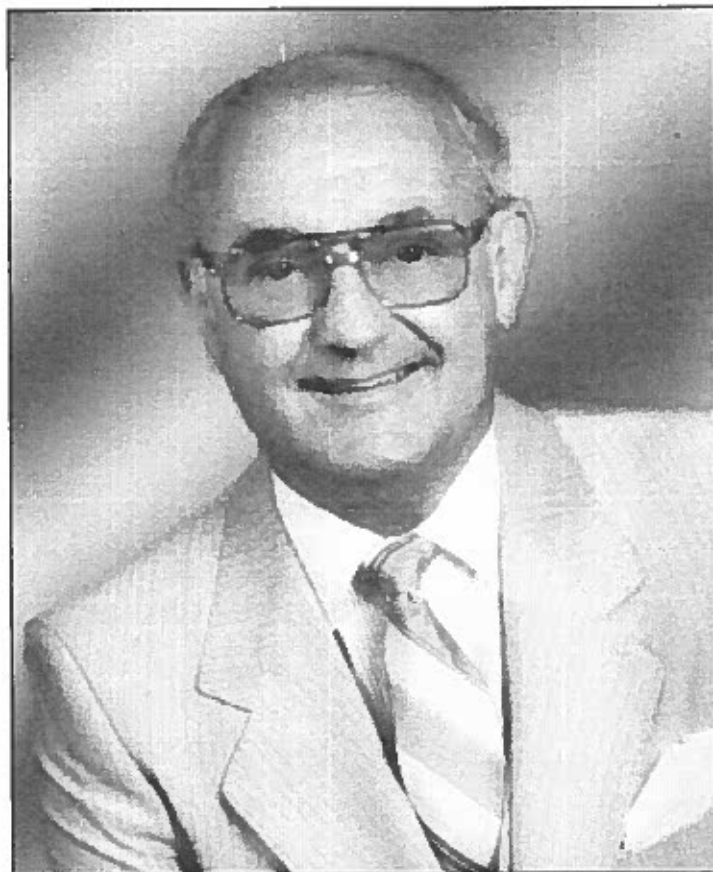

RULES OF THE GAME

1. Each game will consist of two 20 minute halves.
2. Zone presses may be used but must end after first trap past half court.
3. Man-to man defense must be played in the normal attack area.
4. Each player must make an appearance in both halves. Attempts should be made to give all 15 players equal playing time.
5. Dunking will be permitted during the pre-game warm-up.
6. All overtime periods shall be three minutes in length.
7. Each player is allowed six (6) personal fouls before he is disqualified.
8. Teams will be permitted one full time-out and two :30 time-outs per game.
No one & one until the last two minutes of game. Double bonus will be shot on the 10th foul at all times. One & one will be shot on the 7th foul only in last 2 minutes of game.

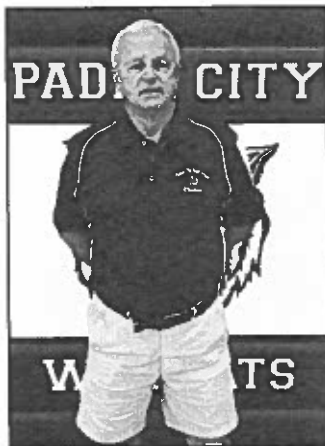

John Sorrenti

John Sorrenti has seen his share of good basketball games and players. Up close and personally, too.

Sorrenti spent basically his entire adult life stationed court side at area gymnasiums, calling basketball games for WEIR Radio in Weirton.

Actually, the 1956 Weir High graduate began broadcasting at the ripe old age of 16 and continue doing games until he retired from radio in 1994 after 40 years of basketball, football and baseball.

Upon retiring, the itch to call the action was still there, so he accepted a position for a short time at WTOV-9 in Steubenville.

Regardless of the outlet, Sorrenti's voice became part of the game for many and his commitment and passion are what have earned him the Bob Burton Distinguished Service Award as part of today's Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Game.

While sports and broadcasting have been a major part of Sorrenti's life and career, he's been quite active in the community of Weirton as well as the entire Ohio Valley.

He worked for Hancock County Schools and served as the Adult Education and Placement Coordinator of the John D. Rockefeller IV Career Center before retiring in 1998.

John and his wife have three children and four grandchildren.

Mike DelRe

It's by no means hyperbole to say Mike DelRe laid the foundation for the Madonna girls basketball program. Actually, it's 100 percent factual.

DelRe, who is being honored today as the recipient of the Richard Saffield Girls Coach Award, started the program at Madonna in 1972, which was almost three school years after he was hired as a science teacher.

In the spring of 1972, DelRe organized an all-female team to play prior to a charity game between the Chamber of Commerce and the Weirton Rotary at Weir High School.

That was all it took to spark an interest in girls basketball. From there, the Blue Dons' program was born.

Madonna played its first official girls basketball season during the 1972-73 school year.

Three seasons later, Madonna -- with DelRe still at the helm -- became one of the Ohio Valley's leaders in girls basketball. He worked with the OVAC to have the sport recognized in the conference and the first championships were held in 1976.

Madonna claimed its first conference title in 1977 and actually DelRe won two conference titles in 1977. Because, the state of West Virginia shifted girls basketball to the fall. It's believed that DelRe is the only coach in OVAC history to win two OVAC titles, in the same sport, in the same year.

DelRe coached the inaugural OVAC All-Star Girls Basketball Game in 1977 and was later chosen in 2002. The Mountain State won both times he coached.

In 1978, the Blue Dons climbed to the top of the small-school mountain in West Virginia, winning the state championship with a spotless 25-0 record. That year also started the annual tradition of the 'City Championship Game' against Weir.

After the 1979 season, DelRe became the women's basketball coach at the College of Steubenville (now Franciscan University), which is a post he held for two seasons. He returned to Madonna as an assistant in 1999 and then took over the head-coaching job for one season and led the Dons back to the state semifinals.

On top of his girls basketball exploits, he also started the volleyball program at Madonna. He coached tennis at Weir and also worked as a girls basketball assistant there for five years before taking over the Director of Athletics until he retired in 2017.

DelRe, who is a 1965 graduate of Moundsville High School, earned a degree from West Liberty and a Master's in Education from West Virginia.

DelRe and his wife Ruth, whom he married in 1970, have two adult children, Meredith Ratke, who lives in Manhattan Beach, Calif. and MJ, who resides in Bethel Park, Pa.

Mike Coyne

It didn't matter what part of Ohio or West Virginia you ventured for a basketball game. If there was a big game, there was a good chance that Mike Coyne would be one of the officials assigned to the game. That was the case for the better part of his 40-plus year career as a basketball official.

During his career, Coyne has received numerous accolades, including induction to the OHSAA Officials Hall of Fame. He's adding another piece of hardware today as the recipient of the Robert Dawson Officials Award at the Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Game.

Coyne has been a registered official for 42 years. He's reached the top of the officiating ladder by working the state tournament 24 times combined between Ohio and West Virginia. Of those assignments, 17 came in the Buckeye State.

Before getting to the state tournament, Coyne's presence has been felt in regional play, too. He has worked 49 regional tournament games and more district games than he could continue to count.

Coyne's work has earned him Ohio State Official of the Year in 1990 and he was also recognized in 1992 with the Upper Ohio Valley Dapper Dan Club Outstanding Achievement Award. He was the District 5 Official of the Year in 2019 and he had earned the District 12 honor in 1990.

In January of 2020 Coyne was recognized for his work to the Cancer Research Classic, which he worked for the first 12 year's of the event's history. Coyne is a member of the Ohio Valley Board of Basketball Officials.

Coyne also pointed out the support he received from his wife of more than 40 years, Rose Ann. The couple has three children. Their oldest son, Scott, is deceased. Their surviving children are Casey and Todd. Todd is also a highly regarded basketball official.

C.W. "Chink" Ward

If you go to basically sporting event that involves Fort Frye, you're more than likely going to cross paths with C.W. "Chink" Ward.

That's especially true if you attend a basketball game -- of either gender -- in the Cadets Gymnasium in Beverly where Ward has been a fixture at the scoring table for half a century.

Because of his long-standing devotion to Fort Frye and the game of basketball, the OVAC All-Star Basketball Game Committee is presenting Ward the 2021 Thomas E. Rataiczak Timer/Scorekeeper Award at today's OVAC All-Star Game.

Ward first became active in supporting Fort Frye athletics in 1958. He's never stopped. He's been a fan and/or booster ever since.

It was during that 1958 football season when Ward was asked to run the scoreboard for Cadets football games. He accepted the offer and did the job until retiring in 2013.

It wasn't until 1970 when he was approached about getting involved with basketball. He began keeping score, stats and running the clock during that season and was there for every game again this winter.

Ward also worked with the softball team, keeping the book for 10 years and he served as the Fort Frye Booster Club Secretary/Treasurer for 12 years.

Ward was in attendance when both Fort Frye basketball teams that have won regional titles played in the OHSAA's State Tournament in Columbus. He was in the crowd in 1962 and at the table in 1999.

Fred King

FRED KING -- quite simply -- was an institution at Paden City High School.

Actually, you could stretch it to all over Wetzel County. On top of his work there, he's been a heavy contributor to the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference.

Today, he's recognized for his years of service to the sport of basketball by virtue of receiving Earl Haberfield Award, which is presented annually to a boys basketball coach.

Prior to arriving at Paden City High School full time in 2001 up until his retirement in 2017, King had teaching stops at Frontier, Sistersville High School, Magnolia and Valley High Schools as well as Newport Junior High School, Paden City Middle School, Tyler Consolidated Middle School, Short Line School and Paden City Elementary. You name the sport and King's has probably coached or been involved.

He's been highly successful as a volleyball coach for the Wildcats, winning three OVAC and our sectional titles.

In basketball, King won three sectionals as the head coach at Sistersville and with the Wildcats, he guided his team to three sectional titles and a regional runner-up finish six times.

Along with his 17 years as the boys basketball coach, he also spent the same tenure as the Paden City volleyball coach and Director of Athletics.

Prior to arriving at Paden City, King had a successful career as a baseball coach. He was on the Frontier staff when the Cougars were state runnerup in 1980. He was also an assistant coach for a pair of football state championships at Sistersville High School in 1985 and 86.

On top of his coaching, King serves on the OVAC Basketball Championship Committee. He's also served on the OVAC Volleyball Committee and was a Class 1A representative to the OVAC's Executive Board.

Fred and his wife, Debbie, will celebrate their 41st wedding anniversary in June.

The couple has two adult children, Michael, who lives in Cheat Lake, WV, and daughter, Brittany Levitt, who resides in North Canton with her husband, Matt. The Kings have two grandchildren.
