There are many words to describe the life of Rudolph Mumley, but perhaps the most appropriate would be service.

For most of his 80-plus years, Mumley, known as "Rudy" to his legion of friends, worked on behalf of many causes. None were more important to him than the youth of the Ohio Valley.

It is befitting that the game which fans are witnessing this evening is named in his honor. If it hadn't been for Rudy's willingness to step forward, the Ohio-West Virginia All-Star Game would not have existed the last 28 years, and it now appears to be a fixture that will carry it well into the next millennium.

The game's history goes back to the early 1940s and, for many years after that, it was sponsored by booster club associations from Eastern Ohio and the West Virginia northern panhandle.

However, the game could not receive NCAA sanction and consequently was held during the spring to allow players who had received scholarships to NCAA schools an opportunity to participate.

When it became apparent that the booster club organizations could no longer sponsor the game, it ceased to exist. An idea was presented to Sam A. Mumley Sr. that the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference® could assume sponsorship of the game and apply for NCAA sanction.

One of the requirements toward receiving NCAA sanction was that only 60 percent of game proceeds could be spent to cover expenses and the other 40 percent had to be used for charitable purposes.

Once the game received sanction, the OVAC® had another problem. It was experiencing financial problems and did not have the resources to provide "seed" money that would be needed to purchase uniforms, pay for training camp and other start-up expenses such as insurance.

Sam Mumley, who was the executive secretary of the OVAC®, appealed to his uncle, Rudy, to provide the financial help. The story has become legend on how Rudy, a bachelor who lived with his beloved sister, Lillian, in the Warwood area of Wheeling, mortgaged their home to receive a loan. The rest, as the saying goes, is history.

There was more adversity to overcome for this inaugural OVAC® venture. The Ohio Valley experienced damaging floods during June of 1972. Wheeling Stadium sustained considerable damage and the facility would not be available for the early August game.

Sam Mumley called his longtime friend, the late Edmund Joseph, who was then athletic director at Martins Ferry High School and asked if the OVAC® could use Ferry Stadium. Once Joseph took the request to school officials and received permission, the game was finally on.

However, on the day of the game, the area was hit hard by a rainstorm. More adversity. By this time, you could not fault Rudy Mumley, who agreed to serve as game director, if he was feeling a bit jinxed. Several hours before kickoff was scheduled, the rain stopped and the sun came out. It turned into a beautiful evening, and the game went off like clockwork before a capacity audience.

The OVAC® was in business as far as renewal of the Ohio-West Virginia midsummer classic was concerned.

However, that's not the end of the story. Over the next two decades-plus that Rudy Mumley served as game director, he made numerous improvements to the game. He turned it from just an all-star game into an extravaganza.

He took the all-star gridders to camp at West Liberty State College, his alma mater, and a place where he had long-standing ties. Each year, Mumley added activities for the players to help them pass the time and provide some relief from the rigors of training camp.

He enlisted the help of the Osiris Shrine and this group gave the game a more meaningful

purpose as it would eventually gain the lion's share of the charity proceeds.

Through his good friend, the late George Strager, another mid-week event, "An Evening With the Stars," was initiated and handled with impeccable care by two other longtime friends, Mike

Young and Pete Cuffaro.

From the time the OVAC® assumed sponsorship of the game, Mumley brought back the Stone & Thomas "Queen of Queens" Pageant which had been a part of the All-Star Game series when it was sponsored by the booster club associations. Stone & Thomas continued to sponsor the event over the next two decades-plus. In recent years, the queen's pageant has continued under the sponsorship of Kaufman's of Wheeling and WTOV-9.

In the meantime, Mumley enlisted the help of Glenn Didriksen and his family, which owned and operated several McDonald's Family Restaurants in the area, to form the McDonald's All-Star Band.

This has become an increasingly popular feature of the game.

Mumley's innovative mind produced a game that would help kick off the Ohio Valley football season, a classic that would involve some 60 to 70 football players annually and several hundred bandsmen. Add to that some 25 to 30 queen candidates and a myriad of volunteers who helped make the 10-day to two week experience a memorable part of their lives.

For a number of years, Rudy and his nephew Sam, along with other OVAC® officials and the dedicated men from the Osiris Shrine, would hold a pep rally at Russek Field on the campus of West Liberty State College. Several thousands of people attended these events and, of course, it was Rudy

who usually stole the show.

From his days at old Wheeling High to those at West Liberty State College, Rudy was always there to help. Following a stint in the military service, he spent the next three decades or so as an educator, primarily in Eastern Ohio. He was principal at Buckeye South High when he retired.

His service to the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference® was ongoing for more than three decades,

and he served as president on two different occasions.

Through his efforts and those of his many friends who joined with him to work on various facets of the all-star classic, more than \$600,000 has been provided to Ohio Valley charitable groups.

Several years before his death, which came in early February of 1999, Mumley relinquished

directorship of the game to his longtime associate and close friend, Ron Mauck.

Nonetheless, Rudy still remained a familiar figure on the sidelines. His walk had slowed considerably although he had bounced back from a series of illnesses. But, the enthusiasm was as great as ever. He had seen the game reach new heights last year when it was televised live by WTOV-9 and the game still drew a near-capacity crowd.

It was a fitting tribute that OVAC® officials several years ago renamed the contest as the Rudy

Mumley OVAC® Charity All-Star Game.

Rudy was to become one of the most recognizable sports figures the Ohio Valley had ever produced. He was honored as the Dapper Dan's "Man of the Year" in 1992, and earlier was inducted into the Athletic Hall of Fame at his beloved West Liberty State College, following in the footsteps of his late brother, Eli, Rudy was the first non-athlete or non-coach to earn this honor, and in recent years, he became a prominent benefactor to the school.

Educator, humanitarian and philanthropist. That's the legacy of a guy who wanted to be known simply as Rudy. And as long as this game can survive, fans of the Ohio Valley for the coming

generations will be able to look skyward and say, "Thanks, Rudy!"

For more than three decades, Samuel A. Mumley served the youth of this area as executive secretary of the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference.

Last February, "Sammy" was called home by his maker to receive his just reward for a lifetime spent in service to others.

Perhaps the greatest compliment one can pay Sam Mumley following his passing is to say that he made his world a much better place to live because he once walked among us.

Mumley devoted nearly five decades to working for the youth of our Ohio Valley. In addition to his time as executive secretary of the OVAC®, which is still believed to be the largest high school athletic conference of its kind in the United States, Mumley was an athletic trainer, coach, basketball official, teacher and a school administrator.

If that wasn't enough time to give, Mumley joined Eric Carder, an assistant principal and director of activities at Wheeling Park High School, in serving as co-director for the West Virginia Super Six state high school football championships, which they brought to Wheeling Island Stadium six years ago.

Additionally, the pair helped secure the West Virginia state soccer championships held last year at the brand new athletic facility at Wheeling Jesuit University.

Sam also played a major role in the wonderful mid-summer football spectacle you are attending tonight at Wheeling Island Stadium. Renamed several years ago to honor his uncle, who also passed away earlier this year, the Rudy Mumley Charity All-Star Football Classic was revived in 1972 under the sponsorship of the OVAC®.

In those days, the NCAA made things difficult for sponsors seeking sanction to hold various all-star contest. The local Ohio-West Virginia All-Star game had been dormant for many years after having been a fixture on the Ohio Valley gridiron scene since the early 1940s. Both Mumley's spent hundreds of hours putting together the formula for a program that the NCAA found acceptable. Today, the game is more vibrant and popular than ever among the area football fans, who nearly pack the Island Stadium each and every July to kick off a new gridiron campaign.

They also helped turn this event into more than just a football game. It has become a mid-summer spectacular complete with an All-Star Band, cheerleaders and the pageantry of a Queen of Queens contest.

It also helped raise hundreds of thousands of dollars for charitable organizations in the Ohio Valley over the past 26 years.

Much of these wonders have been achieved because Mumley refused to take "no" for an answer from anyone and because he dared to dream what many of us have considered to be impossible dreams.

Who would have believed that the state high school football championships could ever be lured out of Charleston to the Northern Panhandle?

Sam did.

And Wheeling will host the state title games for the sixth straight year the first weekend of December.

Through his fund-raising efforts and the help of countless corporate sponsors and Super Six volunteers from up and down the Ohio Valley, the state football finals have been raised to a level that may never be matched in the Mountain State.

When Mumley came back to take over a second time as executive secretary of the OVAC®, the league was in dire financial straits.

Through Mumley's efforts and the backing of other leaders in the community, an OVAC® Foundation Board was formed to serve as a fund-raising arm of the bi-state league. That board is still in existence today.

The sports programs at the various schools were improved immensely. All-star games are now held each year in football, boys' and girls' basketball, baseball, softball and boys' and girls' soccer. The OVAC® sponsors championship tournaments in wrestling, swimming, tennis, golf, volleyball, baseball, softball, boys' and girls' soccer, boys' and girls' cross country, boys' and girls' track, cheerleading, etc.

Girls sports have risen to equal importance because Sam had the foresight and the courage to support each and every program offered by the OVAC®. His efforts with girls' sports earned Mumley a seat on the equity panels for both the Ohio High School Athletic Association and the West Virginia Secondary School Athletic Commission.

The scholarship program also has been enhanced by Sam's ability to involve the corporate sector of the various communities within the extensive OVAC® map. At last May's OVAC® Banquet of Champions held at the Wheeling Civic Center, more than \$15,000 in scholarship money was awarded to deserving OVAC® student-athletes.

That money wasn't just found on the street corner; it was obtained largely through tireless

efforts of the late executive secretary.

Sam put the OVAC®'s "kids" first in all his dreams and work for the conference. "What can we do for the 'kids'? How can we make things better for them?" Those were the first questions he posed whenever the OVAC® or Super Six would discuss changes in their programs.

He took great pains to involve everyone in conference business. He was constantly in touch

with media members, keeping them updated on matters and seeking their opinions.

When important final decisions had to be made, Sam didn't mind being the one to make them. But he did so after many discussions among his constituents and his own private soul-searching. And, of course, his main concern was making sure that the decisions were in the best interest of the OVAC® student-athletes.

From a personal standpoint, if Sam became your friend, he was your friend for life. He was always there with a kind word, a bit of advice if it was asked for, and encouragement when any of his friends were in a difficult situation.

I once wrote in a column that Sam was no saint, but that he was sent to us by angels to perform good works and turn our impossible dreams into reality.

He dearly loved his wife, Nancy, who remained by his side through good times and rough times. No different from the rest of us, Nancy became part of the OVAC® family as well, taking care of the conference's financial books, a role she continues to handle today.

They were married just 11 years when Sam passed away. But, as Nancy once said, they

crammed 40 years of happiness into that short time.

A long bout with cancer terminated Mumley's life at the too young age of 67. But, as this writer has stated before, you won't make me believe "Sammy" lost that fight with cancer. Nothing defeated Sam Mumley in his lifetime. God, whom Sam believed in with all his heart, simply decided it was time to call him home.

Sam Mumley was one of a kind.

He will remain in our thoughts and prayers forever.

In the beginning... "1940" The First All★Star Game

West Virginia's senior All-Star schoolboys today held a 13 to 17 victory as the aftermath of their first meeting with the eastern Ohio team in the maiden football contest played under the new lighting system at the Island Stadium.

The victory of the mountain state youths, who had trailed from the opening quarter until the last seven minutes of the ball game, 7-0, came as a mild surprise as two well-drilled and highly efficient combinations delighted an early season crowd of some 8,000 fans.

The Ohioans drew first blood in the spectacular contest. A Mallery-Shackleford pass, late in the first period, moved the Buckeyes from midfield to the West Virginia 25. Sadlowski, another Bellaire back, took a pass that planted the ball on the nine, from where Sadlowski scored in two plays.

The remainder of the half was devoid of a distinct threat on the part of either team although the Rowe-Howell coached combine had advanced to the Ohio 25 when the intermission arrived.

The mountaineer sturdy rush line battled the equally effective Ohio forwards on fairly even terms into the final period before Johnny August, a Shadyside youth, who shared the starting role for the Bucks, was hit hard on his own 30 and Joe Corba, a Follansbee back, seized the white leather for the eventual winners

Charlie Helinski, Union product, became a ball of fire at this stage. He wheeled off tackle to the Ohio 19 and then lugged the leather to the five aided by a too many times out penalty. Helinski picked up a yard and Mike "Punchy" Dimitro punched his way into the payoff zone. Dimitro cracked the line for the extra point and the issue was deadlocked.

Passes Decide Battle

The remaining time allowed for another kickoff and the West Virginians successfully negotiated an onside kick, recovering the ball as the fray ended.

Coaches Bill Kerns of WVU and Don C. Pedden of Ohio University were the honorary mentors and in addition to sitting on the benches of the contesting squads, both spoke over the P.A. system at halftime. Kerns was accompanied here by Frank Kutz, one of his line mentors, and Ray Carnelly, his plebe mentor. The trio departed today for Charleston and tonight's North-South Game, although Kerns had an opportunity to talk to some local prospects.

Bill Stobbs, the Wheeling native who tutors the Wittenberg athletic teams, was one of the spectators in the stands. Another was George Roark, coach of W & J's Presidents, and probably there were others.

Carl Hamill, Weirton's cagey tutor was in the dressing room to minister to a pair of his former Red Riders. Tony Brown aggravated an old should injury while Luke Tomasovich received a cracked rib.

The West Virginians showed big Sedor due respect while the prospective Ohio State youth was in the game. His Shadyside backfield mate, August despite his costly fumble, was one of the big guns in the Bucks' effort and the Niemiec-Hartwig combinations thrusts left the West Virginia fans worried.

Lou Caffaro; recovering from a nasal operation, held the sticks for the West Virginians but felt the call of battle in his impassive role. Paul Bricker, Weirton end who handled the kicking for Howell and Rowe, and did an effective job although one of his boots slipped off the side of his foot and out of bounds.

"1996" All-Star Game - 25 Year Ago

Ohio quarterback Jose Davis taught West Virginia coach Jim Thomas and the Mountaineer State's all-stars one of life's vital lessons Sunday evening.

Leaving Davis any time at the end of a half is leaving him too much time.

Seconds after West Virginia had pulled to within six points of their Buckeye State counterparts late in the first half. Davis connected on a 63-yard touchdown bomb to Ryan Caldwell with 46 ticks left before intermission to effectively put the 25th annual Rudy Mumley OVAC All-Star Charity Football Classic on ice.

A prized Kent University recruit, Davis' 65-yard scoring strike 10 Buckeye Local's Dave Cornish less than two minutes into the third quarter essentially squelched whatever comeback hopes the Mountaineers may have entertained and Ohio coasted to a 43-21 win. It was the Buckeyes' second straight win in the series, which Ohio now leads, 14-10. It was the Buckeyes' second straight win in the series, which Ohio now leads, 14-10.

Ohio conch Eric Meek of Wellsville felt all along the play of the men in the trenches would decide who would walk away with the "W," and it became apparent during the clash that the Buckeye blockers weren't about to let any Mountaineers close to Davis, who wasn't sacked all night.

"I said before the game it was very important that we do really well at line of scrimmage," Meek noted, "because of all the big names we had at the skill positions. Games are won and lost at the line of scrimmage and I think our kids did a great job." According to Davis, the big plays wee a result of West Virginia's conservative, packed-in defensive style.

"We expected to come out and score at will," said Davis, who completed 12-of-23 passes for 232 yards and three touchdowns with one interception. "I thought they were (bringing) their defense up a lot, so they were asking for the big play. We knew just what we needed to run to score and get it."

Those home-run touchdown tosses were enough to exasperate Thomas, who was nevertheless quick to credit Ohio's

overwhelming talent for its success.

"Their explosiveness showed." Thomas said, I think my kids played well overall but I look up on the scoreboard and they have 43 points. That's to their credit it. They had the right players at the right times. It seemed like every time we made a mistake, they were able to capitalize on it."

The contest got off to an ominous start for Thomas's, Mountaineers, as a foul up between center Jason Kriston and quarterback Brett McLenn resulted in a fumble on the game's opening snap. Ohio's Luke Schumacher pounced on the pigskin on the West Virginia 29, one of two fumble recoveries for the Monroe Central standout on the night.

Six plays later, Cadiz's Denver Williams juked eight yards to paydirt for the game's initial score.

West Virginia took the ensuring kickoff and marched 32 yards before its 11-play drive stalled at the Ohio 46, and the Buckeyes went back to work, punctuating their second possession of the contest with a 19-yard Davis-to-Campbell TD toss, giving the Ohioans a quick 14-0 lead.

It stayed that way until late in the second quarter, when the Mountaineers, relying on the powerful running of tailback Todd Flanagan, finally dented the scoring column.

West Virginia mounted a patient 10-play, 60-yard drive, with 31 yards coming from Flanagan's legs, capped by a 4-yard scoring sprint by Wheeling Park star Robert Davidson with just 2:12 remaining in the second stanza. Flanagan carried the two-point conversion attempt into the end zone, pulling the Mountain Staters to within 14-8.

However, disaster struck, and it struck quickly, when Davis found a streaking Caldwell down the left sideline with a 63-yard bomb just 86 seconds later to give the Buckeyes a 20-8 halftime advantage.

Ohio kept a firm grip of the game's momentum as Davis barreled out of the locker room and hit Cornish with a picture-perfect 65-yard strike 75 seconds into the second half to pad the Buckeye advantage. 26-8.

Unfortunately for West Virginia, things would get worse before they got better.

Valiantly trying to make something out of nothing on the ensuing kickoff, Davidson coughed up the pigskin to Schumacher at the West Virginia 30 but the Mountaineer defense stiffened, keeping Ohio out of the end zone and thwarting a 27-yard field goal attempt by Beallsville's Rick Meade.

After forcing West Virginia into a three-and-out, though, the Buckeyes struck again when Bellaire's Richie Mamie jaunted 29 yards to paydirt, giving Ohio a 33-8 advantage.

The Buckeyes made it 36-8 when Ray Jefferies' interception of a McLean pass set up Meade's 23-yard field goal.

Weirton Madonna's Joe Barnhart and Linsly's Matt Green added late touchdowns for West Virginia, pulling the Mountaineers to 36-21, but Darryl Elisworth's 2-yard touch-down run with just over four minutes remaining ended the scoring for Ohio.

West Virginia out-rushed its cross-river counterpart, 217 yards to 147, but the Buckeyes recorded a decided advantage through the air, out-passing the Gold and Blue, chalking up 232 stripes compared to the Mountaineers.

"2019" All-Star Game - 2 Year Ago

WHEELING — Controlling the tempo of the game is imperative to success. When it came to the second half, that's what Ohio Coach Andrew Connor thought his team did during the 74th annual OVAC Rudy Mumley All-Star Game Saturday night at Wheeling Island Stadium.

The Buckeyes put together some key plays on both sides of the ball as it got past West Virginia 21-17 to secure a victory.

"I give both teams credit," Ohio coach Andrew Connor said. "Both teams played hard out here and gave everything they had. I thought my team throughout the week practiced hard and I think we were ready to play 48 minutes. I thought the second half of the game we really kind of tilted it toward us whether it was our defense or our offense. I thought we controlled the game toward the end of the third quarter."

St. Clairsville's Brady Kolb was named the game's MVP after a 102-yard, one touchdown perfor-mance on 24 carries.

His 28-yard scamper to the end zone with 1:42 left in the first half tied the game at 14-14 where it remained as both teams went into the locker room for halftime.

"This MVP award really goes to the line." Kolb said. "I thought they really stepped up. We start-ed off a little slow, but we got them up and the line led the way and paved the way. It just really means a lot to me."

Down 17-14, midway through the fourth quarter, Connor put the ball in Kolb's hands as Ohio drove down the field and got on the West Virginia 1 thanks to a handful of direct snaps to Kolb with him answering the bell. He ran the ball 10 times during the drive.

However, right when it looked like the tide was turning in Ohio's favor, Kolb fumbled a snap and Nick Defelice recovered the ball for West Virginia.

"We were pushing it and it's tough to always see a turnover happen in a really important time, but I kept my head up and my team kept their heads up," Kolb said. "They got me up, I got them up and we kept going."

Even with its back against the wall, Ohio stepped up in a big way. Cal Kildow took advantage of a pass as a West Virginia player

slipped down as he picked off Wyatt Hirt three plays later that put Ohio in business.

On the next Ohio offensive snap, Davis Black connected with Kolb's high school teammate Craig Bober for 28 yards to make it 21-17 with 6:06 remaining in the game.

"The two picks we had in the second half were just phenomenal catches," Connor said. "It really helped our offense and we tilted the field and it really helped out."

Ohio put the first points on the board as it drove down the field with an impressive opening drive as Connor Banco crossed the goal line from 3 yards out to make it 7-0.

West Virginia, though, was able to hold Ohio in check for the majority of the first half after that

De'Vaughn McWhorter was the equalizer for West Virginia as he took his first handoff and went 76 yards to the house to tie it at 7-7.

McWhorter wasn't done there. On his second rushing attempt, he maneuvered through the Ohio defense and gave the Mountaineers a 14-7 lead with 7:51 left until halftime.

The former Wheeling Park standout accounted for 102 yards on four carries and caught three pass-es for 24.

"That was a great high school football game," West Virginia coach Mike Eddy said, "These kids committed an entire week of their life to be apart of this. The OVAC did a great job of making it feel special for them. They did exactly what you ask kids to do. They go out and gave great effort from start to finish. That's what allows you to have great football games is by players giving great efforts and they did that."

West Virginia looked to get things going on its second possession of the second half. With the help of a 54-yard connection from Hirt to Jack Stakem, the Mountaineers managed to get to the Ohio 4.

However, the Ohio defense stood firm and held West Virginia to a 21-yard field goal by Jonah Phares.

"That's how this game goes." Eddy said. "That's one of the things that makes it exciting and in-teresting. That's why young players have to learn to be resilient. When those moments happen, they're still in the game and they're still in the moment and they're not overcome with emotion. We talk to players all the time about be passionate about

what you're doing and don't be emotional about what you're doing. Unfortunately at the end, that's when you see emotion instead of passion. It's a fine line sometimes, but I couldn't be prouder of these young men and what they did this week."

Hirt finished the game with 155 yards passing while Stakem led the receiving core with 90 yards on four catches.

For Ohio, Brennon Norris went 9 of 13 for 119 yards while Black had 57 passing yards and a TD. Bober hauled in six receptions for 84 yards to lead the Ohio receiving core.

"It's just an honor. It was an honor to coach these guys," Connor said. "I thought my coaching staff did a great job all week and I thought the kids did whatever they could all week long. These are 31 very special young men and they're parents should be proud of them."

NOTE: There was a small scuffle near the end of the game after a roughing the punter penalty was called on West Virginia. The penalty resulted in an automatic first down for Ohio where it kneeled to wind down the clock.

Along with his football duties, Ross is also a member of the Fort Frye girls basketball staff and has previously worked with the boys basketball and track teams.


After high school, Ross attended Marietta College and completed his post-graduate degree at Muskingum.
