the Bob Burton Distinguished Service Award.

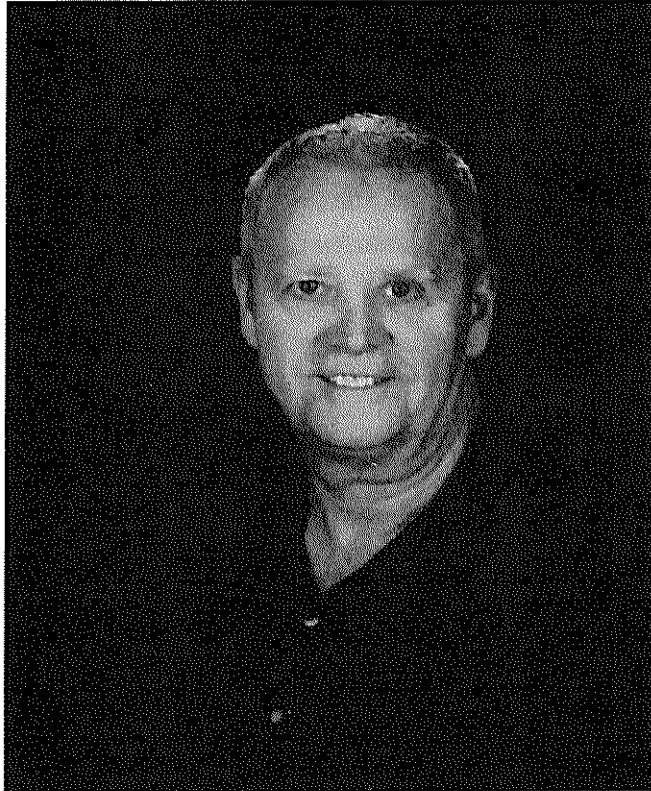
Liberatore graduated from St. John in 1959 and remained active at St. John basically ever since, earning the 'Lifetime Achievement Award' from the school last summer. Before entering the coaching realm, he was involved with the school's booster club. He was one of the founders of the famous St. John football pick sheets, which still exist today. He also worked countless other fundraisers.

When Liberatore broke into the coaching ranks, he started as a summer-league coach in St. Clairsville in 1993. He served as the freshman coach from 1996 until 2004, leading the school to three league titles and a like number of undefeated seasons. In 2005, Liberatore joined Bubba Kapral's varsity staff. In that time, St. John has claimed five OVAC and four sectional titles. Finding a balance was sometimes tough for Liberatore. He worked in human resources for a company in Scio, leading to a 75-minute drive each way.

Jerry and his wife, of 46 years, Cheryl have two children, Ty (Nicole) of Akron and Nikki of Bellaire. The couple also has two grandchildren, Reed (8) and Stella (6).
