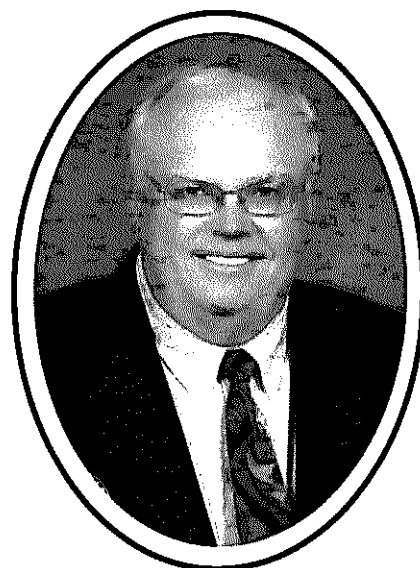
74th Ohio Valley Athletic Conference® Annual Rudy Mumley All★Star Football Game

There are many words to describe the life of Rudolph Mumley, but perhaps the most appropriate would be service.

For most of his 80-plus years, Mumley, known as "Rudy" to his legion of friends, worked on behalf of many causes. None were more important to him than the youth of the Ohio Valley.

It is befitting that the game which fans are witnessing this evening is named in his honor. If it hadn't been for Rudy's willingness to step forward, the Ohio-West Virginia All-Star Game would not have existed the last 28 years, and it now appears to be a fixture that will carry it well into the next millennium.

The game's history goes back to the early 1940s and, for many years after that, it was sponsored by booster club associations from Eastern Ohio and the West Virginia northern panhandle.

However, the game could not receive NCAA sanction and consequently was held during the spring to allow players who had received scholarships to NCAA schools an opportunity to participate.

When it became apparent that the booster club organizations could no longer sponsor the game, it ceased to exist. An idea was presented to Sam A. Mumley Sr. that the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference® could assume sponsorship of the game and apply for NCAA sanction.

One of the requirements toward receiving NCAA sanction was that only 60 percent of game proceeds could be spent to cover expenses and the other 40 percent had to be used for charitable purposes.

Once the game received sanction, the OVAC® had another problem. It was experiencing financial problems and did not have the resources to provide "seed" money that would be needed to purchase uniforms, pay for training camp and other start-up expenses such as insurance.

Sam Mumley, who was the executive secretary of the OVAC®, appealed to his uncle, Rudy, to provide the financial help. The story has become legend on how Rudy, a bachelor who lived with his beloved sister, Lillian, in the Warwood area of Wheeling, mortgaged their home to receive a loan. The rest, as the saying goes, is history.

There was more adversity to overcome for this inaugural OVAC® venture. The Ohio Valley experienced damaging floods during June of 1972. Wheeling Stadium sustained considerable damage and the facility would not be available for the early August game.

Sam Mumley called his longtime friend, the late Edmund Joseph, who was then athletic director at Martins Ferry High School and asked if the OVAC® could use Ferry Stadium. Once Joseph took the request to school officials and received permission, the game was finally on.

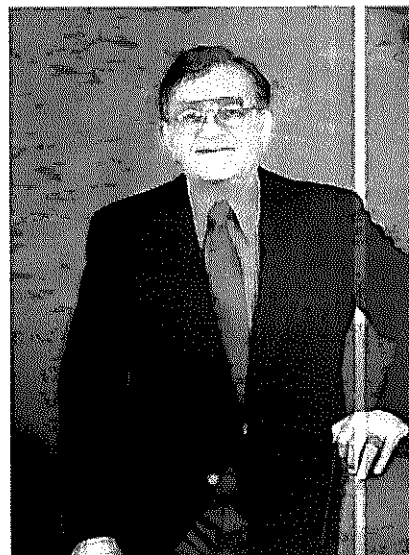
However, on the day of the game, the area was hit hard by a rainstorm. More adversity. By this time, you could not fault Rudy Mumley, who agreed to serve as game director, if he was feeling a bit jinxed. Several hours before kickoff was scheduled, the rain stopped and the sun came out. It turned into a beautiful evening, and the game went off like clockwork before a capacity audience.

The OVAC® was in business as far as renewal of the Ohio-West Virginia midsummer classic was concerned.

However, that's not the end of the story. Over the next two decades-plus that Rudy Mumley served as game director, he made numerous improvements to the game. He turned it from just an all-star game into an extravaganza.

He took the all-star gridders to camp at West Liberty State College, his alma mater, and a place where he had long-standing ties. Each year, Mumley added activities for the players to help them pass the time and provide some relief from the rigors of training camp.

He enlisted the help of the Osiris Shrine and this group gave the game a more meaningful

purpose as it would eventually gain the lion's share of the charity proceeds.

Through his good friend, the late George Strager, another mid-week event, "An Evening With the Stars," was initiated and handled with impeccable care by two other longtime friends, Mike Young and Pete Cuffaro.

From the time the OVAC® assumed sponsorship of the game, Mumley brought back the Stone & Thomas "Queen of Queens" Pageant which had been a part of the All-Star Game series when it was sponsored by the booster club associations. Stone & Thomas continued to sponsor the event over the next two decades-plus. In recent years, the queen's pageant has continued under the sponsorship of Kaufman's of Wheeling and WTOV-9.

In the meantime, Mumley enlisted the help of Glenn Didriksen and his family, which owned and operated several McDonald's Family Restaurants in the area, to form the McDonald's All-Star Band. This has become an increasingly popular feature of the game.

Mumley's innovative mind produced a game that would help kick off the Ohio Valley football season, a classic that would involve some 60 to 70 football players annually and several hundred bandsmen. Add to that some 25 to 30 queen candidates and a myriad of volunteers who helped make the 10-day to two week experience a memorable part of their lives.

For a number of years, Rudy and his nephew Sam, along with other OVAC® officials and the dedicated men from the Osiris Shrine, would hold a pep rally at Russek Field on the campus of West Liberty State College. Several thousands of people attended these events and, of course, it was Rudy who usually stole the show.

From his days at old Wheeling High to those at West Liberty State College, Rudy was always there to help. Following a stint in the military service, he spent the next three decades or so as an educator, primarily in Eastern Ohio. He was principal at Buckeye South High when he retired.

His service to the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference® was ongoing for more than three decades, and he served as president on two different occasions.

Through his efforts and those of his many friends who joined with him to work on various facets of the all-star classic, more than \$600,000 has been provided to Ohio Valley charitable groups.

Several years before his death, which came in early February of 1999, Mumley relinquished directorship of the game to his longtime associate and close friend, Ron Mauck.

Nonetheless, Rudy still remained a familiar figure on the sidelines. His walk had slowed considerably although he had bounced back from a series of illnesses. But, the enthusiasm was as great as ever. He had seen the game reach new heights last year when it was televised live by WTOV-9 and the game still drew a near-capacity crowd.

It was a fitting tribute that OVAC® officials several years ago renamed the contest as the Rudy Mumley OVAC® Charity All-Star Game.

Rudy was to become one of the most recognizable sports figures the Ohio Valley had ever produced. He was honored as the Dapper Dan's "Man of the Year" in 1992, and earlier was inducted into the Athletic Hall of Fame at his beloved West Liberty State College, following in the footsteps of his late brother, Eli, Rudy was the first non-athlete or non-coach to earn this honor, and in recent years, he became a prominent benefactor to the school.

Educator, humanitarian and philanthropist. That's the legacy of a guy who wanted to be known simply as Rudy. And as long as this game can survive, fans of the Ohio Valley for the coming generations will be able to look skyward and say, "Thanks, Rudy!"

For more than three decades, Samuel A. Mumley served the youth of this area as executive secretary of the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference®.

Last February, "Sammy" was called home by his maker to receive his just reward for a lifetime spent in service to others.

Perhaps the greatest compliment one can pay Sam Mumley following his passing is to say that he made his world a much better place to live because he once walked among us.

Mumley devoted nearly five decades to working for the youth of our Ohio Valley. In addition to his time as executive secretary of the OVAC®, which is still believed to be the largest high school athletic conference of its kind in the United States, Mumley was an athletic trainer, coach, basketball official, teacher and a school administrator.

If that wasn't enough time to give, Mumley joined Eric Carder, an assistant principal and director of activities at Wheeling Park High School, in serving as co-director for the West Virginia Super Six state high school football championships, which they brought to Wheeling Island Stadium six years ago.

Additionally, the pair helped secure the West Virginia state soccer championships held last year at the brand new athletic facility at Wheeling Jesuit University.

Sam also played a major role in the wonderful mid-summer football spectacle you are attending tonight at Wheeling Island Stadium. Renamed several years ago to honor his uncle, who also passed away earlier this year, the Rudy Mumley Charity All-Star Football Classic was revived in 1972 under the sponsorship of the OVAC®.

In those days, the NCAA made things difficult for sponsors seeking sanction to hold various all-star contest. The local Ohio-West Virginia All-Star game had been dormant for many years after having been a fixture on the Ohio Valley gridiron scene since the early 1940s. Both Mumley's spent hundreds of hours putting together the formula for a program that the NCAA found acceptable. Today, the game is more vibrant and popular than ever among the area football fans, who nearly pack the Island Stadium each and every July to kick off a new gridiron campaign.

They also helped turn this event into more than just a football game. It has become a mid-summer spectacular complete with an All-Star Band, cheerleaders and the pageantry of a Queen of Queens contest.

It also helped raise hundreds of thousands of dollars for charitable organizations in the Ohio Valley over the past 26 years.

Much of these wonders have been achieved because Mumley refused to take "no" for an answer from anyone and because he dared to dream what many of us have considered to be impossible dreams.

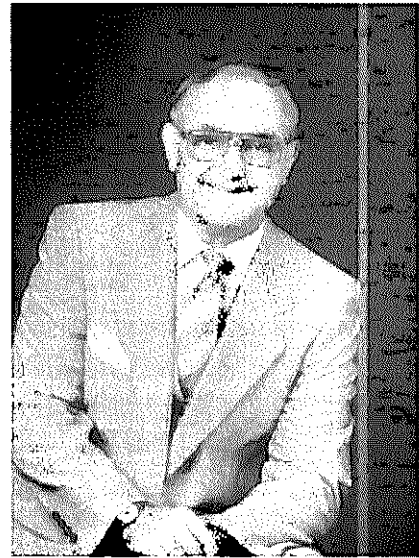
Who would have believed that the state high school football championships could ever be lured out of Charleston to the Northern Panhandle?

Sam did.

And Wheeling will host the state title games for the sixth straight year the first weekend of December.

Through his fund-raising efforts and the help of countless corporate sponsors and Super Six volunteers from up and down the Ohio Valley, the state football finals have been raised to a level that may never be matched in the Mountain State.

When Mumley came back to take over a second time as executive secretary of the OVAC®, the league was in dire financial straits.

Through Mumley's efforts and the backing of other leaders in the community, an OVAC® Foundation Board was formed to serve as a fund-raising arm of the bi-state league. That board is still in existence today.

The sports programs at the various schools were improved immensely. All-star games are now held each year in football, boys' and girls' basketball, baseball, softball and boys' and girls' soccer. The OVAC® sponsors championship tournaments in wrestling, swimming, tennis, golf, volleyball, baseball, softball, boys' and girls' soccer, boys' and girls' cross country, boys' and girls' track, cheerleading, etc.

Girls sports have risen to equal importance because Sam had the foresight and the courage to support each and every program offered by the OVAC®. His efforts with girls' sports earned Mumley a seat on the equity panels for both the Ohio High School Athletic Association and the West Virginia Secondary School Athletic Commission.

The scholarship program also has been enhanced by Sam's ability to involve the corporate sector of the various communities within the extensive OVAC® map. At last May's OVAC® Banquet of Champions held at the Wheeling Civic Center, more than \$15,000 in scholarship money was awarded to deserving OVAC® student-athletes.

That money wasn't just found on the street corner; it was obtained largely through tireless efforts of the late executive secretary.

Sam put the OVAC®'s "kids" first in all his dreams and work for the conference. "What can we do for the 'kids'? How can we make things better for them?" Those were the first questions he posed whenever the OVAC® or Super Six would discuss changes in their programs.

He took great pains to involve everyone in conference business. He was constantly in touch with media members, keeping them updated on matters and seeking their opinions.

When important final decisions had to be made, Sam didn't mind being the one to make them. But he did so after many discussions among his constituents and his own private soul-searching. And, of course, his main concern was making sure that the decisions were in the best interest of the OVAC® student-athletes.

From a personal standpoint, if Sam became your friend, he was your friend for life. He was always there with a kind word, a bit of advice if it was asked for, and encouragement when any of his friends were in a difficult situation.

I once wrote in a column that Sam was no saint, but that he was sent to us by angels to perform good works and turn our impossible dreams into reality.

He dearly loved his wife, Nancy, who remained by his side through good times and rough times. No different from the rest of us, Nancy became part of the OVAC® family as well, taking care of the conference's financial books, a role she continues to handle today.

They were married just 11 years when Sam passed away. But, as Nancy once said, they crammed 40 years of happiness into that short time.

A long bout with cancer terminated Mumley's life at the too young age of 67. But, as this writer has stated before, you won't make me believe "Sammy" lost that fight with cancer. Nothing defeated Sam Mumley in his lifetime. God, whom Sam believed in with all his heart, simply decided it was time to call him home.

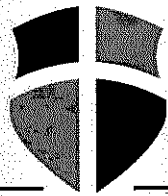
Sam Mumley was one of a kind.

“1940” The First All★Star Game

West Virginia's senior All-Star schoolboys today held a 13 to 17 victory as the aftermath of their first meeting with the eastern Ohio team in the maiden football contest played under the new lighting system at the Island Stadium.

The victory of the mountain state youths, who had trailed from the opening quarter until the last seven minutes of the ball game, 7-0, came as a mild surprise as two well-drilled and highly efficient combinations delighted an early season crowd of some 8,000 fans.

The Ohioans drew first blood in the spectacular contest. A Mallery-Shackleford pass, late in the first period, moved the Buckeyes from midfield to the West Virginia 25. Sadlowski, another Bellaire back, took a pass that planted the ball on the nine, from where Sadlowski scored in two plays.

The remainder of the half was devoid of a distinct threat on the part of either team although the Rowe-Howell coached combine had advanced to the Ohio 25 when the intermission arrived.

The mountaineer sturdy rush line battled the equally effective Ohio forwards on fairly even terms into the final period before Johnny August, a Shady-side youth, who shared the starting role for the Bucks, was hit hard on his own 30 and Joe Corba, a Follansbee back, seized the white leather for the eventual winners.

Charlie Helinski, Union product, became a ball of fire at this stage. He wheeled off tackle to the Ohio 19 and then lugged the leather to the five aided by a too many times out penalty. Helinski picked up a yard and Mike “Punchy” Dimitro punched his way into the payoff zone. Dimitro cracked the line for the extra point and the issue was deadlocked.

Passes Decide Battle

The West Virginia stands settled back after this furious display satisfied with a 7-7 standoff, but the mountaineers were fired with the idea of victory when one of Joe Mallery's passes was intercepted near the 50 shortly after the succeeding kickoff.

Helinski nipped successive passes to Phil Saseen and after the second toss to the Central Catholic back had planted the ball on the Ohioans nine. Helinski and Dimitro required three tries before the former had found the pay dirt and the West Virginia youths had a 13-7 lead.

The remaining time allowed for another kickoff and the West Virginians successfully negotiated an onside kick, recovering the ball as the fray ended.

Coaches Bill Kerns of WVU and Don C. Pedden of Ohio University were the honorary mentors and in addition to sitting on the benches of the contesting squads, both spoke over the P.A. system at halftime. Kerns was accompanied here by Frank Kutz, one of his line mentors, and Ray Carnelly, his plebe mentor. The trio departed today for Charleston and tonight's North-South Game, although Kerns had an opportunity to talk to some local prospects.

Bill Stobbs, the Wheeling native who tutors the Wittenberg athletic teams, was one of the spectators in the stands. Another was George Roark, coach of W & J's Presidents, and probably there were others.

Carl Hamill, Weirton's cagey tutor was in the dressing room to minister to a pair of his former Red Riders. Tony Brown aggravated an old should injury while Luke Tomasovich received a cracked rib.

The West Virginians showed big Sedor due respect while the prospective

Ohio State youth was in the game. His Shady-side backfield mate, August despite his costly fumble, was one of the big guns in the Bucks' effort and the Niemiec-Hartwig combinations thrusts left the West Virginia fans worried.

Lou Caffaro, recovering from a nasal operation, held the sticks for the West Virginians but felt the call of battle in his impassive role. Paul Bricker, Weirton end who handled the kicking for Howell and Rowe, and did an effective job although one of his boots slipped off the side of his foot and out of bounds.

“1969” All-Star Game - 50 Years Ago

Scoring two touchdowns before they had ever run a play from offensive formation, the underdog West Virginia gridders made an early lead stand-up in a 12-0 victory over Ohio in the annual Ohio Valley all-star football game, played before 3,800 fans Saturday night at Wheeling Stadium.

The intrepid Mountaineers shocked the favored Buckeyes with two long and sudden scoring strikes in the first six minutes of the ball game as Wellsburg's little Kit Kull raced 70 yards with a punt for the initial TD and Weirton's Jeff Jennessee picked a fumble out of the air and rambled 63 yards for the second score.

A giant defense line and the celebrated passing arm of St. John's Central quarterback Allen Hornyak had made Ohio the pre-game pick but West Virginia laughed at the odds. The Mountaineers short-circuited the touted Ohio Aerial game with six interceptions - five on passes by Hornyak and one throw by Winterville's Pat Kuzum. After the quick Mountaineer scores early in the game, Ohio fought back and made deep penetrations into West Virginia's territory but was thwarted once by a fumble at the Mountaineer four and subsequently by interceptions - one each in the second quarter by Triadelphia's Gary Tominack and Bishop Donahue's Mark Skypack and four more in the second half.

The Buckeyes never really mounted a serious offensive threat in the second half. In fact after intermission they were never inside the W.Va. 45 as two interceptions by Weirton's Tom Battista and one each by John Marshall's Iggie Kalcum and Triadelphia's Don Ward took the steam out of their attack.

On the other hand, coach Dan Hamill's Mountaineers mounted two serious bids in the third quarter. The John Marshall passing combination of quarterback Tweedlie and flanker Norm Whitlatch combined for three straight completions good for 45 yards and advanced the W.Va. Club to the Buckeye 27 but there the threat petered out.

Subsequently, a Bastista interception gave W.Va. the oval at the Ohio 37. It was Tweedlie to Witlatch for seven yards and Kalcum made a first down at the 26. However, a pass interception by Gary Clutter, of Winterville, in his own end zone killed this bid. Early in the fourth quarter, Tweedlie's 36-yard punt that rolled out of bounds at the Ohio six put the Bucks in a deep hole and they were never able to climb out of their own territory the rest of the warm evening. Hornyak was intercepted three times in the last five minutes of the game.

Actually, Mountaineer defenders latched on to more Buckeye passes than did Ohio receivers. Ohio completed just 5 of 22 aerials for 54 yards while West Virginia hit nine of 23 for 93 yards. Coach Denny Bowman's ground game, with St. John's star Tom Kouski, Martins Ferry's hard running Dave Bruney and Winterville's Clutter doing the heavy duty ball-toting, managed 135 yards but the West Virginia defenders stopped it when they had to. The Mountaineers made just 93 yards rushing and had only seven first downs to Ohio's 10. Moreover, West Virginia backs were tossed for losses of 32 yards to Ohio's 11. Each side lost 20 yards to penalties. At game's end it was announced that Kull had been selected as the outstanding W.Va. back and Skypack as its outstanding lineman. On the Ohio side, honors went to Kouski and St. Clairsville giant Tom Baxa.

West Virginia played alert opportunistic football to attain and protect a 12-0 lead in the first half. Kull's sprint to the initial TD came before the game was five minutes old as he gathered in a punt by Ron Bobek of Shadyside at the West Virginia 30, zipped up the west sidelines as his teammates mowed down the would be tacklers, and galloped 70 yards to the end zone. The placement for extra point by Triadelphia's Gary Tominack was wide.

Ohio bounced back after the next kickoff to penetrate to the West Virginia 37 but then Hornyak's handoff attempt was popped into the air and Weirton's

Jeff Jennessee grabbed it and sprinted 63 yards to a second six pointer which came with 4:45 left in the period. The placement attempt for the extra point by John Marshall's Tom Tweedlie was partially blocked by Bobek.

Late in the opening frame, Ohio was presented with a scoring opportunity when Greg Harris, husky tackle from Bellaire, covered a fumble by Wheeling quarterback Jim Brinkman at the Mountaineer 25. The white shirted Buckeyes ground out nine yards in three tries but on the fourth down St. John's halfback Tom Kouski was pilled up short of the necessary real estate by Greg Turner of Triadelphia, Gary Roman of Weirton Madonna and Jennessee.

Early in the second quarter, Winterville's Gary Clutter returned a punt by Tweedlie 16 yards to the West Virginia 35. After Kouski made six yards and Ferry's Dave Bruney got two at the line, Hornyak passed to Ferry's Rich Weiskircher for seven yards and threw down the middle to tight end Len Masci of Winterville, to put the oval at the four. At this point, Winterville's QB Pat Nuzum came in for Hornyak but fumbled on the attempted handoff with Lambert Tsubiaries, big tackle from Wellsburg, recovering for the Mountaineers at the four.

Later, a Hornyak pass was picked off by Tomanick, who carried it from the W.Va 37 to the Ohio 34. However, the Mountaineers could not take advantage of this opportunity. They made one first down on Tweedlie's passing but the threat died on an unsuccessful dive by Kill of a Tweedlie fourth down throw at the goal line.

As time ran out in the first half, a penalty for grabbing the face mask advanced West Virginia to the Ohio 40, and gave the blue shirts a chance for one more play. With the Bucks obviously expecting a pass, West Virginia broke Iggie Kalcum loose and the John Marshall back carried to within 14 yards of the goal line before being stopped.

"1994" All-Star Game - 25 Years Ago

Vanishing two touchdown leads for Ohio and West Virginia's amazing ability to come back from adversity has become the storyline in the annual Rudy Mumley OVAC Charity Football Classic.

A pair of very costly major penalties and three critical turnovers by the Ohio All-Stars and the bruising second half of West Virginia's Art Miller from Weir High guided the Mountaineers to their second straight come-from-behind win with a 19-14 decision over the Buckeyes in the 23rd annual OVAC mid-summer classic at Wheeling Island Stadium Sunday night.

A near-capacity crowd of close to 10,000 fans looked on as the West Virginia stars of coach P. K. Poling pulled off their second consecutive win from a two touchdown deficit. Last season, the Mountaineers rallied from a 12-point deficit to take a 34-32 decision.

Coach Ron Pobolish's Ohio squad managed to open a 14-0 lead in the first half with late scores by Martins Ferry's Mikale Roby in both the first and second quarters. In the second half, lightning struck the Ohio stars quickly as the Buckeyes fumbled away the opening kickoff to set up the first West Virginia score.

"We made a couple of turnovers in the second half and we let Art Miller put on his show," Pobolish said after the tough Buckeye loss. "He's a great cut-back runner and he seemed to turn it up a notch in the second half."

After outgaining the Mountaineers by nearly 180 yards in the first half, Ohio's offense was put on the back burner in the second half. The Buckeyes were seriously hurt by a pair of fumbles, an interception, and two unsportsmanlike penalties in the second half. "The kickoff return turned the tide of the game," Pobolish noted. "Then we had a big penalty that gave them the ball inside the 20. Then it was just mistake after mistake after mistake. One penalty in the last five minutes just took the starch out of us.

After stopping a lengthy game opening possession by the West Virginians, Ohio took advantage of a strange string of events to put the ball in the end zone first.

The Buckeyes went to the air on their first play with Steubenville Central's Mike Orlando connecting on a 34-yard aerial to Bellaire's Scott Coyne from their 20 to the Mountaineer 46. Two QB sacks by West Virginia and an Ohio penalty pushed Ohio back to their 36 and Roby's 17-yard gainer only set the stage for the Buckeye's first punt.

Ohio's punt by Ryan Bodo of Indian Creek resulted in a West Virginia fumble that was covered by Union Local's Justin Abel for the Buckeyes at the hosts 18. Orlando connected for eight yards to Martins Ferry's Chad Martin and Roby then went off right tackle for the first ten yards to give the Ohio stars a 6-0 lead at 1:59 of the first quarter. Josh Eell's PAT try was wide.

A bad snap on the field goal attempt by West Virginia and back-to-back QB snaps totaling 18 yards by Ohio's Ben Knapp of Cambridge and Rich Thell of St. Clairsville provided the punch for the second Buckeye score.

Taking over on its 36 at the 3:33 mark of the second frame, Ohio opened with a 19-yard gainer by Roby and added five on an Orlando to Martin pass. Orlando added another yard before Scott Coyne took a handoff from Bodo and on a fake punt and picked up five yards for a key first down. Roby ran for five yards, Orlando passed to Martin for nine and threw to Edison's Kevin Koontz for 19.

With just 58 seconds left in the first half, Roby drove over the goal line for his second score. Martin added the two-point conversion on an end-around to stretch the Ohio lead to 14-0.

In the second half, West Virginia struck quickly, with the help of Jason Marling's fumble recovery at the Ohio 35 on the opening kickoff. Miller picked up a yard to the 34, but an Ohio pass interference penalty moved the West Virginians to the 10. Two carries by Miller added 11 yards and one by John Marshall's Larry Bunting added one.

Steubenville's Bobby Lamantia sacked West Virginia's Jeff Hunt, but Hunt came right back with a 10-yard

pass to Oak Glen's Charlie Licata to the five. Miller swept the right side and scored his first of three six-pointers at the 7:48 mark. Bunting booted the PAT.

From the Ohio 24, Orlando passed to Martin at the 34, but the Buckeye receiver coughed up the ball at the 35 and West Virginia's Robert Brown of Valley grabbed the loose ball.

Miller went to the middle for one-yard, Wheeling Central's Bill Isaly passed to Licata for nine yards to the 25 and the elusive Miller then broke through a huge hole on the left side and rambled to the end zone for his second score. A muffed PAT attempt left the Ohio lead at 14-13 with 8:05 on the board.

A series of critical miscues namely two personal foul infractions by the Ohioans, allowed the West Virginians an opportunity to score the eventual game winner.

With 6:43 on the board, the Mountaineers took possession on the Ohio 44 and went to Miller. His running and a costly 15-yard penalty by Ohio pushed the ball to the three. Miller blasted over the middle for the score with 3:08 on the clock. With a 19-14 lead, West Virginia was unable to add the PAT.

Ohio's last ditch effort in the final minutes was thwarted by a West Virginia pass interception by Paden City's Jeff Starcher.

Ohio finished with 78 yards on the ground while adding 161 in the air as 11 of 22 passes clicked. The Buckeyes managed just seven first downs while losing all three fumbles and giving way to six penalties totaling 60 yards. Roby led the Buckeye rushes with 56 yards on seven carries.

West Virginia finished with 147 yards rushing, with Miller picking up 129 on 23 carries, and 22 in the air as three of 13 passes hit the mark. The winners had 20 first downs, lost their only fumble and were penalized three times for 21 yards.

Ohio Snaps Losing Skid In OVAC All-Star Game.

Seminoles' LaFollette Named MVP of 21-14 Buckeyes Win.

WHEELING — A small-school quarterback showing up in a big-time game. On easily the biggest stage of his career, Monroe Central's Ryan LaFollette proved beyond a shadow of a doubt he has what it takes.

LaFollette collected game Most Valuable Player honors after racking up 255 yards of total offense as Ohio snapped a three-game losing streak with a 21-14 victory against West Virginia in the 73rd annual OVAC Rudy Mumley All-Star Football Game on Saturday night at Wheeling Island Stadium. LaFollette completed all 11 of his pass attempts for 136 yards and a score and also carried 21 times for 119 yards and two more touchdowns in his final prep game.

“We put in the work this week and it showed on Saturday night in front of a lot of people,” LaFollette said. “I just trust my game, play hard and know that I can play with great potential against great competition. “I just try to perform my best.”

Even with LaFollette's effort, West Virginia still had the football and looked to be going in for the tying score a little less than halfway through the fourth quarter. A 5-yard pass from University's Clay Bailey to Wheeling Park's Rennie Clark had the Mountaineers with a second-and-goal at the Buckeyes 3. However on the ensuing play, the ballcarrier was stripped and Union Local's Bradan Lucas came out of the pile with the football.

Ohio took over with 8:29 to go and although it ended up punting five plays later from its 19, precious time ran off the clock. It turned out to be a good thing for the Buckeyes, too.

Taking over at the Ohio 32 after a shanked punt, West Virginia quarterback Colby Brown threw three straight incompletions. The Cameron product just escaped pressure on fourth down and fired a jump ball to the end zone, where Magnolia's Brooks Parsons — four catches, 79 yards — beat the coverage and came down with the ball for a touchdown to make it 21-14 with 5:37 remaining.

“We knew where we were going to struggle and that's always a plus to know where your work is cut out for you,” West Virginia coach Scott Holt of Cameron said. “They dominated the line of scrimmage on both sides but we hung in there for being out-sized and having a lot of kids out of position.

“They played well. They did nothing to embarrass themselves, their schools or their conference and I am proud of them for that.” Taking over at their 39 with 5:28 left, the Buckeyes put the game on ice by picking up three first downs on a pair of runs by LaFollette and another by Steubenville's Jonathan Blackmon.

“I'm just happy for our kids and our coaching staff,” said Ohio coach Bruce Stiles, who led his final game after stepping down at Union Local. “You're involved in a lot of wins and losses but I guess you will kind of remember your last one the most.

“The first half I thought we shot ourselves in the foot with wrong formations and things like that. It was just little things that we didn't do well in the first half we did better in the second half.”

Ohio jumped out quickly as LaFollette led a seven-play, 88-yard drive that culminated in a 28-yard touchdown pass to Big Red's Jamaal Petteway. The Mountaineers looked to answer before Meadowbrook's Easton Black picked off Brown at the Ohio 1.

Later in the first quarter John Marshall's Dereck Hess returned a punt 14 yards to the Ohio 29. Four plays later Brown found Brooke's Ethan Secrist on a beautifully thrown 9-yard fade for an equalizer that eventually left the teams tied 7-7 at halftime.

The only score of the third quarter came on Ohio's first drive. Toronto's Jake Keenan — team-leading four catches and 70 yards — hauled in a 12-yarder to get the march started. He came down with a 10-yard gain and LaFollette ripped off runs of 13 and 18 yards before going in from the 1 to make it 14-7.

LaFollette added some insurance when he scampered down the sideline and into the end zone from 26 yards away early in the fourth quarter.

“Not bad, huh?” Stiles said of LaFollette's performance. “What an athlete. Physically he has really developed since the season.

“West Virginia came out and lit us up, too. They were physical.”

Brown led the Mountaineers, who were held to 19 yards rushing, by completing 10 of 18 passes for 155 yards. Secrist caught four of those, good for 53 yards.

“The inability to get any momentum going was a problem.” Holt said. “We got a big play here or there, but we didn't have many drives that were 5, 6 yards a clip the way they did it.

“When you get a rhythm and get some confidence is when you are able to put some points on the board. They were able to do that and we really weren't.”

Dr. Robert Jones is a native of Scribner, Nebraska where he attended West Point High School as a multi-sport athlete in football, basketball, track and baseball. After an outstanding high school football career, he received a scholarship to the University of Nebraska where he played for the great college coach, Bob Devaney.

After college, he was selected by the Washington Redskins to start his professional career. He spent a year with the team on the taxi-squad. From the Redskins, Jones went to the Wheeling Ironmen where he played from 1964 to 1967.

While playing and teaching in the Ohio Valley, he started medical school at West Virginia University. He graduated from medical school in 1972, graduating third in his class. After surgical residency and internships from 1972 to 1979, he came to Wheeling and started his practice where he continues to treat patients to this day. Jones is one of the prominent surgeons in the Ohio Valley and is licensed in Ohio and West Virginia.

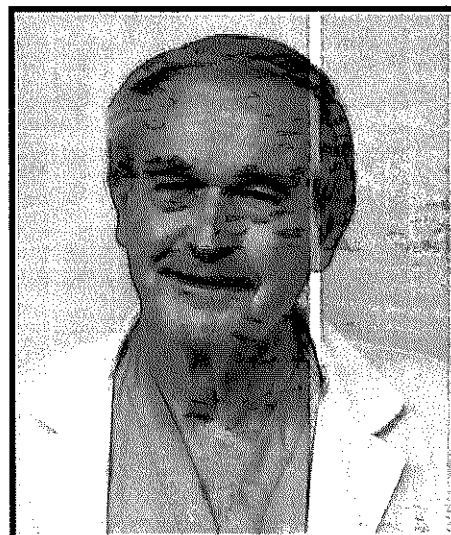
He and his wife Rita live in Wheeling and have six children.

Dr. Jones has been involved with the game since 1984. Dr. Luis Vasquez was the Ohio team doctor invited him to become the West

Virginia team doctor. He has as a simple self-diagnosis to explain his affliction for football. "The game is in my blood and I know of no antibiotic, pill or shot that can get it out of my system. I got involved because of the game of football. The appeal is the game itself ... it doesn't matter what aspect it is."

Many of the games he has seen and worked were good. But one – the 1987 Classic – stands out as great because of the luminous stars that who played in the contest. Ohio – featuring St. Clairsville's duo of Shawn Vincent and John Spencer - defeated the Alex Shook led West Virginia team 13-11 in the All-Star game played at Steubenville because of the renovations to Wheeling Island Stadium.

Of course, the main purpose of football and other sports is to teach the participants qualities they can take with themselves throughout their lives. Football was no different for Jones. He says he learned self-discipline – a necessary component in any surgeon's mental make-up – by playing football all his life. "The discipline of football pushed me to be into the medical field and to be a surgeon," Jones said.

There's a lot more to playing an all-star football game than X's and O's. For proof, just ask Todd Fullerton, who will coordinate all the medical services for tonight's Rudy Mumley OVAC® All-Star Charity Football Classic.

"Basically, my job is to make sure all the i's are dotted and the t's are crossed," Fullerton said, laughing.

Among Fullerton's i's and t's are:

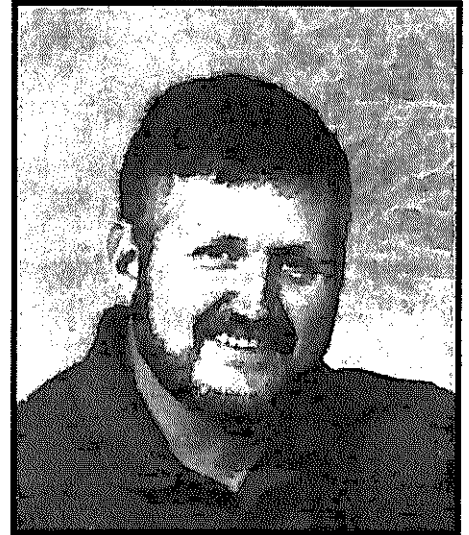
- Making sure enough trainers, doctors and emergency technicians are present, in case of injury.
- Ensuring that the teams have plenty of supplies, from medical tape to ice packs.
- Telling coaches if players injured during the game are healthy enough to return to action.
- Deciding whether or not to play, delay or cancel a game because of weather conditions.

From a medical standpoint, the key to keeping a game running smoothly is communication, Fullerton said. "Basically, we try to work with each other and communicate with the coaches," Fullerton said. "There's a lot of communication between everyone involved."

Fullerton holds a Bachelors Degree in physical education from The Ohio State University and a Masters Degree in exercise physiology from the University of Arizona.

But, Fullerton said, "There's nothing quite as special as the OVAC®." That's why he returned to the Ohio Valley in 1984. He currently works as a registered nurse at MedExpress in Elm Grove. "People like (Van Horne, Simpson and the late Sam Mumley) were very instrumental and influential in high school sports," Fullerton said. "There's great camaraderie, great fellowship...sometimes the kids don't realize what they have until they are out of it."

Fullerton lives in Triadelphia and is the proud father of two adult children - Jaclyn who will graduate from WVU this August and Jake, who will be entering his junior year at WVU.



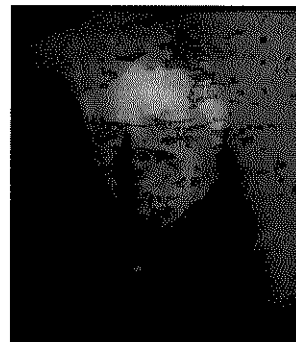

Kimes, who owns two West Virginia state titles as an assistant at Parkersburg, is slated to move to Warren Local for the upcoming season. Along with his football duties, he coached baseball at Parkersburg from 2003 until 2010.

WINTERSVILLE -- Before formally accepting the invitation to coach in the 74th OVAC Rudy Mumley All-Star Football Game, Indian Creek's Andrew Connor wanted to make sure he had a commitment from his coaching staff.

That was a quick and resounding yes from all of the members.

"The guys are really excited," Connor said. "We have three guys who played in the game and one (Matt Shreve) who is celebrating his 10th anniversary, so that was pretty cool."

The staff will lead the Ohio squad into the game on Saturday, July 27th at Wheeling Island Stadium. The coaches will begin work with their players on Sunday, July 21 when they report to camp at Bethany College.

"We're going to try to do our part to make sure we hold up our end of the bargain and have these kids prepared to represent Ohio as well as possible," Connor said.

Slated to join Connor on the sideline are Joe Hammack, Rob Lucas, Mike Voltz, David Kemp, Joe Strohmeyer and Matt Shreve.

Shreve has been working with Connor for four years. Along with his football duties, he also coaches wrestling.

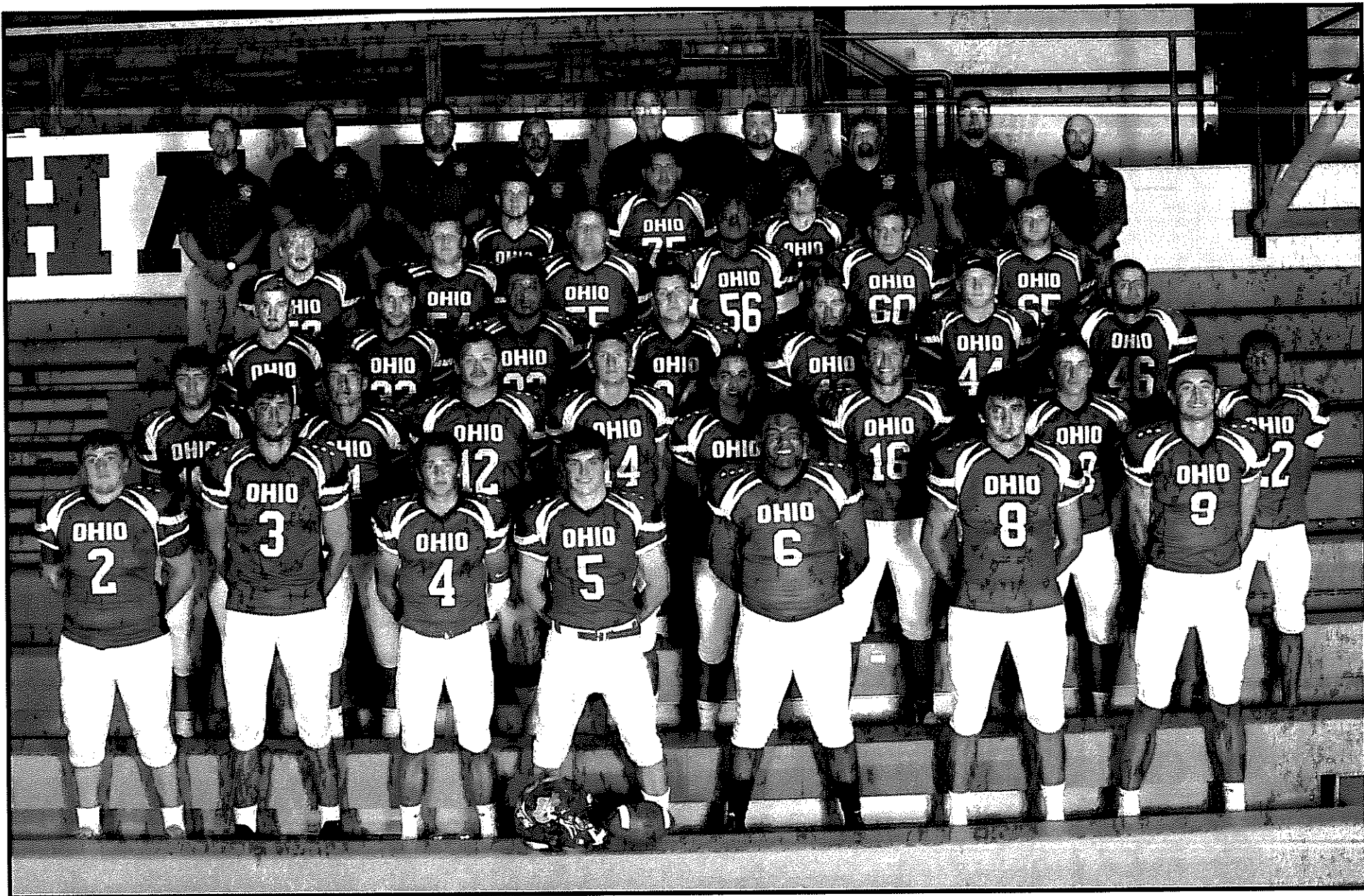
Shreve, who attended Martins Ferry and West Liberty University, was named a captain of the Ohio squad in 2009.
