
73rd Ohio Valley Athletic Conference® Annual Rudy Mumley All Star Football Game

She has been a pillar of the OVAC Executive Board since 2001 and served as the OVAC Executive Board President from 2007-2009. During her tenure as Board President the Varsity Board was initiated to give the student athletes an avenue to express ideas and concerns. Besides her duties as an Executive Board Member, she also is the Coordinator of the "Evening With The Stars" dinner. As coordinator, she handles all reservations, seating, decorations, and the menu for approximately 400 guests and students from the All-Star Football Classic. Furthermore, Dianna serves on the OVAC President's Scholarship Committee and attends various OVAC events to support our student athletes.

Dr. Dianna Vargo is a graduate of St. Clairsville High School. At Ohio University at Athens she earned a Bachelor Degree of Arts and Sciences in Mathematics. In addition, she has a Master's Degree in Science and Mathematics Education from Wheeling Jesuit College, a Master's Degree in Educational Administration and a Doctorate in Educational Leadership, both from West Virginia University.

At Wheeling Park High School, Dianna worked as a mathematics teacher, and coached track and cross country as well as serving as Assistant Principal and Principal. Also, she held the positions of Assistant Superintendent, Deputy Superintendent, and Superintendent of Ohio County Schools. Currently, she serves as the Director of Graduate Education and Accelerated Certification for teaching programs at Wheeling Jesuit University.

In addition to her OVAC obligations, Dianna is active in the community. She serves on the Ohio University Eastern Campus Regional Coordinating Council, is a member of the Wheeling Hall of Fame Board, and is a member of the Civitan of Wheeling.

There are many words to describe the life of Rudolph Mumley, but perhaps the most appropriate would be service.

For most of his 80-plus years, Mumley, known as "Rudy" to his legion of friends, worked on behalf of many causes. None were more important to him than the youth of the Ohio Valley.

It is befitting that the game which fans are witnessing this evening is named in his honor. If it hadn't been for Rudy's willingness to step forward, the Ohio-West Virginia All-Star Game would not have existed the last 28 years, and it now appears to be a fixture that will carry it well into the next millennium.

The game's history goes back to the early 1940s and, for many years after that, it was sponsored by booster club associations from Eastern Ohio and the West Virginia northern panhandle.

However, the game could not receive NCAA sanction and consequently was held during the spring to allow players who had received scholarships to NCAA schools an opportunity to participate.

When it became apparent that the booster club organizations could no longer sponsor the game, it ceased to exist. An idea was presented to Sam A. Mumley Sr. that the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference® could assume sponsorship of the game and apply for NCAA sanction.

One of the requirements toward receiving NCAA sanction was that only 60 percent of game proceeds could be spent to cover expenses and the other 40 percent had to be used for charitable purposes.

Once the game received sanction, the OVAC® had another problem. It was experiencing financial problems and did not have the resources to provide "seed" money that would be needed to purchase uniforms, pay for training camp and other start-up expenses such as insurance.

Sam Mumley, who was the executive secretary of the OVAC®, appealed to his uncle, Rudy, to provide the financial help. The story has become legend on how Rudy, a bachelor who lived with his beloved sister, Lillian, in the Warwood area of Wheeling, mortgaged their home to receive a loan. The rest, as the saying goes, is history.

There was more adversity to overcome for this inaugural OVAC® venture. The Ohio Valley experienced damaging floods during June of 1972. Wheeling Stadium sustained considerable damage and the facility would not be available for the early August game.

Sam Mumley called his longtime friend, the late Edmund Joseph, who was then athletic director at Martins Ferry High School and asked if the OVAC® could use Ferry Stadium. Once Joseph took the request to school officials and received permission, the game was finally on.

However, on the day of the game, the area was hit hard by a rainstorm. More adversity. By this time, you could not fault Rudy Mumley, who agreed to serve as game director, if he was feeling a bit jinxed. Several hours before kickoff was scheduled, the rain stopped and the sun came out. It turned into a beautiful evening, and the game went off like clockwork before a capacity audience.

The OVAC® was in business as far as renewal of the Ohio-West Virginia midsummer classic was concerned.

However, that's not the end of the story. Over the next two decades-plus that Rudy Mumley served as game director, he made numerous improvements to the game. He turned it from just an all-star game into an extravaganza.

He took the all-star gridders to camp at West Liberty State College, his alma mater, and a place where he had long-standing ties. Each year, Mumley added activities for the players to help them pass the time and provide some relief from the rigors of training camp.

He enlisted the help of the Osiris Shrine and this group gave the game a more meaningful

purpose as it would eventually gain the lion's share of the charity proceeds.

Through his good friend, the late George Strager, another mid-week event, "An Evening With the Stars," was initiated and handled with impeccable care by two other longtime friends, Mike Young and Pete Cuffaro.

From the time the OVAC® assumed sponsorship of the game, Mumley brought back the Stone & Thomas "Queen of Queens" Pageant which had been a part of the All-Star Game series when it was sponsored by the booster club associations. Stone & Thomas continued to sponsor the event over the next two decades-plus. In recent years, the queen's pageant has continued under the sponsorship of Kaufman's of Wheeling and WTOV-9.

In the meantime, Mumley enlisted the help of Glenn Didriksen and his family, which owned and operated several McDonald's Family Restaurants in the area, to form the McDonald's All-Star Band. This has become an increasingly popular feature of the game.

Mumley's innovative mind produced a game that would help kick off the Ohio Valley football season, a classic that would involve some 60 to 70 football players annually and several hundred bandsmen. Add to that some 25 to 30 queen candidates and a myriad of volunteers who helped make the 10-day to two week experience a memorable part of their lives.

For a number of years, Rudy and his nephew Sam, along with other OVAC® officials and the dedicated men from the Osiris Shrine, would hold a pep rally at Russek Field on the campus of West Liberty State College. Several thousands of people attended these events and, of course, it was Rudy who usually stole the show.

From his days at old Wheeling High to those at West Liberty State College, Rudy was always there to help. Following a stint in the military service, he spent the next three decades or so as an educator, primarily in Eastern Ohio. He was principal at Buckeye South High when he retired.

His service to the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference® was ongoing for more than three decades, and he served as president on two different occasions.

Through his efforts and those of his many friends who joined with him to work on various facets of the all-star classic, more than \$600,000 has been provided to Ohio Valley charitable groups.

Several years before his death, which came in early February of 1999, Mumley relinquished directorship of the game to his longtime associate and close friend, Ron Mauck.

Nonetheless, Rudy still remained a familiar figure on the sidelines. His walk had slowed considerably although he had bounced back from a series of illnesses. But, the enthusiasm was as great as ever. He had seen the game reach new heights last year when it was televised live by WTOV-9 and the game still drew a near-capacity crowd.

It was a fitting tribute that OVAC® officials several years ago renamed the contest as the Rudy Mumley OVAC® Charity All-Star Game.

Rudy was to become one of the most recognizable sports figures the Ohio Valley had ever produced. He was honored as the Dapper Dan's "Man of the Year" in 1992, and earlier was inducted into the Athletic Hall of Fame at his beloved West Liberty State College, following in the footsteps of his late brother, Eli, Rudy was the first non-athlete or non-coach to earn this honor, and in recent years, he became a prominent benefactor to the school.

Educator, humanitarian and philanthropist. That's the legacy of a guy who wanted to be known simply as Rudy. And as long as this game can survive, fans of the Ohio Valley for the coming generations will be able to look skyward and say, "Thanks, Rudy!"





For more than three decades, Samuel A. Mumley served the youth of this area as executive secretary of the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference.

Last February, "Sammy" was called home by his maker to receive his just reward for a lifetime spent in service to others.

Perhaps the greatest compliment one can pay Sam Mumley following his passing is to say that he made his world a much better place to live because he once walked among us.

Mumley devoted nearly five decades to working for the youth of our Ohio Valley. In addition to his time as executive secretary of the OVAC®, which is still believed to be the largest high school athletic conference of its kind in the United States, Mumley was an athletic trainer, coach, basketball official, teacher and a school administrator.

If that wasn't enough time to give, Mumley joined Eric Carder, an assistant principal and director of activities at Wheeling Park High School, in serving as co-director for the West Virginia Super Six state high school football championships, which they brought to Wheeling Island Stadium six years ago.

Additionally, the pair helped secure the West Virginia state soccer championships held last year at the brand new athletic facility at Wheeling Jesuit University.

Sam also played a major role in the wonderful mid-summer football spectacle you are attending tonight at Wheeling Island Stadium. Renamed several years ago to honor his uncle, who also passed away earlier this year, the Rudy Mumley Charity All-Star Football Classic was revived in 1972 under the sponsorship of the OVAC®.

In those days, the NCAA made things difficult for sponsors seeking sanction to hold various all-star contest. The local Ohio-West Virginia All-Star game had been dormant for many years after having been a fixture on the Ohio Valley gridiron scene since the early 1940s. Both Mumley's spent hundreds of hours putting together the formula for a program that the NCAA found acceptable. Today, the game is more vibrant and popular than ever among the area football fans, who nearly pack the Island Stadium each and every July to kick off a new gridiron campaign.

They also helped turn this event into more than just a football game. It has become a mid-summer spectacular complete with an All-Star Band, cheerleaders and the pageantry of a Queen of Queens contest.

It also helped raise hundreds of thousands of dollars for charitable organizations in the Ohio Valley over the past 26 years.

Much of these wonders have been achieved because Mumley refused to take "no" for an answer from anyone and because he dared to dream what many of us have considered to be impossible dreams.

Who would have believed that the state high school football championships could ever be lured out of Charleston to the Northern Panhandle?

And Wheeling will host the state title games for the sixth straight year the first weekend of December

Through his fund-raising efforts and the help of countless corporate sponsors and Super Six volunteers from up and down the Ohio Valley, the state football finals have been raised to a level that may never be matched in the Mountain State.

When Mumley came back to take over a second time as executive secretary of the OVAC®, the league was in dire financial straits.

Through Mumley's efforts and the backing of other leaders in the community, an OVAC® Foundation Board was formed to serve as a fund-raising arm of the bi-state league. That board is still in existence today.

The sports programs at the various schools were improved immensely. All-star games are now held each year in football, boys' and girls' basketball, baseball, softball and boys' and girls' soccer. The OVAC® sponsors championship tournaments in wrestling, swimming, tennis, golf, volleyball, baseball, softball, boys' and girls' soccer, boys' and girls' cross country, boys' and girls' track, cheerleading, etc.

Girls sports have risen to equal importance because Sam had the foresight and the courage to support each and every program offered by the OVAC®. His efforts with girls' sports earned Mumley a seat on the equity panels for both the Ohio High School Athletic Association and the West Virginia Secondary School Athletic Commission.

The scholarship program also has been enhanced by Sam's ability to involve the corporate sector of the various communities within the extensive OVAC® map. At last May's OVAC® Banquet of Champions held at the Wheeling Civic Center, more than \$15,000 in scholarship money was awarded to deserving OVAC® student-athletes.

That money wasn't just found on the street corner; it was obtained largely through tireless efforts of the late executive secretary.

Sam put the OVAC®'s "kids" first in all his dreams and work for the conference. "What can we do for the 'kids'? How can we make things better for them?" Those were the first questions he posed whenever the OVAC® or Super Six would discuss changes in their programs.

He took great pains to involve everyone in conference business. He was constantly in touch with media members, keeping them updated on matters and seeking their opinions.

When important final decisions had to be made, Sam didn't mind being the one to make them. But he did so after many discussions among his constituents and his own private soul-searching. And, of course, his main concern was making sure that the decisions were in the best interest of the OVAC® student-athletes.

From a personal standpoint, if Sam became your friend, he was your friend for life. He was always there with a kind word, a bit of advice if it was asked for, and encouragement when any of his friends were in a difficult situation.

I once wrote in a column that Sam was no saint, but that he was sent to us by angels to perform good works and turn our impossible dreams into reality.

He dearly loved his wife, Nancy, who remained by his side through good times and rough times. No different from the rest of us, Nancy became part of the OVAC® family as well, taking care of the conference's financial books, a role she continues to handle today.


They were married just 11 years when Sam passed away. But, as Nancy once said, they crammed 40 years of happiness into that short time.



In the beginning... Complete by Babe Schill 1940' The First All Star Game

West Virginia's senior All-Star schoolboys today held a 13 to 17 victory as the aftermath of their first meeting with the eastern Ohio team in the maiden football contest played under the new lighting system at the Island Stadium.

The victory of the mountain state youths, who had trailed from the opening quarter until the last seven minutes of the ball game, 7-0, came as a mild surprise as two well-drilled and highly efficient combinations delighted an early season crowd of some 8,000 fans.

The Ohioans drew first blood in the spectacular contest. A Mallery-Shackleford pass, late in the first period, moved the Buckeyes from midfield to the West Virginia 25. Sadlowski, another Bellaire back, took a pass that planted the ball on the nine, from where Sadlowski scored in two plays.

The remainder of the half was devoid of a distinct threat on the part of either team although the Rowe-Howell coached combine had advanced to the Ohio 25 when the intermission arrived.

The mountaineer sturdy rush line battled the equally effective Ohio forwards on fairly even terms into the final period before Johnny August, a Shadyside youth, who shared the starting role for the Bucks, was hit hard on his own 30 and Joe Corba, a Follansbee back, seized the white leather for the eventual winners.

Charlie Helinski, Union product, became a ball of fire at this stage. He wheeled off tackle to the Ohio 19 and then lugged the leather to the five aided by a too many times out penalty. Helinski picked up a yard and Mike "Punchy" Dimitro punched his way into the payoff zone. Dimitro cracked the line for the extra point and the issue was deadlocked.

Passes Decide Battle

The West Virginia stands settled back after this furious display satisfied with a 7-7 standoff, but the mountaineers were fired with the idea of victory when one of Joe Mallery's passes was intercepted near the 50 shortly after the succeeding kickoff.

Helinski niched successive passes to Phil Saseen and after the second toss to the Central Catholic back had planted the ball on the Ohioans nine. Helinski and Dimitro required three tries before the former had found the pay dirt and the West Virginia youths had a 13-7 lead.

The remaining time allowed for another kickoff and the West Virginians successfully negotiated an onside kick, recovering the ball as the fray ended.

Coaches Bill Kerns of WVU and Don C. Pedden of Ohio University were the honorary mentors and in addition to sitting on the benches of the contesting squads, both spoke over the P.A. system at halftime. Kerns was accompanied here by Frank Kutz, one of his line mentors, and Ray Carnelly, his plebe mentor. The trio departed today for Charleston and tonight's North-South Game, although Kerns had an opportunity to talk to some local prospects.

Bill Stobbs, the Wheeling native who tutors the Wittenberg athletic teams, was one of the spectators in the stands. Another was George Roark, coach of W & J's Presidents, and probably there were others.

Carl Hamill, Weirton's cagey tutor was in the dressing room to minister to a pair of his former Red Riders. Tony Brown aggravated an old should injury while Luke Tomasovich received a cracked rib.

The West Virginians showed big Sedor due respect while the prospective Ohio State youth was in the game. His Shadyside backfield mate, August despite his costly fumble, was one of the big guns in the Bucks' effort and the Niemiec-Hartwig combinations thrusts left the West Virginia fans worried.

Lou Caffaro; recovering from a nasal operation, held the sticks for the West Virginians but felt the call of battle in his impassive role. Paul Bricker, Weirton end who handled the kicking for Howell and Rowe, and did an effective job although one of his boots slipped off the side of his foot and out of bounds.

"1968" All-Star Game - 50 Years Ago

Ohio made a first quarter touchdown standup for a 6-0 victory over West Virginia in the 25th Ohio Valley All-Star Football Game Saturday night at Wheeling Stadium.

A crowd of only about 3,500, perhaps the smallest in the history of the interstate classic, saw the Buckeyes strike through the air early, with a halfback pass from Wintersville's Don Young to Union Local end Ron Dean accounting for the game's only score.

The Ohioans coached by Barnesville's Harold Mercer with Brilliant mentor Jake Olsavsky as his assistant, posted a decided statistical edge but were never able to strike pay dirt again after the first period foray of 31 yards in eight plays.

Ohio finished with 14 first downs to a mere six for the underdog Mountaineers and rolled up a combined rushing-passing net of 200 yards from scrimmage compared to 48 for the losers.

Although the only touchdown was made on a pass, neither side was impressive through the air, Ohio having only two completions, both on passes by Young, in nine attempts. While the Mountaineers recorded only one completion in 10 tries and that for just a single yard.

West Virginia's offense was impotent for the first half but picked up a bit in the third quarter when Follansbee Coach Denny Williams, piloting the Mountaineers, inserted Bishop Donahue's Bill Higgins at quarterback.

WV was not inside the OH 40 until the final period when an 11 yard punt return by Weirton's Tom Curtis planted the oval on the Buck 35. Paden City's Steve Billeter skirted end to the 25. Then Higgins completed a pass to the 13, but the aerial was nullified by

an offside penalty which moved the pigskin back to the 30. On the next play Bill Bates, Cadiz, nailed Higgins for a seven yard loss as the Donahue QB was attempting to pass and the Mountaineer threat then died on a brief flurry of incompletions.

Ohio took over the ball at its 33 and proceeded to drive, largely on the running of the elusive Young, to the WV 25. The Buckeyes appeared headed for its second TD but a fumble by the big Barnesville fullback, Dan Hannahs, was confiscated by Union's Jerry Minor to thwart the bid.

This was the third time during the evening that the Ohioans yielded the ball on a fumble. Ted Stewart, West Virginia's captain from Magnolia, recovered the other two and subsequently was rewarded with the trophy as his team's most valuable player. The slippery Young was the choice of the press for Ohio's MVP.

Rain, which fell early in the evening, undoubtedly cut into the size of the crowd and made footing a bit precarious on some of the sweeps but the field was in good condition, generally. It's a pity that the carpet of grass will probably be gone by mid-October.

Last night's nod gave the Buck's a 15-10 edge in the series and avenged last year's 18-0 loss.

Ohio capitalized upon a break to score before the game was seven minutes old. WV received the opening kickoff, made one first down on the running of Weirton's Tom Curtis and Paden City's Steve Billeter and then was forced into a punting situation. However, Weirton Madonna's Bill Vitar was unable to get his boot off because of a low pass from center and was tackled on his own 31 by Jim Jackson of Mingo and Bill Bates of Cadiz.

It took the Buckeyes eight plays to score from there. They broke Wintersville speedster Don Young loose for 10 yards and Bellaire's Dave Hudson picked up 10 in three carries before the quarterback from Brilliant, Bob Evans, sneaked to a first down at the seven. Young then zipped for five on a cutback but Evans lost two on a keeper at end. On third down Young started right as if to circle end and threw a halfback pass which Union Local's Ron Dean snared in the end zone for the TD. A pass by Evans for the extra point try was incomplete.

Early in the second period the Mountaineers got a second break when Magnolia's Ted Stewart covered a Buckeye fumble on the Ohio 49 but Mt. Pleasant's Charles Demote dropped Warwood QB Frank Biega for a 12 yard loss and WV was stymied.

Ohio penetrated to the blue and gold 39 midway through the second frame with another Young to Dean pass picking up 15 precious yards. Wheeling Central's Dave Singer and Frank Papini dropped Bates for a seven yard loss and the Buckeyes were ultimately forced to punt.

Late in the half the fans saw two interceptions on successive plays as both clubs tried to strike by air to beat the clock. West Virginia's Joe Yoho, from Cameron, grabbed a toss from Winterville's Denny Montgomery but on the next play Montgomery returned the favor. After Powhatan's Bob Renolds had deflected a Biega aerial, Montgomery latched onto the ball for the interception.

"1993" All-Star Game - 25 Years Ago

Much of the largest crowd in the history of the Rudy Mumley OVAC All-Star Football Charity Classic finally began filling out of Wheeling Island Stadium with about six minutes left in Sunday night's 22nd annual Ohio-West Virginia scrap.

The much anticipated battle between Billy West of Buckeye Local and Curtis McGhee of Wheeling Central took a back seat to Bishop Donahue quarterback Mark Gordon, who passed for nearly two hundred yards in the second half.

Who could blame the fans for trying to get a head start on the island traffic bottle-neck? The Mountain States who trailed 26-14, had just given the ball back to the Buckeyes by having too many men on the field following an Ohio punt.

With a weapon like Buckeye Local's Billy West in the Ohio backfield and time whirling off the stadium clock, the show was obviously over for a gallant West Virginia squad.

In one of the most incredible turnarounds in all-star grid annals, the Mountain Staters scored three touchdowns in the final 2:53 and stuffed West on a two-point conversion with less than a minute to go to pull off a 34-32 shocker.

Determination helped West Virginia hold Ohio to minus four yards on three snaps following the late penalty to force another punt.

A pass from Donauhue's Mark Gordon - who took every snap at QB for Blake's squad - to Weir's Marcus Clausell gave West Virginia a first down at the four and the second of two sweeps by Wheeling Central's Curtis McGhee cut the lead to 26-21 following Matt DiLorenzo's PAT.

There was just 2:53 showing on the stadium clock but the Mountaineers seemed as animated on the sidelines as a team nursing a one point lead in the waning moments of a state championship game.

DiLorenzo, an all-state soccer player

at Wheeling Park ripped a hard, low roller perfectly toward the right sideline.

An Ohio player stepped just inside the ten-yard buffer zone in an attempt to field the ball but the bounding oval bounced off his helmet as he was crunched by the West Virginia pursuit. When the pile unfolded, West Virginia had the ball.

Shadyside's Chad Wiley on the very snap following the recovery, blew through the line to sack Gordon back at the West Virginia 42.

John Marshall's J. B. Burge steeped in front of the pass at the Ohio 45 and found nothing but green and white stripes between himself and a Mountain State TD.

Burge's six pointer and the DiLorenzo PAT appeared to have put Ohio down for the count with less than a minute to play but, like West Virginia a few minutes earlier, the Buckeyes proved that they too were made of sterner stuff.

After the kick-off, Wellsville's Andy Martin found a seam in the middle of the West Virginia coverage team and broke it all the way for an all-star game record 99yard TD return as the Ohio stands erupted.

With 43 seconds remaining, the Buckeyes now trailed 34-32 and everybody in the stadium knew who was going to get the ball on the two-point conversion try.

West had been held to just 16 yards on six totes after intermission. Ohio lined up in a strong-right information for the critical two-pointer with west taking the toss and rolling toward the right sideline, looking to cut back behind a wall of blockers.

The seam never opened and West had to sprint for the corner where Brooke's Buck Neel was waiting. West tried to power through Neel inside the five but the Bruin star held his ground and tumbled the play out of bounds at the two.

In the opening frame, Ohio stayed on the ground with West scoring first at the 3:58 mark of the first quarter. Just as they were plagued throughout the contest, Ohio was shut out of the PAT.

West Virginia bounced back late in the frame that highlighted the running of McGhee and was keyed by a 28-yard Gordon-to-McGhee pass. On the first play of the second frame, McGhee carried for eight yards and the score, followed by a DiLorenzo boot to give the Mountaineers a 7-6 upper hand.

After trading possessions, the Buckeyes took control on the West Virginia 16. West rant for 7 yards, Schehl for six and West for two more before West took it in with 5:42 on the clock. Ohio led 12-17, as once again the PAT was unsuccessful.

Two plays later, Ohio again got on the board as River's Don Hendershot stripped the W. Va. runner of the ball and returned it 30 yards for a score at 4:51. Call added a two-pointer for a 20-7 Ohio lead.

In the third quarter, West Virginia narrowed the gap to 20-14 as Gordon connected with Bishop Donahue's Artie Moore for 40 yards then McGhee scored from the five at 3:45. DiLorenzo added the PAT.

Ohio retaliated in the third as the Beallsville passing combo of Dana Kelley and Ron Street combined for three completions and 27 yards and the running of Schehl and West added 26 more yards, with Schehl getting the final two yards at 1:16 to push the Buckeye lead to 26-14.

With the Ohioans leading 26-14 as the third quarter closed with a spirited free-for-all in front of the Mountaineer bench that resulted in five player ejections.

The two teams combined for over 600 yards of total offense. West had 131 yards on 21 carries to lead all rushers while Moore had five catches for 133 yards – all in the second half pace the receiving corp. Gordon completed 14 of 26 passes for 214 yards.

Dr. Robert Jones is a native of Scribner, Nebraska where he attended West Point High School as a multi-sport athlete in football, basketball, track and baseball. After an outstanding high school football career, he received a scholarship to the University of Nebraska where he played for the great college coach, Bob Devaney.

After college, he was selected by the Washington Redskins to start his professional career. He spent a year with the team on the taxi-squad. From the Redskins, Jones went to the Wheeling Ironmen where he played from 1964 to 1967.

While playing and teaching in the Ohio Valley, he started medical school at West Virginia University. He graduated from medical school in 1972, graduating third in his class. After surgical residency and internships from 1972 to 1979, he came to Wheeling and started his practice where he continues to treat patients to this day. Jones is one of the prominent surgeons in the Ohio Valley and is licensed in Ohio and West Virginia.

He and his wife Rita live in Wheeling and have six children.

Dr. Jones has been involved with the game since 1984. Dr. Luis Vasquez was the Ohio team doctor invited him to become the West

Virginia team doctor. He has as a simple self-diagnosis to explain his affliction for football. "The game is in my blood and I know of no antibiotic, pill or shot that can get it out of my system. I got involved because of the game of football. The appeal is the game itself ... it doesn't matter what aspect it is."

Many of the games he has seen and worked were good. But one – the 1987 Classic – stands out as great because of the luminous stars that who played in the contest. Ohio – featuring St. Clairsville's duo of Shawn Vincent and John Spencer - defeated the Alex Shook led West Virginia team 13-11 in the All-Star game played at Steubenville because of the renovations to Wheeling Island Stadium.

Of course, the main purpose of football and other sports is to teach the participants qualities they can take with themselves throughout their lives. Football was no different for Jones. He says he learned self-discipline – a necessary component in any surgeon's mental make-up – by playing football all his life. "The discipline of football pushed me to be into the medical field and to be a surgeon," Jones said.



There's a lot more to playing an all-star football game than X's and O's. For proof, just ask Todd Fullerton, who will coordinate all the medical services for tonight's Rudy Mumley OVAC® All-Star Charity Football Classic.

"Basically, my job is to make sure all the i's are dotted and the t's are crossed," Fullerton said, laughing.

Among Fullerton's i's and t's are:

- Making sure enough trainers, doctors and emergency technicians are present, in case of injury.
- Ensuring that the teams have plenty of supplies, from medical tape to ice packs.
- Telling coaches if players injured during the game are healthy enough to return to action.
- Deciding whether or not to play, delay or cancel a game because of weather conditions.

From a medical standpoint, the key to keeping a game running smoothly is communication, Fullerton said. "Basically, we try to work with each other and communicate with the coaches," Fullerton said. "There's a lot of communication between everyone involved."

Fullerton holds a Bachelors Degree in physical education from The Ohio State University and a Masters Degree in exercise physiology from the University of Arizona.

But, Fullerton said, "There's nothing quite as special as the OVAC®." That's why he returned to the Ohio Valley in 1984. He currently works as a registered nurse at MedExpress in Elm Grove. "People like (Van Horne, Simpson and the late Sam Mumley) were very instrumental and influential in high school sports," Fullerton said. "There's great camaraderie, great fellowship...sometimes the kids don't realize what they have until they are out of it."

Fullerton lives in Triadelphia and is the proud father of two adult children - Jaclyn who will graduate from WVU this August and Jake, who will be entering his junior year at WVU.

Along with his football duties, Thompson also spent many years as the track coach at Union Local.


A 1970 UL graduate, Thompson owns a degree from Bethany College in 1974.
