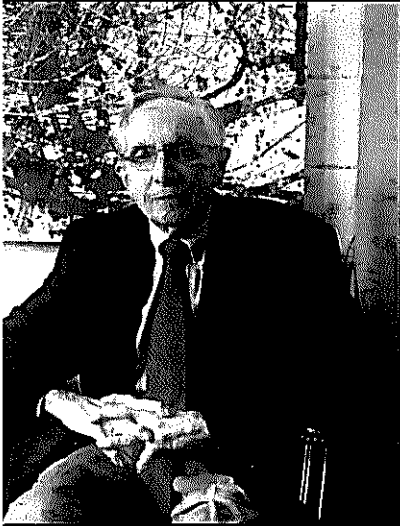
RULES OF THE GAME

1. Each game will consist of two 20 minute halves.
2. Zone presses may be used but must end after first trap past half court.
3. Man-to man defense must be played in the normal attack area.
4. Each player must make an appearance in both halves. Attempts should be made to give all 15 players equal playing time.
5. Dunking will be permitted during the pre-game warm-up.
6. All overtime periods shall be three minutes in length.
7. Each player is allowed six (6) personal fouls before he is disqualified.
8. Teams will be permitted one full time-out and two :30 time-outs per game. No one & one until the last two minutes of game. Double bonus will be sh on the 10th foul at all times. One & one will be shot on the 7th foul only in last 2 minutes of game.

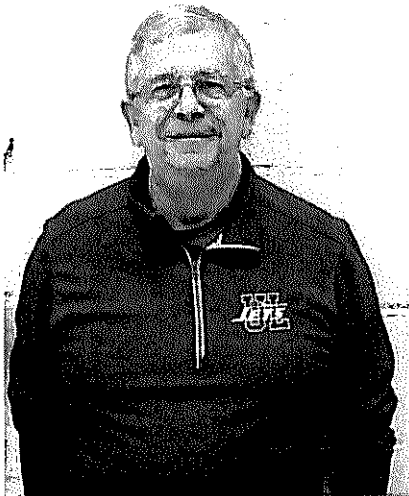

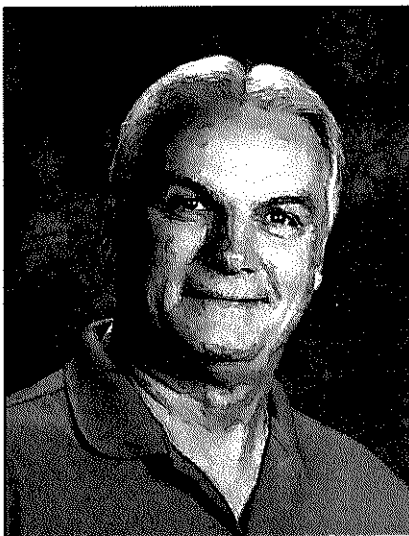

Kim Clifford

Kim Clifford and coaching success became synonymous during his more than 30-year career as head basketball coach at both Cadiz and St. Clairsville High Schools. Clifford stepped down last spring after a 27-year tenure with the Red Devils in which he racked up 371 career victories. All told, Clifford finished his prep coaching career with a 27-22 career record.

Today, Clifford is adding another bullet point to his lengthy resume. He's being recognized with the Earl Haberman Boys Basketball Coach Award.

Clifford's most memorable season came in 2012 when he guided the Red Devils to their only Division II State tournament appearance in school history. They won the OVAC, District and Regional championships that season. They came back in 2013 and won another district and OVAC title, but fell just short of the state tourney.

When he was at Cadiz, Clifford guided the Cardinals to a conference title there, too. It came in his first season as head coach, which was the 1985-86 season.

Though he was out of coaching, Clifford spent a lot of time in the gymnasium this winter. His three sons – Ryan (St. Clairsville varsity), Justin (Harrison Central varsity) and Kurt (St. Clairsville junior high) – all guided their respective teams to strong seasons.

Donald H. Hofreuter, M.D.

Dr. Donald Hofreuter is known by many around the Ohio Valley for his medical practice and then as former CEO of Wheeling Hospital. But, his presence in the Ohio Valley far exceeds that, especially on the athletics landscape. He has been one of the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference's biggest supporters in a myriad of areas, including the annual A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Basketball Game and the sport of basketball. Because of that, Hofreuter is receiving the Burton Service Award at today's annual all-star game.

Hofreuter helped the OVAC out of financial crisis many years ago. He and several others got together to help the conference, but that was just the start. He combined his medical practice and sports by offering medical clinics for every football player and official in the Ohio Valley on Saturdays during the fall. He also provided the OVAC official a free physical prior to their seasons.

Along with his work with the OVAC, Hofreuter served as the Chairman of the Linsly Board for 35 years and has worked at the school for 50 continuous years. He also spent 21 years on the Wheeling Park Commission and more than 20 years working with Wheeling Health Rite.

Still, Hofreuter found time to practice medicine from 1961 until his retirement in 1993. He then took over as the CEO of the hospital and held that position until 2006.

Roger Levi

Seeing Roger Levi on the basketball court became a commonplace during his 44-year run as basketball official. That kind of career allowed Levi to officiate more than 2,200 varsity boys and girls both Ohio and West Virginia. That dedication to the craft has earned Levi this year's Robert Dawson Award at today's OVAC Samuel A. Mumley All-Star Basketball Games.

Levi's expertise earned him 17 state-tournament assignments during his career. He worked weekend on the Ohio side 12 times (five boys and seven girls) and three boys in West Virginia and Levi actually worked a state title game in both genders in both states, which is a rarity. Prior to the tournament, Levi received 65 regional tournament assignments in both states. On top of his post-season Levi was recognized as the Ohio District 5 and District 12 Official of the Year during his career.

Though he's retired from working on the court, Levi still serves as the secretary-treasurer of Valley Board of Approved Officials. He's maintained that position for the last 10 years. He had spent two terms as the board's president.

Roger is currently a member of the OHSAA Official's Hall of Fame. He was elected in 2008.

Roger Micker

Roger Micker coached no fewer than five sports during his 40-year career at Steubenville High. However, it was in girls' basketball where he left his biggest imprint.

Micker is being recognized for his career in girls hoops today at the Samuel A. Mumley OVAC Basketball Game with the annual Richard Saffield Girls Coach Award.

Micker ascended to the role of head coach of the Big Red girls in 1984 and guided teams consecutive sectional titles. Twice he lost in the district championship game to the eventual state champion by a combined eight points. Micker's 1986 team won the OVAC and Eastern Buckeye Athletic League with a school-record 22 victories.

Along with his on-court success, Micker was chosen to coach in two OVAC All-Star Games and a number of Eastern District All-Star games. On top of his girls hoops duties, Micker also coached football, basketball, track and volleyball.

Micker graduated from Yorkville High School in 1966 and then from West Liberty State College.

Thomas E. Owings

As it pertains to basketball at Union Local High School, Thomas Owings is a fixture. Each year since the 1986-87 season, Owings has found himself seated at the center of the scoring table for each of the Jets' home basketball game as the clock operator. The following season, Owings added the girls' to his resume. Add all of that up and Owings is the 2019 recipient of the Thomas E. Rataiczak Timer and Keeper Award at today's Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Game.

Owings, who graduated from Seton Central High School in 1968, grew up in Flushing. After high school, he attended Ohio State University and earned a bachelor's degree in civil engineering. He returned to the Ohio Valley and opened his own company, Owings Contracting. He's since retired after a career in construction. He has built many homes in the Ohio Valley.

Along with his work at basketball games, Owings has worked with the Union Local Boosters and served as the club as its president.

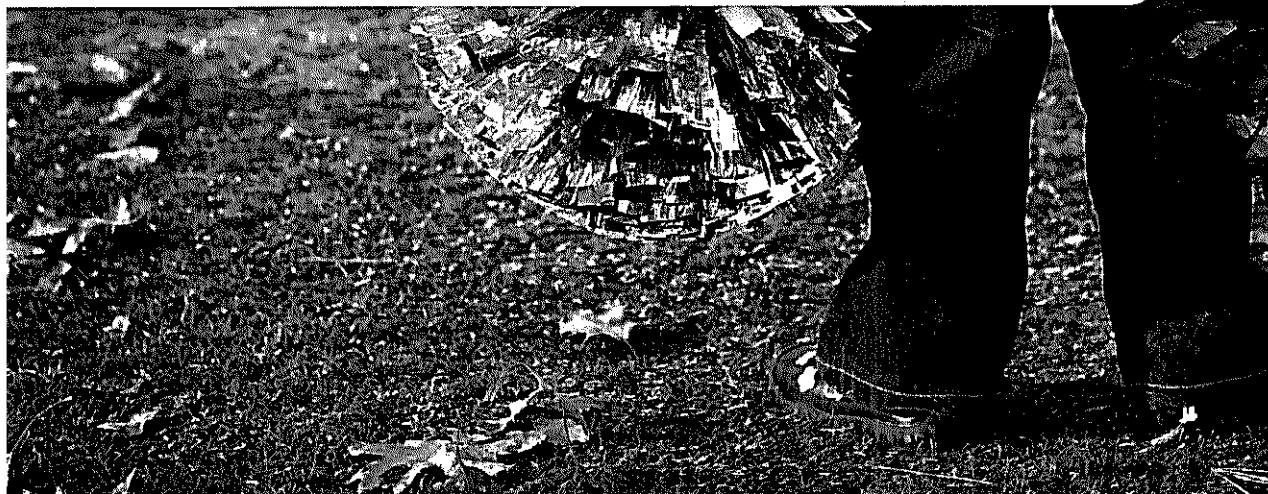
Thomas is the father of two grown children, Tammy and Thomas, who reside in Cleveland Heights and Medina, respectively, with their families.
