For more than three decades, Samuel A. Mumley served the youth of this area as executive secretary of the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference®.

Last February, "Sammy" was called home by his maker to receive his just reward for a lifetime spent in service to others.

Perhaps the greatest compliment one can pay Sam Mumley following his passing is to say that he made his world a much better place to live because he once walked among us.

Mumley devoted nearly five decades to working for the youth of our Ohio Valley. In addition to his time as executive secretary of the OVAC®, which is still believed to be the largest high school athletic conference of its kind in the United States, Mumley was an athletic trainer, coach, basketball official, teacher and a school administrator.

If that wasn't enough time to give, Mumley joined Eric Carder, an assistant principal and director of activities at Wheeling Park High School, in serving as co-director for the West Virginia Super Six state high school football championships, which they brought to Wheeling Island Stadium six years ago.

Additionally, the pair helped secure the West Virginia state soccer championships held last year at the brand new athletic facility at Wheeling Jesuit University.

Sam also played a major role in the wonderful mid-summer football spectacle you are attending tonight at Wheeling Island Stadium. Renamed several years ago to honor his uncle, who also passed away earlier this year, the Rudy Mumley Charity All-Star Football Classic was revived in 1972 under the sponsorship of the OVAC®.

In those days, the NCAA made things difficult for sponsors seeking sanction to hold various all-star contest. The local Ohio-West Virginia All-Star game had been dormant for many years after having been a fixture on the Ohio Valley gridiron scene since the early 1940s. Both Mumley's spent hundreds of hours putting together the formula for a program that the NCAA found acceptable. Today, the game is more vibrant and popular than ever among the area football fans, who nearly pack the Island Stadium each and every July to kick off a new gridiron campaign.

They also helped turn this event into more than just a football game. It has become a mid-summer spectacular complete with an All-Star Band, cheerleaders and the pageantry of a Queen of Queens contest.

It also helped raise hundreds of thousands of dollars for charitable organizations in the Ohio Valley over the past 26 years.

Much of these wonders have been achieved because Mumley refused to take "no" for an answer from anyone and because he dared to dream what many of us have considered to be impossible dreams.

Who would have believed that the state high school football championships could ever be lured out of Charleston to the Northern Panhandle?

Sam did.

And Wheeling will host the state title games for the sixth straight year the first weekend of December.

Through his fund-raising efforts and the help of countless corporate sponsors and Super Six volunteers from up and down the Ohio Valley, the state football finals have been raised to a level that may never be matched in the Mountain State.

when Mumley came back to take over a second time as executive secretary of the OVAC® the league was in dire financial straits.

Through Mumley's efforts and the backing of other leaders in the community, an OVAC® Foundation Board was formed to serve as a fund-raising arm of the bi-state league. That board is

still in existence today.

The sports programs at the various schools were improved immensely. All-star games are now held each year in football, boys' and girls' basketball, baseball, softball and boys' and girls' soccer. The OVAC® sponsors championship tournaments in wrestling, swimming, tennis, golf, volleyball, baseball, softball, boys' and girls' soccer, boys' and girls' cross country, boys' and girls' track, cheerleading, etc.

Girls sports have risen to equal importance because Sam had the foresight and the courage to support each and every program offered by the OVAC®. His efforts with girls' sports earned Mumley a seat on the equity panels for both the Ohio High School Athletic Association and the West Virginia

Secondary School Athletic Commission.

The scholarship program also has been enhanced by Sam's ability to involve the corporate sector of the various communities within the extensive OVAC® map. At last May's OVAC® Banquet of Champions held at the Wheeling Civic Center, more than \$15,000 in scholarship money was awarded to deserving OVAC® student-athletes.

That money wasn't just found on the street corner; it was obtained largely through tireless

efforts of the late executive secretary.

Sam put the OVAC®'s "kids" first in all his dreams and work for the conference. "What can we do for the 'kids'? How can we make things better for them?" Those were the first questions he posed whenever the OVAC® or Super Six would discuss changes in their programs.

He took great pains to involve everyone in conference business. He was constantly in touch

with media members, keeping them updated on matters and seeking their opinions.

When important final decisions had to be made, Sam didn't mind being the one to make them. But he did so after many discussions among his constituents and his own private soul-searching. And, of course, his main concern was making sure that the decisions were in the best interest of the OVAC® student-athletes.

From a personal standpoint, if Sam became your friend, he was your friend for life. He was always there with a kind word, a bit of advice if it was asked for, and encouragement when any of his friends

were in a difficult situation.

I once wrote in a column that Sam was no saint, but that he was sent to us by angels to perform

good works and turn our impossible dreams into reality.

He dearly loved his wife, Nancy, who remained by his side through good times and rough times. No different from the rest of us, Nancy became part of the OVAC® family as well, taking care of the conference's financial books, a role she continues to handle today.


They were married just 11 years when Sam passed away. But, as Nancy once said, they

crammed 40 years of happiness into that short time.

A long bout with cancer terminated Mumley's life at the too young age of 67. But, as this writer has stated before, you won't make me believe "Sammy" lost that fight with cancer. Nothing defeated Sam Mumley in his lifetime. God, whom Sam believed in with all his heart, simply decided it was time to call him home.

Sam Mumley was one of a kind.

He will remain in our thoughts and prayers forever.

In the beginning... "1940" The First All★Star Game

West Virginia's senior All-Star schoolboys today held a 13 to 17 victory as the aftermath of their first meeting with the eastern Ohio team in the maiden football contest played under the new lighting system at the Island Stadium.

The victory of the mountain state youths, who had trailed from the opening quarter until the last seven minutes of the ball game, 7-0, came as a mild surprise as two well-drilled and highly efficient combinations delighted an early season crowd of some 8,000 fans.

The Ohioans drew first blood in the spectacular contest. A Mallery-Shackleford pass, late in the first period, moved the Buckeyes from midfield to the West Virginia 25. Sadlowski, another Bellaire back, took a pass that planted the ball on the nine, from where Sadlowski scored in two plays.

The remainder of the half was devoid of a distinct threat on the part of either team although the Rowe-Howell coached combine had advanced to the Ohio 25 when the intermission arrived.

The mountaineer sturdy rush line battled the equally effective Ohio forwards on fairly even terms into the final period before Johnny August, a Shadyside youth, who shared the starting role for the Bucks, was hit hard on his own 30 and Joe Corba, a Follansbee back, seized the white leather for the eventual winners.

Charlie Helinski, Union product, became a ball of fire at this stage. He wheeled off tackle to the Ohio 19 and then lugged the leather to the five aided by a too many times out penalty. Helinski picked up a yard and Mike "Punchy" Dimitro punched his way into the payoff zone. Dimitro cracked the line for the extra point and the issue was deadlocked.

Passes Decide Battle

The West Virginia stands settled back after this furious display satisfied with a 7-7 standoff, but the mountaineers were fired with the idea of victory when one of Joe Mallery's passes was intercepted near the 50 shortly after the succeeding kickoff.

Helinski niched successive passes to Phil Saseen and after the second toss to the Central Catholic back had planted the ball on the Ohioans nine. Helinski and Dimitro required three tries before the former had found the pay dirt and the West Virginia youths had a 13-7 lead.

The remaining time allowed for another kickoff and the West Virginians successfully negotiated an onside kick, recovering the ball as the fray ended.

Coaches Bill Kerns of WVU and Don C. Pedden of Ohio University were the honorary mentors and in addition to sitting on the benches of the contesting squads, both spoke over the P.A. system at halftime. Kerns was accompanied here by Frank Kutz, one of his line mentors, and Ray Carnelly, his plebe mentor. The trio departed today for Charleston and tonight's North-South Game, although Kerns had an opportunity to talk to some local prospects.

Bill Stobbs, the Wheeling native who tutors the Wittenberg athletic teams, was one of the spectators in the stands. Another was George Roark, coach of W & J's Presidents, and probably there were others.

Carl Hamill, Weirton's cagey tutor was in the dressing room to minister to a pair of his former Red Riders. Tony Brown aggravated an old should injury while Luke Tomasovich received a cracked rib.

The West Virginians showed big Sedor due respect while the prospective Ohio State youth was in the game. His Shadyside backfield mate, August despite his costly fumble, was one of the big guns in the Bucks' effort and the Niemiec-Hartwig combinations thrusts left the West Virginia fans worried.

Lou Caffaro; recovering from a nasal operation, held the sticks for the West Virginians but felt the call of battle in his impassive role. Paul Bricker, Weirton end who handled the kicking for Howell and Rowe, and did an effective job although one of his boots slipped off the side of his foot and out of bounds.

"1973" All-Star Game - 50 Years Ago

Quarterback Brian Book electrified a crowd of more than 9,000 sweltering fans at Wheeling Island Stadium Saturday night by hurling for 247 yards and four touchdowns, three of which were snagged by his former Magnolia High School teammate John "Fuzzy" Filliez, as the underdog West Virginia all-stars rose up to smack down a heavier Ohio team 38-24, in a wild-and-wooly 28th renewal of the interstate gridiron series.

It was a thrilling struggle from start to finish as the Buckeyes battled back from a 17-0 deficit and pulled within six points at 30-24 midway

through the third quarter.

Ohio had a chance to tie the score or go ahead early in the fourth quarter before ex-Linsly Cadet Andy Vrotsos and Magnolia's Steve Dills sparked a defensive surge which ended the Buckeyes hopes.

Book had scoring passes of 21 yards to Dills and bombs of 40 an 52 yards to Filliez. The Book-to-Filliez combination clicked again from nine yards out late in the game to wrap up the scoring.

The Mountaineers had 390 yards in total offense, with their top ground gainers being Brooke's Emmanuel Kohelis, with 67 yards in 19 carries, and Wheeling scat back Jim Tully, who had 47 in seven carries and made a TD.

Filliez made four catches for 118 yards while Dillis caught four for 62 yards.

W. Va. held a 17-9 edge in first downs. Two of the pick-offs were by Filliez, playing at defensive halfback, and the other was by Brooke's Rick Fankhouser, who also blocked a punt to give the Mountaineers a safety in the first half.

After intermission, West Virginia zoomed 63 yards in three plays, after the placement went wide, the winners held a 30-16 advantage.

Ohio had a chance wiped out on the next series when River QB Mike Flannery's deep pass was wrestled away

from Fankhouser at the Mountaineer

However, W. Va. was forced to kick and Barnesville's Kevin Welsh returned the punt 14 yards from the 40 to the W. Va. 26. On the next play, River's stumpy Dan McGuire hit off left tackle on a trap play and zipped to the end zone. Flannery added to the two points on a keep and Ohio trailed just 30-24 with 6:3 left in the third quarter.

W. Va. got its final score after a 46 yd. punt by Kohelis pinned the Bucks deep in their own territory at the five. Filliez picked off Flannery's desperation pass at the 30 and was knocked out of bounds at the 22. Three runs by Kohelis put the ball at the nine and Book found Filliez all alone in the left corner for the TD.

Filliez then ran right-end for the two pointer.

The victory for Coach Lou Nocida's charges was the twelfth scored by W. Va. in the long series. Ohio has won 16 times. The contest also marked the end of a coaching era as Ohio mentor Marty Flannery concluded his 24 yr. coaching career.

In the first quarter, Book found Wheeling Central tight end Phil Pest free down the middle for a 23 yd. gainer, which moved the ball to the Buckeye 28. Book fired to Magnolia buddy Steve Dills in the end zone with 8:50 left in the opening frame. Dave Forbes, also of Magnolia, came on to kick the extra point.

W. Va.'s defense provided the next two points as Brooke's Rick Funkhouser cracked through to block a punt by Alexander and covered the ball in the end zone for a safety.

Book engineered another beautifully-executed TD drive. Wheeling's Jim Tully had a key third-down six yard scamper, with a fifteen yard piling on penalty to advance the ball to the Ohio 46.

Buckeye West middle guard Doug Finney broke through and slammed

Book for a nine-yard loss. On the next play, Filliez uncorked a fifty-plus yard heave to Filliez. On the PAT, ball-holder Filliez picked up the ball, circled to the right and threw a strike to Brooke's Ramon Bowen for the two-pointer and a 17-0 lead, with more than nine minutes left in the half.

Ohio bounced right back on the passing of its talented QB, Mike Flannery, of River, to go 60 yards after Forbes kick-off went out of bounds. Cadiz great Cal Gregory was dumped for a five yard loss by Madonna's John DeSantis on the next play, but Flannery then threw a 41-yard strike down the center to fleet Beallsville back Kevin Welsh, putting the pigskin at the W. Va. 24.

The Bucks then dipped into their bag of tricks and tackle eligible pass to Martins Ferry's Mike Greenwell was to go to the four. Dan McGuire, River FB, scored two plays later off left tackle from the two. Flannery passed to Bellaire's Terry Brinker off a fake kick for the two-point conversion to cut the W. Va. lead to 17-8 with 6:05 on the clock in the second frame.

On the following Mountaineer possession, Tully sparked a surge after three runs for 34 yards, the last coming from the eight on a sweep of left end when he battled his way through two defenders and fell into the end zone. The kick by Forbes made it 24-8 with 4:40 left in the half.

After trading possessions, Ohio responded when a pass by Book from his own 14 was picked off by St. John's star Mike Rotilio, a defensive stalwart all night. 



Mike Young is no stranger to the OVAC All-Star Football Game. The veteran head coach will be making his third appearance in the late-July contest. He coached Ohio in 1991 with his St. Clairsville staff and West Virginia in 2013 with his Wheeling Central staff.

Joining Young are members of his Wheeling Central staff. They include: Jim Wolfe, Jason Rine, Shannon Kuchinski, Phil Pest, Mario DiBias, John Tankovits and Dylan Raker.

The following is a capsule look at the West Virginia coaching staff:

MIKE YOUNG — In 17 seasons at Wheeling Central, Young has compiled an OVAC Hall of Fame career by winning 175 of his 225 games. He has led the Maroon Knights to eight state championships (2005-07, 2010-11, 2017-19). They've also claimed three OVAC championships (2006-07, 2022).

His overall record at St. Clairsville and Wheeling Central is an impressive 226-91.

Young coached St. Clairsville to a pair of OVAC Tennis title (1983-84) and served as head pro at the Ohio Valley Raquet Club. He led the St. Clairsville boys basketball program to the district finals and also served as head boys basketball coach at Ohio University Eastern for one season.

Young and his wife, Carol, have three sons, John, Jason and Justin, and a daughter, Whitney. They also have three grandkids.

"It's an honor and privilege to coach in this game," Young said. "I remember when Rudy and Sam Mumley were involved. It's still all about the kids, though."

Young said he is excited to be a part of it again.

"This game has a lot of history and tradition."

JIM WOLFE – Wolfe is a 1965 graduate of Wheeling Central where he lettered four years. He has served as an assistant for the Maroon Knights for 39 years coaching the offensive line and defensive tackles. He started his coaching career at Blessed Trinity and St. John's. He has been a part of 11 W.Va. state championship teams and four OVAC titlists. He and his wife, Joyce, are the parents of Dr. Matthew Hartzell and his wife, Dr. Jennifer Hartzell. They have two grandsons, Jordan and Simon.

JASON RINE – Rine is in his 32nd season of coaching in the Ohio Valley. After one season at Brooke, he returned to his alma mater, Wheeling Central. He served as wide receiver and secondary coach on JT Thomas's staff, winning state titles in 2000, 2002 and 2004. In 2005, he became the offensive coordinator and the Maroon Knights have won eight state crowns. He was the WTOV Offensive Coordinator of the Year in 2007 and 2019. He and his wife, Heather, have three sons, Isaac, Jacob and Levi.

SHANNON KUCHINSKI – Kuchinski was a member of the 1993 Steubenville Catholic football team that captured the Ohio Division V state championship. He was also a two-time state track qualifier and played Rugby at Wheeling Jesuit University. He has served as the Maroon Knights defensive coordinator for the past six seasons and been an assistant for 11. He was the WTOV Defensive Coach of the Year in 2020. He and his wife, Kelly, have three children, daughter, Kendall, and sons, Camden and Easton.

PHIL PEST – Pest is a 1973 graduate of Wheeling Central and a 1977 graduate of Bethany. He earned three letters for the Bison and was all-conference three times. He taught at Ohio County Schools for a dozen years and at Buckeye Local for 17. He also served as head coach of the Panthers football program for three seasons and has coached at Wheeling Central for 14 seasons.
